# CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK


Arizona Reid • Junior Forward • High Point Gaffney, S.C.

Reid averaged 27.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in leading the Panthers to a pair of key Big South victories last week, including a historic 20th win this season, the first in the program's Division I history. He posted his League-leading 12th double-double with 26 points and 11 rebounds (five offensive) at UNC Asheville. He also hit a three-pointer in the final minute to pull HPU within one point, then grabbed a rebound that set-up the game-winning shot. Saturday against Charleston Southern, Reid tallied 28 points, seven rebounds and four assists in the win. He had the final seven points of the first half, including a 30-foot buzzer-beater that halted a 12-0 CSU run, then scored seven of the first nine HPU points in the second half as High Point put the game away.

# NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Amir Johnson Guard • Radford Pittsburgh, Pa.

Johnson averaged 19.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 5.5 assists and 3.0 steals in two games for the Highlanders. He posted a careerhigh 23 points against VMI on 7-of-11 shooting (=.636), in addition to eight rebounds and seven assists. He also was a perfect 8-of-8 from the free throw line. At UNC Asheville, Johnson was 6-of-8 from the floor (=.750), including 4-of-5 three-pointers in finishing with 16 points against the Bulldogs, while recording five steals. On the week, Johnson was 13-of-19 from the field ( =.684), 5-of-8 from long range ( =.625) and 8-of-8 from the line.

#### WINTHROP ESTABLISHES LEAGUE RECORD FOR BEST CONFERENCE START AT 12-0

The Winthrop Eagles have established the Big South record for best Conference start at 12-0, breaking the feat set by Coastal Carolina in both 1989-90 and 1990-91. The Eagles recorded the historic win Feb. 14 at home vs. Charleston Southern, which also clinched them at least a share of the regular-season title. Winthrop has won 14 consecutive regular-season League games, dating back to last season, and faces a challenging task this week in hosting second-place High Point (20-8, 10-2) Tuesday and visiting Coastal Carolina (15-12, 7-5) Saturday to close out the regular-season.

#### LARRY BLAIR WATCH: 3 POINTS FROM ALL-TIME SCORING RECORD

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR is three (3) points from becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer, and will likely reach the mark this Wednesday, Feb. 21 when Liberty visits VMI. Blair started the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart. Below are the top five scorers in Big South history:

#### REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE DECIDED THIS WEEK

The final week of the regular-season is upon us, and the regular-season champion and No. 1 seed are still undetermined. While Winthrop has clinched at least a share of the regular-season title, it must win one of its two games this week to claim the outright crown. If Winthrop loses to High Point Tuesday, the Eagles would need HPU to suffer a third Conference loss on Saturday at home vs. VMI. If High Point wins both games this week, and Winthrop drops its two contests, the Panthers would share the regular-season title with the Eagles, but would receive the No. 1 seed based on the League's tiebreaker.

After head-to-head (which would be a 1-1 split), the next tiebreaker is record vs. next team in the standings, which is Coastal Carolina. High Point swept CCU, and under this scenario, WU and Coastal would have split the season series. Coastal swept Liberty this season and would be assured of an eighth Conference win and third place should they defeat the Eagles Saturday, no matter if Liberty finishes with eight League wins as well.

#### THREE OF FOUR HOME SEEDS CLINCHED

Winthrop, High Point and Coastal Carolina have all clinched first round home games in the 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Championship. Winthrop is the first and only squad to clinch a home seed each of the five years the League has used the home site tournament format, which began in 2003. Coastal is a home seed for the second-straight year, while High Point has secured a home seed for the first time since 2004. While three home sites have been determined, the seeds are still up for grabs. Entering this week, here is where the current top four could end up:

No. 1: Winthrop or High Point No. 2: High Point or Winthrop No. 3: Coastal Carolina or Liberty No. 4: Coastal Carolina or Liberty (or VMI)

# BIG SOUTH ENJOYS ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL BRACKETBUSTERS APPEARANCE

Winthrop's resounding 77-66 win at Missouri State last Friday night on ESPN2 highlights the Big South's second consecutive 2-1 performance in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event. The Eagles outscored the Bears 50-38 in the second half and converted 14-of-27 3FG (=.519) and 19-of-22 FT (=.864) in earning their 13th consecutive victory. On Saturday, Coastal Carolina came back to defeat Canisius at home, 83-66. Liberty fell just short at Niagara, 90-81. In two years of participation in the event, the Big South is now 4-2 overall, plus 2-1 in return games. In 2007-08, Winthrop will host Missouri State and Liberty will host Niagara, while Coastal will travel to Canisius.

# WILLIAMS, VMI LOOKING TO JOIN NCAA HISTORY

If VMI (102.9 points) and **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (28.5), which currently lead the nation in team scoring and individual scoring, respectively, can remain the national leaders, it would be just the 10th time since 1947-48 that one team led the NCAA in scoring offense and produced the nation's individual scoring leader in the same season. The last time was in 1996-97 when Long Island was tops in scoring at 91.5 and Blackbirds' player Charles Jones averaged 30.1 points. The previous nine occurrences are listed below.

#### **POLLSTERS**

Winthrop's BracketBusters win over Missouri State has vaulted the Eagles in the two national Top 25 polls. In this week's *Associated Press* Top 25, Winthrop was 31st with 75 points, up from last week's high-water mark of 15 points. Winthrop is rated No. 29 in the current ESPN/*USA Today* poll with 61 points, up from last week's No. 33 position and previous-best 23 points. Meanwhile, Winthrop was ranked No. 3 in the recent (Feb. 12) *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25, its 12th consecutive week in the top 10 and fifth-straight week among the top three. While the Eagles dropped down one spot from the previous week, they did receive first-place votes (three) for the first time ever.

#### **HIGH TIDE**

At 20-8, High Point has recorded its first 20-win season since moving up to Division I and its first 20-win campaign since 1995-96 (24 wins). Coupled with Winthrop's 23 wins, it gives the Big South two 20-win teams during the regular-season for just the second time in League history. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament.

#### HOME SWEET HOME

Winthrop has won 19-straight home games, currently the seventh-longest streak in the NCAA. Winthrop has won 42 of its last 43 at the Winthrop Coliseum and is 52-5 (=.912) at home since the start of the 2003-04 season. High Point is 22-3 in its last 25 home appearances at Millis Center, and is 43-10 (=.811) at home since **BART LUNDY** took the reigns in '03-04. Meanwhile, since **BUZZ PETERSON** took over the Coastal Carolina program last year, the Chanticleers are 26-3 at Kimbel Arena (=.897).

#### VMI'S RECORD-SETTING SEASON BOOSTING WIN TOTAL

VMI's five Conference wins are its most since joining the Big South in 2003. The previous high was four in that initial 2003-04 season. In addition, the Keydets' 12 overall wins are the most since winning 12 ballgames in 1998-99. Meanwhile, VMI has already set the following Big South single-season records: points scored (2,880); field goal attempts (2,338); three-point field goals (388), three-point attempts (1,218), assists (606) and steals (442). The Keydets are on pace to set several per game records, as well as NCAA Division I records for three-point field goals and steals. Individually, **REGGIE WILLIAMS** has already broken the Big South single-season records for points and field goals made, and will set the points per game mark as well.

### **GOING CLUBBIN'**

Radford's CHRIS OLIVER became the fifth player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds when he surpassed the total Feb. 10 at Winthrop, and now ranks third-all-time with 830. He is also just the second player in League history with more than 1,600 points and 800 boards. High Point's ARIZONA REID is the 15th player in Big South annals with 1,200 career points (1,256) and 600 rebounds (622). Meanwhile, of the 33 players in Big South history in the 1,000 career point/500 career rebound club, six are active players: Oliver, Reid, MOSES SONKO (1,112-565), MATT MURRER (1,121-542), REGGIE WILLIAMS (1,730-541) and recent addition CRAIG BRADSHAW (1,034-523).

# DOUBLE TROUBLE

Liberty's LARRY BLAIR is the lone player in the Big South to score in double figures in every game this season (28 games). Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 49 consecutive games and 61 of his last 62 games. Meanwhile, Blair became the League's all-time career leader in field goals made Feb. 17 at Niagara, breaking TONY DUNKIN's career mark of 775. Blair is now first all-time with 778 field goals and 1,875 field goal attempts.

# **REID ALL ABOUT IT**

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** is quickly climbing the Big South's career rebounding chart, as he is now 25th all-time with 622 rebounds. He reached the 600-rebound milestone Feb. 10 vs. Coastal Carolina - exactly one month and 11 games after reaching 500 rebounds at VMI on Jan. 10. He needs six rebounds to catch **KEENAN MANN** (Augusta, 627) for 24th place in Big South history.

#### STOP, THIEVES!!

VMI owns the Conference's single-season steals record, as the Keydets sit at 442 on the year -- the first Big South squad with 400 steals in a season. The Keydets are averaging 15.79 steals per game and are on pace to finish with 489 steals, which would break the NCAA record of 486 set by Oklahoma in 1987-88. VMI's per game clip is pacing ahead of the NCAA mark of 14.9, held by Long Island in 1997-98. Meanwhile, TRAVIS HOLMES is two steals away from becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 100 steals in a season.

#### TV GUIDE

The final weekend of the Big South regular-season will include two televised games and one video streamed affair on Saturday, Feb. 24. A regional doubleheader on SportSouth will begin with Winthrop at Coastal Carolina at 2:00pm, immediately followed by Liberty at Radford at 4:00pm, which will also be carried by WDRL-TV in Roanoke. The final game of the day, VMI at High Point at 7:00pm, will be video streamed live on The Big South EDGE presented by Aéropostale.

#### **BUZZING ON THROUGH**

Coastal Carolina head coach BUZZ PETERSON recorded his 200th career coaching victory Feb. 12 with Coastal's thrilling one-point win at Liberty. The second-year CCU coach owns a 201-131 (=.605) career coaching record, including 35-22 at Coastal, and has secured at least a .500 record for the ninth time in his 11 seasons as a head coach.

# **20-10 VISION**

Winthrop established some League firsts with its 80-76 victory over Liberty on Feb. 6. The Eagles became the first team in Big South history with three consecutive 20-win seasons, and reached 10 Conference wins for the eighth consecutive year, extending their League record. Since the 2004-05 campaign, Winthrop is 73-18 overall (=.802) and 40-4 (=.909) in Conference play.

#### VMI SITTING ATOP NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.9 POINTS PER GAME

VMI is averaging 102.9 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in 16 games and have posted six additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in nine of 12 contests -- just missing all 12 games by a combined eight points -- and is averaging 115.0 points per game at Cameron Hall. The last Division I team to average 100 points per game was Southern University in 1994 (101.0). No Big South team was ever led the nation in scoring, and the Keydets are well on their way to setting the Conference's season scoring offense record, which is (was) 83.6 points by Winthrop in 1992-93.

#### POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 12-16 on the year, the Keydets have lost 10 games by seven points-or-less -- including four by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty has dropped nine games by the same seven-point margin, followed by Radford and Coastal Carolina with five. The Highlanders have lost four of those games by three points-or-less.

#### LEASURE WORLD

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 297 career three-pointers, third all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 82 of 86 career games, needs three to become the third player in League history with 300 career treys. He also stands 13 three-pointers shy of his secondstraight season with 100 triples.

#### SONKO SINKS IT

Coastal Carolina senior forward MOSES SONKO continues to lead the Big South in field goal shooting at .557 percent (167-of-300). He is looking to become just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as DuWAYNE CHEATAM was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent).

#### MARSHALL PLAN

Winthrop head coach GREGG MARSHALL became the second head coach in League history with 100 regular-season Conference wins when the Eagles defeated Liberty on Feb. 6, reaching the mark in the fastest amount of time (124 games). He is currently 102-24 (=.810) all-time in regular-season League matchups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament. Marshall is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 188 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor ROB BRADLEY is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109.

#### TRIPLE CROWN?

The Big South has three players averaging 20 points per game in REGGIE WILLIAMS (28.5), ARIZONA REID (21.4) and LARRY BLAIR (20.3). If the trio can maintain their respective averages, it would mark just the second time in Big South history that three players averaged 20 points a game in the same season. In 1992-93, TONY DUNKIN (23.7), DARNELL SNEED (23.0) and DEVIN BOYD (23.0) were the first.

The old Big South records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. #### IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed two student-athletes on the 2007 ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-team. Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE was named to the team for the second consecutive year, while Charleston Southern sophomore GIEDRIUS KNYSAS received his first such honor. Leasure and Knysas advance to the national ballot with the opportunity to earn Academic All-America status.

#### **DEFENSIVE MINDED**

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during GREGG MARSHALL's tenure as head coach. Through 27 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 60.6 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip. In addition, Winthrop is holding opponents to a .406 field goal percentage, while Conference foes are managing just .392 percent.

### LIFE BEGINS AT 40

The Big South has had seven individual 40-point games in 2006-07, the most currently on record for a single-season and the most since it was accomplished four times during the 1992-93 campaign. REGGIE WILLIAMS has scored 40 points in a game four times this season, the most by an individual in a singleseason. The Chanticleers have secured home court for the first round of the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championships for the third time in the last four years ... Coastal can lock up the No. 3 seed in this year's tournament with either a win over UNC Asheville on Thursday or against Winthrop Saturday ... Should the Chants tie Liberty and/or VMI in the final standings, Coastal wins the tiebreaker over both squads due to sweeping each season series.

#### **HIGH POINT**

High Point extended its win streak to four games with a pair of key Big South wins over UNC Asheville and Charleston Southern ... The victory over CSU was the squad's 10th League victory, equalling the program record set in 2003-04 ... The Panthers win over Asheville marked the 50th Big South win in program history ... Junior ARIZONA REID is just six points shy of becoming HPU's all-time leading scorer in the school's Division I era, passing DANNY GATHINGS ... HPU closes out the regular-season this week beginning Tuesday at Winthrop and at home Saturday vs. VMI.

#### LIBERTY

The regular-season finale at Radford on Feb. 24 will mark the 50th meeting between the rivals. Radford holds the all-time advantage at 29-20. Liberty has won at Radford only twice with the most recent being an 89-75 victory on Feb. 22, 1997 ... LARRY BLAIR scored a career-high 40 points on 17-of-25 shooting Feb. 12 vs. Coastal Carolina. The 17 field goals were a career-high and a Vines Center record. The 40 points were a national high for the day ... If Blair scores at least 10 points at VMI Wednesday, it will be the 103rd game in double figures in his career.

### **RADFORD**

Radford split the week, getting a record-breaking win over VMI at home before losing at Asheville ... Against VMI last week, CHRIS OLIVER became Radford's all-time leading rebounder with 824, and has reached 830. He also tallied a career-high 36 points in the victory and is now third in scoring all-time at Radford ... Radford set the Dedmon Center record for points scored in the win (114) and set a school record for most combined points (221) ... The 114 points also marked the third-most points scored by the Highlanders in a single-game ... Radford hosts Liberty in its final regular-season game of the season on Saturday on SportSouth.

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 1-1 last week as the Bulldogs just missed upsetting High Point Wednesday evening, losing on a last-second shot, 69-67 ... **BRYAN SMITHSON** tied a career-high with 25 points against Radford in Saturday's win ... **K.J. GARLAND** had a solid week with 14 points and a career-high nine assists against High Point. He is now tied for seventh on Asheville's career assist chart with 311 ... Sophomore 7-7 center **KENNY GEORGE** enjoyed a career-high against High Point with 14 points on 7-of-8 FG. Against Radford, he had eight points and eight rebounds and played a season-high 19 minutes.

#### VM

VMI has established a Big South record for assists with 606 this year, and have also set a school record for field goals made in a season, currently at 1,014 ... **REGGIE WILLIAMS** has broken the school record for field goals made, which was 285 ... Williams has tied **GAY ELMORE**'s school-record for most 30-point games in a career with 15 ... **MATT MURRER** moved into a tie for 22nd in career scoring at VMI with 1,121 career points. He has averaged 24.5 points and 9.0 rebounds over the past four games ... **CHAVIS HOLMES** broke the school record for most 3-point attempts in a season (242) ... The Keydets are 10-6 when scoring 100 points this season ... VMI hosts Liberty Wednesday and visits High Point Saturday.

#### **WINTHROP**

Winthrop picked up a huge non-Conference win Friday night over Missouri State in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters, its first-ever win over a Missouri Valley opponent ...
