Walker played well above her season averages during the week to lead the Highlanders to a 3-0 record. She got her week started with a career-high 21 points against Winston-Salem State on Jan. 9. She shot 64 percent from the floor, connected on 4-of-6 treys and came up with five assists, seven rebounds and three steals in RU's 72-48 win. Two days later against Longwood, Walker posted six points and handed out six helpers with five steals and five boards in the win over the Lancers. She wrapped her week up with 15 points, five boards, six assists and five steals as the Highlanders opened up League play with a 77-53 win at Charleston Southern. For the week, she averaged 14 points per game, shot 44 percent from the floor, and handed out 17 assists (5.6 per game) to go along with 17 boards (5.7 per game) and 13 steals (4.3 per game).

**1K... AND COUNTING**

The Big South added two new members to its 1,000 point club over the past week. Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** joined the group when she scored 26 points against Savannah State on Jan. 8. She added 11 against Radford on Jan. 13 and now has 1,020 points in her career to rank 47th all-time ... Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** entered the list on Jan. 13 with 25 points vs. Liberty to give her 1,009 points in her career and put her at 48th all-time.

**CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS**

The League had two new players enter the 500 rebound club this season in Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** and Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS**. Wicker currently has 559 rebounds in her career to rank 38th all-time, while Stephens has 540 to rank 41st ... UNC Asheville's **AMANDA ELDER** is close to joining the League's 500 board club as she currently has 434 for her career.

**NOT TOO SHABBY**

Since Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** joined the Big South Conference in the 1999-00 season he has posted a record of 92-7 in Big South regular-season games. The only teams to beat Liberty in his tenure have been High Point, Radford and former member Elon. High Point and Elon have defeated Green three times each, while Radford has put a loss on Green once.

**ASK HOW, ASK NOW, ASK CORRIE FERTITTA**

Radford's **CORRIE FERTITTA** is enjoying a fine junior season for the Highlanders in the paint. She is currently No. 1 in the League with 8.1 rebounds per game, while ranking No. 11 in the Big South with 10.5 points per contest. Fertitta had a three-game stretch of 10-or more boards in the early part of January and currently has seven games with 10-or more boards to rank No. 1 in the League. She is also tops in the Conference with seven double-doubles this season.

**CATCH ME SCORING 30**

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33.

**SHE'S THE REAL DILL**

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 3 in the country with 22.8 points per game. The Lady Chants are currently tops in the Big South as Dill has posted a League-high nine games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors twice this season ... Her 22.8 points per game currently ranks third in the Conference annuals for single-season scoring average.

**YOUNG AND RESTLESS**

Birmingham-Southern freshman **MARISAH HENDERSON** has been playing unlike a freshman for the Panthers this season. She is currently tops in the Big South with 5.33 assists per game, while coming up with 2.73 steals per outing to rank No. 2 in the Conference ... She has earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors a League-high three times this season.

**M<sup>3</sup>**

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currently **MEGAN, MOLLY** and **MORIAH FRAZEE** are the top three scorers, respectively, on the team. Megan is posting 17.2 ppg, followed by Molly with 8.1 and Moriah with 7.9.

**MOVE'N ON UP**

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 176 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 133 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 90 wins at High Point and is currently tied for 7th all-time in the League's annuals.

**HAPPY HOLIDAYS**

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs had a good holiday break as they won the Mercer Invitational. Asheville downed Kennesaw State and the homestanding Bears on its way to the tournament crown ... The Bulldogs are the only team in the League to win a tournament championship this season.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC dropped its conference opener this week to High Point, going to 0-5 in Big South openers since joining the league in the 2001-02 season ... Two Panthers scored in double digits, including a career-high 23 points from junior forward **REBA ROSS**, and 11 points from senior guard **PAM THORNBORROW** ... Ross leads the squad with 12.9 points and 6.3 rebounds a game.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs extended their winning streak to three games, their longest one of the season, as they beat Savannah State Monday, remaining undefeated in the North Charleston Coliseum ... It looked like they would continue to roll as they led Radford in the first half, shooting 51.6 percent. After the break, the wheels came off, as the Lady Bucs finished the game scoring just five points in the final 12 minutes of the game. They shot just 30.4 percent in the second half, and were 0-8 from the free throw line ... **RACHEL POTTS** and **KEENA WICKER** were the only Lady Bucs to score in double-figures in both games. Wicker scored 26 against Savannah State, and 11 against Radford, while Potts scored 20 and 12. Wicker has scored in double figures in 13 of CSU's 14 games, and her 26 points against Savannah State was her best performance of the season so far.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal ends its five-game homestand and seven-game streak of games in the Conway/Myrtle Beach area Jan. 15 against Radford. Coastal will then go on the road to UNC Asheville Saturday at 3 p.m. ... Senior **ALISHA DILL** became the 10th player in Coastal history and the 51st player in Big South history to reach the 1,000-point plateau when she hit a three-pointer with 5:22 remaining in the game against Liberty ... Dill now has 1,009 career points and is only 21 points away from ninth place on Coastal's all-time scoring list ... Dill also moved back into third place on the NCAA season scoring list, averaging 22.8 points per game ... Earlier in the week against Savannah State, **VICTORIA BLANCHARD** had career highs in points (21), rebounds (8), assists (4) and steals (2) in the 71-51 win. Blanchard is now averaging 5.0 points and 3.5 rebounds a contest ... Coastal fell to 14-7 all-time in Big South openers with the 58-54 loss to Liberty. It also was the first loss for the Lady Chanticleers in Kimbel Arena this season ... Coastal shot 81.8 percent from the free-throw line in the two games this week.

## HIGH POINT

High Point concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule last week with a win over Longwood ... the Panthers also opened Big South play by defeating Birmingham-Southern ... With the win over BSC, head coach Tooey Loy earned his 90th career win and moved into second place on HPU's All-Time coaching wins list. He is also tied for seventh on the Big South list ... High Point will continue conference play this week against UNC Asheville on Wednesday before hosting Liberty on Saturday.

## LIBERTY

Liberty opened Big South Conference play with a 58-54 win at Coastal Carolina on Saturday. The victory was the Lady Flames' third-straight win overall, their seventh-straight triumph in Big South openers and their 26th-consecutive win against Coastal Carolina ... The victory over the Chanticleers marked Liberty's first win away from the Vines Center since a triumph at Binghamton on Nov. 25 ... Sophomore guard **MEGAN FRAZEE** paced Liberty with 24 points in the Coastal Carolina game, the 12th time she has eclipsed the 20-point plateau in her career. No other player on the current Lady Flames roster has ever tallied a 20-point game ... **MEGAN**, **MOLLY** and **MORIAH FRAZEE** will be featured on the CBS Sports college women's basketball special "Pride, Passion and Power," scheduled to be televised nationally, Sunday afternoon (Jan. 21) at 2 p.m. EST.

## RADFORD

**KELLI DARDEN** became RU's all-time blocks leader on Saturday at Charleston Southern. With her first block of the game in the first half, she surpassed Joyce Sampson (1983-86) for the all-time lead and currently has 143 ... Radford's defense has been a strong point for most of the season. The Highlanders are forcing 23 turnovers per game and have forced 20 or more in 10 straight contests (12 overall) ... The Highs have also forced 30+ on two occasions against Virginia Interment (32) and Hampton (30) ... Along with the turnovers, RU is holding its opponents to 56.0 points per game and 37.5 percent shooting. They are allowing 56 or fewer points in their last eight games. In those games, the Highs are allowing 50.4 ppg and holding opponents to 35.6 percent from the field and are forcing 24.6 turnovers and have a +5.4 turnover margin. Twelve times this season, RU has allowed 61 or fewer points, including under 60 points 10 times. They have held opponents under 40 percent shooting nine times, twice under 30 ... For the first time in **JERI PORTER'S** five-year tenure, Radford won its Big South road opener, defeating Charleston Southern on Saturday. The last time RU earned a road-opening victory was at tonight's opponent, Coastal Carolina on Jan. 5, 2002 ... Junior **CORRIE FERTITTA** became the second Highlander this season to grab their 500th career rebound vs. Longwood. She is the 18th RU player to reach this milestone. Senior Sarah Stephens reached 500 earlier in the season. Stephens and Fertitta rank 16th and 18 respectively on the all-time list.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville defeated Waake Forest and Winthrop this week to move its winning streak to five in a row. The Bulldogs have won eight of their last 10 games holding opponents to 53.8 points per game over the last 10 ... Head coach **BETSY BLOSE** became the winningest coach in UNC Asheville history with her 65 career victory at Asheville in the win over Winthrop. The Bulldogs victory at Wake Forest was Asheville's first ever victory against a team from the ACC ... **ASHTON BARTON** had her second double-double of the season with 19 points and 10 rebounds against the Demon Deacons. She added 11 points and eight rebounds against Winthrop to give her an average of 15 points and nine rebounds for the week ... Freshman **KYLA JONES** had her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds against Wake while **AMANDA ELDER** led the Bulldogs past Winthrop with 14 points. Asheville returns home this week to open a three-game homestand against High Point and Coastal Carolina.

## WINTHROP

**FRANCESCA DAVENPORT** scored 14 points in the conference opener vs. UNCA. It was the first time in 9 games that she reached double-figures. She's currently averaging 6.9 ppg ... Winthrop was 1-for-9 from behind the arc in the loss to UNCA. The one three-point field goal and the nine three-point attempts were season-lows.
