The Lady Flames and the Highlanders have a date for the last weekend of the regular season on March 3 that will ... The race is still up for grabs as the Big South's teams head into the final week of the season

#### MILESTONE

Liberty mentor **CAREY GREEN** picked up his 100th Big South with a win over Charleston Southern on Feb. 19. Green is the coach in Big South history to have 100 wins Big South wins in their career as he surpassed **LUBY LICHONCZAK**'s 99 wins.

#### BIG WIN!

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs completed a feat over the weekend that only High Point has accomplished in the past three seasons. On Saturday, Asheville downed the Lady Flames on their home court in the Vines Center. The win marked the first time Asheville has beaten Liberty at the Vines Center in 17 years. Its last win at Lynchburg before Saturday's game was on Feb. 12, 1990.

#### MARCH MADNESS, BIG SOUTH STYLE

The 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship is right around the corner with the first round on Thursday, March 8. The tournament is being hosted by UNC Asheville and will take place in the Justice Center on the campus of UNC Asheville.

#### STUDENT-ATHLETE

The Big South Conference boasted 3-of-the-5 players on the *ESPN The Magazine/COSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team*. Liberty had two players on the First-Team in **MEGAN FRAZEE** and **ALLYSON FASNACHT**. High Point's **LESLIE COOK** joined Frazee and Fasnacht on the first team as well. Last season Cook earned Academic All-America honors.

#### CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33. Dill recorded another 30-point game with 32 points against Savannah State on Feb. 7 ... **KELLI DARREN** rounds out the list of 30-point scorers this season as she dropped 31 points on Winthrop on Feb. 10.

#### 1K ... AND COUNTING

The Big South added two new members to its 1,000 point club this season ... Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** entered the list on Jan. 13 and is currently at 1,263 points in her career to rank 24th all-time ... Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** joined the group on Jan. 8 and now has 1,226 points in her career to rank 28th all-time.

#### CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS

The League had three players enter the 500 rebound club this season in Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** and Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS** and **CORRIE FERTITTA**. Wicker currently has 647 rebounds in her career to rank 23th all-time, while Fertitta has 626 to rank 27th. Stephens' 590 career boards is good for 35th all-time ... UNC Asheville's **AMANDA ELDER** joined the 500 board club over the last weekend and rounds out the list with 502 rebounds, 46th all-time

#### WNIT EXPANSION

The WNIT announced that it will expand its field to 48 teams this year for the first time in the history of the WNIT. The expansion will allow for an automatic bid from all 31 Leagues around the nation. The Big South's bid will be highest finishing team in the Conference's regular-season standings that does not advance to the NCAA Tournament.

#### SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 6 in the country with 22.0 points per game. Dill has posted a League-high 17 games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors four times this season ... Her 22.0 points per game currently ranks fourth in the Conference annuals in single-season scoring average.

#### MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 184 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LEFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 140 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 98 wins at High Point and is currently 6th all-time in the League's annuals.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

### BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers split this week with a win on the road against Winthrop, Monday, and a close home loss to Radford, Saturday, for Homecoming ... Head coach BRAD HODGE reached a career milestone this week, notching his 100th career win, Monday, against Winthrop.

### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneer offense went cold this week ... On their current three-game losing streak, CSU has not reached 50 points in any of them ... They are 0-5 on the season when not reaching that mark ... Senior KEENA WICKER scored 21 and 17 in the two games, and was the only Lady Buccaneer to reach double figures in both games ... Sophomore PAM TOLBERT did so against Winthrop, scoring 10 points. CSU will try to right the ship this week as they close out the regular season with two contests at the CSU Field House, where they are 6-4 this season.

### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal heads into the final weekend of the regular season with a 7-5 conference record, which ties them with UNC Asheville for fourth place ... The Lady Chants shook up the top of the standings with wins over Radford (61-54) and High Point (66-57) ... Senior ALISHA DILL averaged 25.0 points per game and now is 49 points away from becoming Coastal single-season scoring leader. NIKKI REDDICK had 621 points in the 2000-01 season ... In Coastal's last five games, VICTORIA BLANCHARD is averaging 9.6 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. This includes a 12-point performances against Radford and High Point ... Coastal also is shooting 73.6 percent from the free-throw line in that stretch ... The Lady Chants wrap up the regular season with games against Winthrop and Charleston Southern ... The Winthrop game Wednesday night is Senior Night, as seniors ALISHA DILL, HEATHER HUMMEL, VANESSA LAUG, CALISHA YATES and KRISTY YURICHAK will be honored before the game.

### HIGH POINT

High Point was 1-1 on the week, winning at home against Asheville, 59-53 before falling to Coastal on the road, 57-66 ... The Panthers are in a threeway tie for first in the Big South Conference with Radford and Liberty ... Senior guard LESLIE COOK scored her 1000th collegiate point this past week when she connected for a three pointer with 15:13 left in the game. Cook's first 520 points came while she was UNC Charlotte ... HPU will conclude the regular season this week with a game at Charleston Southern on Monday before returning home to face Winthrop in the season finale on Saturday.

### LIBERTY

Liberty's 91-40 win over Charleston Southern on Monday enabled CAREY GREEN to set the record for most Big South Conference victories ... Green is now 100-10 in Big South Conference regular season games ... The 91 points scored also mark the Lady Flames' all-time highest single-game output in a Big South game ... Prior to Saturday's 54-51 home loss to UNC Asheville, no Big South team other than High Point had won at the Vines Center since Jan. 13, 2000, when Elon did so ... Liberty's senior quartet of JAMIE FEAGIN, LESLIE JONES, MICHELLE PARKER and KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ finished their home career with a 50-6 record at the Vines Center.

### RADFORD

Radford reached 17 wins for the first time since the 1995-96 season and nine Conference wins since 1999-00 ... CORRIE FERTITTA moved into 10th on RU's career rebound chart against Coastal and currently has 625 ... JOHNETTE WALKER entered RU's top 10 career assists list against Coastal and currently has 236 ... KELLI DARDEN had seven blocks this week and needs seven more to break the single-season record of 79 held by JOYCE SAMPSON (1986-87). She needs four blocks to move into fourth on the Big South's single season list.

### UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville defeated Liberty on Saturday ending a 24-game losing streak to the Flames ... AMANDA ELDER led the way with 13 points including the final two free throws with three seconds left. It was the Bulldogs first win at Liberty since Feb. 12, 1990 and the first win over the Flames since Feb. 8, 1997. Elder led the team in scoring in both games on the week averaging 12 points per game. Elder also reached the 500 career rebound milestone at High Point on Wednesday ... Freshman KYLA JONES was second on the team in scoring averaging 8.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game last week as the Bulldogs split against the top two teams in the conference ... Asheville will face the third co-leader on Wednesday as it hosts Radford before finishing the regular season with Senior Day against Birmingham-Southern.

### WINTHROP

Last week the Lady Eagles had three players average double-figure scoring led by TIFFANY RODD at 15.0 ppg ... ASHLEY FANN averaged 14.0 and SHELLY HANKINS averaged 11.5 ... As a team Winthrop has struggled offensively this season and averages just 54.4 ppg, but last week it averaged 63.0 in two games while allowing just 56.0 ... Freshman forward SHANICE COLE came off the bench in the victory over Charleston Southern and had a career-game.
