Drafts amassed a Big South single-game record 452 total yards in leading Charleston Southern to a 28-14 win over Gardner-Webb. He was 31-of-41 passing (75.6 percent) for 409 yards with four touchdowns and zero interceptions, and set a League record for completions in a game and posted the second-highest yardage total. Drafts also rushed 19 times for a team-high 46 yards in leading the Bucs to their first-ever 2-0 start in Big South play, and surpassed 9,000 career passing yards and 10,000 total offensive yards in the win. He has been named one of *I-AA.org's* Weekly All-Stars for his performance against the Bulldogs.

Carmon recorded four tackles and two critical interceptions in Charleston Southern's win over Gardner-Webb. Carmon ended a Gardner-Webb drive at 9:33 in the fourth quarter with an interception at the CSU 18-yard line, stopping a drive that started after the Buccaneers took a 28-14 lead. With under two minutes to play and with Gardner-Webb in the midst of a 12-play, 73-yard drive in just a 1:45 span, Carmon jumped a Devin Campbell pass and picked it off at the CSU 4-yard line, ending the threat and preserving the victory for the Bucs. It was his first career two-interception game.

It was his second 10-point game of the season and ninth of his career. Hoke also became the first kicker in Big South history to make nine PATs in a game twice in his career.

Torrence helped the LU defense post its Big South-record third shutout of the year with the Flames' 21-0 blanking of Western Carolina with four tackles, one TFL and one pass break-up. He recorded his second-highest tackle total of the season, and for the third time this year, he finished a game with three solo stops. Torrence also recorded the first tackle for loss in his collegiate career (one yard) and added his third pass break-up of the campaign, which forced Western Carolina to punt.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TO APPEAR ON SPORTSOUTH NEXT TWO WEEKS

SportSouth, the former Turner South network, will air Big South football the final two weeks of the regular-season, beginning with Saturday's Coastal Carolina at Gardner-Webb match-up and concluding with the Nov. 18 Charleston Southern at Coastal Carolina contest. Both games will also air nationally on Fox College Sports. CCU-GWU will air on FCS Pacific, while CSU-CCU will air on FCS Atlantic. PAUL CRANE will handle play-by-play duties, with JAMIE NEWBERG as the analyst.

BIG SOUTH HOLDS WINNING RECORD VS. THE SOCON

With Liberty's 21-0 win over Western Carolina this past weekend, the Big South improved to 4-3 against Southern Conference members, setting a League record for wins against the SoCon in a season. The previous high was three, set in 2004. The Big South has two games remaining against SoCon foes -- VMI at The Citadel this weekend and Gardner-Webb vs. Wofford on Nov. 18. The Big South's 21 non-Conference wins this year are a League record, surpassing the previous high of 17 in 2003, set during a 12-game season.

STILL GOING ... CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EXTENDS WIN STREAK TO 14 GAMES

The 9-0, No. 16 Charleston Southern Buccaneers extended their win streak to 14 this past weekend, currently the second-longest winning streak in the nation, behind San Diego's 17-game streak. CSU's 14-game win streak also extends the longest win streak in Big South history. CSU broke Coastal Carolina's record 10-game streak on Oct. 14. CSU's nine-straight wins this season also sets the League record for longest in-season winning streak in League history, surpassing eight-straight wins by Gardner-Webb (2002) and Coastal Carolina (2004). The Bucs will carry a 10-game home winning streak into the 2007 season as well.

ZERO TOLERANCE

The Liberty Flames' 21-0 blanking of SoCon foe Western Carolina was its third shutout of the year, setting a Big South record for most shutouts in a season. The previous record was two, set by Gardner-Webb in 2003. It was the fourth shutout by a Big South member this year, also a League mark.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE

Saturday's Charleston Southern at Liberty contest will feature the top two defenses in the Big South, as Liberty is first in the League and 10th nationally in scoring defense at 13.33 points and first in the Conference in total defense (302.22). Charleston Southern is second to Liberty and 13th nationally in scoring defense at 14.89 points allowed and second in the League in total defense (321.67). However, the Bucs are second in the Big South and 20th in I-AA in total offense (373.67), while Liberty is fourth in the League and 58th in the country in total offense (333.78). The Big South record for scoring defense is 16.0, set by Coastal Carolina in 2004, while the League mark for total defense is 313.6, held by Coastal that same season.

WALTER PAYTON AWARD CANDIDATE TYLER THIGPEN

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN was named to *The Sports Network's* revised Walter Payton Award Watch List on Oct. 11. The list consists of 16 players who are under consideration for I-AA football's version of the Heisman Trophy as the top player in I-AA football and will be presented Thursday, Dec. 14 in Chattanooga, Tenn. Thigpen is the first ever Big South Conference player on the Payton Watch List. Former Gardner-Webb DB MARIO WILLIAMS was a Buck Buchanan Award defensive player of the year candidate in 2004.

BIG SOUTH CURRENTLY SPORTING TWO TOP 25 PROGRAMS

For five consecutive weeks, the Big South has had two teams ranked in a national top 25 poll in the same week this season. Don Hansen's *National Weekly Football Gazette* has ranked Coastal Carolina (12th) and Charleston Southern (16th) in his Top 25 for the fifth-straight week, while the CSN Coaches poll has Coastal ranked 14th and Charleston Southern ranked 25th. The Chanticleers are also ranked No. 16 by *The Sports Network* and 18th by *I-AA.org*. Charleston Southern has cracked the Top 25 in *The Sports Network* poll for the first time this season, and is 25th in the *I-AA.org* rankings.

DRAFTS BREAKS BIG SOUTH SINGLE-GAME TOTAL OFFENSE, COMPLETIONS RECORD

Charleston Southern QB COLLIN DRAFTS set a Big South single-game record with 452 yards of total offense Saturday vs. Gardner-Webb. He broke the record of 428 yards, set by Gardner-Webb's NICK ROBERTS last season vs. UT-Martin. Drafts, who threw for 406 yards and rushed for 46, recorded his second career 400-yard passing game and is the lone player in Big South history to throw for more than 400 yards in a game. Meanwhile, Drafts' 31 pass completions vs. the Bulldogs broke the single-game record of 29, which he shared with former CSU quarterback DARREN SWIGGETT.

THIGPEN BREAKS BIG SOUTH TOTAL OFFENSE RECORD

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who is third in I-AA in total offense with an average of 309.00 yards per game, broke the Big South's single-season record in limited action this past weekend vs. Savannah State. Thigpen played 1.5 quarters vs. the Tigers and finished with 193 total yards to move to 2,781 on the season, breaking the previous mark of 2,773, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2004. Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by **COLLIN DRAFTS** in '04. He has recorded six 300-plus games of total offense, a Big South single-season record, and is third in League history with 7,053 career total yards. PRICE BREAKS SINGLE-SEASON RECEPTION RECORD

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the League's all-time leader in receptions and yardage in Week 7, recorded his fourth game this year with at least 10 catches Saturday when he caught 11 balls vs. Gardner-Webb to break the Big South's single-season receptions record. Price now has 84 receptions on the year, surpassing the previous season high of 79, set by **AARON DUNKLIN** in 2003. Price, who is the Conference's all-time leader with 183 catches and 2,307 receiving yards, is on pace for 102.7 receptions this season.

BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE GAMES ENJOYING EDGE-OF-YOUR-SEAT ACTION, LAST QUARTER WINS

Charleston Southern's 14-point win over Gardner-Webb this past weekend snapped the League's streak of five-straight Conference games decided by five points-or-less this season. Through six contests, the average margin of victory in League tilts is still just 5.3 points. In 2005, the Conference had seven of its 10 games decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory at 10.5, the lowest average in Big South history. PASSING GRADES

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** and Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** each threw four touchdown passes this weekend to push their season total to 21 each, which ties the Big South single-season record, set by Drafts in 2004.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 42 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 38 contests, followed by VMI (25), Charleston Southern (18) and Liberty (16).

10-4 GOOD BUDDY

Four Big South quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is two away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 17 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 14 rushing touchdowns, ahead of **TYLER THIGPEN** (12).

HEAD RUSH

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5, surpassed former Gardner-Webb back **GEORGE PRESSLEY** (1,409) for eighth-place on the League's all-time rushing list. Thigpen is at 1,437 and needs 119 yards to pass former Gardner-Webb rusher **CHRIS FOSTER** (1,555) for seventh-place.

YOU COMPLETE ME

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is currently completing 72.7 percent of his passes this season (186-of-256), which is on pace to set the Big South single-season record. **NICK ROBERTS** owns the completion percentage record of 63.2 percent, set last season. Meanwhile, both Drafts and Coastal's **TYLER THIGPEN** are out-performing the League's passing efficiency record of 140.58. Thigpen is first in the League in the category at 168.37, holding the slight advantage over Drafts (166.18). Drafts set the record of 140.58 during the 2004 season.

TOUGH SCHEDULE -- AND LOSSES

A Big South football member faces a nationally-ranked opponent for the ninth-straight week this coming Saturday, as Liberty hosts No. 16 Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb entertains No. 12 Coastal Carolina. Meanwhile, of the League's 12 non-conference losses, two were against Division I-A programs, four were against nationally-ranked opponents, and two were against teams that eventually cracked the Top 25 (UT-Martin and Towson) nationally.

HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina junior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has caught a touchdown pass in his last five games (seven total) and has 11 touchdown receptions on the season, setting his career-high and two away from tying the Big South single-season record of 13. He became the ninth player in Big South history to surpass 100 career receptions in Week 9, and is fourth all-time in League history with 1,692 receiving yards. Simpson, who needs 57 yards for third-place, has caught 28 of his 103 career receptions for touchdowns -- 27.2 percent.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty sophomore RB **ZACH TERRELL** just missed recording his third consecutive 100-yard rushing game of the season this past Saturday, as he finished with 99 yards vs. Western Carolina. Terrell scored a touchdown for the fourth-straight game (seven total) and has 388 rushing yards in the three-game span (129.3 per game). He increased his career rushing total to 1,232, jumping three spots on the League's career list to 11th all-time. Terrell needs 143 rushing yards to surpass **SAM GADO** (1,374) and crack the Top 10.

JENNINGS STILL LEADS BIG SOUTH IN RUSHING

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** continues to lead the Big South with 866 rushing yards, which is the eight-highest total in a single-season. Jennings is attempting to become the first Liberty rusher to lead the Big South in rushing since **DRE BARNES** in 2003, and needs 134 yards to record just the fifth 1,000-yard rushing season in Big South history.

MIZ KID

VMI senior RB **SEAN MIZZER**, the League's career leader with 601 rushing attempts, is 28 yards away from become the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards. **DRE BARNES** is the Big South's career rushing leader at 3,409. Meanwhile, Mizzer is the Big South's career leader in all-purpose yards with 4,318.

COLLIN CARD

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** became the first player in Big South history to surpass 10,000 total offense yards this past weekend vs. Gardner-Webb. He currently holds 11 Big South career records, which are as follows:

THE GOOD HANDS PEOPLE

For the second-straight week, the Big South will have a game featuring four players with 100 career receptions when Coastal Carolina visits Gardner-Webb Saturday. The Bulldogs boast three of those players: **KORY ALSTON** (118), **AUSTIN GAINES** (117) and **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (115), while Coastal Carolina counters with **JEROME SIMPSON** (103).

WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark against South Carolina State in Week 4, has 2,314 yards through nine games (257.1 per game). He is 281 yards shy of breaking the League's single-season passing record of 2,594. Meanwhile, Thigpen is fifth in the Conference with 467 rushing yards, breaking his own single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback (437, last season).

TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **JAMAR LEATH** became the Big South's all-time leader in tackles in Week 7 following his 13-tackle performance at VMI. He surpassed **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN** for the career lead, and currently stands at 339. Liberty LB **MANNY ROJAS**, who moved into sole possession of second-place on the all-time list in Week 8 vs. Gardner-Webb, has 329. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** -- the first player in Big South history to record 20 tackles in a game twice in the same season -- became the sixth player in League history with 300 career tackles when he reached the milestone this past Saturday.
