**RASHAD JENNINGS • RB • R-Sophomore**

Jennings rushed for a season-high 194 yards on 21 carries at Savannah State. He recorded three rushing touchdowns for the second time this season and averaged 9.2 yards per rush, which is his second-best yards per carry average of the year. Jennings broke two 50-yard runs in the game -- a 53-yard touchdown scamper in the second quarter and a season-best 57-yard run in the third quarter that eventually led to a touchdown. He also became the first player in the Big South to rush for three touchdowns in a game twice in a season since Sam Gado in 2004, and has tied a League record in reaching 500 rushing yards (542) in just four games.

**NEW BALANCE  
DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Teal posted eight tackles, including six solos, and two pass break-ups in Coastal's 33-14 home win over South Carolina State. Playing on a defense without five starters Saturday, Teal had five stops and one break-up in the second half that led the Chanticleers to limiting the visiting Bulldogs to just 46 yards of total offense in a dominating second-half performance. One of his pass break-ups kept SCSU out of the end zone, as he dislodged the ball with a hit at CCU's three-yard line and SCSU was not able to cash in on the drive for points. He also stepped in on special teams by blocking a punt and returning kicks -- the first time he has been a returner since his senior year in high school.

Smith connected on 2-of-2 field goals to account for all of Gardner-Webb's scoring in a loss to No. 2 Appalachian State. He scored the game's first points with a 29-yard field goal then added a 45-yarder in the fourth stanza -- his Big South-record sixth career field goal from 45-yards or beyond. In addition, two of his three kickoffs went for touchbacks. Smith has booted home his last four field goal attempts - with his lone miss this season coming on a 49-yard try against Tennessee Tech in Week Two, and has made 14 of his last 18 tries dating back to last season.

**LIBERTY, BIG SOUTH TO PLAY IN FRONT OF NATIONAL WEB AUDIENCE SATURDAY**

The Liberty Flames' game at Wake Forest Saturday will be broadcast live on ESPN360, which is part of ESPN.com's broadband video service. It will be the Big South's first appearance on the web-only medium. Kickoff is scheduled for 3:30pm. The webcast will mark the League's second consecutive appearance on an ESPN property, as Gardner-Webb appeared on ESPNU this past Saturday. Next week, VMI's game at Army will also be carried by an ESPN property, which will be announced at a later date.

**BIG SOUTH CAPTURES WINNINGEST SEPTEMBER**

The Big South is 10-8 in the month of September thus far, establishing a League record for most wins in the traditional first month of the season. The previous best was nine wins, set in 2003 and equalled in 2005. With one week remaining in the month, the Big South will look for just its second winning record in September, and needs to finish no worse than 2-3 this coming Saturday. In 2002, the Conference went 8-6 in September.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN OWNS SECOND-LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN NATION**

Charleston Southern, which became the first team to start 3-0 since the Big South started football in 2002, owns the second-longest winning streak in the nation at eight games. The Bucs moved up a spot following Brown's nine-game streak ended this past weekend. San Diego has the longest streak at 11 games. Charleston Southern's eight-game win streak is third-longest in Big South history, behind Gardner-Webb's nine-game streak from 2002-03. Charleston Southern also has won its last five home games entering this weekend.

**PERK-OLATING**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards following his 18-carry, 78-yard performance against South Carolina State this past Saturday. Perkins surpassed former Gardner-Webb RB **JERMAINE BOSTON** (1,952) for fourth all-time in the process and is currently at 2,027 -- 188 yards away from reaching former teammate **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) for third-place. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list.

**FLAMES DEFENSE ON FIRE**

The Liberty Flames rank first in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to a miniscule 4.25 points per game (17 in 4 games). Liberty posted its second shutout of the season Saturday at Savannah State, becoming just the second team in Big South history to whitewash two opponents in one season. Gardner-Webb was the first in 2003. The Flames' defense has limited opponents to less than 10 points in three games this year, the most since Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina did it three times in 2004. The Big South record for scoring defense in a season is 16.0, set by the Chanticleers in 2004.

**TOTALLY OFFENSIVE**

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who leads I-AA in total offense with an average of 330.25 yards per game (1321 total), is just under halfway from the Big South's single-season record of 2,773 total yards, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2004. However, Thigpen is blazing ahead of the League's per game mark of 265.2, set by **COLLIN DRAFTS** in '04. Thigpen, the first player in Big South history to record more than 300 total offensive yards in three-straight games during Weeks 1-3, just missed a fourth-straight week as he finished with 290 yards vs. South Carolina State. **JENNINGS PACING AHEAD OF LEAGUE' SEASON RUSHING RECORD**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has tied a Big South record in reaching 500 yards in the first four games of the season. Jennings has notched 542 rushing yards in his first four games, joining VMI's **SEAN MIZZER**, who rushed for 517 yards in the first four games of '03. Jennings is averaging 135.5 yards per game -- good for fifth in the country, and is on pace for 1,490 rushing yards this season, which would break the Big South's single-season record of 1,347, set by Liberty's **DRE BARNES** in 2003. Jennings' current total is already 20th most in a season.

**NOBODY BEATS THE MIZ**

VMI redshirt-senior **SEAN MIZZER** continues to push towards the Big South career rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**. Mizzer now stands at 2,618 rushing yards in his Big South tenure (791 away from tying Barnes), and needs to average 113.0 per game over the remaining seven contests to reach the mark. Mizzer is currently averaging 104.3 yards per game, and has posted three 100-yard rushing games this season. He has 13 as a Big South member, which is second all-time to Barnes' League record of 17, and 16 overall in his VMI career.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE**

Big South football members face a nationally-ranked opponent for the third-straight week this coming Saturday, as VMI hosts No. 12 James Madison. The Dukes are ranked No. 12 by *Football Gazette*, as well as 15th by both *The Sports Network* and CSN Coaches Poll. The trend is likely to continue next week as Coastal Carolina hosts current No. 3 Furman. Last season, Big South members faced a nationally-ranked opponent nine out of 12 weeks.

**WHO NEEDS FEDEX WHEN THIGPEN DELIVERS IN THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND**

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the fastest player in Big South history to throw for 1,000 yards in a season when he passed the mark Saturday against South Carolina State. He has 1,115 yards through four games (278.8 per game) and is just the second Big South QB to have at least two 300-yard passing games in one season. Meanwhile, Thigpen became the first QB in League history to record two 90-yard rushing games in a season after Saturday's 91-yard effort against the Bulldogs. He gained 94 at Wofford in Week 2. Thigpen ranks 11th in Big South history with 1,176 career rushing yards, and needs seven yards to break **NICK ROBERTS'** quarterback rushing record of 1,182.

**LIBERTY SETS TEAM DAYLIGHT RECORD IN NIGHT GAME AT SAVANNAH STATE**

Liberty rushed for 296 yards on 33 carries Saturday night at Savannah State for a Big South single-game record 8.97 yards per carry. The old record was 8.82, set by Charleston Southern last season vs. West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15. The Bucs rushed for 397 yards on 45 attempts in that game.

**TWO TEAMS SET SINGLE-GAME ATTENDANCE RECORDS SATURDAY**

This past Saturday, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb enjoyed record crowds at their respective stadiums. The Chanticleers drew a crowd of 9,287 at Brooks Stadium for its win over South Carolina State, while the Runnin' Bulldogs attracted 8,490 to Spangler Stadium for its meeting with defending national champion Appalachian State. **POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 37 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Liberty held the previous record of 35-straight games with a point from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of the 2005 season when it was shutout by Connecticut. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 33 contests, followed by VMI (20), Charleston Southern (12) and Liberty (11).

**DEFENSIVE MINDED**

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **MANNY ROJAS** moved into fifth all-time on the Big South's career tackle chart this past Saturday with his five stops at Savannah State with 293. He surpassed former VMI DB **ROBERT MASON** (292) for the fifth spot, and is now seven hits away from becoming the fourth player in League history with 300 tackles. Rojas is 16 tackles shy of breaking the League's career total of 308, shared by former VMI standouts **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN**.

**PRICE NOW SECOND ON BIG SOUTH RECEPTIONS CHART**

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the fifth player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 1, is looking to become the League's all-time leading receiver by the end of the season. He is second all-time with 128 receptions after passing **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** and **AARON DUNKLIN** in Week 3. Price is in third-place with 1,738 career yards, and needs 11 to pass Dunklin for second on that list as well. Price stands 24 catches and 199 receiving yards away from becoming the Big South's career leader in both categories.

**COLLIN CARD**

Charleston Southern senior QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** became the first Big South player to surpass 8,000 career total offensive yards during Week 3. His 302-yard effort against Wingate pushed his Big South record total to 8,204. It was his seventh career game with more than 300 total yards, breaking the career record held by **NICK ROBERTS** (6). Drafts rushed for a personal-high 90 yards in that game, which is now tied for the ninth-most by a QB in a single-game in League history. Meanwhile, he is 209 passing yards away from becoming the first Big South QB to throw for 8,000 yards.

**EIGHT IS NOT ENOUGH**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South with eight touchdowns and 48 points, and is fifth nationally in scoring with 12.00 points per game. His eight TDs have all come on the ground, tied for the ninth-most in a single-season. Jennings has recorded two games with three rushing scores, the first player since **SAM GADO** accomplished the feat in 2004. The League record for rushing touchdowns is 14, shared by Coastal's **AUNDRES PERKINS** and Liberty's **EUGENE GOODMAN** in 2003. Jennings is closing in on becoming just the fifth Big South player with 10 rushing touchdowns in a season.

**10-4 GOOD BUDDY**

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** became the fourth signal-caller in Big South history to rush for 10 career touchdowns during Saturday's game vs. South Carolina State. **NICK ROBERTS** is the League's career leader among QBs with 19, followed by **JONATHAN WILSON** and **COLLIN DRAFTS** with 12 each. Thigpen is fourth with 10.

**GEORGIA (SOUTHERN) ON HIS MIND**

Coastal Carolina junior **JEROME SIMPSON** posted a record-breaking day at Georgia Southern in Week 3. He caught eight passes for 207 yards and two touchdowns, averaging 25.9 yards per catch. He became the second player in League history to post more than 200 yards receiving in a game, and his 207 yards are second-most in League annals -- just three yards from tying the record. Simpson's two touchdowns gave him 21 in his career, tying **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** as the Big South's career leader in the category. In fact, 28.4 percent of Simpson's career receptions have been for touchdowns.

**THOUSAND ISLAND**

Following his 207-receiving yard output in Week 3, Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** vaulted two spots on the Big South's career receiving yards list. He is now eighth all-time at 1,255, just behind Gardner-Webb's **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (seventh) at 1,294. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb's **AUSTIN GAINES** (1,157) cracked the all-time top 10 this past Saturday against Appalachian State, and is 76 yards from displacing **GARY PRICE** (1,232) for ninth.

**BICENTENNIAL MEN**

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** reclaimed the Big South's career scoring lead in Week 2 after teammate **JOSH HOKE** tied him in Week 1 at 230. Perkins is now at 248 points after scoring touchdowns the last three games, and is three points ahead Hoke, who is at 245. Hoke has 27 points on the season (8-8 PATs, 4-5 FG) thus far. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **HUNTER SMITH** is approaching the 200 point club, as he has scored 191 during his career. Smith has 15 points this season (3-3 PATs, 4-5 FG).

**FULL PRICE**

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE** -- ranked No. 7 among all I-AA wide receivers by *The Sports Network* entering the season -- is currently first in the nation in receptions per game with 9.67. He has 29 catches through three games, and ranks 10th nationally in receiving yards per game with 98.0. Price grabbed 12 balls for 130 yards in Week 2 at The Citadel, which was his fourth game with at least 10 receptions -- setting a Big South career record. It was also his eighth career 100-yard receiving game, which extended his League mark.

**BIG SOUTH'S BEN FRANKLINS**

**RASHAD JENNINGS** and **SEAN MIZZER** each have rushed for 100 yards in three games this season, and are averaging more than 100 rushing yards per game. The Big South has not had two rushers average 100.0 yards a game since 2004, when a record four players averaged triple digits. Jennings' per game clip of 135.5 is pacing ahead of the League record of 126.3, set by **DRE BARNES** in 2004.

**BABY BOOMER**

Gardner-Webb sophomore punter **MICHAEL HANNA** set a Big South single-game record for punting average in Week 2 against Tennessee Tech, booting five balls for 264 yards -- an average of 52.8. Hanna's punts, in order, were 54, 57, 59, 56 and 38. Three landed inside the 20 and Tech did not return any kicks. Hanna shared the previous record of 50.7 with former Bulldog **GRAHAM WHITLOCK**. Hanna, who has seven 50-yard-plus punts this year, is challenging Whitlock's League record of 45.5, as he is averaging 45.2 yards per punt.

**ALSTON ALL ALONE AT THE TOP**

Gardner-Webb return specialist **KORY ALSTON** became the Big South's all-time leader in three punt return categories in Week 1. He is now the all-time leader in punt return touchdowns (3), return yards (438) and return average of 19.0 yards (23 for 438). In addition, Alston owns two of the three longest punt returns in Big South history (80 and 76).

**TWO NEW MEMBERS SET TO JOIN BIG SOUTH**

On April 6, 2006, the Big South Conference announced that Presbyterian College will join the League, effective in 2007-08. Presbyterian is the alma mater of Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** and will play a Conference schedule beginning in 2008. Meanwhile, the Conference announced on May 26 that Gardner-Webb, an associate football member since the start of Big South football in 2002, would join the League as full members beginning in 2008-09.

**TIME TO GET SIRIUS**

Two Big South teams will receive national exposure as part of Sirius Satellite Radio's new I-AA College Football Game of the Week series. Sirius carried the Sept. 16 Coastal Carolina at Georgia Southern game and will air the Sept. 30 James Madison at VMI contest.
