Hendley averaged 19.5 points per game to help Asheville close out the regular-season on a three-game winning streak. She got her week started with 21 points against Radford on 8-of-10 from the floor and 5-of-6 from downtown. She also dished out seven assists and came up with three boards and a steal in the win against the Highlanders. Three days later against Birmingham-Southern, she connected on 46 percent from the floor, 50 percent from beyond the arc and nailed two free throws as she put in 18 points for the Bulldogs in the win over the Panthers. For the week, she was 14-of-23 (61 percent) from the floor and a blistering 9-of-14 (64 percent) from long range and added nine assists, four boards and four steals for the Bulldogs in the two-game span.

Jones posted 11.0 points per contest in the Bulldogs' final two games of the regular-season. Against Radford on Feb. 28, she notched 16 points on 42 percent from the floor, 2-of-4 from three-point land and connected on 4-of-6 from the charity stripe. Jones also corralled five boards and posted a steal against the Highs. Against the Panthers, she posted six points, five steals and two boards in the win. For the week, she shot 50 percent from long range and 70 percent from the line to go along with seven caroms, six steals and two helpers.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

High Point claimed its first-ever Big South regular-season championship over the weekend as it finished the season with an 11-3 record in League play ... This season marked the first time since 1997 that Liberty was not the regular-season champion and No. 1 seed heading into the tournament ... The Panthers were the only team in the Big South to protect thier home court as they posted a perfect 7-0 Big South record at home.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina and UNC Asheville are currently on the League's two longest winning streaks. The Lady Chant's have won their last four games, while the Bulldogs are on a three game winning streak. The two teams will put their streaks on the line in the first round of the 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament as the Lady Chants and the Bulldogs square off game two of the tournament. The Bulldogs will have the luxury of the home court where they posted a 5-2 record in Big South games this season. Being on the road isn't all bad for Coastal Carolina as it posted a 5-2 record in League games.

ALL-CONFERENCE ANNOUNCEMENT

The Big South will announce its 2007 postseason awards Wednesday night at the 2007 Women's Basketball Banquet ... The Banquet will serve as the kickoff for the 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. The League returned to a "one site" format as all the games of the tournament will be played at the Justice Center on the Campus of UNC Asheville.

COOK EARNS ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

LESLIE COOK of High Point was tabbed First Team Academic All-America by *ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA*, it was announced last week. The honor marks the second-straight year Cook earned the honor.

WNIT EXPANSION

The WNit announced that it will expand its field to 48 teams this year for the first time in the history of the WNit. The expansion will allow for an automatic bid from all 31 Leagues around the nation. The Big South's bid will be highest finishing team in the Conference's regular-season standings that does not advance to the NCAA Tournament.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33. Dill recorded another 30-point game with 32 points against Savannah State on Feb. 7, only to repeat the feat with 32 points against Winthrop on Feb. 28 ... **KELLI DARREN** rounds out the list of 30-point scorers this season as she dropped 31 points on Winthrop on Feb. 10.

1K ... AND COUNTING

The Big South added two new members to its 1,000 point club this season ... Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** entered the list on Jan. 13 and is currently at 1,321 points in her career to rank 19th all-time ... Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** joined the group on Jan. 8 and now has 1,267 points in her career to rank 24th all-time.

CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS

The League had four players enter the 500 rebound club this season in Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** and Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS** and **CORRIE FERTITTA**. Wicker currently has 656 rebounds in her career to rank 23th all-time, while Fertitta has 636 to rank 25th. Stephens' 598 career boards is good for 35th all-time ... UNC Asheville's **AMANDA ELDER** joined the 500 board club over the last weekend and rounds out the list with 524 rebounds, 40th all-time

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 4 in the country with 22.5 points per game. Dill has posted a League-high 19 games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors four times this season ... Her 22.5 points per game currently ranks fourth in the Conference annuals in single-season scoring average ... She is also only 18 points away from entering the Big South's single season scoring top five with 631 points on the season.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 185 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LEFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 142 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers, five shy of third All-Time ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 100 wins at High Point and is currently 6th all-time in the League's annuals.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 0-2 to finish out the regular season this week, dropping a game at home to Liberty, Monday, and losing on the road to UNC Asheville, Saturday. Junior **REBA ROSS** led BSC against Liberty with 16 points and eight rebounds, and senior **MUNECA OLIVER** led the Panthers against UNCA with a career-high 22 points.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Senior **KEENA WICKER** finished up her final regular season in style, leading the Lady Bucs in both games this week, including a 22-point effort against Coastal Carolina ... At halftime, Wicker had 16 of the teams 23 points. In the first game of the week, the Lady Bucs battled back, trailing as much as 27, but could not close the gap enough. Sophomore **PAM TOLBERT** had 17 points in each of the two games.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal will be the fifth seed in the Big South Tournament and will face host UNC Asheville Thursday at 2 p.m ... Coastal is 2-1 all-time against UNC Asheville in the Big South Tournament, but the two have not played since 1997-98, when the Chants were defeated by the Bulldogs, 60-59 ... Coastal has advanced to the semifinals four of the last five seasons, including last year ... **ALISHA DILL** became Coastal's all-time leading scorer in the 60-53 win over Charleston Southern. Dill now has 631 points this season and is only 18 points away from Liberty's **ELENA KISSELEVA** (1996-97) in moving into fifth place on the Big South list ... Coastal's 18 regular season wins tied with the 1999-2000 club for most regular-season wins while a Division I program.

HIGH POINT

High Point won its first Big South regular season title this week, going 11-3 in the conference... The Panthers will take the #1 seed in next week's Big South Conference Tournament... Head Coach **TOOEY LOY** picked up his 100th career win on Saturday against Winthrop ... The Panthers also honor seniors **LESLIE COOK**, **KATIE RALLS**, **CANDYCE SELLARS** and **ERICA BROCKMYER** prior to the final home game ... Junior **AMBER MANUEL** pulled down an impressive 18 boards against the Eagles to set her new career-high. She put together back-to-back double-doubles with 18 points and 13 rebounds against CSU followed by a 14 point, 18 rebound performance against Winthrop ... The Panthers will face the Eagles in the first round of the conference tournament.

LIBERTY

Liberty saw its string of consecutive Big South regular-season titles end at nine ... The Lady Flames overcame a 14-point deficit to win at Birmingham-Southern on Monday, representing their largest comeback win of the season ... Liberty's 23-point loss at Radford to close the season on Saturday was its most lopsided setback against a Big South foe since UNC Greensboro beat the Lady Flames, 84-40, on March 7, 1996 ... Liberty has won 28-straight Big South Championship contests, entering this week's tournament.

RADFORD

With the victory over Liberty, Radford snapped a 15-game losing streak to the Lady Flames ... The Highlanders reached 18 overall wins for the first time since 1993-94 and 10 Big South victories since 1997-98. They also won 12 home games for the first time since 1988-89 ... **SHAVON EARP** became the second Highlander this season to tie the single-game three-point record, going 6-for-8 vs. Liberty. Her performance catapulted her into fourth on RU's career charts with 101 ... **SERENA WHITE** drained her 100th triple of her career, fifth most in school history ... **KELLI DARDEN** had six blocks this week, bringing her season total to 79, tying RU's single-season record which is tied for the third best in the Big South.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs posted a 2-0 week averaging 85 points per game against Radford and Birmingham-Southern ... Asheville lit it up from three-point range this week going 17-for-31 (54.8%) from beyond the arc while RU and BSC combined to go 2-for-22 (09.1%) ... **BRITTANY HENDLEY** averaged 19.5 ppg shooting 61% (14-for-23) from the floor and 64% (9-for-14) from three-point range ... **AMANDA ELDER** recorded double-doubles in both games with 10 pts, 11 reb vs RU and a career-high 21 pts, 11 reb vs BSC ... **STACY SHEPARD**, **KYLA JONES**, and **ANA BAKER** also averaged double figures last week ... This season the Bulldogs have posted single-season school records for three-pointers made and attempted. They are closing in on records for free throws made and attempted as well as most points scored.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles set a school record for threes in a single season. They have made 158 this season and passed the old record of 155 that was set last season.
