The League's teams will open Conference play on Saturday, Jan. 13 with all the Big South teams in action.

DEFENSE-DEFENSE

The Conference's top two defenses will face each other this weekend in Coastal Carolina and Liberty. The Lady Chants currently rank No. 1 in the League, holding opponents to 55.0 points per contest. The Lady Flames are not far behind as they are only allowing 56.6 points per game.

If High Point's **LESLIE COOK** stays on her current pace this season (11.2 ppg), she will be newest member of the Big South Conference 1,000 point club. She will likely hit the mark in early February. Cook currenty has 890 points in her career.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33.

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 4 in the country with 22.7 points per game. The Lady Chants are currently tops in the Big South as Dill has posted a Leaguehigh seven games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors twice this season ... Her 22.7 points per game currently ranks third in the Conference annuals for single-season scoring average.

YOUNG AND RESTLESS

Birmingham-Southern freshman MARISAH HENDERSON has been playing unlike a freshman for the Panthers this season. She is currently tops in the Big South with 5.29 assists per game, while coming up with 2.69 steals per outing to rank No. 1 in the Conference ... She has earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors a League-high three times this season.

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currently **MEGAN**, **MOLLY** and **MORIAH FRAZEE** are the top three scorers, respectively, on the team. Megan is posting 16.8 ppg, followed by Molly with 8.1 and Moriah with 8.0.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** is currently leading the Big South on the glass as she is averaging 8.3 boards an outing. Frazee is also no stranger to scoring. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year is also tied No. 2 in the League in scoring with 16.8 ppg. Frazee is the League-leader with six double-doubles and is the only player in the Big South to have more than one 20-point, 10 rebound games with four this season.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 175 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 132 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 88 wins at High Point and currently ranks 8th in the League's annuals, two wins shy of 7th all-time.

HAPPY HOLIDAYS

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs had a good holiday break as they won the Mercer Inviational. Asheville downed Kennesaw State and the homestanding Bears on its way to the tournament crown ... The Bulldogs are the only team in the League to win a tournament championship this season.

ASH(TON)VILLE

UNC Asheville's **ASHTON BARTON** has become the go-to player for the Bulldogs this season. Barton has stepped up to become one of Asheville's top scoring threats with five 20-plus point performances this season. Barton scored a career-high 25 points vs. East Tennessee State and matched that total two days later against Western Carolina ... The duo of Barton and **AMANDA ELDER** are the only duo to have posted two games this season with 20 or more points in the same contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers got their first road win this week with an 80-62 victory over Savannah State, Saturday ... Juniors MALLORY MORRING and REBA ROSS and freshman MARISAH HENDERSON all posted career scoring highs in the game, combining for 61 points ... BSC also shot above 50 percent from the field for the second time this year and above 40 percent from three-point range for the third

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs ended 2006, and started the new year off right, winning both games this week ... KEENA WICKER scored 23 points and had eight rebounds in each game, leading CSU to their second two-game winning streak of the season ... Against Bryan, Wicker also recorded four steals and four assists ... Sophomore PAM TOLBERT averaged 15 points this week, the only Lady Buc, other than Wicker, to score in double figures in both games ... Against Pfeiffer, CSU spread out the scoring, having four players hit double figures.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal will open Big South play this week as Liberty comes into town for a 2 p.m. tip ... Coastal faces Savannah State before that Tuesday, Jan. 9 at 7 p.m ... The Lady Chants defeated Coker for the 32nd straight time 77-43 Jan. 4 ... Coastal shot 60 percent in the first half and scored 38 points in the paint in the win ... ALISHA DILL is now 8-4 in controlling the opening tip this season ... Coastal has won all but one game in which she wins the tip (IPFW) ... Freshman DEVIN RIVERS had seven rebounds and five steals in the win over the Cobras ... Coastal is 14-7 in Big South openers dating back to the 1986-87 season.

HIGH POINT

High Point will conclude non-conference play this week on Tuesday against Longwood ... The Panthers will get the Big South schedule started on Saturday when they travel to Birmingham ... Last week HPU faced the third ACC team on the 2006-2007 schedule when they played Florida State.

LIBERTY

Liberty shot over 50 percent from the field in each of their two home victories last week, over American and Longwood. The Lady Flames made 58.6 percent (34-of-58) of their field goals on Jan. 5 versus Longwood, marking the team's best-ever field goal percentage at the Vines Center ... Senior guard MICHELLE PARKER dished out 16 assists in the two victories, including nine against American on Jan. 2. Parker's nine assists represented the highest single-game total by a Lady Flame since DAINA STAUGAITIENE recorded 10 helpers against Morgan State on Nov. 22, 2002 ... Sophomore guard/forward MEGAN FRAZEE eclipsed the 500-point total for her career during the Longwood game. She has scored 511 points in her first 29 games at Liberty, good for an average of 17.6 ppg ... Liberty's 82-48 victory over Longwood was the Lady Flames' 89th triumph in the 100 games CAREY GREEN has coached at the Vines Center.

RADFORD

Radford's defense has been strong most of the season, especially when it comes to forcing turnovers. RU is forcing almost 23 per game and have forced 20+ nine time this season, including the last seven games. During that seven-game stretch, they have forced 24.6 turnovers. Also, they have allowed 56 or fewer points in their last five games ... Radford is enjoying its first homestand of the season. After playing seven of its first 10 games away, RU is currently in the midst of a fourgame homestand, the longest of the season. They have won their first two games and are 4-1 at home this season, winning four straight after dropping their home opener to VCU.

UNC Asheville won its only game of the week 99-40 over Montreat. It was the Bulldogs biggest scoring night is post 114 against Limestone in 1994-95 season. It was also Asheville's largest margin of victory since the 1983-84 season when the Bulldogs were NAIA ... Six players posted season-high's as TASHA BRANCH had a career-high 16 points ... STACY SHEPARD scored a season-high 13 points while KYLA JONES had a career-best 14 points and eight assists ... LESLIE YOUNG had season highs in points and rebounds with 10 and eight ... JESSICA MONROE had a season-high eight points, and RACHEL WILLIAMS also posted a career-high with six points ... As a team, the Bulldogs recorded season-highs in field goals, field goal attempts, points, assists, and steals ... Asheville faces Wake Forest on Monday morning before face Winthrop in its Big South opener.

TIFFANY RODD was out of the starting line-up at Charlotte on Friday for the first time this season. She came off the bench to score 13 points. On the week she averaged 9.0 points and shot 55 percent from the field and 57 percent from three ... The Lady Eagles really struggled taking care of the basketball and rebounding last week. Winthrop allowed a total of 70 points off turnovers. It also allowed 44 total offensive rebounds that led to 47 second-chance points in the two losses.
