### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**TYLER THIGPEN • QB • Senior**  
 Coastal Carolina • Winnsboro, S.C.

Thigpen was standout in Coastal's 52-24 win over Gardner-Webb. He was 22-of-27 passing (81.5 percent) for 306 yards and two touchdowns, and added 119 rushing yards on 10 carries to finish with a school-record 425 yards of total offense. He connected on his first five pass attempts en route to his third 300-yard passing game of the year and his seventh 300+ total offense game of the season (Big South record). Thigpen directed Coastal to six touchdown drives of 75 yards-or-longer as well as 638 total yards, a record for a Big South Conference match-up. His 76-yard run in the fourth quarter was the fifth-longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history, and he became the first player in League history to surpass 3,000 yards of total offense in a season and the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 500 yards in a campaign.

### NEW BALANCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**MANNY ROJAS • LB • R-Senior**  
 Liberty • Oakdale, Pa.

Rojas helped the Flames hold Charleston Southern's potent offense to just 265 yards, its second lowest output of the season, as well as two offensive touchdowns (both rushing) in Liberty's 34-20 win over the Buccaneers. He posted a team-high 11 tackles (three solo, eight assists), his second-straight double figure tackle game, and picked off a pass and returned it 13 yards late in the second quarter. The win snapped Liberty's six-game Conference losing streak and Charleston Southern's 14-game win streak.

Jackson became the second Flame this year to return a kickoff for a touchdown. After CSU returned a punt for a touchdown, Jackson returned the ensuing kickoff 80 yards for a score to push Liberty's lead to 20-7. He also added three punt returns for 24 yards (8.0 average), including a 22-yard return, his third-longest of the year. The Flames now rank sixth nationally in kickoff return average at 24.3 yards.

**BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE TELEVISED SATURDAY ON SPORTSOUTH**

The Big South will crown its fifth football champion Saturday, and the game will be televised live regionally on SportSouth and nationally on Fox College Sports. Coastal Carolina, which has clinched at least a share of the title, will look to win the championship outright with a win over Charleston Southern. A CSU win would give the League co-champions for the second-straight year. CSU-CCU will air on FCS Atlantic, and PAUL CRANE will handle play-by-play duties, with JAMIE NEWBERG serving as analyst.

**COASTAL NOTCHES CONFERENCE'S FIRST THREE-PEAT**

With Saturday's 52-24 win over Gardner-Webb, Coastal Carolina has clinched at least a share of its third consecutive Big South football championship, becoming the first team in the Big South's five-year football history to win or share three-straight titles. Gardner-Webb won the first two championships in 2002 and 2003, with Coastal winning in 2004. The Chanticleers and Charleston Southern were co-champs in 2005 with 3-1 records.

**LIBERTY SNAPS LOSING STREAK AND CHARLESTON SOUTHERN'S 14-GAME WIN STREAK**

The Liberty Flames defeated Charleston Southern 34-20 Saturday, ending a six-game Conference losing streak and snapping the Buccaneers' 14-game win streak in the process. CSU's streak was the second-longest in I-AA, as well as the longest win streak in Big South history. CSU's nine-straight wins this season also set the League record for longest in-season winning streak. Meanwhile, the longest active win streak now belongs to Coastal Carolina at seven games -- the third-straight year CCU has built win streaks of seven games-or-longer. Coastal's streak is currently the fifth-longest in I-AA.

**ZERO TOLERANCE**

Liberty is looking to set Big South single-season records for scoring defense, fewest points allowed and total defense, among others. The Flames, which have recorded a League-record three shutouts this season, are on the cusp of the following defensive records entering Saturday's season finale at VMI:

**WALTER PAYTON AWARD CANDIDATE TYLER THIGPEN**

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN was named to *The Sports Network's* revised Walter Payton Award Watch List on Oct. 11. The list consists of 16 players who are under consideration for I-AA football's version of the Heisman Trophy as the top player in I-AA football and will be presented Thursday, Dec. 14 in Chattanooga, Tenn. Thigpen is the first ever Big South Conference player on the Payton Watch List. Former Gardner-Webb DB MARIO WILLIAMS was a Buck Buchanan Award defensive player of the year candidate in 2004.

**THIGPEN OWNS BIG SOUTH TOTAL OFFENSE RECORD**

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN, who is second in I-AA in total offense with an average of 320.6 yards per game, became the first player in Big South history to surpass 3,000 total offense yards in a season this past weekend at Gardner-Webb. His record total stands at 3,206 yards, and he has recorded a League-record seven 300-plus games of total offense this year. Thigpen is third all-time in total offense at 7,478 yards and needs 395 for second-place (NICK ROBERTS - 7,872). Below is Thigpen's game-by-game breakdown this season:

**BIG SOUTH'S TOP 25 PROGRAMS GO HEAD-TO-HEAD FOR THE FIRST TIME**

For the first time in Big South history, the League will have two Top 25 members go head-to-head on the gridiron, as Coastal Carolina hosts Charleston Southern Saturday. Don Hansen's *National Weekly Football Gazette* has ranked Coastal Carolina (7th) and Charleston Southern (21st) in his Top 25 for the sixth-straight week. While CCU and CSU were also ranked in the Top 25 in last week's CSN Coaches Poll and *The Sports Network* poll, the Bucs have fallen out of the rankings following their loss at Liberty. This week, Coastal is ranked 13th by *The Sports Network*, 15th by *I-AA.org* and 12th in the CSN Coaches Poll.

**PRICE THREE RECEPTIONS AWAY FROM 100 IN A SEASON**

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the League's all-time leader in receptions and yardage in Week 7, recorded his fifth game this year with at least 10 catches Saturday when he caught 13 balls at Liberty. Price now has 97 receptions on the year and Big South career records of 196 catches and 2,368 receiving yards. Price leads the NCAA with 9.70 receptions per game, and is three receptions away from recording the eighth 100-reception season in NCAA history, which is as follows:

**COASTAL RECORDS TWO MORE FIRSTS IN WIN OVER GARDNER-WEBB**

Coastal Carolina became the first Big South team in history to rush for more 300 yards and pass for more than 300 yards in the same game Saturday at Gardner-Webb, as the Chanticleers amassed 332 rushing yards and 306 passing yards in their win over the Bulldogs. The 638 total yards also set a League record in a Big South Conference match-up. Meanwhile, QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the first player in Big South history to throw for 300 yards and rush for 100 in the same game, as the senior totaled 306 passing yards and 119 rushing yards on the day.

**TALE OF TWO HALVES**

The scoring margin for the first five games of the Big South season averaged 3.6 points, as the combined margin was 18 points and all five games were decided by five points-or-less. However, the last three League contests have been decided by an average of 18.7 points (56 total), pushing the season average up to 9.3 points. The Big South record for lowest average margin of victory in a Conference season is 10.5, set last season.

**PASSING GRADES**

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** has thrown 23 touchdown passes and 2,620 yards this season, breaking the single-season records of 21 and 2,594, respectively, this past weekend at Gardner-Webb. Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** set the TD record in 2004 and the passing yardage record in 2005. Drafts has 21 touchdown strikes this year as well. Meanwhile, both Thigpen and Drafts are out-performing the League's passing efficiency record of 140.58. Thigpen is first in the League in the category at 171.7, holding and advantage over Drafts (162.4). Drafts set the record of 140.58 during the 2004 season.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 43 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 39 contests, followed by VMI (26), Charleston Southern (19) and Liberty (17).

**50-50 CHANCE**

Coastal Carolina is the second team in Big South history to score 50 points in back-to-back games, as CCU scored 66 points against Savannah State, Nov. 4, and 52 at Gardner-Webb this past weekend. GWU was the first team to score 50 in consecutive games, set last season in the first two weeks of the campaign (65 on Sept. 3, 54 on Sept. 10).

**10-4 GOOD BUDDY**

Four Big South quarterbacks have scored 10 rushing touchdowns in their careers, and Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is two away from tying the Big South career record in the category. Drafts is second all-time with 17 rushing touchdowns, trailing just **NICK ROBERTS**, who scored 19 in his career. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is third with 14 rushing touchdowns, ahead of **TYLER THIGPEN** (12).

**HEAD RUSH**

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5, became the first QB in League history to rush for 500 yards in a season following his 119-yard output Saturday at Gardner-Webb. Thigpen's total against the Bulldogs was the third-highest by a QB, while his 11.9 average per carry is the second-highest single-game average by any runner with at least 10 carries. Thigpen also moved into seventh-place all-time on the Big South's record rushing list with 1,556 yards. Former Liberty RB **EUGENE GOOD MAN** is in sixth-place at 1,769.

**YOU COMPLETE ME**

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is currently completing 72.8 percent of his passes this season (201-of-276), which is on pace to set the Big South single-season record. **NICK ROBERTS** owns the completion percentage record of 63.2 percent, set last season. Drafts needs 17 more completions to break the Big South single-season record of 217, which he set in 2005. He is also the first QB in League history with three consecutive 2,000 yard passing seasons. Meanwhile, Drafts' streak of 18-straight games with a TD pass ended Saturday at Liberty.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE -- AND LOSSES**

A Big South football member faces a nationally-ranked opponent for the 10th-straight week this coming Saturday, as Gardner-Webb hosts No. 20 Wofford and Charleston Southern visits No. 7 Coastal Carolina. Meanwhile, of the League's 13 non-conference losses, two were against Division I-A programs, four were against nationally-ranked opponents, and two were against teams that eventually cracked the Top 25 (UT-Martin and Towson) nationally.

**BIG SOUTH CLOSES OUT RECORD-SETTING SEASON SATURDAY**

The Big South enters the final week of the season with a League-record 21 non-Conference wins, as well as a Conference-best four wins over Southern Conference members. The previous high for non-League wins was 17 in 2003, set during a 12-game season. The Big South is 4-4 against the SoCon with one game remaining, breaking the record of three wins, set in 2004.

**HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE**

Coastal Carolina junior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has caught a touchdown pass in his last six games (eight total) and has 12 touchdown receptions on the season, setting his career-high and one away from tying the Big South single-season record of 13. He became the ninth player in Big South history to surpass 100 career receptions in Week 9, and is third all-time in League history with 1,784 receiving yards. Simpson, who needs 153 yards for second-place, has caught 29 of his 107 career receptions for touchdowns -- 27.1 percent.

**ZACH ATTACK**

Liberty sophomore RB **ZACH TERRELL** rushed for two touchdowns Saturday vs. Charleston Southern, the fifth-straight game with a score (nine total), four of which have been multi-TD efforts. He now has a League-leading 12 rushing touchdowns this season, just two away from tying the Big South single-season record of 14, shared by **AUNDRES PERKINS** and **EUGENE GOODMAN** in 2003. Terrell has 469 rushing yards in his last four outings (117.3) and has moved into third in the League with 645 rushing yards this season. His career rushing total now stands at 1,313, 11th all-time, and he needs 62 rushing yards to surpass **SAM GADO** (1,374) to crack the Top 10.

**JENNINGS STILL LEADS BIG SOUTH IN RUSHING**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** continues to lead the Big South with 909 rushing yards, which is the sixth-highest total in a single-season. Jennings is attempting to become the first Liberty rusher to lead the Big South in rushing since **DRE BARNES** in 2003, and needs 91 yards to record just the fifth 1,000-yard rushing season in Big South history.

**MIZ KID**

VMI senior RB **SEAN MIZZER** became the second player in Big South history with 3,000 rushing yards when he surpassed the total this past Saturday at The Citadel. He enters Saturday's season finale against Liberty with 3,052 rushing yards during his Big South tenure (3,562 overall), and has carried the ball a Big South-record 617 times. Mizzer is the Big South's career leader in all-purpose yards with 4,436.

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards in Week 4, is third all-time with 2,261 rushing yards.
