### CHOICE HOTELS CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Tyler Thigpen • QB • Senior**  
 Coastal Carolina • Winnsboro, S.C.

Thigpen was key for the Chanticleers in their dramatic 41-38 road victory at No. 27 Wofford. He was 13-of-20 through the air for 288 yards, three touchdowns and no interceptions, and added 10 carries for a team-high 94 yards and one score on the ground. Thigpen, whose 382 yards of total offense is the fourth-highest single-game performance in Big South history, directed the Chanticleers on six scoring drives of 61 yards or more, including four of 80 yards or more. His 288 yards are the second most single-game passing yards in school history, while his 94 rushing yards are sixth-most in a game by a Big South quarterback. Thigpen also became the second quarterback in League history to surpass the 1,000-yard rushing mark in his career.

**Collin Drafts • QB • Senior**  
 Charleston Southern • Beaufort, S.C.

Drafts tied a Big South record with five touchdown passes in CSU's 38-35 double-overtime win at The Citadel, the program's first-ever win over the Bulldogs. Drafts was 24-of-35 passing (68.6 percent) for 320 yards, including a 25-yard scoring strike in the first overtime to Maurice Price. He led CSU on three touchdown drives of more than 60 yards and added 35 yards rushing for 355 yards of total offense - eighth-most in Big South history. Drafts' 320 yards are fifth-most in a game and he guided the Bucs offense to a 7.1 yards per play average (377 yards in 53 plays).

### NEW BALANCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Okeba Rollinson • CB • Sophomore**  
 Charleston Southern • Gastonia, N.C.

Rollinson posted seven tackles (five solo), 4.5 tackles for loss of 26 yards, 2.5 sacks (22 yards), one forced fumble and one pass break-up in CSU's win over The Citadel. On the first play from scrimmage in the second quarter, Rollinson caused a fumble with his first sack of the game. He posted another two tackles in the series (including one for minus three yards) to force a Bulldogs punt. Later in the quarter, he assisted on a sack that eventually led to another punt, and added another sack in the third quarter. Rollinson was part of a defense that allowed just 4.9 yards per play.

### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

**Stan Doolittle • Quarterback**  
 Gardner-Webb • Ninety Six, S.C.

Doolittle went 7-of-8 passing for 80 yards and a touchdown in Gardner-Webb's 30-26 win over Tennessee Tech. He entered the game on GWU's third drive of the night (second quarter) and calmly marched the Runnin' Bulldogs 76 yards in 13 plays (5:12) to deliver a touchdown pass of seven yards to Duvaughn Flagler. Later in the fourth quarter, Doolittle entered to complete a pass that led to a Gardner-Webb field goal that trimmed Tech's lead to 26-24. He finished the game with 13 rushing yards and 93 yards of total offense.

**Michael Hanna • Punter • Sophomore**  
 Gardner-Webb • Lawrenceville, Ga.

Hanna set a new school and Big South single-game record for punting average, booting five balls for an average of 52.8 yards against Tennessee Tech. Hanna's punts, in order, were 54, 57, 59, 56 and - in an attempt to pin TTU deep with GWU at the Tech 38 - 38 yards with less than a minute to play. Hanna pinned Tech inside the 20 three times, including his 59-yard kick that was downed at the one-yard line. TTU did not return any of his punts and its average start was its own 12-yard line. Hanna leads I-AA with an average of 48.8 yards per punt.

**BIG SOUTH CONTINUES IMPRESSIVE START WITH SECOND-STRAIGHT 4-1 WEEKEND**

The Big South is 8-2 after two weeks, the best start ever in the League's five-year football history. The previous best was 6-4, established last season. Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina each posted historical wins over SoCon members Saturday, while Gardner-Webb rallied to defeat OVC member Tennessee Tech. The League is 7-2 in the month of September thus far, just two wins shy of equalling its most in the month.

Meanwhile, the wins have not gone unnoticed, as Liberty has received Top 25 votes the first two weeks of the season, while Charleston Southern is 38th in the current *Football Gazette* Top 40 poll. Coastal Carolina is ranked 30th by *Football Gazette* and has been among the vote-getters in the first two regular-season Top 25 polls.

**BIG SOUTH KICKING FOR THREE**

The Big South has three teams at 2-0 for the first time in League history. Gardner-Webb is 2-0 for the second-straight year, joining Coastal Carolina (2003, 2004) as the only Big South programs to open 2-0 twice. Liberty is 2-0 for the first time since 1997, while Charleston Southern is 2-0 for the first time in school history. Gardner-Webb is looking to achieve its first 3-0 start since 1999, while Liberty is looking for its first 3-0 opening since 1997, when the Flames started 4-0. The Big South is looking for its first 3-0 squad since starting football in 2002.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UPS WIN STREAK TO SEVEN**

Charleston Southern defeated The Citadel in double overtime, 38-35, for its first win in four attempts against the Bulldogs. The win pushed CSU's win streak to seven -- currently third-longest in the nation. San Diego owns the longest streak at 10 games, while Brown is just ahead of the Bucs with eight-straight wins. Charleston Southern's seven-game win streak is tied for third-longest in Big South history (Coastal Carolina won seven-straight last season). Meanwhile, Charleston Southern opens its home schedule Saturday with a four-game home win streak as well.

**THIS WEEK'S SCHEDULE FEATURES TWO RANKED TEAMS**

The Big South will face two ranked opponents for the first time this season when Coastal Carolina travels to #17 Georgia Southern and VMI visits #8 Richmond Saturday. In addition, Liberty will face Towson, which received votes in two Top 25 polls this week. Last season, the League played eight games against ranked non-Conference foes, and 12 total with Coastal Carolina included. Next week's schedule (Sept. 23) could feature as many as three ranked opponents (Appalachian State, William & Mary and South Carolina State).

**PROGRAM ALERT**

Coastal Carolina's game Saturday at Georgia Southern will be televised live on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS). It will be the first of a League-record five television appearances for the Chanticleers this season. The game will also be Sirius Satellite Radio's National College Football Game of the Week as well.

**COASTAL'S THIGPEN RANKS FIRST IN NATION IN TOTAL OFFENSE**

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN is first in I-AA in total offense with an average of 349.50 yards per game (699 total). In the first two weeks of the season, Thigpen has recorded the top two passing games in school history (312 and 288) and his 382 yards of total offense at Wofford are fourth-most in a single-game in Big South history.

**MORE ON THIGPEN**

Against the Terriers, TYLER THIGPEN rushed for 94 yards, the sixth-highest single-game rushing total by a Big South QB in history. He also became the second QB in League history with 1,000 career rushing yards, and now owns 1,069, good for 13th all-time. Thigpen is 114 yards away of breaking NICK ROBERTS' quarterback rushing record of 1,182.

**THREE AMONG TOP 15 IN TWO STATISTICAL CATEGORIES**

The Big South and Pioneer League are the lone Conferences with three quarterbacks ranked among the top 12 nationally in Total Offense. As mentioned, TYLER THIGPEN is first, while DEVIN CAMPBELL is fourth and COLLIN DRAFTS is 12th. Meanwhile, the Big South, Pioneer and Southern each have three players among the top 15 in All-Purpose Yards. SEAN MIZZER is 10th, RASHAD JENNINGS is 14th and DUVAUGHN FLAGLER is 15th.

**JENNINGS OFF TO CONSISTENT START**

Liberty sophomore RB RASHAD JENNINGS is first in the nation in rushing yards with 321 and second with 160.50 per game. In his Flames debut Aug. 31, Jennings rushed for 160 yards and two touchdowns against St. Paul's. He totaled 161 yards and three touchdowns this past Saturday vs. Greenville State. Jennings' five touchdowns already match Liberty's individual leader from last season (MARCUS HAMILTON).

**MAKING THEIR POINT**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 35 games in its history, tying the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Liberty established the record from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 31 contests. Following GWU are VMI (18), Charleston Southern (11) and Liberty (9).

**FLAMES RECORD BIG SOUTH FIRST**

With its 31-7 win over Glensville State Saturday, the Liberty Flames became the first Big South squad ever to allow less than 10 points in back-to-back games. LU opened the season with a 27-0 shutout over St. Paul's Aug. 31, and ranks seventh in the nation in scoring defense at 3.5 points allowed per game. The last time Liberty held two opponents under 10 points in consecutive games was in 1995.

**MMM, GOOD**

Gardner-Webb starting QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** also turned in a notable performance this past weekend, helping the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 30-26 comeback in their home opener. The sophomore completed 17-of-34 passes for a career-best 298 yards and three touchdowns, and rushed for a team-high 55 yards to finish with a career-best 353 yards of total offense. The key stat came on the Bulldogs' game-winning drive, as Campbell orchestrated a 91-yard touchdown drive to give GWU its 30-26 lead, making three big plays along the way. He hit **AUSTIN GAINES** for a 49-yard gain to move out of the shadows of the GWU end zone, then - facing a key 3rd-and-11 situation, scrambled for 24 yards inside the Tech 20-yard line. Facing a third-and-goal at the TTU 17, Campbell responded by stepping out of a sure sack, rolling right and finding **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** in the end zone for his third scoring hookup of the day and a 30-26 lead.

**RETURN POLICY**

Gardner-Webb's **KORY ALSTON** and Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** are among the top punt returners in the nation through Week 2. Alston is second at 26.0 yards per return (4 for 104), while Jackson is 16th at 13.7 (10 for 137). Jackson's 137 punt return yards already rank as the 12th most in a single-season in the Big South, while Alston's is 17th. The single-season record for punt return yardage is 247, set by Alston last year.

**I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"**

Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** and VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** have each rushed for 100 yards in both games this season. The last Big South players to rush for 100 yards in consecutive games was **PATRICK HALL** and **DRE BARNES** in the last two weeks of 2004 (Nov. 13-20). Hall gained 157 and 195 yards in the span, while Barnes tallied 117 and 127 the final two games of '04. Hall and Barnes also were the last Big South players to rush for 100 yards in three-straight games (Nov. 6-20, 2004).

**THAT'S THE LENGTH OF FIVE FOOTBALL FIELDS, TO YOU AND ME**

Coastal Carolina (510) and Gardner-Webb (504) each eclipsed 500 yards of total offense this past Saturday, the fourth time in League history two squads reached the mark the same week. It was Gardner-Webb's ninth time over 500 yards of total offense since 2002, extending their League record, while Coastal surpassed the figure for the fourth time in its history. Coastal averaged 8.95 yards per play against Wofford (57 for 510), the second-highest per play average in Big South history. Charleston Southern owns the record of 9.65, set vs. West Virginia Wesleyan last season.

**NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ**

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER** continues to push towards the Big South career rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**. Following Saturday's 109 yard effort at Norfolk State, Mizzer now stands at 2,483 rushing yards in his Big South tenure (926 away from tying Barnes). It was Mizzer's 15th career 100-yard rushing game -- 12th as a Big South member, which is second all-time to Barnes' record of 17.

**PERKING UP**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who moved into fifth-place on the Big South's career rushing list in Week 1, is currently at 1,888 yards, 65 yards from passing former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON** for fourth all-time (1,952 yards). Perkins also is 112 yards shy of becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 2,000 rushing yards.

**UPDATING THE RUSHING LIST**

The Big South currently has 13 career 1,000-yard rushers, and that list will likely expand in the next few weeks. VMI's **NAT JACKSON**, who his 15th all-time at 848, needs 152 yards for 1,000, while Liberty sophomore **ZACH TERRELL** is 231 yards from the 1,000 milestone (769, 16th all-time).

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE** -- ranked No. 7 among all I-AA wide receivers by *The Sports Network* entering the season -- is currently first in the nation in receptions per game with 10.5. He grabbed 12 balls for 130 yards this past Saturday at The Citadel, which was his fourth game with at least 10 receptions -- setting a Big South career record. It was also his eighth career 100-yard receiving game, which extends his League mark.

**100% TOTAL**

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** added another Big South Conference career record to his resume this past week -- Total Offense Yards. Following his 355-yard effort Saturday at The Citadel, Drafts sits at 7,902 yards of total offense, breaking **NICK ROBERTS'** record of 7,872. Drafts is the Big South career leader in passing yards (7,579), attempts (1,082), completions (648), touchdown passes (58), passing yards per game (216.5), passing efficiency, total offensive plays (1,472) and total offense per game (225.8).

**THOUSAND ISLAND**

Gardner-Webb's **AUSTIN GAINES** and Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** became the 10th and 11th players, respectively, to surpass 1,000 career receiving yards this past weekend. Gaines is 10th at 1,070, just ahead of Simpson's total of 1,012. Former Charleston Southern WR **HARRY SEABROOK** owns the ninth spot at 1,101 yards.

**BABY BOOMER**

Gardner-Webb sophomore punter **MICHAEL HANNA** set a Big South single-game record for punting average against Tennessee Tech, booting five balls for 264 yards -- an average of 52.8. Hanna's punts, in order, were 54, 57, 59, 56 and 38. Three landed inside the 20 and Tech did not return any kicks. Hanna shared the previous record of 50.7 with former Bulldog **GRAHAM WHITLOCK**. Meanwhile, VMI punter **ADAM PETERS** averaged 46.4 yards on his five punts at Norfolk State, which is the 11th highest average in a single-game in Big South history.

**END ZONE CELEBRATIONS**

Three Big South wide receivers are vying for the League's career touchdown reception record. Coastal's **JEROME SIMPSON** is two scores away from tying the mark of 21, while Gardner-Webb's **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** is three shy of the record. Flagler's teammate, **KORY ALSTON**, is six away from the record, but four from Simpson's total.

**PRICE APPROACHING RECEIVING RECORDS**

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 1, continues to move up the League's career charts in receptions and yardage. He is now fourth in receptions with 120, and should vault into second place this week against Wingate, as former CSU receiver **AARON DUNKLIN** is second with 124. Price also moved into third-place with 1,667 career yards, and needs 82 to pass Dunklin for second on that list as well. Price stands 32 catches and 270 receiving yards away from becoming the Big South's career leader in both categories.

**ALSTON ALL ALONE AT THE TOP**

Gardner-Webb return specialist **KORY ALSTON** became the Big South's all-time leader in three punt return categories in Week 1. He is now the all-time leader in punt return touchdowns (3), return yards (402) and return average of 19.1 yards (21 for 402). In addition, Alston owns two of the three-longest punt returns in Big South history (80 and 76).

**DEFENSIVE MINDED**

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **MANNY ROJAS**, sixth all-time on the Big South's career tackle chart with 279, is 30 tackles shy of breaking the League's career total of 308, shared by former VMI standouts **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN**. He needs 13 more tackles to move past VMI's **ROBERT MASON** for fifth-place. Rojas is 21 hits away from becoming the fourth player in history with 300 stops.

**THERE IS A DRAFTS IN HERE**

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** tied the Big South record of five touchdown passes Saturday at The Citadel. He first reached the mark with five scoring strikes against North Greenville on Oct. 23, 2004. Gardner-Webb's **JEREMY MARTIN** was the first Big South QB to throw five TD passes in a game in 2002. Drafts also recorded his sixth career game with at least 300 yards passing Saturday night.

**WHAT'S THE SCORE?**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** reclaimed the Big South's career scoring lead with his first touchdown of the year and 39th career rushing score Saturday at Wofford. Perkins is now at 236 points, one point ahead of teammate PK **JOSH HOKE**, who is at 235. Hoke has 17 points on the young campaign (5-5 PATs, 4-5 FG).

**FLAMES' DEFENSE BURNS OUT ST. PAUL'S OFFENSE, JUST MISSES LEAGUE RECORD**

The Liberty Flames' defense allowed just 57 yards of total offense to St. Paul's in the season opener Aug. 31 (37 rush, 20 pass) on 40 plays. The 57 total offensive yards fell one yard short of tying the Big South record for fewest total offensive yards allowed. The 2003 Liberty Flames allowed 56 yards against Kentucky Wesleyan (-20 rush, 76 pass) on Sept. 20, 2003. The 20 passing yards allowed (3-of-13) was the third-fewest allowed in Big South history, behind Charleston Southern (16 vs. Elon on 2-of-4 in 2002) and Gardner-Webb's league-record of 15 vs. Georgia Southern in 2002 (1-of-5 passing).

**THE INCREDIBLE HOKE**

Coastal Carolina senior PK **JOSH HOKE** tied a Big South single-game record with his four field goals Saturday against Elon in Week 1. Hoke joined former VMI kicker **MATT SHARPE**, who set the record vs. Gardner-Webb on Oct. 18, 2003 and tied it at Coastal Carolina on Nov. 1, 2003. Hoke attempted five field goals on the night, tying the Conference's single-game record as well. He finished with 12 points against Elon, marking his eighth career game scoring 10-or-more points.

**BIG SOUTH ADDS TWO NEW MEMBERS**

On April 6, 2006, the Big South Conference announced that Presbyterian College will join the League, effective in 2007-08. The 2005 Blue Hose football team finished 10-2 overall, hosted a second round Division II playoff game and was ranked 10th nationally by the AFCA. Presbyterian is the alma mater of Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT**. PC will play a Conference schedule beginning in 2008. Meanwhile, the Big South announced on May 26 that Gardner-Webb, an associate football member, would join the League as full members beginning in 2008-09.
