Dill averaged 18.3 points per game over the holiday break to lead her Lady Chanticleers to a 2-1 record. She got her week started with 11 points against No. 2 North Carolina on Dec. 18. Two days later against UNC days later against UNC Wilmington, she put in 29 points as against she connected on 44 percent from the floor and 2-of-3 from beyond the arc. She also added 11-of-12 from the charity stripe for 92 percent in the win against the Seahawks. She closed her week out with 15 points in just 21 minutes as Coastal Carolina downed Converse on Dec. 31. In the threegame span, Dill was 41 percent from the floor on 17-of-42 shots and hit 44 percent of her shots from downtown (4-of-9). She was 17-of-20 at the line for 85 percent, and she also notched 12 rebounds, seven assists and five steals in the three games

NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

Lacey Lyons F • Coastal Carolina Beverly Hills, Fla.

Lyons averaged 15.7 points per game and shot 52 percent from the floor for Coastal Carolina during the holiday break. She scored in double figures in each of the three contests, including 19 points against No. 2 UNC on Dec. 18. She connected on 16-of-31 from the floor in the threegame span and was 50 percent from downtown on 12-of-24 shots. She also finished with five boards, two blocks and one assist for the Lady Chants.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33.

SHE'S THE REAL DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South 23.0 points per game. The Lady Chants are currently tops in the Big South as Dill has posted a League-high seven games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors twice this season ... Her 23.0 points per game currently ranks third in the Conference annuals for single-season scoring average.

HAPPY HOLIDAYS

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs had a good holiday break as they won the Mercer Inviational. Asheville downed Kennesaw State and the homestanding Bears on its way to the tournament crown.

YOUNG AND RESTLESS

Birmingham-Southern freshman **MARISAH HENDERSON** has been playing unlike a freshman for the Panthers this season. She is currently tops in the Big South with 5.15 assists per game, while coming up with 2.69 steals per outing to rank second in the Conference. Her 1.10 assist-to-turnover ratio ratio is also tops in the League.

SUFFOCATING

Defense is the name of the game in Conway, S.C. Coastal Carolina leads the League in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 56.1 points per game. They are also No. 1 in scoring margin as the Lady Chants are outscoring their opponents by 9.5 points per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Radford's **KELLI DARDEN** has moved into fifth place in the Big South's All-Time top five in blocked shots. She currently has 135 blocked shots in her career ... This season she has 25 blocks and is averaging 2.27 blocks per game.

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currently **MEGAN**, **MORIAH** and **MOLLY FRAZEE** are the top three scorers, respectively, on the team. Megan is posting 17.5 ppg, followed by Moriah with 8.4. and Molly with 7.5.

ASH(TON)VILLE

UNC Asheville's **ASHTON BARTON** has become the go-to player for the Bulldogs this season. Barton has stepped up to become one of Asheville's top scoring threats with five 20-plus point performances this season. Barton scored a career-high 25 points vs. East Tennessee State and matched that total two days later against Western Carolina. The two 20-point games mark the only consecutive 20-point games this season ... **AMANDA ELDER** has also brokeout as one of the League's top rebounders. She is currently second in the League averaging 8.0 boards per contest, with four 10-plus rebound games this season ... The duo of Barton and Elder have posted two games this season with 20 or more points in the same contest.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** is currently leading the Big South on the glass as she is averaging 8.9 boards an outing. Frazee is also no stranger to scoring. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year is also No. 2 in the League. Frazee is the League-leader with six double-doubles and is the only player in the Big South to have more than one 20-point, 10 rebound games with four this season.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 173 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 131 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 88 wins at High Point and currently ranks 8th in the League's annuals, two wins shy of 7th all-time.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-3 over the holidays, winning their lone home game against Alabama State, but dropping an away game at Alabama and two neutral-site games in the GSU Invitational in Atlanta, Ga ... BSC has struggled away from Bill Battle Coliseum this season, going 0-7 on the road and against neutral opponents ... Freshman center HALI MOORE was named to the All-Invitational team at Georgia State this past weekend.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs won two out of three games this week, with a victory over defending NAIA National Champion Bryan College ... Senior **KEENA WICKER** led CSU with 17.7 points per game, and was also the leading rebounder at 7.0 boards per game ... She scored 23 points in the victory over Bryan, her second 20-plus performance this season ... Sophomore PAM TOLBERT also averaged double digits with 11 points per game. Tolbert has scored in double figures all but one game this season.

Coastal ended the 2006 portion of its schedule with a 7-4 record, including wins over the College of Charleston, Campbell and UNC Wilmington ... ALISHA DILL is averaging 23.0 points per game, which will probably put her third in the country behind Carrie Moore of Western Michigan and Courtney Paris of Oklahoma when the new rankings come out. Dill had 29 points in a 66-59 win over UNĆ Wilmington Dec. 20 ... AMANDA STULL, DEVIN RIVERS and LACEY LYONS each have won Big South Freshman of the Week honors this season. They became the 11th trio in Big South history to earn Freshman of the Week honors from the same team ... The 73-43 win over Converse included career highs in points from LORI WHITAKER (10) and VICTORIA BLANCHARD (8), while Stull had a career high eight assists and VANESSA LAUG tied a career high with eight rebounds ... In the loss to #2 North Carolina, Lyons had 19 points, which is the third highest scoring output by a Tar Heel opponent this season ... Coastal will face Coker Jan. 4 at 7 p.m., in its only game of the week.

HIGH POINT

High Point returned to the court after the holiday break at the FAU Invitational where senior guard CANDYCE SELLARS was named to the All-Tournament team ... The Panthers split the games, falling to Ohio in the first round and defeating Campbell in the consolation game ... High Point will face Florida State on Tuesday of this week. FSU is the third and final ACC team on the 2006-2007 schedule for the Panthers.

Liberty has lost its last four games, representing the team's longest losing streak since seven-consecutive games during Dec. 2000 ... The Lady Flames' 58-54 setback to Texas-Arlington was Liberty's first loss to a team with a below-.500 record since Wisconsin-Milwaukee edged the Lady Flames on Nov. 30, 2003 ... The Lady Flames' 76-43 defeat against Marist was Liberty's most lopsided loss versus an unranked opponent since UNC Greensboro routed the Lady Flames, 84-40, in the first round of the 1996 Big South Championship ... Liberty's record when trailing at halftime (2-2) is better than the team's record when leading at the intermission (4-5) ... After just 27 career games, MEGAN FRAZEE is already the 45th-leading scorer in program history with 486 points ... Liberty hosts American on Tuesday and Longwood on Friday. The Lady Flames have played just four of their first 13 games at the Vines Center and are 3-1 in those contests.

RADFORD

With eight more blocks over the past four games, KELLI DARDEN has moved within six blocks of breaking the RU career record held by JOYCE SAMPSON (1983-86) ... Radford's defense has caused its opponents into several mistakes this season ... The Highlanders are forcing 22.5 turnovers per game and have forced 20 or more in eight games ... They have done so in the last six straight contests, including a season high 30 vs. Hampton last contest.

UNC ASHEVILLE
UNC Asheville won the Mercer-Blade Holiday Classic this week with victories over Kennesaw State and Mercer ... The Bulldogs were led by ASHTON BARTON who had 21 points against Kennesaw and followed up with 15 points against Mercer to lead the team both nights ... AMANDA ELDER had 20 points against Kennesaw State marking the third time this season the Bulldogs have had two 20 point scorers in the same game ... It is the second time Barton and Elder have turned the trick ... BRITTANY HENDLEY had 14 points against Mercer as she continues to lead the Bulldogs in scoring in road games ... Barton leads the team overall at 14.5 points per game ... Asheville tied a school record hitting on 11 three-pointers at Mercer ... The last time the Bulldogs hit 11 three-pointers in a game was against Liberty during the 2000-01 season ... This week the Dogs return home to play Montreat on Jan. 4, before playing at Wake Forest on Jan. 8, in their final non-conference game of the year

WINTHROP

Sophomore TIFFANY RODD moved into 5th on the all-time list at Winthrop for three-point baskets made. She has 84 in a season and a half and is tied for 5th with MISTY MOORING ... At her current pace she will finish with 73 this year, which would put her in easily in second on the list and just 18 behind the all-time leader ... Sophomore **ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT** has averaged in double-figures in her last three games and is averaging 12.7 ppg in that span. That's with one start in the three games.
