COASTAL CAROLINA FALLS IN FIRST ROUND OF DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

No. 13 Coastal Carolina battled but could not overcome a hot start by defending national champion No. 1 Appalachian State, losing 45-28 in the first round of the NCAA Division I Football Championship, Nov. 25. With the loss, the Chanticleers end their historic season and the Big South's first-ever play-off berth with a 9-3 mark. The Mountaineers jumped out to a 31-0 halftime lead, but Coastal fought back to score the most points against ASU this season. Coastal Carolina received an at-large berth in the playoffs after winning its second outright Big South title in three years.

COASTAL NOTCHES CONFERENCE'S FIRST THREE-PEAT

With its 31-17 win over Charleston Southern in the regular-season finale, Coastal Carolina has won or shared three consecutive Big South football titles, the first team in the Big South's five-year football history to accomplish the feat. Gardner-Webb won the first two championships in 2002 and 2003, with Coastal winning in 2004. The Chanticleers and Charleston Southern were co-champs in 2005 with 3-1 records.

STREAKERS

Coastal Carolina's eight-game win streak was snapped at No. 1 Appalachian State in the first round of the playoffs. Coastal's streak was the fifth-longest in the nation at the time, and marked the third-straight year CCU built win streaks of seven games-or-longer. The longest in-season win streak in the Big South in 2006 was nine games by Charleston Southern, which won 14-straight dating back to 2005. Liberty will carry the longest win streak into next season at three wins.

COASTAL SETS 13 BIG SOUTH TEAM RECORDS IN 2006

Coastal Carolina set 13 Big South Conference team records during the regular-season. Among the records the Chants set include total offense (5,617 yards), total offense per game (468.1), total offense per play (7.1), pass efficiency (166.6), passing yards (3,429), passing yards per game (285.8), offensive touchdowns (53) and touchdown passes (30).

WALTER PAYTON AWARD FINALIST TYLER THIGPEN

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN finished seventh in the voting for *The Sports Network's* 2006 Walter Payton Award. One of 16 Finalists considered for the award for the Football Championship Subdivision's version of the Heisman Trophy, Thigpen is the first Big South player in history to be a Finalist for the award. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina head coach DAVID BENNETT is a Finalist for the 2006 Eddie Robinson Award.

THIGPEN OWNS BIG SOUTH TOTAL OFFENSE RECORD

Coastal Carolina senior QB TYLER THIGPEN, who is second nationally in total offense with an average of 329.33 yards per game, set the Big South single-season record for total offense and total offense per game. He notched a League-record nine games this season with at least 300 total yards, and finished with a record 3,952 yards. Thigpen also moved into second all-time in total offense with 8,236 yards. HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina junior WR JEROME SIMPSON caught a touchdown pass in his final eight games (12 total) and finished the year with a record 16 touchdown receptions, setting his career-high and also breaking the League's overall single-season touchdown record of 14. He caught a TD pass in all but one game this year (South Carolina State) and recorded five multi-TD games to lead the League. Simpson's 1,077 receiving yards in 2006 season a single-season Big South record, becoming the third player in League annals with 1,000 receiving yards in a campaign. He also is just the second player in Big South history to surpass 2,000 career receiving yards, which he reached during Coastal's play-off game at Appalachian State. He enters his senior season eighth all-time in receptions (120) and second in yardage (2,023). Simpson is the Big South's career leader with 33 touchdown receptions -- 27.5 percent of his 120 receptions.

PASSING GRADES

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** set single-season Big South passing records of 29 touchdown passes, 3,296 yards, 274.7 yards per game and a 167.4 passing efficiency rating this season. Thigpen's five 300-yard passing games are a season record, he became the first player in Big South history to throw for 3,000 yards in a season, the first to throw for 300 yards in three consecutive games, and the first to throw 300 yards and rush for 100 in the same game (at Gardner-Webb in Week 11).

HEAD RUSH

Coastal Carolina senior QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who became the Big South's career rushing leader among quarterbacks at Winston-Salem State in Week 5, is the first QB in League history to rush for 600 yards in a season, finishing fourth in the League with a quarterback record 656 rushing yards. Thigpen's 119 yards on the ground at Gardner-Webb was the third-highest by a QB, while his 11.9 average per carry in the game is the second-highest single-game average by any runner with at least 10 carries. He ends his career ranked seventh all-time on the Big South's career rushing list with 1,638 yards.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 45 games in its history, establishing the Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 40 contests, followed by VMI (27), Charleston Southern (20) and Liberty (18).

50-50 CHANCE

Coastal Carolina became the second team in Big South history to score 50 points in back-to-back games in a season, as CCU scored 66 points against Savannah State, Nov. 4, and 52 at Gardner-Webb, Nov. 11. GWU was the first team to score 50 in consecutive games, set during the 2005 season in the first two weeks of the campaign (65 on Sept. 3, 54 on Sept. 10).

PERK-OLATING

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who became the fourth player in Big South history to rush for 2,000 career yards in Week 4, finishes his career third all-time with 2,343 rushing yards. Perkins started the season sixth all-time on the Big South's career rushing list, and is the League's all-time leader in touchdowns scored with 47 (46 rush, 1 receiving). His third touchdown at Gardner-Webb in Week 11 was his first career receiving touchdown. With nine TDs this season, Perkins just missed his fourth-straight year with at least 10 touchdowns.

TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **JAMAR LEATH** became the Big South's all-time leader in tackles in Week 7 following his 13-tackle performance at VMI. He surpassed **JUSTIN HUGGARD** and **TODD BALDWIN** for the career lead, and ends his career with 364. Liberty senior LB **MANNY ROJAS** ends his career second at 348. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern junior **JADA ROSS** -- the first player in Big South history to record 20 tackles in a game twice in the same season -- became the sixth player in League history with 300 career tackles when he reached the milestone in Week 10, and is third all-time at 323. BIG SOUTH ENJOYS MOST SUCCESSFUL FOOTBALL SEASON IN LEAGUE HISTORY

Coastal Carolina's berth in the NCAA Division I Football Championship highlights the Big South's most successful football season in the five years since the Conference began sponsoring the sport in 2002. The League won a record 21 non-Conference games in 2006, breaking the old record of 17 in 2003, set during a 12-game season. The Big South also won four games against Southern Conference members, breaking the League record of three wins, set in 2004.

KEEPING IT CLOSE

The scoring margin for the 10 Big South games this season averaged 9.4 points, a League-record for lowest average margin of victory in a Conference season. The old mark of 10.5 was set last season. In addition, six of the 10 contests this season were decided by six points-or-less.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

The Big South faced a nationally-ranked opponent the final 11 weeks of the 2006 season, while Gardner-Webb played three playoff teams this year in UT-Martin, Appalachian State and Coastal Carolina. Meanwhile, of the League's 15 non-conference losses, two were against Division I-A programs, five were against nationally-ranked opponents, and three were against teams that eventually cracked the Top 25 (UT-Martin, Towson and Wofford) nationally.

PRICE BECOMES SEVENTH PLAYER IN NCAA HISTORY WITH 100 RECEPTIONS IN A SEASON

Charleston Southern junior WR **MAURICE PRICE**, who became the League's all-time leader in receptions and yardage in Week 7, finished the 2006 season with a League-record 103 receptions, becoming the seventh player in NCAA history with 100 catches in a season. Price, who leads the NCAA with 9.56 receptions per game, increased his Big South career records to 202 receptions and 2,429 receiving yards. He also had a record five games with at least 10 receptions this year. Below is the updated 100-reception seasons in NCAA history:

YOU COMPLETE ME

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** completed a Big South single-season record 69.9 percent of his passes this year (223-of-319), breaking the old mark of 63.2 percent held by Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**, set last season. Drafts' 223 completions are also a League record, breaking his own mark of 217, which he set in 2005. He is the only QB in League history with three consecutive 2,000-yard passing seasons (each over 2,500 yards to be exact) and is the second QB in Big South annals with 500 rushing yards in a season (513).

MIZZER EDGES JENNINGS FOR SEASON RUSHING TITLE

VMI senior **SEAN MIZZER** rushed for 171 yards vs. Liberty in the season finale, and Flames RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** countered with 111 yards of his own in Liberty's 38-32 win over VMI. After the dust settled, Mizzer ended the year with 1,022 rushing yards -- two ahead of Jennings' 1,020. It marks the second time in League history that two players rushed for 1,000 yards in a season, and Mizzer is the first VMI player to lead the Big South in rushing in a season. Meanwhile, Jennings became the 15th player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty sophomore RB **ZACH TERRELL** rushed for one touchdown at VMI, ending the season with a rushing TD in six-straight games (10 total), four of which were multi-TD efforts. He posted a League-leading 13 rushing touchdowns, falling one TD short of tying the Conference record of 14, shared by **AUNDRES PERKINS** and **EUGENE GOODMAN** in 2003. Terrell finished third in the League with 673 rushing yards -- 497 of which game in his last five outings. His career rushing total now stands at 1,341, 11th all-time, and 34 yards from cracking the League's Top 10.

ZERO TOLERANCE

Liberty has set Big South single-season records for scoring defense, fewest points allowed, total defense and fewest touchdowns allowed, among others. The Flames, which recorded a League-record three shutouts this season, are now the record holders for the following categories:

KICK START

Liberty set a Big South single-season record with three kickoff return touchdowns this season, with **DOMINIC BOLDEN** recording two of them, setting the League's individual record. Bolden returned just seven kickoffs this season for 293 yards for a 41.9 average, but does not meet the minimum qualification to be ranked among the national leaders. **WYNTON JACKSON** was the other player with Liberty's kickoff return TD, and the Flames finished the year averaging a Big South-record 25.56 yards per return, third in the nation this season.

10-AND-5 PLAYERS

The Big South had a record five players score at least 10 touchdowns this season, led by **JEROME SIMPSON** (16), **ZACH TERRELL** (13), **SEAN MIZZER** (10), **RASHAD JENNINGS** (10) and **MAURICE PRICE** (10). The previous high was three players, set in 2003 and 2004. Meanwhile, Terrell and Jennings are just the second pair of teammates in Big South history to score 10 TDs in a season since **AUNDRES PERKINS** and **PATRICK HALL** did so for Coastal Carolina in 2004. The Big South has two players (Simpson and Price) with 10 TD receptions for the first time in League history as well.

THE GOOD HANDS PEOPLE

Gardner-Webb was the first team in Big South history this season to have three active players surpass 100 career receptions. Junior **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** ends the year 3rd all-time with 128 catches, and 4th with 1,769 receiving yards, as well as 2nd with 22 touchdowns. **KORY ALSTON** ends his career tied for 4th all-time with 127 receptions, while ranking 6th in receiving yards (1,743) and fifth in touchdowns (17). **AUSTIN GAINES** caps his career tied for 4th with 127 catches and 8th with 1,599 receiving yards.

BICENTENNIAL MEN

The Big South has three players with 200 career points, led by Coastal kicker **JOSH HOKE**, who ends his career at 297 points. **AUNDRES PERKINS**, who entered the season as the League's all-time leading scorer, is second with 286 points. Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** concludes his career third all-time with 229 points.
