Campbell led Gardner-Webb to a 27-24, second-half comeback win at Liberty, as the Bulldogs were down 17-0 at halftime. Campbell was 22-of-30 passing (73.3 percent) for 267 yards in the final 30 minutes - helping GWU score on each of its five drives in the second half against the nation's No. 4 scoring defense. On Gardner-Webb's decisive drive, Campbell led a 10-play, 65-yard drive that started at GWU's 12-yard line with 5-of-7 passing for 62 yards (12, 23, 4, 9, 14) to set up the game-winning field goal with :05 seconds left. He also completed a string of eight consecutive passes spanning the third and fourth quarters. Campbell finished the day with 293 yards passing on 26-of-41 attempts, with the 26 completions marking a season-high in the Big South this year.

NEW BALANCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JADA ROSS • LB • R-Junior
 Charleston Southern • Summerville, S.C.

Ross posted 20 tackles (eight solo, 12 assists), 1.5 tackles for loss (three yards), 0.5 sacks and a fumble recovery in Charleston Southern's 27-22 win over VMI. He was part of a defense that allowed just two offensive touchdowns in nine possessions, notched a key tackle for loss and fumble recovery in Buccaneer territory during the same drive mid-way through the fourth quarter, and recorded six of his tackles during VMI's final drive of the game, including a half-sack that forced a fourth-down and eventually the win for CSU. Ross also became the first player in Big South history to record two 20-tackle games in a season, as he had 20 stops Sept. 30 vs. North Greenville. For his efforts, Ross has been named one of *I-AA.org's* Weekly All-Stars for this week.

Smith boomed home two 40-plus yard field goals in the fourth quarter at Liberty, including the game-winning 40-yard kick with :05 seconds left to give GWU the 27-24 win. Smith kicked a 44-yard field goal to tie the game at 24-24 with 9:03 remaining - and had to hit that effort twice after offsetting penalties forced a re-kick. He also was a perfect 3-of-3 on PATs to finish with nine points, and averaged 57.5 yards on his six kickoffs with one touchback. Smith now has 10 career field goals of 40 yards-or-longer, most in Big South history.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

CHRISTIAN KELLY • Defensive Back

Kelly became the first player in Big South history to record three interceptions in one game when he picked off three Collin Drafts' passes Saturday at Charleston Southern. His first pick halted a drive at the VMI five-yard line and set up a 95-yard scoring drive by the Keydets for their first score of the game in the first quarter. Kelly ended another CSU drive in the first quarter with an interception at the VMI 25-yard line, and recorded his third pick at the 12:49 mark of the fourth quarter. Kelly also contributed three tackles and became the first VMI defender since 1973 to intercept three passes in a game.

BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE SEASON GETTING TIGHTER AND TIGHTER

For the second-straight week, Big South competition enjoyed down-to-the-wire finishes, as Gardner-Webb won on a last-second field goal at Liberty and Charleston Southern held off VMI. Through three games, each contest has been decided by five points-or-less, and the average margin of victory is 4.0 points. In 2005, the Conference had seven of its 10 games decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory at 10.5 points, the lowest average in Big South history.

STILL GOING ... CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EXTENDS WIN STREAK TO 12 GAMES

The 7-0, No. 19 Charleston Southern Buccaneers extended their win streak to 12 this past weekend, currently the second-longest winning streak in the nation, behind San Diego's 15-game streak. CSU's 12-game win streak also establishes the longest win streak in Big South history, breaking Coastal Carolina's record 10-game streak from 2004-05. CSU's seven-straight wins this season is the second-longest in-season winning streak in League history. The Bucs have won eight-straight home games as well.

START ME UP

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb are 1-0 in Conference play. CSU is 1-0 for just the second time in five years (2004). Coastal Carolina is 1-0 for the third-straight year, while Gardner-Webb is 1-0 for the first time since 2003 and third time overall. Charleston Southern has never opened 2-0 in League action. Coastal is looking for its third consecutive 2-0 start against Conference foes. Gardner-Webb has been 2-0 twice before in Big South games (2002, 2003).

THIGPEN ADDED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD LIST

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN was named to the revised Walter Payton Award Watch List, *The Sports Network* announced on Oct. 11. The list consists of 16 players who are under consideration for I-AA football's version of the Heisman Trophy as the top player in I-AA football and will be presented Thursday, Dec. 14 in Chattanooga, Tenn. Thigpen is the first ever Big South Conference player on the Payton Watch List. Former Gardner-Webb DB MARIO WILLIAMS was a Buck Buchanan Award defensive player of the year candidate in 2004.

ROLL CALL

The Big South Conference is enjoying a record-breaking season at the gate in 2006, as the five football members are averaging a combined 7,488 fans per game. The Conference has drawn a total attendance of 127,302 through 17 home dates (11 home games remaining). The League record attendance figure is 157,465 in 2004 (28 home dates), for a record average of 5,624.

BIG SOUTH ASSURED OF FIRST-EVER NON-CONFERENCE WINNING SEASON

The Big South improved its non-conference record to 18-12 in Week 7 with Charleston Southern's and Gardner-Webb's out-of-League wins, assuring the League's first-ever non-conference winning season in the five-year football history of the Big South. The five football members each have one non-conference game remaining, which at worst would give the League an 18-17 mark. The 18 non-conference wins sets a Big South record, surpassing the previous high of 17 non-League wins in 2003 during a 12-game season.

BIG SOUTH CURRENTLY SPORTING TWO TOP 25 PROGRAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in a national top 25 poll in the same week. Don Hansen's *National Weekly Football Gazette* has ranked Coastal Carolina (17th) and Charleston Southern (19th) in his Top 25 for the third consecutive week, while I-AA.org has Coastal ranked 23rd and Charleston Southern ranked 25th. The Chanticleers are also ranked No. 22 by *The Sports Network* and No. 23 in the CSN Coaches poll. Charleston Southern is 27th in the remaining two polls, while Gardner-Webb received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 this week for the first time this season.

PRICE CONTINUES TO ADD TO RECORD RECEIVING TOTALS

Charleston Southern junior WR MAURICE PRICE, who became the League's all-time leader in receptions and yardage in Week 7, became the first player in Big South history with 2,000 receiving yards this past weekend against VMI. Price caught 12 passes for 166 yards, increasing his record totals to 168 catches and 2,157 receiving yards. He surpassed VMI's ZOHN BURDEN in Week 7, who held the records of 151 catches for 1,936 yards. Price's 67 receptions this year are fifth-most in a season, and 13 shy from breaking the Conference's single-season record of 79, held by AARON DUNKLIN in 2003. He is on pace for 108.5 receptions this season.

HEAD RUSH

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5, is currently 10th all-time on the Big South's career rushing chart with 1,367. He needs eight yards to pass current Houston Texans RB and Liberty grad SAM GADO for ninth place (1,373).

The previous Big South record of two interceptions in a game was done 18 times, the last by Kelly's teammate **JAMAAL WALTON** in the season opener vs. Davidson.

TOTALLY OFFENSIVE

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who is first in I-AA in total offense with an average of 327.14 yards per game (2,290 total), is 484 total yards away from the Big South's single-season record of 2,773, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2004. Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by **COLLIN DRAFTS** in '04. He has recorded six 300-plus games of total offense, a Big South single-season record, and became the third player in Big South history with 6,000 career total yards in Week 6 vs. Furman. HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina junior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has caught a touchdown pass in his last three games (five total) and has nine touchdown receptions on the season, tying his career-high and four away from tying the Big South single-season record of 13. He became the fifth player in Big South history with 1,500 career receiving yards at VMI (1,537), and is four receptions away from 100 in his career. Of his 96 career receptions, 26 have been for touchdowns -- 27.1 percent.

VMI'S WILSON RETURNS TO LINEUP

VMI senior QB **JONATHAN WILSON** returned to the lineup this past week at Charleston Southern and did not show any signs of rust. He amassed 346 yards of total offense (12th most in Big South history), including 90 rushing yards. Wilson was 15-of-21 passing (71.4 percent) for 256 yards, a 17.1 yard average per completion. He surpassed 400 career completions in the contest and stands 97 yards away from becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 5,000 passing yards.

10-4 GOOD BUDDY

Four Big South quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is three away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 16 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 13 rushing touchdowns, ahead of **TYLER THIGPEN** (12).

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 40 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 36 contests, followed by VMI (24), Charleston Southern (16) and Liberty (14).

THE HUNT FOR SCARLET OCTOBER

Gardner-Webb placekicker **HUNTER SMITH** posted two 40-plus yard field goals Saturday at Liberty, increasing his career total from that distance to 10, most in Big South history. He is currently second in League annals with 35 field goals, trailing Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE**, who owns 37.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty sophomore RB **ZACH TERRELL** rushed for a season-high 175 yards Saturday vs. Gardner-Webb with two touchdowns while averaging 6.0 yards per carry. Terrell needs 126 rushing yards to pass **TRAVIS MAYS** (1,144) for 13th-place on the Big South career rushing list.

TURN OF THE CENTURY

Gardner-Webb duo **ALSTON GAINES** and **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** became the seventh and eighth players, respectively, in Big South history with 100 career receptions. The two surpassed the mark Saturday at Liberty. Gaines reached the milestone first with three catches in the first half. Meanwhile, Liberty WR **WYNTON JACKSON** surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards in the game, becoming the 13th player in League history to reach the total. MIZ KID

VMI senior RB **SEAN MIZZER** is the League's new career leader in rushing attempts, breaking the record this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. Mizzer is first all-time with 583 rushing attempts, breaking **DRE BARNES'** record of 563. Meanwhile, Mizzer is 94 yards away from become the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards. Barnes is the Big South's career rushing leader at 3,409.

JENNINGS STILL LEADS BIG SOUTH IN RUSHING

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South with 768 rushing yards -- which surpasses last season's top rusher in the Conference (**ANDRE COPELAND**, 721), but is hampered by an injury suffered against William & Mary in Week 7. Saturday against Gardner-Webb, Jennings saw limited action and rushed for five yards on two attempts. He is attempting to become the first Liberty rusher to lead the Big South in rushing since **DRE BARNES** in 2003. Jennings needs 232 yards to record just the fifth 1,000-yard rushing season in Big South history.

FLAMES' DEFENSE BURNING UP

The Liberty Flames still rank first in the Big South and sixth in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to 13.14 points per game (92 in 7 games). The Big South record for scoring defense in a season is 16.0, set by Coastal Carolina in 2004. The record for fewest points allowed is 176 points, held by the Chanticleers in '04. Liberty's defense is holding opponents to 290.3 yards per game, which is pacing ahead of the single-season Conference record of 313.6, set by Coastal Carolina in 2004.

COLLIN CARD

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career passing yards this during Week 5 against North Greenville, stands at 8,793 in his career -- 207 yards from the 9,000-yard barrier. Drafts recorded his fourth 300-plus game of total offense against Savannah State (363) in Week 6, his ninth career game with more than 300 total yards, extending his League record. Drafts' Big South record total offense total stands at 9,378.

PERK-OLATING

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards in Week 4, is currently fourth all-time at 2,158 -- 57 yards away from reaching former teammate **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) for third-place. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list, and is the League's all-time leader in touchdowns scored with 41 (all rushing).

WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark against South Carolina State in Week 4. He has 1,893 yards through seven games (270.4 per game) and is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. He is 702 yards shy of breaking the League's single-season passing record of 2,594. Meanwhile, Thigpen is fourth in the Conference with 397 rushing yards, and needs 41 yards to break his single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback (437). Earlier this season, he became the first QB in League history to record two 90-yard rushing games in the same year after his 91-yard effort against S.C. State in Week 4. He gained 94 at Wofford in Week 2.

COAST TO COAST

Coastal Carolina's offense set two Big South single-game records in Week 7 at VMI. The Chanticleers rushed for 330 yards on 28 carries, setting a League mark for yards per rush at 11.79. The old record was 8.97, set by Liberty earlier this season at Savannah State (33 for 296 on Sept. 23). Coastal Carolina's 9.91 average gain per play (555 yards on 56 plays) against the Keydets also broke the Big South single-game record of 9.65, which was established by Charleston Southern on Oct. 15, 2005 against West Virginia Wesleyan (695 yards on 72 plays).

LIBERTY ESTABLISHES LARGEST CROWD IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY
