FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

UNC Asheville claimed its first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Championship on March 10th as it downed Radford, 67-57 ... **AMANDA ELDER** was named the Tournament MVP, while teammate **BRITTANY HENDLEY** joined Elder on the all-tournament team ... With the win, the Bulldogs earned the Big South's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament and picked up a No. 14 seed in their region.

YOU'RE INVITED

With its regular-season championship, High Point earned a bid to the WNIT post-season tournament for the first time in the school's history ... The game will mark the second time that High Point has played in the WNIT as it played in the tournament at the beginning of the season ... Although the Panthers are on the road, they have the luxury of playing close to home as they travel to Charlotte to take on the 49ers ... **LESLIE COOK** began her career with the 49ers before transferring to High Point to finish up her career.

TWICE AS NICE

For the first time-ever in Big South history, the League has two teams participating in post-season play.

IT'S GOTTA BE BUTTER, CUZ WE'RE ON A ROLL

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs are peaking at the right time going into the NCAA Tournament ... The Bulldogs have turned it on and are going into the Tournament on a six-game winning streak.

YEAH, WE'RE THE ONLY ONES

The High Point Panthers were the only team to sweep Liberty in the series this season ... The sweep marked the first time since the 1996-1997 season that the Lady Flames were swept ... Also, the Panthers were the only team in the Big South win all their Conference home games as they went 7-0 this season.

COOK EARNS ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

LESLIE COOK of High Point was tabbed First Team Academic All-America by *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA, it was announced last week. The honor marks the second-straight year Cook earned the honor.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33. Dill recorded another 30-point game with 32 points against Savannah State on Feb. 7, only to repeat the feat with 32 points against Winthrop on Feb. 28 ... **KELLI DARDEN** rounds out the list of 30-point scorers this season as she dropped 31 points on Winthrop on Feb. 10.

1K ... AND COUNTING

The Big South added two new members to its 1,000 point club this season ... Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** entered the list on Jan. 13 and is currently at 1,342 points in her career to rank 17th all-time ... Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** joined the group on Jan. 8 and now has 1,292 points in her career to rank 21st all-time.

CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS

The League had four players enter the 500 rebound club this season in Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** and Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS** and **CORRIE FERTITTA**. Wicker currently has 664 rebounds in her career to rank 23th all-time, while Fertitta has 644 to rank 24th. Stephens' 613 career boards and is tied for 31st all-time ... UNC Asheville's **AMANDA ELDER** joined the 500 board club over the last weekend and rounds out the list with 533 rebounds, 38th all-time

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 6 in the country with 22.5 points per game. Dill has posted a League-high 20 games of 20 or more points to earn Big South Player of the Year honors ... Her 22.5 points per game ranks fourth in the Conference annuals in single-season scoring average ... She is also entered the Big South's single season scoring top five with 652 points on the season.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 186 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 142 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers, five shy of third All-Time ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 100 wins at High Point and is currently 6th all-time in the League's annuals.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC entered the Big South Conference Tournament as the sixth seed to face third-seeded Liberty, and lost, 70-58, in UNC Asheville's Justice Center. It was the third post-season meeting between the teams, and the first time that they had played each other on a neutral court ... Junior forward **REBA ROSS** earned First-Team All-Big South Conference and Academic All-Conference honors, while freshman guard Marisah Henderson was named to the All-Freshman squad.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

They Lady Bucs ended a 10-20 season with a first-round loss to Radford ... Senior **KEENA WICKER** ended her career on top, scoring a game-high 25 points, adding eight rebounds, two blocks and two steals. She will finish her career with 1,292 points, putting her squarely in third place all-time in CSU history ... Her 664 career rebounds puts her fourth all-time on the career rebounding charts ... She is the only one to currently rank in the top-five in both categories ... Sophomore **PAM TOLBERT** also averaged double figures for the season, adding 12.1 points per game, with a 12.8 ppg mark in Conference games ... With 61 blocks this season, **SHAUNTE SMALL** broke her own record for blocks in a season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal bowed out of the Big South Tournament with a quarterfinal loss to eventual Big South Tournament champion UNC Asheville 65-51 ... Coastal finished with a winning record for the second straight season and now has had back-to-back 18-win seasons ... **ALISHA DILL** ended the year with 652 points, which is the single-season record at Coastal. That mark also is fifth all-time in the Big South ... Dill became the second Big South Player of the Year from Coastal ... **BROOKE WEISBROD** won the honor in 2000-01 ... Coastal had three players on the All-Freshman Team ... Coastal had three players all-time on the Rookie team before this year.

HIGH POINT

High Point won the Big South Regular Season title, but fell in the first round of the conference tournament to Winthrop ... With the regular season crown, the Panthers earned the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT and will face Charlotte on Thursday, March 15 at 7 p.m. in Charlotte. This will be the fourth meeting between the two teams, with Charlotte holding the 2-1 advantage ... HPU placed senior **CANDYCE SELLARS** on the All-Conference First Team while **LESLIE COOK** earned Second Team honors ... Cook was named the Big South Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year after earning Academic All-America First Team honors ... This was her second consecutive year being named Scholar-Athlete of the Year ... Head Coach **TOOEY LOY** was named the Big South Coach of the Year after leading the Panthers to an 11-3 record, this was his second Coach of the Year honors, having won it previously in 2005 ... The Panthers earned the Big South's bid to the WNIT where it fell to Charlotte.

LIBERTY

The Liberty women's basketball team enjoyed its 11th-consecutive winning season in 2006-07, finishing 19-12 overall and tying for second in the Big South standings with a 10-4 conference mark. The Lady Flames' streaks of 10-consecutive Big South Championship titles and 29-straight Big South Championship wins came to an end with a 57-55 setback against Radford in the Big South semifinals ... The team ranked sixth nationally in rebounding margin, out-rebounding foes by an average of 10.6 rpg, marking the fourth-straight season Liberty has been among the nation's 10 best rebounding teams. Individually, sophomore **MEGAN FRAZEE**, the team's leading scorer (17.2 ppg) and rebounder (8.5 rpg) was a Big South All-Conference first-team selection as well as a member of the all-tournament team. She scored 37 points and pulled down 15 rebounds in Liberty's biggest win of the season, a 75-71 win at Virginia on Nov. 20 which made the Lady Flames the first visiting team ever to win at John Paul Jones Arena ... Head coach **CAREY GREEN** became the conference's all-time leader in conference victories this season and is now 101-11 in eight years of conference play.

RADFORD

Radford recorded one of its best seasons in over 10 years winning 20 games for the first time since 1991-92 and reaching the Big South Championship game for the first time since 1995-96 ... Radford had a League-high three members of its team named All-Conference a first since 1991-92. Junior **KELLI DARDEN** a career season which included setting Radford's and the Big South's single-season block record with 85. She also broke RU's career record and will enter next season, needing 63 to become the League's all-time leader. Also, junior **CORRIE FERTITTA** and sophomore **JOHNETTE WALKER** entered the top ten in career categories at RU, while the team broke the single-season block record and posted top-10 numbers in other categories as well.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville won its first-ever Big South Championship with a 67-57 victory over Radford ... **AMANDA ELDER** was named tournament MVP averaging 17.3 points and 9.7 rebounds in the tournament while **BRITTANY HENDLEY** was also named to the all-tournament team averaging 11.3 points per game ... This season, Asheville has broken school records for wins as a Division I school, most three-pointers made and attempted, most free throws made and attempted, most points, and most blocked shots ... The Bulldogs enter the NCAA Tournament on a season-high six game winning streak. It is the second time this season the Dogs have won six in a row. Asheville's 21 wins marks only the fourth 20 win season school history and the first since 1984-85 ... The NCAA tournament appearance is the school's first post season appearance since winning the NAIA National Championship in 1984 ... The Bulldogs fell to No. 3 in the NCAA Tournament.

WINTHROP

Sophomore guard **TIFFANY RODD** finished the season with 74 three-point baskets, which sets a school record ... Sophomore **ASHLEY FANN** was named to the Big South Conference All-Tournament Team for the second straight season despite not reaching the championship game either season. She averaged 18 ppg, 7.5 rpg and 3.5 spg in her two games at the tourney.
