Sellars posted 16.5 points per game in two games to lead the Panthers to a 1-1 record on the week, including an overtime win over Big South rival Liberty on Jan. 20. She scored seven of High Point's 10 overtime points to lead her Panthers past the Lady Flames. She shot 44 percent from the floor, connected on 3-of-7 from downtown and added four from the line to finish with 21 points in the game against Liberty. Against Asheville on Jan. 17, she was 5-of-11 from the floor and shot 40 percent from beyond the arc to finish with 12 points. In the paint, she posted 10 boards to go along with four assists and four steals in the two-game span.

**1K... AND COUNTING**

The Big South added two new members to its 1,000 point club over the past week. Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** joined the group on Jan. 8 now has 1,074 points in her career to rank 41st all-time ... Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** entered the list on Jan. 13 and is currently at 1,051 points in her career and put her at 43rd all-time.

**CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS**

The League had three threeplayers enter the 500 rebound club this season in Charleston Southern's **KEENA WICKER** and Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS** and **CORRIE FERTITTA**. Wicker currently has 580rebounds in her career to rank 36th all-time, while Stephens has 549 to rank 39th. Fertitta rounds out the list with 535 career boards, good for 40th all-time ... UNC Asheville's **AMANDA ELDER** is close to joining the League's 500 board club as she currently has 453 for her career.

**DEJA VU**

The High Point and Liberty series has been the series to watch during the past couple of seasons. High Point is the only team in the League to have beaten Liberty more than once since 1999. The two teams split the season series the past two seasons, and this season High Point opened up the series with a 64-62 overtime win at home. Last season each team won on their home floor.

**DIAPER DANDIES**

Coastal Carolina has earned a Big South Freshman of the Week honor a League-high five times this season. **AMANDA STULL** is the latest Freshman of the Week picking up the honor for the second time this week. **LACEY LYONS** has also earned the honor twice, while **DEVIN RIVERS** earned Freshman of the Week once.

**NOT TOO SHABBY**

Since Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** joined the Big South Conference in the 1999-00 season he has posted a record of 92-8 in Big South regular-season games. The only teams to beat Liberty in his tenure have been High Point, Radford and former member Elon. High Point and Elon have defeated Green three times each, while Radford has put a loss on Green once.

**ASK HOW, ASK NOW, ASK CORRIE FERTITTA**

Radford's **CORRIE FERTITTA** is enjoying a fine junior season for the Highlanders in the paint. She is currently No. 1 in the League with 8.2 rebounds per game, while ranking No. 11 in the Big South with 10.4 points per contest. Fertitta had a three-game stretch of 10-or more boards in the early part of January and currently has seven games with 10-or more boards to rank No. 1 in the League. She is also tops in the Conference with seven double-doubles this season.

**CATCH ME SCORING 30**

Three Big South women's players have posted 30-point games this season ... Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the first player to break the 30-plus plateau when she posted 37 points against in-state and ACC foe Virginia on Nov. 20 ... Coastal Carolina freshman **LACEY LYONS** put in 30 of her own on Nov. 26 in the Lady Chants' win over Howard ... On Dec. 11, Coastal Carolina guard **ALISHA DILL** joined the 30-point club with a career-high 33 points against Campbell. Her 33 points matched the point total of the whole Campbell team as the Lady Chanticleers downed the Camels, 58-33.

**SHE'S THE REAL DILL**

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** currently leads the Big South and ranks No. 4 in the country with 22.6 points per game. The Lady Chants are currently tops in the Big South as Dill has posted a League-high 11 games of 20 or more points. She also has earned Player of the Week honors twice this season ... Her 22.6 points per game currently ranks third in the Conference annuals for single-season scoring average ... Dill is currently on a four-game streak with at least 20 points per game.

**M<sup>3</sup>**

Liberty is the only school in Division I to have a set of triplets on the roster. Currently **MEGAN, MORIAH** and **MOLLY FRAZEE** are the top three scorers, respectively, on the team. Megan is posting 16.7 ppg, followed by Moriah with 8.2 and Molly with 8.1.

**MOVE'N ON UP**

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's All-Time winningest coach with 177 career wins at Liberty ... Also moving up in the category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point ... Leforce is currently 4th All-Time with 134 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers ... Loy moved into the top 10 last season and has been moving up this season. The Panther mentor has 91 wins at High Point and is currently 7th all-time in the League's annuals.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-1 this week, losing at home to Winthrop, Monday, but getting their first conference win on the road against Charleston Southern, Saturday ... Junior forward **REBA ROSS** posted her third 20-point game of the season against CSU with 21 points, while freshman center **HALI MOORE** grabbed double-digit rebounds for the first time this season with 11 boards on Saturday.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern dropped both Big South Conference games this week, but went out of the League to get a victory over Longwood in the middle of the week ... Helping lead CSU to their 1-2 record was **KEENA WICKER**, who just got better as the week went along ... After being held to just 10 points against Liberty, her second-lowest outing of the season, she scored 18 in the victory at Longwood, then tied a season high with 26 points against BSC ... She averaged 18.0 points per game for the week, upping her season average to 17.2 ppg ... Point guard **PAM TOLBERT** averaged 11.2, thanks in large part to an 18-point effort against Longwood. Tolbert also led the way with 12 assists.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal hosts Birmingham-Southern and Charleston Southern this week ... It will end a streak of nine of the last 10 games in the Conway/Myrtle Beach area ... Coastal picked up its first Big South win Jan. 20 at UNC Asheville. It was the first time since the 2002-03 season that Coastal has won at the Justice Center ... The win also snapped UNCA's six-game winning streak ... After CCU struggled against Radford at the free-throw line, the Lady Chants went 21-of-28 from the line in the win over UNC Asheville. Junior **C.J. WARE** scored all six of her points from the line, while **VICTORIA BLANCHARD** and **ALISHA DILL** had six and five makes, respectively ... Dill has now scored 20 or more points in the last four games and has been in double figures in all 16 games this season ... Coastal head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** was inducted into East Tennessee State's Hall of Fame on Saturday. He was the Buc's head men's coach for six seasons, leading ETSU to an upset of Arizona in the 1992 NCAA Tournament.

## HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week. Earlier in the week the Panthers suffered a close loss at UNCA, 72-69 before turning around and defeating Liberty, 64-62 in overtime. The win over the Flames marked the second straight year the Panthers have defeated the Flames in the Millis Center ... Senior guard **CANDYCE SELLARS** scored seven of her 21 points during the overtime period of the game against Liberty ... Senior point guard **KATIE RALLS** also dished out a career-high nine assists ... With the win, HPU head coach **Tooyey Loy** moves into seventh on the Big South All-Time wins list ... This week the Panthers with travel to Rock Hill, S.C. to face Winthrop.

## LIBERTY

Liberty's 64-62 overtime loss at High Point on Saturday ended the Lady Flames' 12-game Big South Conference winning streak. It also marked Liberty's first overtime encounter since a double-overtime win at American on Jan. 6, 2004. The Lady Flames had played 100-straight non-overtime games since then ... Monday's game against Winthrop, Liberty's Big South home opener, will mark the Lady Flames' 200th contest at the Vines Center. Liberty is 159-40 all-time at the facility ... **MOLLY** (13 points), **MORIAH** (12 points) and **MEGAN** (10 points) **FRAZEE** all reached double figures in scoring at High Point. The triplets have now accomplished the feat three times this season.

## RADFORD

Radford has held its opponents to under 60 points the last 10 games (12 overall) including three times under 40 points. During the last 10 games, RU has held its opponents to 50 ppg, forcing almost 25 turnovers per game. They have a +15.5 scoring advantage and a +5.3 turnover margin ... With a victory at Coastal, RU swept the "beach" trip for the first time since the 1999-00 season. It also marked the first win in Conway for head coach **Jeri Porter** in five tries ... Along with their first sweep of CCU and CSU, Radford won back-to-back roads games in Conference play for the first time since 2003-04. The two road wins almost equal RU's total over the last two seasons (3-11) ... Radford has had a very balanced scoring attack this season. When **VANDY PULLEN** led RU at Coastal Carolina, she became the seventh Highlander to lead them in scoring this season.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville saw its six game winning streak end as it split a pair of conference game against High Point and Coastal Carolina this week. The Bulldogs downed HPU 72-69 behind a pair of double-doubles ... **AMANDA ELDER** had 20 points and 12 rebounds while **STACY SHEPARD** added 13 points and 11 rebounds ... The game was the third this year which Asheville had two players record double-doubles in the same game ... The Bulldogs last to Coastal 73-61 despite 19 points from **ASHTON BARTON** ... Elder also had 13 points and seven rebounds. Elder now has 453 career rebounds ... Asheville will wrap up a three-game homestand against Charleston Southern on Tuesday before traveling to Birmingham-Southern on Saturday.

## WINTHROP

Sophomore **TIFFANY RODD** hit four three-point baskets in the victory at Birmingham-Southern, giving her 92 for her career. She is now all alone in fourth place on Winthrop's all-time list for 3-pt field goals made ... Sophomore **SHELLY HANKINS** is in a shooting slump as she's hit just six of her last 25 shots (24 percent) ... Sophomore **ASHLEY FANN** now has 562 points in her career. She's well on her way to scoring 1,000 points in her career. She is also on pace for 500 rebounds by her junior season as she's pulled down 316 in 48 games (6.6 average) ... In the Lady Eagles four victories this season, sophomores **FRANCESCA DAVENPORT**, **TIFFANY RODD** and **ASHLEY FANN** have averaged double-figures in scoring. Rodd leads the way at 14.5, Davenport averages 12.0 and Fann averages 11.5. In the teams 15 losses, only Fann averages double-figure scoring (10.4).
