CATCH ME SCORING 30

Two Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's MEGAN FRAZEE was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman LACEY LYONS put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard.

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's ALISHA DILL has come out of the gates strong early in the season and currently ranks second in the country and leads the Big South 22.8 points per game. She has put in 114 points this season in five games, as the Lady Chants are 3-2.

BONNIE (NO CLYDE)

Radford's JOHNETTE WALKER has established herself as one of the backcourt leaders in the Big South. She currently leads the League with 3.14 steals per game, while posting a Conference-high 5.14 helpers per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Radford's KELLI DARDEN has moved into fifth place in the Big South's All-Time top five in blocked shots. She currently has 127 blocked shots in her career.

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currenty MEGAN, MOLLY and MORIAH FRAZEE are the top three scorers, respectivley, on the team. Megan is posting 19.9 ppg, followed by Molly with 9.6 and Moriah with 8.2.

ASH(TON)VILLE

UNC Asheville's ASHTON BARTON has come out of the gates hot in the 2006-07 season. Barton has stepped up to become one of Asheville's top scoring threats with three 20-plus point performances in seven games this season. Barton scored a career-high 25 points vs. East Tennessee State and matched that total two days later against Western Carolina. The two 20-point games mark the only consecutive 20-point games this season ... AMANDA ELDER has also brokeout as one of the League's top rebounders. She is currently second in the League averaging 9.4 boards per contest, with four 10-plus rebound games this season.

NOT COMING UP SHORT IN HIGH POINT

High Point guard AYONNA THOMPSON is the shortest listed women's basketball in Division I at 5-1. Size is no matter for her as she is posting 8.1 points per game this season. Against Davidson on Nov. 29, Thompson put in a season 20 points against the Wildcats, connecting on seven field goals and four treys.

CHAIRWOMAN OF THE BOARD

Liberty's MEGAN FRAZEE is the only Big South player to average double-digits in rebounding thus far into the season. She is averaging 10.2 boards an outing and is the only player in the League to be averaging a double-double. Frazee is also no stranger to scoring. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year is also No. 2 in the League with 19.9 points per game. Frazee is the League-leader with five double-doubles and is the only player in the Big South to have three 20-point, 10 rebound games.

HIGH-SCORES

Radford is the only team in the Big South to put 100 or more points on the board this season as it lit up the scoreboard for 101 points against Virginia Intermont on Nov. 27. The Highlanders currently rank No. 1 in the Big South with 71.9 points per game ... Not far behind is Liberty who has notched two 90-point games this season and is averaging 71.0 points per contest.

NO.1 AND COUNTING

Liberty's CAREY GREEN is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 172 career wins at Liberty.

NOW THAT'S OUT OF THE WAY...

Charleston Southern head coach JULIE GOODENOUGH got the monkey off her back, picking her first win at CSU. The Lady Bucs downed Bethune-Cookman on Nov. 27 and followed with a win over crosstown rival the College of Charleston three days later. The wins also marked the first wins of the season for Charleston Southern.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern defeated Spring Hill in its lone game this week at home, 85-47 ... The Panthers shot above 50 percent for the first time this season (54.0%) and also recorded a season-high 41.7% from three-point range ... BSC also recorded a season-high rebounding marging, out-rebounding the Badgers by 12, 45-33 ... Junior guard MALLORY MORRING led the Panthers with a career-high 20 points on a 7-of-8 showing from the field and a 5-of-6 performance from three-point land, while freshman guard MARISAH HENDERSON posted a career-high nine assists and tied her career high with nine rebounds ... Three others Panthers besides Morring also scored in double digits.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU played just one game last week before taking almost a two-week break for final exams ... In the loss to Charlotte, senior RACHEL POTTS led the team in scoring with 14 points, while senior KEENA WICKER scored 12 and sophomore PAM TOLBERT added 11 ... The Lady Bucs lost, despite shooting 45.5 percent from the floor, including a 16-30 (53.3 percent) mark in the second half ... Their break will conclude on Saturday as they travel to Kennesaw State.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal will start a stretch of five games in nine days on Monday with a home game against Campbell ... Coastal will play 11 of its next 13 games either on campus or at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center ... ALISHA DILL currently is second in the nation in scoring, averaging 22.8 points per game ... Coastal has won the last eight games played against Campbell, including last year's 57-42 win in Buies Creek ... This will be Coastal's first ever game against North Greenville and the Lady Chants won the last meeting with UNC Greensboro 68-54.

HIGH POINT

High Point enters into the exam break on a two game winning streak ... Senior **CANDYCE SELLARS** set a career high in rebounding against Elon with 11 ... The Panthers will face Campbell on Saturday.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames have lost their last three contests, marking their longest losing streak since a sevengame slide during the 2000-01 season. This is only the third time that Liberty has suffered three-straight setbacks since Carey Green took over as head coach in 1999-2000 ... Sophomore guard/forward MOLLY FRAZEE missed a free throw during the second half of Sunday's game at George Washington. She had made her previous 20 foul shots, the longest such streak by a Liberty player since KRISTAL THARP connected on 20-consecutive free throws during the 2003-04 campaign. Frazee is shooting 86.5 percent from the charity stripe this season ... Sophomore guard/forward MEGAN FRAZEE recorded a pair of double-doubles last week. She has now posted 14 double-doubles in 22 career games..

RADFORD

KELLI DARDEN passed BETH CLEVENGER (1980-84) for second on the career charts with 127. She is know 14 shy of breaking the career blocked shot record of 140 held by JOYCE SAMPSON (1983-86) ... For the first time since the 1996-97 season, Radford scored 100+ points in a game, when it defeated Virginia Intermont, 101-36. The last time RU reached 100 points, they defeated Winthrop, 110-90 on Jan. 7, 1997. It was the 13th time Radford reached the century mark ... Another accomplishment that was recorded in the victory over Virginia Intermont was that it was the third largest margin of victory (+65) in school history. During the 1975-76 season, Radford defeat Bluefield 131-38 and two games later defeated Clinch Valley, 94-34 ... All 13 players who dressed for the Highlanders scored at least one point in their win over the Cobras.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville won its only game of the week 62-47 over Mars Hill on Monday night ... The Bulldogs held the Lions scoreless for the final 7:14 of the game and finished on a 15-0 run to secure the victory ... AMANDA ELDER recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds ... She also had six assists and five blocked shots in the game ... ASHTON BARTON had 13 points to lead the Bulldogs in the Mars Hill game and freshman RACHEL WILLIAMS picked up a season-high seven rebounds ... UNC Asheville is in final exams so the Bulldogs will not play against until Saturday, Dec. 16, at North Carolina A&T.

WINTHPOP

Sophomore center ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT had a break-out game on Saturday against South Carolina State as she scored a career-best 18 points and pulled down a career-high 9 rebounds. She was 7-for-9 from the field, 2-for-2 from three and 2-for-2 from the line. She also had two steals. On the week she averaged 9.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg, 1.0 spg and 1.5 bpg in an average of 20 minutes a game ... After holding a half-time lead, Winthrop fell behind by two points with 16:12 as Rasheeda Jones made a lay-up. That would be the last field goal the Bulldogs would make until 23 seconds left in the game as Brittany Baity banked in a three from the left side ... TIFFANY RODD tied her career-high of 23 points in the Lady Eagles 11-point loss at North Carolina State. She connected on five three-pointers, pulled down four rebounds and dished out five assists. On the week she averaged 15 points, 2.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists.
