Campbell earns his second straight weekly award after leading Gardner-Webb to its fourth, fourth quarter come-from-behind win this season, as the Bulldogs defeated VMI, 35-31. Campbell led the Bulldogs back from two deficits during the game. He first brought Gardner-Webb back from a 16-7 halftime hole, directing two scoring drives of 61 yards-or-longer in the third quarter and capping them off with touchdown passes to Kory Alston to give GWU a 21-16 lead. Late in the fourth stanza with VMI leading 31-28, Campbell directed the game-winning 12-play, 80-yard drive in 4:13. He was 5-of-8 passing for all 80 yards through the air, hitting Duvaughn Flagler on a five-yard fade route with 3:05 remaining. Campbell passed for 223 of his 279 yards in the final two quarters and finished the game 21-of-34 passing with three touchdowns.

Teal recorded a career-high 13 tackles in the 28-26 home win over Liberty. He had one tackle for loss, but his biggest play may have been an interception on Liberty's opening drive of the game, where he intercepted a pass in the end zone to thwart the Flames' scoring opportunity on first-and-goal. Teal is the Big South's all-time interception leader with 16.

Montgomery shined in Gardner-Webb's 35-31 win over VMI Saturday, rushing 15 times for a career-best 103 yards and a 34-yard touchdown. He leads the Bulldogs with 276 rushing yards and 6.0 yards per carry this season (two touchdowns).

BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE GAMES ENJOYING EDGE-OF-YOUR-SEAT ACTION, LAST QUARTER WINS
 The 2006 Big South Conference season is at the mid-way point, and the five completed League games have all been decided by five points-or-less, and the average margin of victory is 3.6 points. In 2005, the Conference had seven of its 10 games decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory at 10.5, the lowest average in Big South history. Below are the school-by-school scoring margins for their respective Conference games this season:

STILL GOING ... CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EXTENDS WIN STREAK TO 13 GAMES

The 8-0, No. 18 Charleston Southern Buccaneers extended their win streak to 13 this past weekend, currently the second-longest winning streak in the nation, behind San Diego's 16-game streak. CSU's 13-game win streak also extends the longest win streak in Big South history. CSU broke Coastal Carolina's record 10-game streak two weeks ago. CSU's eight-straight wins this season is tied for the longest in-season winning streak in League history, joining Gardner-Webb (2002) and Coastal Carolina (2004). The Bucs have won nine-straight home games as well.

START ME UP

Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb are 2-0 in Conference play. Charleston Southern is 1-0 for just the second time in five years (2004). Coastal Carolina is 2-0 to open League play for the third-straight year, while Gardner-Webb is 2-0 for the first time since 2003 and third time overall. Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern meet in Charleston Saturday. GWU has been 3-0 twice before in Big South games (2002, 2003). Charleston Southern has never opened 2-0 in League action.

WALTER PAYTON AWARD CANDIDATE TYLER THIGPEN

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN** was named to *The Sports Network's* revised Walter Payton Award Watch List on Oct. 11. The list consists of 16 players who are under consideration for I-AA football's version of the Heisman Trophy as the top player in I-AA football and will be presented Thursday, Dec. 14 in Chattanooga, Tenn. Thigpen is the first ever Big South Conference player on the Payton Watch List. Former Gardner-Webb DB **MARIO WILLIAMS** was a Buck Buchanan Award defensive player of the year candidate in 2004.

ROLL CALL

The Big South Conference is enjoying a record-breaking season at the gate in 2006, as the five football members are averaging a combined 7,084 fans per game. The Conference has drawn a total attendance of 141,673 through 20 home dates (eight home games remaining). The League record attendance figure is 157,465 in 2004 (28 home dates), for a record average of 5,624.

BIG SOUTH SCORES FIRST-EVER NON-CONFERENCE WINNING SEASON

The Big South improved its non-conference record to 19-12 with Charleston Southern's 24-10 win over Patriot League member Georgetown this past Saturday, extending the League's record for non-conference wins in a season. The Conference has four non-conference games remaining, which at worst would give the League a 19-16 mark. The League's previous record for non-conference wins was 17 in 2003, set during a 12-game season.

BIG SOUTH CURRENTLY SPORTING TWO TOP 25 PROGRAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has had two teams ranked in a national top 25 poll in the same week this season. Don Hansen's *National Weekly Football Gazette* has ranked Coastal Carolina (17th) and Charleston Southern (18th) in his Top 25 for the fourth consecutive week, while the CSN Coaches poll has Coastal ranked 17th and Charleston Southern ranked 25th. The Chanticleers are also ranked No. 17 by *The Sports Network* and 20th by *I-AA.org*. Charleston Southern is 27th in the TSN and *I-AA.org* rankings, while Gardner-Webb received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 for the second-straight week.

SIX ON THE BOARD

For the first time since the 2003 season, the Big South has three teams (Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb) with at least six wins in a season. In fact, the Conference will have three programs above .500 for the first time in League history. Coastal Carolina has posted its fourth-straight winning season, while Gardner-Webb is enjoying its first winning campaign since 2003. In 2003, four squads posted six wins during a 12-game schedule, two of which finished above .500.

TOUGH SCHEDULE -- AND LOSSES

A Big South football member faces a nationally-ranked opponent for the eighth-straight week this coming Saturday, as Gardner-Webb visits No. 18 Charleston Southern. Meanwhile, of the League's 12 non-conference losses, two were against Division I-A programs, four were against nationally-ranked opponents, and two were against teams that eventually cracked the Top 25 (UT-Martin and Towson) nationally.

PRICE CONTINUES TO ADD TO RECORD RECEIVING TOTALS

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the League's all-time leader in receptions and yardage in Week 7, became the first player in Big South history with 2,000 receiving yards in Week 8 against VMI. Price's record totals now stand at 172 receptions and 2,208 receiving yards. His 73 receptions this year are a career-high and third-most in a Big South season. Price is seven catches shy of breaking the Conference's single-season record of 79, held by **AARON DUNKLIN** in 2003, and is currently on pace for 100.39 receptions this season.

BOLDEN CHILD

Liberty sophomore **DOMINIC BOLDEN** had a 93-yard kickoff return for a touchdown Saturday at Coastal Carolina, the fourth kickoff return TD in Big South history. It also was the third-longest return in Conference history. Of the League's four kickoff return touchdowns, Liberty has recorded two of them -- both in Big South games. In addition to Bolden, **SAM GADO** returned a kick 97 yards for a score at Coastal Carolina on Oct. 23, 2004.

TOTALLY OFFENSIVE

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who is first in I-AA in total offense with an average of 323.50 yards per game (2,588 total), is 186 total yards away from breaking the Big South's single-season record of 2,773, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2004. Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by **COLLIN DRAFTS** in '04. He has recorded six 300-plus games of total offense, a Big South single-season record, and became the third player in Big South history with 6,000 career total yards in Week 6 vs. Furman. POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 41 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 37 contests, followed by VMI (25), Charleston Southern (17) and Liberty (15).

10-4 GOOD BUDDY

Four Big South quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is two away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 17 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 14 rushing touchdowns, ahead of **TYLER THIGPEN** (12).

HEAD RUSH

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5, surpassed current Houston Texans RB and Liberty grad **SAM GADO** for ninth-place on the League's all-time rushing list this past weekend. Thigpen is at 1,408 and needs two yards to pass former Gardner-Webb back **GEORGE PRESSLEY** (1,409) for eighth-place.

HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina junior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has caught a touchdown pass in his last four games (six total) and has 10 touchdown receptions on the season, setting his career-high and three away from tying the Big South single-season record of 13. He became the ninth player in Big South history to surpass 100 career receptions this past weekend vs. Liberty, and moved into fourth-place in League history with 1,682 receiving yards. Simpson, who needs 67 yards for third-place, has caught 27 of his 102 career receptions for touchdowns -- 26.5 percent.

DEFENSIVE FRONT

Charleston Southern and Liberty are tied for the League lead in scoring defense at 15.0 points allowed per game, ranking tied for 15th in the nation. The League record is 16.0, set by Coastal Carolina in 2004. Liberty is limiting opponents to 306.8 yards per game, which is pacing ahead of the Big South record of 313.6, held by Coastal in '04. Charleston Southern currently averages 356.2 yards per game. Charleston Southern and Liberty meet on the gridiron on Nov. 11 in Lynchburg.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty sophomore RB **ZACH TERRELL** recorded his second consecutive 100-yard rushing game of the season this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina. Terrell rushed for 114 yards and two touchdowns -- his third-straight game with at least two scores, and has 289 in his past two contests (144.5 per game). He increased his career rushing total to 1,133, and needs 12 yards to pass **TRAVIS MAYS** (1,144) for 13th-place on the Big South career rushing list, and 50 yards to pass **NICK ROBERTS** (1,182) for 12th.

JENNINGS STILL LEADS BIG SOUTH IN RUSHING

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South with 828 rushing yards -- which surpasses last season's top rusher in the Conference (**ANDRE COPELAND**, 721), and is the ninth-highest total in a single-season. He rushed for 60 yards on 14 carries Saturday at Coastal and is looking to return to form after suffering an injury against William & Mary in Week 7. Jennings is attempting to become the first Liberty rusher to lead the Big South in rushing since **DRE BARNES** in 2003. Jennings needs 172 yards to record just the fifth 1,000-yard rushing season in Big South history.

MIZ KID

VMI senior RB **SEAN MIZZER**, the League's career leader with 601 rushing attempts, is 28 yards away from become the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards. **DRE BARNES** is the Big South's career rushing leader at 3,409. Meanwhile, Mizzer is the Big South's career leader in all-purpose yards with 4,318.

CATCH US IF YOU CAN

KORY ALSTON (113) moved into fifth all-time on the League's career reception list this past weekend, while **AUSTIN GAINES** (111) moved into sixth-place. **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** remains in the eighth spot with 107, while **JEROME SIMPSON** is ninth at 102. Gaines needs 18 yards to move past **LAUREN WILLIAMS** for eighth all-time in career receiving yards, while Alston is 74 yards away from fifth.

COLLIN CARD

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career passing yards during Week 5 against North Greenville, stands at 8,984 in his career -- 16 yards from the 9,000-yard barrier. VMI'S WILSON RETURNS TO LINEUP

VMI senior QB **JONATHAN WILSON** returned to the lineup in Week 8 at Charleston Southern and did not show any signs of rust. He amassed 346 yards of total offense (12th most in Big South history), including 90 rushing yards. Wilson was 15-of-21 passing (71.4 percent) for 256 yards, a 17.1 yard average per completion. He surpassed 400 career completions in the contest as well. This past week, he became the fourth player in Big South history with 5,000 passing yards when he surpassed the milestone at Gardner-Webb, and is currently at 5,010.

PERK-OLATING

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards in Week 4, is currently fourth all-time at 2,199 -- 16 yards away from surpassing former teammate **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) for third-place. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list, and is the League's all-time leader in touchdowns scored with 42 (all rushing).

WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark against South Carolina State in Week 4, has 2,150 yards through eight games (268.8 per game) and is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. He is 445 yards shy of breaking the League's single-season passing record of 2,594. Meanwhile, Thigpen is fifth in the Conference with 438 rushing yards, breaking his own single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback (437, last season).

TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **JAMAR LEATH** became the Big South's all-time leader in tackles in Week 7 following his 13-tackle performance at VMI. He surpassed **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN** for the career lead, and currently stands at 335. Liberty LB **MANNY ROJAS**, who moved into sole possession of second-place on the all-time list in Week 8 vs. Gardner-Webb, has 319. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** -- the first player in Big South history to record 20 tackles in a game twice in the same season -- enters the week with 293 career stops, seventh all-time.
