Mizzer led VMI in rushing with 173 yards on 22 carries and two touchdowns in the Keydets' season-opening 20-19 win over Davidson. He averaged 7.9 yards per carry, scored on touchdown runs of 10 and 63 yards - his longest career run from scrimmage -- and finished with 219 all-purpose yards. Mizzer produced his 14th career 100-yard rushing game and notched his 20th career rushing touchdown in the win as well.

NEW BALANCE

Walton had nine total tackles (five solo, four assists), two interceptions and another pass break-up. He picked off two passes in the second half that each led to VMI scores. His first interception came at the VMI two-yard line to stall a Davidson drive and set-up a 98-yard scoring drive for the Keydets. Walton's second pick stopped another Wildcat effort at the VMI 14 and set-up an 86-yard scoring drive.

Wynton Jackson • Return Specialist • Junior
Liberty • Jacksonville, Fla.

Jackson returned six punts for 86 yards (14.3 average) and a kickoff return for 20 yards in Liberty's season-opening 27-0 win over St. Paul's. He recorded a career long punt return of 46 yards to set up the Flames' second touchdown drive of the game and also posted punt returns of 16 and 11 yards. Jackson tied a school and Big South Conference single-game record with his six punt returns, while his 86 punt return yards rank as the fifth-highest in Big South history.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Brandon Jackson • Running Back
Gardner-Webb • Orlando, Fla.

Jackson bolted for 108 yards on just seven carries (15.4 average), including long runs of 28 and 36 yards in Gardner-Webb's season-opening 49-14 win at Jacksonville. The scored a touchdown on the 36-yard run, which was his fourth carry of the game. Playing just the 11th organized football game of his life, Jackson is the first true freshman back to gain 100 yards-or-more in his first career game for Gardner-Webb at the Division I-AA level. Jackson played just one season of prep football at Pine Castle Christian High School near Orlando.

BIG SOUTH GOES 4-1 IN OPENING WEEKEND FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR

The Big South went a combined 4-1 during the first weekend of the 2006 campaign, tying the League record for best season-opening mark. The Conference went 4-1 to kickoff last season. Since the start of Big South football in 2002, the League is now a combined 14-10 in season openers, with Gardner-Webb's 4-1 record the best among the membership.

AUGUST MOON

For the first time since the 2003 season, the Big South football season opened in August with last Thursday's St. Paul's at Liberty contest. The Flames' 27-0 shutout win improved the League's August record to 3-5. It also was Liberty's first win in four August games.

BIG SOUTH'S NEW HEAD COACHES VICTORIOUS IN DEBUTS

Liberty's **DANNY ROCCO** and VMI's **JIM REID** won their respective head coaching debuts in Week 1. Rocco's Flames defeated St. Paul's, 27-0, while Reid's Keydets held off Davidson, 20-19. Rocco became just the third coach in Liberty history to pick up a win in his first game, joining **JOHN CARTWRIGHT** (1974) and **SAM RUTIGLIANO** (1989) as victorious coaches in their LU debuts. Reid became the first VMI head coach to win his debut game since **BOB THALMAN** in 1971.

MORE ON OPENING WINS

Charleston Southern won its first season opener since 2001 with its 21-13 win over future Big South member Presbyterian. The victory also snapped a 12-game losing streak to the Blue Hose and marked the Bucs' first season-opening win on the road. Gardner-Webb improved to 19-16-2 in season openers and 8-2 under coach **STEVE PATTON**. Liberty won its third-straight opener, and VMI has opened the past two seasons with wins for the first time since 1990-91. Coastal Carolina did not win its season opener for the first time in the program's four years.

ONE STREAK CONTINUES...

Charleston Southern also extended its overall win streak to six consecutive games with Saturday's victory over Presbyterian. The Bucs will look to make it seven-straight Saturday at The Citadel, a team CSU has not defeated in three previous attempts.

...WHILE ANOTHER STREAK ENDS

Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's Big South-record 12-game home win streak was snapped Saturday with its 23-20 loss to Elon. In that span, the Chanticleers scored 591 points, for an average of 45.5 per game. They held their opponents to 209 points, or 16.1 per contest during the streak.

LOOKING TO START 2-0

Gardner-Webb is looking to start 2-0 for the second-straight year. Only one Big South team has started 2-0 in successive years -- Coastal Carolina (2004, 2005). In fact, CCU and GWU are the lone members to start 2-0 in the Big South's football history. The last time Liberty started 2-0 was in 1997. VMI last opened 2-0 in 2002 as members of the SoCon. Charleston Southern has never been 2-0.

ALSTON ALL ALONE AT THE TOP

Gardner-Webb return specialist **KORY ALSTON**'s 80-yard punt return for a touchdown Saturday at Jacksonville vaulted him to the top of three Big South career punt return records. He moved into first-place with three punt return TDs; jumped into first-place in return yards with 378, and now owns a return average of 21.0 yards (18 for 378), which passes **GREG WILLIAMSON**'s career mark of 18.0. In addition, Alston owns two of the three-longest punt returns in Big South history and has scored 18 career touchdowns -- 14 Pass, 3 Punt Return, 1 Rush.

NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER**'s 173 rushing yards Saturday pushed him into second-place on the Big South's career rushing list with 2,374. He moved past former Coastal Carolina RB **PATRICK HALL** (2,214). Former Liberty RB **DRE BARNES** is the Conference's all-time leading rusher with 3,409. Mizzer is 103 carries away from tying Barnes' League record of 563. In addition, Mizzer's two TD runs Saturday moved him into a four-way tie for fifth-place on the Big South's career rushing touchdown list with 15.

PERKING UP

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** moved into fifth-place on the Big South's career rushing list this past Saturday. He now stands at 1,803 yards, surpassing former Liberty RB **EUGENE GOODMAN** (1,769). Perkins is 150 yards from passing former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON**, who is fourth at 1,952 yards, and is 197 yards shy of becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 2,000 rushing yards.

FLAMES' DEFENSE BURNS OUT ST. PAUL'S OFFENSE, JUST MISSES LEAGUE RECORD

The Liberty Flames' defense allowed just 57 yards of total offense to St. Paul's (37 rush, 20 pass) on 40 plays. The 57 total offensive yards falls one yard short of tying the Big South record for fewest total offensive yards allowed. The 2003 Liberty Flames allowed 56 yards against Kentucky Wesleyan (-20 rush, 76 pass) on Sept. 20, 2003. The 20 passing yards allowed (3-of-13) are the third-fewest allowed in Big South history, behind Charleston Southern (16 vs. Elon on 2-of-4 in 2002) and Gardner-Webb's league-record of 15 vs. Georgia Southern in 2002 (1-of-5 passing).

RETURN SPECIALISTS

Gardner-Webb utilized a punt return touchdown and interception return touchdown in its 49-14 win at Jacksonville, the third such occurrence in League history. Gardner-Webb first posted a punt return TD and interception return TD in the same game on Nov. 9, 2002, while VMI did it on Oct. 11, 2003. It was the fifth punt return TD and sixth INT touchdown for Gardner-Webb since 2002, both League records.

FULL PRICE

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE** -- ranked No. 7 among all I-AA wide receivers by *The Sports Network* entering the season -- became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions when he caught his first pass of the day against Presbyterian. He finished with nine catches for 93 yard to increase his career numbers to 108 receptions and 1,537 yards. Price needs two catches to move into fourth all-time, and 124 yards for third-place. He needs 44 catches and 400 receiving yards to become the Big South's career leader in both categories. The Big South's up-to-date receiving records are provided in the chart to the right.

LIBERTY ENDS 10-GAME LOSING STREAK WITH SHUTOUT

Liberty snapped its 10-game losing streak with its first shutout since 2000 by blanking St. Paul's 27-0. Entering the game, the Flames' losing streak was the fourth-longest current losing streak in I-AA. It also was the first shutout in the Big South since VMI's 33-0 win over Davidson in last year's season opener, and the eighth in League history. The Flames' last shutout of an opponent was Samford (24-0) on Oct. 28, 2000 at Williams Stadium.

100% TOTAL

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** is looking to add another Big South Conference career record to his resume this season -- Total Offense. The Preseason Offensive Player of the Year is second all-time with 7,547 yards of total offense, 325 away from **NICK ROBERTS'** record of 7,872. Drafts already owns the League career marks in passing yards (7,259), attempts (1,047), completions (624), touchdown passes (53), passing yards per game (213.5), passing efficiency, total offensive plays (1,428) and total offense per game (222.0).

MILEAGE

Three Big South wide receivers are approaching 1,000 career receiving yards. Gardner-Webb's **AUSTIN GAINES** is 28 yards away (972), while Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** is 33 yards shy (967) of becoming the 10th player in Big South history to reach the 1,000 receiving yard mark. GWU's **AARON RICHARDSON** stands at 914 (13th all-time).

END ZONE CELEBRATIONS

Three Big South wide receivers are also vying for the League's career touchdown reception record. Coastal's **JEROME SIMPSON** is three scores away from tying the mark of 21, while Gardner-Webb's **DUVUAGHN FLAGLER** is five shy of the record. Flagler's teammate, **KORY ALSTON**, is seven away from the record, but four from Simpson's total.

THE INCREDIBLE HOKE

Coastal Carolina senior PK **JOSH HOKE** tied a Big South single-game record with his four field goals Saturday against Elon. Hoke joins former VMI kicker **MATT SHARPE**, who set the record vs. Gardner-Webb on Oct. 18, 2003 and tied it at Coastal Carolina on Nov. 1, 2003. Hoke attempted five field goals on the night, tying the Conference's single-game record as well. He finished with 12 points against Elon, marking his eighth career game scoring 10-or-more points, and he now owns 230 career points, tying teammate **AUNDRES PERKINS** for first on the Big South's overall scoring list.

RASHAD RUNS THROUGH

In his first game at Liberty, **RASHAD JENNINGS** became the 29th player in school history to rush for 100 yards in a game as he rushed for a game-high 160 yards against St. Paul's. He averaged 6.4 yards per carry and rushed for two touchdowns. Jennings posted 160 yards despite not playing after Liberty's first drive of the second-half. His effort was fifth-best rushing performance of the opening weekend in I-AA football.

GARDNER-WEBB'S WIN IN JACKSONVILLE ONE TO REMEMBER

During Saturday's Gardner-Webb at Jacksonville game, a power outage at D.B. Milne Stadium early in the first quarter zapped the scoreboard, the air conditioning in the press box and negated the effect of the sideline cooling fans Gardner-Webb traveled with in an attempt to overcome stifling 95-degree heat (and reported 109 heat index) for the rest of the game. The statistics crew was forced to plug into a generator located on the stadium's track surface to complete the stats input.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **MANNY ROJAS**, seventh all-time on the Big South's career tackle chart with 275, is 34 tackles shy of breaking the League's career total of 308, shared by former VMI standouts **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN**. He needs 17 more tackles to move past VMI's **ROBERT MASON** for fifth-place. Rojas is 26 hits away from becoming the fourth player in history with 300 stops.

T-MOBILE

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN** is 25 rushing yards away from 1,000 in his career, which would make him the second Big South quarterback to reach the rushing milestone. He is currently 13th all-time in League rushing annals, and needs 208 yards to pass former Gardner-Webb standout **NICK ROBERTS'** quarterback record 1,182 rushing yards.

MAKING THEIR POINT

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 34 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 30 contests. The League record is 35-straight games, held by Liberty from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut.

TYLER THROWS FOR THREE-HUNDRED

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN** broke his school record for passing yards by throwing for 312 Saturday against Elon. The total is the ninth-highest total in Big South history. Thigpen surpassed his own Coastal record of 287 yards, set vs. James Madison last season.

BIG SOUTH ADDS TWO NEW MEMBERS

On April 6, 2006, the Big South Conference announced that Presbyterian College will join the League, effective in 2007-08. The 2005 Blue Hose football team finished 10-2 overall, hosted a second round Division II playoff game and was ranked 10th nationally by the AFCA. Presbyterian is the alma mater of Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT**. PC will play a Conference schedule beginning in 2008. Meanwhile, the Big South announced on May 26 that Gardner-Webb, an associate football member, would join the League as full members beginning in 2008-09.

Two Big South teams will receive national exposure as part of Sirius Satellite Radio's new I-AA College Football Game of the Week series. Sirius will carry the Sept. 16 Coastal Carolina at Georgia Southern game and the Sept. 30 James Madison at VMI contest.
