Dill averaged 28.0 points per game to lead the Lady Chanticleers to a 2-1 record on the week. She got her week started with 33 points on 13-of-26 for 50 percent from the floor and 5-of-13 from downtown as CCU downed Campbell, 58-33 on Dec. 11. Two days later, the guard connected on 10-of-18 from the field (56 percent) and added two treys and two free throws for 24 points to lead the Lady Chants to the win over North Greenville. She capped her week off with 27 points, including five treys in Coastal's game against UNC Greensboro on Dec. 16. For the week, Dill hit 32-of-66 shots from the floor for 49 percent and shot 43 percent from beyond the arc (12-of-28), and posted 14 boards, seven assists and seven steals. Dill currently ranks No. 2 in the country in scoring, averaging 24.8 points per contest.

Rivers averaged 5.7 rebounds and 4.0 points per game on the week. She got her week started with seven boards against Campbell on Dec. 11 and followed that performance with a career-high eight points and eight rebounds against North Greenville two days later. CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33.

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** has come out of the gates strong early in the season and currently ranks second in the country and leads the Big South 24.8 points per game. She has led the Lady Chanticleers to a breakout record of 5-3 with six games of 20 or more points. She also earned Player of the Week honors during the past week with 84 points in three games for a 28.0 points per game average.

SUFFOCATING

Defense is the name of the game in Conway, S.C. Coastal Carolina leads the League in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 53.5 points per game to rank No. 20 in Division I. They are also second in scoring margin as the Lady Chants are outscoring their opponents by 13.4 points per game.

WALK IT OUT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has established herself as one of the backcourt leaders in the Big South. She currently leads the League with 3.14 steals per game, while posting a Conference-high 5.14 helpers per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Radford's **KELLI DARDEN** has moved into fifth place in the Big South's All-Time top five in blocked shots. She currently has 127 blocked shots in her career.

M3

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currently **MEGAN**, **MOLLY** and **MORIAH FRAZEE** are the top three scorers, respectively, on the team. Megan is posting 19.0 ppg, followed by Molly with 8.7 and Moriah with 8.6.

ASH(TON)VILLE

UNC Asheville's **ASHTON** BARTON has come out of the gates hot in the 2006-07 season. Barton has stepped up to become one of Asheville's top scoring threats with four 20-plus point performances in seven games this season. Barton scored a career-high 25 points vs. East Tennessee State and matched that total two days later against Western Carolina. The two 20-point games mark the only consecutive 20-point games this season ... **AMANDA ELDER** has also brokeout as one of the League's top rebounders. She is currently second in the League averaging 9.4 boards per contest, with four 10-plus rebound games this season.

CHAIRWOMAN OF THE BOARD

Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** is currently leading the Big South on the glass as she is averaging 9.6 boards an outing. Frazee is also no stranger to scoring. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year is also No. 2 in the League and 25th in the nation with 19.0 points per game. Frazee is the League-leader with five double-doubles and is the only player in the Big South to have three 20-point, 10 rebound games.

HIGH-SCORES

Radford is the only team in the Big South to put 100 or more points on the board this season as it lit up the scoreboard for 101 points against Virginia Intermont on Nov. 27. The Highlanders currently rank No. 1 in the Big South with 71.9 points per game ... Not far behind is Liberty who has notched two 90-point games this season and is averaging 70.4 points per contest.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 173 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 129 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 87 wins at High Point and currently ranks 8th in the League's annuals.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers did not play any games this week due to final exams, but are back in action Monday night at Alabama at 7 p.m. BSC then plays at home once more in 2006, taking on Alabama State, Thursday night at 7 p.m.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs got their first road victory of the season, after a 11-day layoff for final exams ... Junior NATALIE CALDWELL scored 20 points to lead all scorers, scoring 14 of those in the second half ... It was the defense that set the tone early for CSU, as they held Kennesaw State to a season-low 20 points in the first half ... This was the first game that the Lady Bucs have won the turnover battle.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal will host second-ranked North Carolina in the first game of the 2006 Bojangle's Basketball Bash Monday at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center ... Coastal has dropped eight all-time meetings with the Tar Heels ... Coastal will then head back to the Convention Center for the Crescent Bank Carolinas Challenge Dec. 20 with a 5 p.m. game against UNC Wilmington before heading into the Christmas break ... Coastal won 2-of-3 games this past week to up its record to 5-3 ... Coastal is holding its opponents to just 20 percent from three-point range this season. This includes a 2-of-10 performance by UNC Greensboro Dec. 16 ... ALISHA DILL is just 13 points away from moving into 10th place on Coastal's all-time scoring list. She currently has 888 career points ... Dill became the third player in the Big South this season to score 30 or more points. She joined teammate Lacey Lyons and Liberty's Megan Frazee when she scored 33 in a win over Campbell.

HIGH POINT

High Point enters the week on a three game winning streak ... In their last game HPU defeated Campbell, 89-74, fueled by a career-high 29 points from senior guard **LESLIE COOK** ... She was 6-of-11 from behind the arc ... This week the Panthers face intra-Triad rival UNCG on Monday before facing SEC foe South Carolina on Wednesday ... The USC game is the final game for HPU before entering into the holiday break.

LIBERTY

All 11 players who saw action for Liberty scored as the Lady Flames snapped a three-game losing streak with a 66-49 home win over Virginia Union on Dec. 16 ... Liberty hit eight three-pointers in the victory, marking the team's most proficient performance from behind the arc since the Lady Flames hit eight three-pointers at Winthrop on Feb. 22, 2006 ... MEGAN FRAZEE was one of seven players in the nation averaging at least 19.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg entering last week's action ... The Lady Flames are playing at the Caribbean Classic in Cancun, Mexico this week. This is Liberty's first trip outside the United States since the Lady Flames competed in the Bahamas Sun Splash Shootout on Dec. 20-21, 1999, during CAREY GREEN'S first year at the helm. Liberty will meet unbeaten Pittsburgh in its second of two games at the event. The Panthers will be the second ranked team the Lady Flames have met in their last four games.

RADFORD

When **SERENA WHITE** scored a team high 17 points in RU's last game at Belmont, she became the sixth different Highlander to lead them in scoring ... Also, six Highlanders are averaging 8.1 ppg or better with three posting double figures in scoring ... **SHAVON EARP** and **SERENA WHITE** are pacing the Highlanders from beyond the arc early on this season. The two are a combined 25-56 for 44.6 percent. Earp is shooting at a 48.1 percent (13-27) clip, while White is at 41.4 percent (12-29).

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville dropped its only game of the week 63-59 at North Carolina A&T ... ASHTON BARTON had 20 points giving her four game with 20 or more points ... She has been in double-figures in eight of the Bulldogs' nine games this season ... AMANDA ELDER just missed her fifth double-double of the year with nine points and nine rebounds at A&T ... She also had six assists keeping her as the theam leader in assists ... This week the Bulldogs host Gardner-Webb and travel to Chattanooga before the Holiday break.

WINTHROP

Sophomore TIFFANY RODD moved into 6th place on the all-time three-point field goals made list as she hit five against Wake Forest. She has 80 in her brief career and currently has 29 on the season ... Sophomore ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT had her second consecutive game with double-figure scoring off the bench. Against Wake Forest she had 10 points and five rebounds to go along with a career-high two assists ... Wake Forest shot 39 free throws against the Lady Eagles on Sunday. It is the second time this season one of Winthrop's opponenets went to the line at least 31 times in a single game. However, Winthrop entered the week 46th in the nation in fewest fouls a game at (15.8) ... Rodd scored 17 points on Sunday against Wake Forest. In her two games against Atlantic Coast Conference teams this season she has averaged 20.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg while shooting 10-for-21 from three.
