Simpson had one of his best games of the season Saturday in Coastal's 29-27 upset win over No. 3 Furman, recording a team season-high of nine catches for 151 yards and two touchdowns. Additionally, of Simpson's catches, three of them were for 20 yards or more during the game and seven went for first downs. On CCU's opening scoring drive, Simpson had two catches for 64 yards to get the Chanticleers in position for their first score of the game. He later scored the game-tying touchdown (21-21) early in the fourth quarter, then added the game-winning score (29-27) with 5:48 left to play. Most of Simpson's nine catches were acrobatic and timely, and went for distances of 42, 22, 34, 8, 16, 8, 3, 10 and 8. In addition, he has been named National co-Offensive Player of the Week by *The Sports Network* for his efforts.

NEW BALANCE

Leath recorded a season-high 14 tackles (one off his career best) to lead the Chanticleers to a win over No. 3 Furman. He had five solo tackles, one tackle for loss and one forced fumble in the win. He also had a hand in stopping a crucial fourth-and-nine late in the game that gave Coastal the ball back, as he defended the intended receiver. With his 14 tackles, he became just the fourth player in Big South history to record 300 career tackles and currently sits in second-place all-time at 307, needing one to tie the Big South career record and two stops to take over the career lead.

It was the first-ever two-point PAT return in the history of the Chanticleers' program.

COASTAL CAROLINA UPSETS NO. 3 FURMAN, 29-27

For the second year in a row, the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers have defeated a top five program at Brooks Stadium, this time knocking off perennial national power and No. 3 ranked Furman this past Saturday, 29-27. Coastal's first such win was last year against then-No. 1 James Madison on Sept. 10, 2005. Saturday's win was Coastal's third-straight of the season, evened its record against SoCon members this year at 2-2, and vaulted CCU back into the national rankings at No. 19 this week by the *Football Gazette* and No. 24 in the CSN Coaches Poll. The Chanticleers are 3-1 against nationally-ranked opponents since the start of the 2005 season.

CONFERENCE SEASON OPENS SATURDAY WITH COASTAL CAROLINA AT VMI

Big South Conference game action begins this Saturday with No. 19 Coastal Carolina at VMI at 1:00pm. Coastal is 2-1 in League openers, winning its last two. VMI is 1-2, having won its opener a year ago. While the Chanticleers will open its Conference slate against the Keydets for the second time (won 21-14 at VMI - Oct. 16, 2004), it marks the first time VMI will start the Big South schedule against the Chanticleers. Coastal leads the series, 2-1.

BIG SOUTH CONTINUES WINNING WAYS

The Big South improved its non-conference record to 16-11 this past weekend with Coastal's upset win over No. 3 Furman and Charleston Southern's victory at Savannah State. The Conference needs just one more non-League victory to tie the Big South record for most non-conference wins in a season. In 2003, Big South members combined to win 17 non-League contests during a 12-game season.

BIG SOUTH CURRENTLY SPORTING TWO TOP 25 PROGRAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in a national top 25 poll in the same week. Don Hansen's *National Weekly Football Gazette* has ranked Charleston Southern 18th and Coastal Carolina 19th this week. The Chanticleers are also ranked No. 24 in the CSN Coaches poll (CSU received votes) and both program's received votes in *The Sports Network* and *I-AA.org* Top 25 polls as well.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EXTENDS SECOND-LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN NATION

The 5-0 No. 18 Charleston Southern Buccaneers extended their win streak to 10 this past weekend, currently the second-longest winning streak in the nation, behind San Diego's 13-game streak. CSU's 10-game win streak is tied for the longest in Big South history, matching Coastal Carolina's 10-game streak from 2004-05. Charleston Southern also looks to extend its home game win streak to seven this weekend.

HEAD RUSH

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5. is currently 10th all-time on the Big South's career rushing chart with 1,290. He needs 85 yards to pass current Houston Texans RB and Liberty grad SAM GADO for ninth place (1,373).

TOTALLY OFFENSIVE

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN, who is first in I-AA in total offense with an average of 331.33 yards per game (1,988 total), is 786 total yards away from the Big South's single-season record of 2,773, set by NICK ROBERTS in 2004. Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by COLLIN DRAFTS in '04. He has recorded five 300-plus games of total offense, a Big South single-season record, and became the third player in Big South history with 6,000 career total yards this past weekend vs. Furman. HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina junior WR JEROME SIMPSON was unstoppable against No. 3 Furman this past Saturday, as he tallied nine catches for 151 yards and two touchdowns. The two scores increased his Big South career record total to 25, while his career receiving yard total has reached 1,492. He needs eight more receiving yards to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 1,500 career receiving yards. Simpson is also 10 receptions away from 100 in his career, and 27.8 percent of his 90 career catches have been for touchdowns.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 39 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Liberty held the previous record of 35-straight games with a point from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 34 contests, followed by VMI (22), Charleston Southern (14) and Liberty (12).

TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **JAMAR LEATH** became the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career tackles this past Saturday with his 14 stops against No. 3 Furman. He entered the contest sixth all-time at 293, and now stands just one hit shy of tying the Big South career record of 308. Leath vaulted over Liberty LB **MANNY ROJAS**, who is at 299 and did not play this past weekend due to the Flames' bye week. Below are the top tacklers in Big South history:

TOUGH SCHEDULE -- AND LOSSES

A Big South football member faces a nationally-ranked opponent for the fifth-straight week this coming Saturday, as VMI hosts No. 19 Coastal Carolina. Meanwhile, of the League's 11 non-conference losses, two have come against Division I-A programs, four were against nationally-ranked opponents, and two were against teams that have gone on to crack the Top 25 (UT-Martin and Towson) nationally.

PRICE CHECK

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 1, will likely break the League's all-time receiving records this Saturday against Edward Waters. He is second all-time with 147 receptions, and needs five to break **ZOHN BURDEN**'s career mark of 151. Price is second all-time with 1,882 career yards, 55 away of breaking Burden's Big South record of 1,936 career receiving yards.

NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER** continues to push towards the Big South career rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**. Mizzer now stands at 2,774 rushing yards in his Big South tenure (635 away from tying Barnes), and needs to average 127.0 per game over the remaining five contests to reach the mark. He is 226 yards shy of becoming the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards. Mizzer is currently averaging 95.5 yards per game, and has posted four 100-yard rushing games this season. He has 14 as a Big South member, which is second all-time to Barnes' League record of 17, and 17 overall in his VMI career.

JENNINGS CHALLENGING LEAGUE'S SEASON RUSHING RECORD

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has fallen off his pace -- for now -- to break the Big South's single-season rushing record of 1,347, set by Liberty's **DRE BARNES** in 2003. Jennings would need to average 128.5 yards per game over the next six games to break the mark. He is currently averaging 115.4 yards per game (13th in the country), which would equal 692.4 over the six-game span, and combined with his current total of 577, he would finish at 1,269.

FLAMES DEFENSE STILL BURNING HOT

The Liberty Flames rank first in the Big South and third in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to 10.20 points per game (51 in 5 games). The Big South record for scoring defense in a season is 16.0, set by the Chanticleers in 2004. Liberty has posted two shutouts this season, becoming just the second team in Big South history to whitewash two opponents in one campaign. Gardner-Webb was the first in 2003. The Flames' defense has limited opponents to less than 10 points in three games this year, the most since Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina did it three times in 2004.

10-4 GOOD BUDDY

Four quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is three away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 16 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 12 rushing scores, followed by **TYLER THIGPEN** with 11.

COLLIN CARD

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career passing yards this during Week 5 against North Greenville. He now has 8,358 is his career. Drafts also became the first player in Big South history to eclipse 8,000 career total offensive yards during Week 3. Drafts recorded his fourth 300-plus game of total offense Saturday against Savannah State (363), his ninth career game with more than 300 total yards, extending his League record. Drafts' Big South record total offense total stands at 8,887.

TV GUIDE

Following its acquisition of Turner South five months ago, Fox Cable Networks announced last week that the network will be re-launched and re-branded Friday, Oct. 13 as **SportSouth**. The Big South has two football games scheduled on Turner South/SportSouth -- the Nov. 11 Coastal Carolina at Gardner-Webb game and the Nov. 18 Charleston Southern at Coastal Carolina contest. SportSouth will be abbreviated SPSO in listings and can be found where Turner South was on respective cable systems.

WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark against South Carolina State in Week 4. He has 1,668 yards through six games (278.0 per game) and is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. He is 927 yards shy of breaking the League's single-season passing record of 2,594. Meanwhile, Thigpen is fourth in the Conference with 320 rushing yards, and needs 118 yards to break his single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback (437). Earlier this season, he became the first QB in League history to record two 90-yard rushing games in the same year after his 91-yard effort against S.C. State in Week 4. He gained 94 at Wofford in Week 2.

PERK-OLATING

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards following his 18-carry, 78-yard performance against South Carolina State in Week 4. Perkins surpassed former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON** (1,952) for fourth all-time in the process and is currently at 2,068 -- 147 yards away from reaching former teammate **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) for third-place. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list.

BABY BOOMER

Gardner-Webb sophomore punter **MICHAEL HANNA**, who set a Big South single-game record with a 52.8 punting average in Week 2 against Tennessee Tech, is averaging 45.0 yards per punt this season and is challenging **GRAHAM WHITLOCK**'s League record of 45.5. Hanna has averaged at least 43.8 yards per punt in four out of five games this season, and has booted eight 50-yard-plus punts this year. He is currently second in the nation in punting.

TURNING THE PAGE

Liberty WR **BRANDON TURNER** became the 12th player in League history with 1,000 career receiving yards following his four-catch, 84-yard performance at Wake Forest in Week 5. He is currently 12th all-time with 1,002 yards and needs an even 100 to move into 11th.

FULL PRICE

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE** -- ranked No. 7 among all I-AA wide receivers by *The Sports Network* entering the season -- is currently first in the nation in receptions per game with 9.60. He has 48 catches through five games, and if he can maintain his average, he is on pace for 105.6, which would shatter the Big South single-season record of 79, set by **AARON DUNKLIN** in 2003.

MIZ KID

VMI senior RB **SEAN MIZZER** is 27 rushing attempts away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader in the category. He currently has 537 career carries during his League tenure, trailing **DRE BARNES**' record of 563. Mizzer is second in the Big South with 573 rushing yards this year, and his 68-yard touchdown run at Army this past Saturday is tied for the eighth-longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history. He also broke loose for a 63-yard score in Week 1 vs. Davidson.

HOKE'S PAT STREAK ENDS

Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE** saw his 85 consecutive PAT attempts end Saturday when Furman blocked his extra point attempt in the fourth quarter. Hoke is now 19-of-20 on the season in PAT kicks, and is the League's all-time leader with 147 out of 153 career attempts (=96.1).
