**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**JEROME SIMPSON • WR • Junior**  
 Coastal Carolina • Reidsville, N.C.

Simpson posted one of the best games in Big South history at No. 17 Georgia Southern. Simpson recorded eight catches for a school-record 207 yards and two touchdowns (30 and 58 yards). His 207 yards are only the second 200-yard receiving game in League history (three shy of the record), while his two touchdowns move his career total to 21, tying him with William Andrews, Jr. for the Big South career touchdown receptions lead. During a second-quarter drive, Simpson caught a pair of passes, the first for 50 yards and the second for 30 to complete the two-play, 80-yard touchdown drive in 0:36. Seven of his eight catches were at least 10 yards (14, 10, 23, 50, 30, 14, 58) while six went for first downs.

**NEW BALANCE**  
**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**MANNY ROJAS • LB • R-Senior**  
 Liberty • Oakdale, Pa.

Rojas tied for the team-high tackling honors with nine stops in Liberty's defensive battle at Towson. It was his best defensive performance of the season as he entered the game with just seven tackles in his first two outings. He finished the game with a career-high two pass break-ups and helped the Flames extend their streak of three sacks per game with a nine-yard takedown in the first quarter that eventually forced a Towson punt. Rojas also stopped two third-down conversion attempts and was part of a defense that allowed just 10 points and a modest 317 yards on the night. Liberty currently ranks third in the nation in scoring defense (5.67 points per game), 13th in sacks per game and 17th in total defense (226.33 yards per game).

**BEN BEASLEY • Punter/Kicker • Senior**

Beasley had a career night punting for the Flames at Towson as he booted on a career-high nine punts for a career-high 349 yards. He averaged a personal-best 38.8 yards per punt and kept the Flames in a defensive contest with solid punting all night. Beasley booted two 50-yard punts, including a career-long 56-yarder in the second quarter, and his final five kicks averaged 45.8 yards. He also gave Liberty its lone points of the game with a 27-yard field goal in the fourth quarter, while Towson started at its own 15-yard line on his two kickoffs. Beasley's nine punts tied for third-most in a game in Big South history, while his yardage was seventh-best all-time.

**FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK**

**JAMAR ANDERSON • WR**

Anderson was Coastal's second-leading receiver Saturday at Georgia Southern. He had four catches for 52, a season best for the freshman. In just his second game of collegiate action, Anderson had two catches that gave the Chanticleers first downs, and he hauled in three passes and 47 yards during one drive, including a personal-best 33-yard reception. His four catches were the third-most by a CCU receiver this year.

**BIG SOUTH TO RECEIVE NATIONAL EXPOSURE ON ESPN THIS SATURDAY**

The Big South will have its first football game televised on ESPN's Family of Networks this weekend when ESPN broadcasts Gardner-Webb's 6:00pm home match-up against defending national champion Appalachian State on same-day tape-delay at 10:00pm. The broadcast was added to the TV schedule late last week, and increases the League's scheduled televised games this year to eight. VMI's Oct. 7 game at Army will also be carried by an ESPN network, which will be announced at a later date.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UPS WIN STREAK TO EIGHT; FIRST 3-0 BIG SOUTH SQUAD**

Charleston Southern became the first team to start 3-0 since the Big South started football in 2002 with its 20-17 comeback win over Wingate last Saturday. The win pushed CSU's win streak to eight -- currently third-longest in the nation. San Diego owns the longest streak at 11 games, while Brown is just ahead of the Bucs with nine-straight wins. Charleston Southern's eight-game win streak is third-longest in Big South history, behind Gardner-Webb's nine-game streak from 2002-03. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern has won its last five home games as well.

**BIG SOUTH TWO WINS AWAY FROM WINNINGEST SEPTEMBER**

The Big South is 8-6 in the month of September thus far, just two wins shy of establishing its most wins in the traditional first month of the season with two weekends left. The record is nine wins, set in 2003 and equalled in 2005.

**BIG SOUTH FACES DEFENDING NATIONAL CHAMPION FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR**

Gardner-Webb hosts defending Division I-AA National Champion Appalachian State this Saturday, marking the second-straight year a Big South squad hosts the defending national champion. Last year, Coastal Carolina upset defending champion and then-No. 1 James Madison 31-27 in Conway. Appalachian State is currently ranked No. 2 in the country and is the first ranked opponent on Gardner-Webb's schedule this season. GWU has played at least three ranked opponents each year since 2003.

**GEORGIA (SOUTHERN) ON HIS MIND**

Coastal Carolina junior **JEROME SIMPSON** posted a record-breaking day at Georgia Southern this past Saturday. He caught eight passes for 207 yards and two touchdowns, averaging 25.9 yards per catch. He became the second player in League history to post more than 200 yards receiving in a game, and his 207 yards are second-most in League annals -- just three yards from tying the record. Simpson's two touchdowns gave him 21 in his career, tying **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** as the Big South's career leader in the category. And the 25.9 average is fourth-highest in a game with at least five receptions.

**COASTAL'S THIGPEN FIRST PLAYER WITH THREE-STRAIGHT 300 TOTAL OFFENSE GAMES**

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who remains first in I-AA in total offense with an average of 343.67 yards per game (1031 total), became the first player in Big South history to record more than 300 total offensive yards in three-straight games this past weekend. He opened the season with 317 vs. Elon, notched 382 the next week at Wofford and totaled 332 last Saturday at Georgia Southern. Thigpen also has tied the single-season League record for most 300-yard total offense games (three).

**COLLIN CARD**

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career total offensive yards Saturday against Wingate. His 302-yard effort against the Bulldogs pushed his Big South record total to 8,204. It was his seventh career game with more than 300 total yards, breaking the career record held by **NICK ROBERTS** (6). Drafts rushed for a personal-high 90 yards Saturday, which is tied for the eight-most by a QB in a single-game in League history. Meanwhile, he is 209 passing yards away from becoming the first Big South QB to throw for 8,000 yards.

**FLAMES DEFENSE ON FIRE**

The Liberty Flames are the first team in Big South history to hold three-straight opponents to 10 points-or-less. Liberty held Towson to 10 points this past Saturday, after limiting Glenville State to seven points in Week 2 and shutting out St. Paul's in the season opener. Liberty is the first Big South squad ever to hold an opponent to less than 10 points in consecutive games, and currently ranks third in the nation in scoring defense (5.67 points per game), 13th in sacks per game and 17th in total defense (226.33 yards per game).

**WEB-TV GUIDE**

The Liberty Flames' Sept. 30 game at Wake Forest will be broadcast live on ESPN360, which is part of ESPN.com's broadband video service. It will be the Big South's first appearance on the web-only medium. Kickoff is scheduled for 3:30pm.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE**

Big South football members face a nationally-ranked opponent for the second-straight week this coming Saturday, as Gardner-Webb hosts No. 2 Appalachian State. The trend is likely to continue next week as VMI hosts current No. 15 James Madison. Last season, Big South members faced a nationally-ranked opponent nine out of 12 weeks.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 36 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Liberty held the previous record of 35-straight games with a point from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 32 contests, followed by VMI (19), Charleston Southern (12) and Liberty (10).

**NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ**

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER** continues to push towards the Big South career rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**. Mizzer now stands at 2,517 rushing yards in his Big South tenure (892 away from tying Barnes). He has two 100-yard rushing games this season and 12 as a Big South member, which is second all-time to Barnes' record of 17. Overall, Mizzer has rushed for 100 yards in a game 15 times in his VMI career.

**A YOUNG 40**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the first Big South player to reach 40 career touchdowns when he rushed for a score Saturday at Georgia Southern. Meanwhile, Perkins, who moved into fifth-place on the Big South's career rushing list in Week 1, is currently at 1,949 yards, just four yards from passing former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON** for fourth all-time (1,952 yards). Perkins also is 51 yards shy of becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 2,000 rushing yards.

**PRICE MOVES INTO SECOND ON BIG SOUTH RECEPTIONS CHART**

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 1, continues to move up the League's career charts in receptions and yardage. He is now second all-time in receptions with 128 after passing **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** and **AARON DUNKLIN** this past weekend vs. Wingate. Price remains in third-place with 1,738 career yards, and needs 11 to pass Dunklin for second on that list as well. Price stands 24 catches and 199 receiving yards away from becoming the Big South's career leader in both categories.

**DEFENSIVE MINDED**

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **MANNY ROJAS**, sixth all-time on the Big South's career tackle chart with 288, is 21 tackles shy of breaking the League's career total of 308, shared by former VMI standouts **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN**. He needs four more tackles to move past VMI's **ROBERT MASON** for fifth-place. Rojas is 12 hits away from becoming the fourth player in League history with 300 stops.

**AN AIR ABOUT HIM**

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** is on the cusp of becoming the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season. He has 916 yards through three games (305.3 per game), and broke his own single-game school record for passing yards for the second time in three weeks. After throwing for 312 yards against Elon in Week 1, Thigpen totaled 316 yards Saturday at Georgia Southern. He is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the other with three such games in 2004.

**RETURN POLICY**

Gardner-Webb's **KORY ALSTON** and Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** are among the top punt returners in the nation through Week 3. Alston is second at 26.40 yards per return (5 for 132), while Jackson is 23rd at 12.31 (13 for 160). Jackson's 160 punt return yards already rank as the eighth-most in a single-season in the Big South, while Alston's is 13th. The single-season record for punt return yardage is 247, set by Alston last year.

**AIR MAIL**

Coastal Carolina is averaging 310.0 passing yards a game, the top mark in all of I-AA football and almost double the school record of 158.1 yards per game in 2005. **TYLER THIGPEN** is leading the charge, ranking first in the country at 305.3 yards per contest. If Coastal and Thigpen can maintain their respective averages, they would become the first Big South squad and QB to average 300 yards passing in a single-season. The League's team record is 264.9, set by Gardner-Webb in 2005, while **COLLIN DRAFTS** owns the individual mark of 253.2 in 2004.

**HONOR ROLL**

Several Big South football student-athletes were recognized last week for their efforts in Week 2. **COLLIN DRAFTS** was named a *I-AA.org* Weekly All-Star as well as one of *Football Gazette's* National Offensive Players of the Week. **TYLER THIGPEN** was honored as *CollegeSportsReport.com's* I-AA Performer of the Week as well as by *Football Gazette*. *Football Gazette* also bestowed national player of the week honors on **OKIBA ROLLINSON** (defense) and **MICHAEL HANNA** (special teams). Following Week 1, **JAMAAL WALTON** has one of *Football Gazette's* National Defensive Players of the Week.

**THOUSAND ISLAND**

Following his 207-receiving yard output Saturday at Georgia Southern, Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** vaulted two spots on the Big South's career receiving yards list. He is now ninth all-time at 1,219, and needs 14 yards to move past **GARY PRICE** for eighth place. He is 46 yards shy of catching Gardner-Webb's **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (seventh) at 1,265. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb's **AUSTIN GAINES** is 32 yards from the all-time top 10 (**HARRY SEABROOK** - 1,101).

**WHAT'S THE SCORE?**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** reclaimed the Big South's career scoring lead in Week 2 after teammate **JOSH HOKE** tied him in Week 1 at 230. Perkins is now at 242 points after scoring touchdowns the last two games, and is four points ahead Hoke, who is at 238. Hoke has 20 points on the season (8-8 PATs, 4-5 FG) thus far.

**T-MOBILE**

Against Wofford in Week 2, **TYLER THIGPEN** became the second QB in League history with 1,000 career rushing yards, and now owns 1,085, good for 13th all-time. Thigpen is 98 yards away of breaking **NICK ROBERTS'** quarterback rushing record of 1,182.

**I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"**

Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** and VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** each rushed for 100 yards in their first two games this season. The last Big South players to rush for 100 yards in consecutive games was **PATRICK HALL** and **DRE BARNES** in the last two weeks of 2004 (Nov. 13-20). Hall gained 157 and 195 yards in the span, while Barnes tallied 117 and 127 the final two games of '04.

**BIG SOUTH'S BEN FRANKLINS**

Despite their lowest rushing totals of the season this past weekend, **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **SEAN MIZZER** are still averaging 100 rushing yards per game. Jennings is 19th in the nation with a 116.0 per game average, while Mizzer is 25th at 105.33. The Big South has not had two rushers average 100.0 yards a game since 2004, when a record four players averaged triple digits.

**THAT'S THE LENGTH OF FIVE FOOTBALL FIELDS, TO YOU AND ME**

Coastal Carolina (510) and Gardner-Webb (504) each eclipsed 500 yards of total offense in Week 2, the fourth time in League history two squads reached the mark the same week. It was Gardner-Webb's ninth time over 500 yards of total offense since 2002, extending their League record, while Coastal surpassed the figure for the fourth time in its history. Coastal averaged 8.95 yards per play against Wofford (57 for 510), the second-highest per play average in Big South history. Charleston Southern owns the record of 9.65, set vs. West Virginia Wesleyan last season.

**FULL PRICE**

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE** -- ranked No. 7 among all I-AA wide receivers by *The Sports Network* entering the season -- is currently first in the nation in receptions per game with 9.67. He has 29 catches through three games, and ranks ninth nationally in receiving yards per game with 98.0 Price grabbed 12 balls for 130 yards in Week 2 at The Citadel, which was his fourth game with at least 10 receptions -- setting a Big South career record. It was also his eighth career 100-yard receiving game, which extended his League mark.

**BABY BOOMER**

Gardner-Webb sophomore punter **MICHAEL HANNA** set a Big South single-game record for punting average in Week 2 against Tennessee Tech, booting five balls for 264 yards -- an average of 52.8. Hanna's punts, in order, were 54, 57, 59, 56 and 38. Three landed inside the 20 and Tech did not return any kicks. Hanna shared the previous record of 50.7 with former Bulldog **GRAHAM WHITLOCK**. Meanwhile, VMI punter **ADAM PETERS** averaged 46.4 yards on his five punts at Norfolk State that week, which is the 11th highest average in a single-game in Big South history.

**ALSTON ALL ALONE AT THE TOP**

Gardner-Webb return specialist **KORY ALSTON** became the Big South's all-time leader in three punt return categories in Week 1. He is now the all-time leader in punt return touchdowns (3), return yards (430) and return average of 19.5 yards (22 for 430). In addition, Alston owns two of the three-longest punt returns in Big South history (80 and 76).

**THERE IS A DRAFTS IN HERE**

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** tied the Big South record of five touchdown passes in Week 2 at The Citadel. He first reached the mark with five scoring strikes against North Greenville on Oct. 23, 2004. Gardner-Webb's **JEREMY MARTIN** was the first Big South QB to throw five TD passes in a game in 2002. Drafts also recorded his fifth career game with at least 300 yards passing in that game.

**TWO NEW MEMBERS SET TO JOIN BIG SOUTH**

On April 6, 2006, the Big South Conference announced that Presbyterian College will join the League, effective in 2007-08. Presbyterian is the alma mater of Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** and will play a Conference schedule beginning in 2008. Meanwhile, the Conference announced on May 26 that Gardner-Webb, an associate football member since the start of Big South football in 2002, would join the League as full members beginning in 2008-09.
