OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**TYLER THIGPEN • QB • Senior**  
 Coastal Carolina • Winnsboro, S.C.

Thigpen was 19-of-26 passing (73.1 percent) for 279 yards and a school-record four touchdowns in Coastal's 31-12 win at Winston-Salem State. He finished with a 213.98 passing efficiency against the Rams, while his 73.1 completion percentage is seventh-best in League history. Thigpen also rushed for a team-high 57 yards and finished the day with 336 yards of total offense - his fourth game this season over 300 total yards, a Big South single-season record. He had a long rush of 50 yards in the third quarter, and became the Big South's all-time leading quarterback rusher during the contest, finishing with 1,233 to pass Gardner-Webb's Nick Roberts (1,182).

**NEW BALANCE  
DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**MARIO E. BROWN • LB • Sophomore**  
 Gardner-Webb • Greenville, S.C.

Brown broke the Big South single-game mark for total tackles Saturday against Southeastern Louisiana with 25 hits (15 solo, 10 assist) against the Lions - including four on the game-deciding drive that halted SELU's final chance to tie the game with less than a minute remaining. Brown's third quarter interception and 21-yard return set up a Gardner-Webb touchdown. Late in the game, he stopped a Lions' receiver for just a one yard gain on third and five inside the GWU six-yard line, and then forced the quarterback to overthrow on fourth down to seal the Bulldogs' 28-21 win. Brown's 15 solo tackles are also a career-high, and he finished the day with a personal-best three tackles for loss (eight yards) and two quarterback hurries.

**MICHAEL HANNA • Punter • Sophomore**

Hanna continued his fine punting this season as he averaged 44.3 yards on six punts at Southeastern Louisiana, pinning the Lions inside their own 20 yard line twice and holding SELU to an average start of its own 18 yard line on his six kicks. He booted long kicks of 52, 48 (twice) and 41 and finished with a net average of 41.7 yards, as Southeastern managed just 16 yards on three returns (5.3 average).

**FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK**

**DAVID MONTGOMERY • RB**  
 Gardner-Webb • Sugar Hill, Ga.

Montgomery had a breakout game in the backfield, rushing for a career-high 93 yards on just six carries (15.5 average) in the Bulldogs' 28-21 win at Southeastern Louisiana. Late in the fourth quarter with the game tied 21-21, Montgomery raced 73 yards - the fourth-longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history -- to set up the game-winning score for Gardner-Webb. He also had key runs of eight and 10 yards in succession on the Bulldogs' previous scoring drive as well.

**BIG SOUTH TO APPEAR ON ESPN NETWORK FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT WEEK**

Big South Conference football will appear on an ESPN property for the third-straight weekend this Saturday when VMI visits Army live on ESPN Classic at 1:00pm. The Conference's first appearance was Sept. 23 on ESPNU (Appalachian State at Gardner-Webb, tape-delayed), followed by this past weekend's Liberty at Wake Forest game on ESPN360.

**GARDNER-WEBB'S MARIO E. BROWN TACKLES TWO NATIONAL HONORS**

Big South New Balance Defensive Player of the Week **MARIO E. BROWN** has been named National Defensive Player of the Week by *The Sports Network* and a *I-AA.org* Weekly All-Star following his Big South single-game record of 25 total tackles at Southeastern Louisiana. He surpassed the previous record of 24, set by teammate **MIKE PAVELKO** in last year's triple-overtime win at VMI. Of the four players with 20 tackles in a game, three are from Gardner-Webb (Brown, Pavelko and **MARIO WILLIAMS**, who had 22 vs. Savannah State in 2002).

**BIG SOUTH CAPTURES WINNINGEST SEPTEMBER**

The Big South concluded the month of September with a 13-10 record (.565), the League's most wins in the traditional first month of the season and just the second winning record in September. The previous record for wins was nine, set in 2003 and equalled in 2005. The last time the Conference posted a winning record in September was '02 (8-6), the League's first year of football.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN OWNS SECOND-LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN NATION**

The 4-0 Charleston Southern Buccaneers extended their win streak to nine this past weekend, currently the second-longest winning streak in the nation, behind San Diego's 12-game streak. CSU's nine-game win streak is tied for second-longest in Big South history, matching Gardner-Webb's nine-game streak from 2002-03. The Big South record for consecutive wins is 10, set by Coastal Carolina from 2004-05.

**HEAD RUSH**

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks this past weekend at Winston-Salem State. He finished the game with 57 rushing yards on six carries to increase his career rushing total to 1,233 yards, surpassing former Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS'** record of 1,182. Thigpen is now 10th all-time on the Big South's career rushing chart, and needs 142 yards to pass current Houston Texans RB and Liberty grad **SAM GADO** for ninth place (1,373).

**TOUGH SCHEDULE**

A Big South football member faces a nationally-ranked opponent for the fourth-straight week this coming Saturday, as Coastal Carolina hosts No. 3 Furman. Last season, Big South members faced a nationally-ranked opponent nine out of 12 weeks.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 38 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Liberty held the previous record of 35-straight games with a point from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 34 contests, followed by VMI (21), Charleston Southern (13) and Liberty (12).

**TONIGHT ON 20/20**

Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** recorded a career-high 20 stops (7 solo, 13 assists) Saturday vs. North Greenville to become the third player in League history to post 20 tackles in a game. Later that night, **MARIO E. BROWN** became the fourth with his record-breaking 25 at SE Louisiana.

**TOTALLY OFFENSIVE**

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who is second in I-AA in total offense with an average of 331.40 yards per game (1,657 total), is 1,117 total yards away from the Big South's single-season record of 2,773, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2004. Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by **COLLIN DRAFTS** in '04. He has recorded four 300-plus games of total offense, a Big South single-season record, and needs 71 yards to become the third player in Big South history with 6,000 career total yards. **JENNINGS CHALLENGING LEAGUE'S SEASON RUSHING RECORD**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has fallen off his pace -- for now -- to break the Big South's single-season rushing record of 1,347, set by Liberty's **DRE BARNES** in 2003. Jennings would need to average 128.5 yards per game over the next six games to break the mark. He is currently averaging 115.4 yards per game (15th in the country), which would equal 692.4 over the six-game span, and combined with his current total of 577, he would finish at 1,269.

**SIMPSON BECOMES BIG SOUTH'S CAREER TOUCHDOWN RECEPTIONS LEADER**

Coastal Carolina junior **JEROME SIMPSON** moved into sole possession of first-place on the Big South's career touchdown receiving chart this past weekend with two scores at Winston-Salem State, increasing his career total to 23. For the past two weeks, he shared the record of 21 with **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** Simpson's career touchdown total represents 28.4 percent of his career receptions (81).

**TACKLE BOX**

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **MANNY ROJAS**, who entered the season seventh on the Big South's career tackle chart, is currently tied for fourth all-time with **MARIO WILLIAMS** at 299, and is 10 tackles shy of setting the League mark. Coastal Carolina's **JAMAR LEATH** is behind Rojas with 293 career stops, and due to Liberty's bye week this weekend, will have first chance at becoming the fourth player in League history with 300. **PRICE CHECK**

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 1, is closing in on the League's all-time receiving records. He is second all-time with 138 receptions, and needs 13 to match **ZOHN BURDEN**'s career mark of 151. Price is now second all-time with 1,807 career yards after passing **AARON DUNKLIN** this past Saturday against North Greenville. Price stands 130 yards away of breaking Burden's Big South record of 1,936 career receiving yards.

**FLAMES DEFENSE STILL BURNING HOT**

The Liberty Flames rank first in the Big South and fifth in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to 10.20 points per game (51 in 5 games). The Big South record for scoring defense in a season is 16.0, set by the Chanticleers in 2004. Liberty has posted two shutouts this season, becoming just the second team in Big South history to whitewash two opponents in one campaign. Gardner-Webb was the first in 2003. The Flames' defense has limited opponents to less than 10 points in three games this year, the most since Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina did it three times in 2004.

**WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND**

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark against South Carolina State in Week 4. He has 1,394 yards through five games (278.8 per game) and is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. He is 1,201 yards shy of breaking the League's single-season passing record of 2,594. Meanwhile, Thigpen is fourth in the Conference with 263 rushing yards this season, and needs 175 yards to break his single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback (437). Earlier this season, he became the first QB in League history to record two 90-yard rushing games in the same year after his 91-yard effort against S.C. State in Week 4. He gained 94 at Wofford in Week 2.

**COLLIN CARD**

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career passing yards this past weekend against North Greenville. He now has 8,082 is his career. Drafts also became the first player in Big South history to eclipse 8,000 career total offensive yards during Week 3. Drafts recorded his third 300-plus game of total offense Saturday against the Crusaders (320), his eighth career game with more than 300 total yards, extending his League record. Drafts' Big South record total offense total stands at 8,524.

**WAKE UP CALL**

Despite falling to Division I-A Wake Forest 34-14 this past Saturday, the Liberty Flames managed to score the most points against the Demon Deacons this season. The most points Wake had previously allowed was 13 vs. Duke. In addition, the Flames posted the third-most total yards this year vs. Wake (301) and passed for the second-most in game (216) against the Wake defense. The Flames' rushing game gained a respectable 85 yards on the ground, bettering the Deacs' season average of 76.5 entering the contest.

**10-4 GOOD BUDDY**

Four quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is five away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 14 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. **VMI's JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 12 rushing scores, followed by **TYLER THIGPEN** with 10.

**BABY BOOMER**

Gardner-Webb sophomore punter **MICHAEL HANNA**, who set a Big South single-game record with a 52.8 punting average in Week 2 against Tennessee Tech, is averaging 45.0 yards per punt this season and is challenging **GRAHAM WHITLOCK's** League record of 45.5. Hanna has averaged at least 43.8 yards per punt in four out of five games this season, and has booted eight 50-yard-plus punts this year. He is currently second in the nation in punting.

**NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ**

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER** continues to push towards the Big South career rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**. Mizzer now stands at 2,660 rushing yards in his Big South tenure (749 away from tying Barnes), and needs to average 125.0 per game over the remaining six contests to reach the mark. He is 340 yards shy of becoming the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards. Mizzer is currently averaging 91.80 yards per game, and has posted three 100-yard rushing games this season. He has 13 as a Big South member, which is second all-time to Barnes' League record of 17, and 16 overall in his VMI career.

**PERK-OLATING**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards following his 18-carry, 78-yard performance against South Carolina State in Week 4. Perkins surpassed former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON** (1,952) for fourth all-time in the process and is currently at 2,047 -- 168 yards away from reaching former teammate **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) for third-place. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list.

**EIGHT IS NOT ENOUGH**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South with eight touchdowns and 48 points, and is 11th nationally in scoring with 9.60 points per game. His eight TDs have all come on the ground, tied for the ninth-most in a single-season. Jennings has recorded two games with three rushing scores, the first player since **SAM GADO** accomplished the feat in 2004. The League record for rushing touchdowns is 14, shared by Coastal's **AUNDRES PERKINS** and Liberty's **EUGENE GOODMAN** in 2003. Jennings is closing in on becoming just the fifth Big South player with 10 rushing touchdowns in a season.

**TURNING THE PAGE**

Liberty WR **BRANDON TURNER** became the 12th player in League history with 1,000 career receiving yards following his four-catch, 84-yard performance Saturday at Wake Forest. He is currently 12th all-time with 1,002 yards and needs an even 100 to move into 11th. Meanwhile, both **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** and **JEROME SIMPSON** are poised to surpass former Liberty WR **LAUREN WILLIAMS**, who is sixth all-time with 1,391. Flagler is seventh at 1,361, while Simpson is 20 yards behind him at 1,341.

**LIBERTY SETS TEAM DAYLIGHT RECORD IN NIGHT GAME AT SAVANNAH STATE**

Liberty rushed for 296 yards on 33 carries at Savannah State in Week 4 for a Big South single-game record 8.97 yards per carry. The old record was 8.82, set by Charleston Southern last season vs. West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15. The Bucs rushed for 397 yards on 45 attempts in that game.

**BICENTENNIAL MEN**

The Big South's career scoring record is up for grabs, as **AUNDRES PERKINS** and **JOSH HOKE** continue to go back-and-forth for the overall lead. Hoke is currently first with 252 career points, just ahead of Perkins (248). Perkins, the all-time non-kick scoring leader, has 18 points thus far, compared to Hoke's 34 kick points (12-12 PATs, 6-9 FG). Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **HUNTER SMITH** is approaching the 200 point club, as he has scored 195 during his career. Smith has 19 points this season (7-7 PATs, 4-5 FG).
