

#### WINTHROP BECOMES FIRST BIG SOUTH SQUAD TO REACH SECOND ROUND OF NCAA TOURNAMENT

No. 11 seed Winthrop became the first Big South men's basketball program to advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament with its 74-64 win over No. 6 seed Notre Dame on Friday, March 16 in Spokane, Wash. Senior **CRAIG BRADSHAW** led Winthrop with 24 points and **TORRELL MARTIN** posted a double-double for the Eagles with 20 points and 11 rebounds. Winthrop's run was ended in the second round by No. 3 seed and eventual Elite Eight participant Oregon, 75-61. Martin led the Eagles with 15 points and 12 boards against the Ducks. Winthrop entered the game as the NCAA Tournament's highest remaining seed, and its memorable season ended at 29-5. Winthrop's No. 11 seed was the highest in Big South history, as the previous high was No. 14 twice by Winthrop (2000 and 2005).

#### GREGG MARSHALL WINS TWO COACH OF THE YEAR AWARDS

The United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) voted Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the 2007 District III Coach of the Year, marking the first time that the nine-year coach of the Eagles has received the honor. District III includes all schools in the states of South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia and Maryland. Marshall, who was voted Big South Coach of the Year this season for a record fourth time, also received the *CollegeInsider.com* **HUGH DURHAM** Mid-Major Coach of the Year award, which was announced during the Final Four. Marshall also was a finalist for the **JIM PHELAN** National Coach of the Year award.

#### WINTHROP BECOMES FIRST BIG SOUTH PROGRAM RANKED IN TOP 25

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference placed a men's basketball program into the national Top 25 rankings, as the Winthrop Eagles were ranked No. 22 in the March 5 ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll, and No. 24 in the Associated Press poll. Winthrop was ranked No. 22 in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll announced April 3. Here is a look at Winthrop's week-by-week placement in the national polls this season:

#### WINTHROP DUO RECOGNIZED NATIONALLY FOR OUTSTANDING SEASONS, CAREERS

Winthrop seniors CRAIG BRADSHAW and TORRELL MARTIN capped their college careers in grand fashion by leading the Eagles to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and earned several individual honors along the way. Bradshaw was named a Mid-Major All-American by *CollegeInsider.com*, and was named CBS Chevrolet Player of the Game vs. Notre Dame. Martin, who was the CBS Chevrolet Player of the Game vs. Oregon, participated in the NABC All-Star Game in Atlanta on March 30. In addition, Bradshaw and Martin participated in the 2007 NBA-sanctioned Portsmouth Invitational Tournament.

#### CHRIS GAYNOR NAMED NATIONAL MID-MAJOR MOST VALUABLE PLAYER

Winthrop junior guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** was named the 2006-07 National Mid-Major Most Valuable Player by *CollegeInsider.com*. The publication stated that Gaynor "was the difference-maker for Winthrop. He was the difference between a good team and the best team in school history."

#### HE IS MARSHALL

With Winthrop's NCAA Tournament win over Notre Dame, head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** became the Big South Conference's all-time winningest coach with 194 victories, breaking the record of 193 held by former Radford head coach **RON BRADLEY**. Marshall's career record stands at 194-83 (=.700) and he also is the League's record holder for winning percentage. Bradley posted a 193-124 mark during his tenure from 1991-02 with the Highlanders (=.609). Marshall improved his Big South Tournament record to 19-2 (=.905) and his regular-season Big South record of 104-24 (=.813) is best in League history. His Conference Games win total is second to Bradley's 109.

#### WIN...THROP

At 29-5, the Winthrop Eagles set a school and Big South single-season record for wins, breaking the previous mark of 27, set by the 2004-05 Winthrop squad. On Feb. 6 vs. Liberty, Winthrop became the first team in Big South history to win at least 20 games three consecutive seasons, and reached at least 10 Conference wins for the eighth consecutive year, extending its League record. Since the 2004-05 campaign, Winthrop is 79-19 overall (=.806) and 42-4 (=.913) in Conference play. Winthrop's five losses this season -- all against nationally-ranked teams -- set the single-season League record for fewest losses in one campaign. The 34 games played were the most played by one Big South squad in a single-season.

#### WINTHROP'S WIN STREAKS

Winthrop's win streak reached 19 before its loss to Oregon in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The streak marked the second time in three seasons that the Eagles won at least 18 consecutive games. In 2004-05, Winthrop won its final 15 regular-season League games and three Big South Tournament games entering the NCAA Tournament, but fell to Gonzaga in the first round. Meanwhile, Winthrop's 23-game home win streak is fourth-longest in the country and will be intact entering the 2007-08 campaign.

#### WINTHROP CAPS PERFECT CONFERENCE SEASON WITH THIRD-STRAIGHT TOURNAMENT TITLE

Winthrop, which became the first team in Big South history to post an undefeated season in Conference play this year at 14-0, captured its third consecutive Big South Tournament championship with its 84-81 win over No. 6 seed VMI on March 3. The title was the Eagles' eighth overall, extending its Big South record, and marked the seventh in the last nine years. Winthrop is also the first Big South member to win at least three-straight League Tournament championships twice. The Eagles won four-in-a-row from 1999-02.

#### MID-MAJOR MANIA

Highlighted by Winthrop, the Big South continued its presence in the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll during the 2006-07 season, with Winthrop being ranked in the top 10 all year, including the top two in the final five polls. The Eagles received first-places from Feb. 12-March 12, including a high of 14 in the March 5 poll (two points out of the No. 1 spot). #### THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

Winthrop once again finished the season as the Big South's leaders in scoring defense, as the Eagles held opponents to a League-low 61.4 points -- which is third-lowest in a season in Big South history. Winthrop has now led the Big South in scoring defense nine consecutive seasons, all during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip. In addition, Winthrop held opponents to a .411 field goal percentage this season, while Conference foes managed just .398 percent in 2006-07.

#### REID NAMED AP HONORABLE MENTION ALL-AMERICA; ALL-DISTRICT

Big South Player of the Year ARIZONA REID picked up three postseason honors, as he was named Honorable Mention All-America by the Associated Press, as well as receiving All-District accolades by the NABC (District 5 Second-team) and the USBWA (District III). Reid became the first player in League history to average 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in one season in 2006-07, as he finished campaign with a 21.0 points per game average and 9.5 rebounding clip. The only player in League history to come close to the 20.0/9.0 per game rate was Campbell's JOE SPINKS in 1993-94. Spinks averaged 20.9 points and 8.8 rebounds that season for the Camels.

#### REGGIE WILLIAMS, VMI JOIN NCAA HISTORY

VMI (100.9 points) and REGGIE WILLIAMS (28.1) led the nation in team scoring and individual scoring, respectively, becoming the first to do so in Big South history. It also marked just the 10th time since 1947-48 that one team led the NCAA in scoring offense and produced the nation's individual scoring leader in the same season. The last time was in 1996-97, when Long Island was tops in scoring at 91.5 and Blackbirds' player Charles Jones averaged 30.1 points. The 10 occurrences are listed below.

#### WILLIAMS CLAIMS BIG SOUTH SINGLE-SEASON SCORING RECORD

VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS finished the season with a 28.1 scoring average, establishing the Big South single-season record for points per game. The old mark was 24.6, held by Campbell's CLARENCE GRIER in 1986-87. Williams, who was named a Division I All-District 4 Second-team member by the NABC, also set the League's points record with 928 this year -- the first player in League history with 900 points in a season. He also set the single-season records for field goals (338) and field goal attempts (636).

#### NO. 6 SEED VMI MAKES LASTING IMPRESSION WITH CHAMPIONSHIP CHASE

VMI, which was picked to finish last in the Big South preseason poll, enjoyed a memorable run in the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship to finish as the League's runner-up. The nation's leading scoring team entering the postseason at 102.7 points, VMI altered its offensive and defensive schemes to stage two upsets to reach the title game against Winthrop. The Keydets won at No. 2 seed Liberty. 79-78 before shutting down No. 2 High Point, 91-81 in the Semifinals. VMI also stayed close to Winthrop in the Championship Game, never trailing by more than nine points and remaining within a field goal several times. VMI tied the game twice late in the contest before Winthrop pulled away for the victory. VMI was just the second No. 6 seed to advance to the Championship Game in the Big South's Tournament history.

#### RADFORD HIRES BRAD GREENBERG AS HEAD COACH

On March 23, Radford named Virginia Tech associate head coach BRAD GREENBERG as the sixth head coach in school history, replacing BYRON SAMUELS. While this will be Greenberg's first head coaching opportunity, he has more than 25 years of NBA and NCAA coaching success, having served stints at South Florida, American and St. Joseph's at the collegiate level. Greenberg also spent time with the Portland Trail Blazers (1989-95) and was General Manager of the Philadelphia 76ers from 1996-97, drafting ALLEN IVERSON his first year. He also was an assistant coach with the New York Knicks and the Los Angeles Clippers, and was a player personnel consultant with the Denver Nuggets, Washington Bullets and Orlando Magic during his career.

#### LIBERTY HIRES RITCHIE McKAY AS HEAD COACH

On March 26, Liberty named former New Mexico head coach RITCHIE McKAY as the seventh head coach in school history, replacing RANDY DUNTON. McKay comes to Lynchburg with a 165-158 career record during his 10 years as a head coach, which includes two-year stints each at Portland State (1996-98), Colorado State (1998-00) and Oregon State (2000-02). He spent five years at New Mexico (2002-07), highlighted by a Mountain West Conference championship in 2005. With a 26-7 record that year, the conference championship earned New Mexico its first NCAA Tournament appearance in six years and the program's first conference title since 1996. McKay sported an 82-69 overall record at New Mexico.

#### **20/20 VISION**

For just the second time in League history, the Big South had two 20-win teams prior to its postseason tournament. Winthrop concluded the regular-season 25-4, while High Point was 21-9 -- its first 20-win season since moving up to Division I and its first 20-win campaign since 1995-96 (24 wins). In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament.

#### BIG SOUTH ENJOYS ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL BRACKETBUSTERS APPEARANCE

Winthrop's resounding 77-66 win at Missouri State Feb. 16 on ESPN2 highlighted the Big South's second consecutive 2-1 performance in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event. The Eagles outscored the Bears 50-38 in the second half and converted 14-of-27 3FG (=.519) and 19-of-22 FT (=.864) in earning their 13th consecutive victory. On Feb. 17, Coastal Carolina came back to defeat Canisius at home, 83-66. Liberty fell just short at NCAA Tournament participant Niagara, 90-81. In two years of participation in the event, the Big South is now 4-2 overall, plus 2-1 in return games. In 2007-08, Winthrop will host Missouri State and Liberty will host Niagara, while Coastal will travel to Canisius.

#### MORE ON VMI'S RECORD-SETTING SEASON

VMI's 14 overall wins this season was double its output from a year ago, and the most by a Keydet squad since winning 14 in 1997-98. In addition, VMI's five Conference wins were its most since joining the Big South in 2003. The Keydets advanced to their first Tournament finals since 1988 when they were members of the Southern Conference. Lastly, VMI was the first team in NCAA Division I to average 100.0 points per game since Southern University in 1994 (101.0), and is in position to becoming the first team in Big South history to lead the nation in scoring.

#### TURN OF THE CENTURY

VMI concluded the 2006-07 season with 17 games of 100 points-or-more, plus an additional eight games in the 90s. VMI scored 100 points at home in 10 of 13 contests -- just missing all 13 games by a combined eight points -- and averaged 114.5 points per game at Cameron Hall. The Keydets finished 8-5 at home this season, but lost its five games by an average of 7.6 points.

#### POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI finished 14-19 on the year, the Keydets lost 11 games by seven points-or-less -- including four by a mere two points, the most in the Big South this season. Liberty dropped 10 games by the same seven-point margin, followed by Coastal Carolina with seven. In addition, Radford lost four games by three points-or-less.

#### LARRY BLAIR: BIG SOUTH'S ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER ... FOR NOW

Liberty's LARRY BLAIR became the Big South Conference's all-time leading scorer Feb. 21 at VMI, breaking the record of 2,151 points held by TONY DUNKIN since 1993. Blair concluded his stellar career with 2,211 points, but will enjoy the top spot for just a short while, as VMI junior REGGIE WILLIAMS is now fourth all-time at 1,861 points -- just 350 points away from catching Blair. #### MACK ATTACK

Coastal Carolina's **JOSHUA MACK** was voted Big South Freshman of the Year by the League's head coaches, sports information directors and media panel. He is Coastal's second Freshman of the Year winner in three seasons, and the school's fifth overall honoree, the most by one school in Conference history. Former member Campbell is second to Coastal with three Freshman of the Year selections, followed by Winthrop and UNC Asheville, plus former members UNC Greensboro and UMBC, with two each.

#### CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

Big South Player of the Year ARIZONA REID grabbed 304 rebounds this year, becoming the fourth player in League history with 300 boards in a season. Reid's total is fourth-highest in Big South history, and are the most since Winthrop's GREG LEWIS (313) and Radford's ANDREY SAVTCHENKO (309) in 2001-02. Reid set the Big South single-game rebounding record on Feb. 24 when he corralled 25 caroma against VMI. The previous overall record was 23 rebounds, held by Winthrop's ALLEN WASHINGTON vs. Piedmont on Nov. 30, 1985. The Conference Games mark of 22 was shared by Winthrop's STEVE NAPPER vs. UMBC (Jan. 29, 1994) and Coastal's MOSES SONKO against VMI this season on Feb. 3.

#### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Liberty's LARRY BLAIR was the lone player in the Big South to score in double figures in every game this season (31 games). Dating back to last season, Blair scored in double digits in 52 consecutive games and 64 of his last 65 games. Meanwhile, Blair became the League's all-time career leader in field goals made Feb. 17 at Niagara, breaking TONY DUNKIN's career mark of 775, and ended his career first all-time with 801 field goals and 1,926 field goal attempts.

#### TWENTY SOMETHING

The Big South had three players average 20 points per game this season in **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (28.1), **ARIZONA REID** (21.0) and **LARRY BLAIR** (20.4). It was just the second time in Big South history that three players averaged 20 points a game in the same season. In 1992-93, **TONY DUNKIN** (23.7), **DARNELL SNEED** (23.0) and **DEVIN BOYD** (23.0) were the first.

#### STOP, THIEF!

VMI sophomore and Big South Defensive Player of the Year **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the fourth player in Big South with 100 steals in a season, and ended the campaign with 111 takeaways -- second-most in a single-season. He finished three steals away of tying the record of 114, set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Holmes' per game average of 3.36 is fourth-highest in League history, and he was the first player to average more than 3.0 steals per game since Liberty's **CARL WILLIAMS** in 1999-00 (3.82).

#### THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE made 90 three-pointers this season to increase his career total to exactly 300, good for third-place all-time in Big South history. He will enter his senior campaign in 2007-08 needing 102 treys to break DOUG DAY's career Conference record of 401. Meanwhile, VMI sophomore CHAVIS HOLMES became the fifth player in Big South history to make 100 three-pointers in a season (eighth time overall), and his total of 108 this year is fifth-most in one season. Winthrop's MICHAEL JENKINS joined the 100 three-pointer club during the NCAA Tournament and finished with exactly 100 this season.

#### **BOARD MEETING**

Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** ended his career third all-time in Big South history with 845 rebounds, as well as just the second player in Conference annals with more than 1,600 points and 800 boards. Oliver was one of seven active players this season with both 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds, a list that grew to 34 by season's end. #### PLAYAS CLUI

Winthrop's **CRAIG BRADSHAW** and **PHILLIP WILLIAMS** each ended their careers with 123 games played, setting the Big South career record in that category. The previous high was 122 career appearances, set by Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** and High Point's **LANDON QUICK** at the conclusion of the 2007 Big South Tournament. Blair and Quick surpassed the record of 120 games played, held by Winthrop's **PIERRE WOOTEN** from 1998-03.

#### **BIG SOUTH NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY**

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop, which extended its Big South record for NCAA Tournament appearances with seven, garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

#### IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE was named to the 2007 ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-America team as a second-team selection, the organization announced in late February. Leasure is the Big South's first men's basketball Academic All-American since Radford's COREY REED in 1997-98. Leasure and Charleston Southern sophomore GIEDRIUS KNYSAS were selected to the ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-team as well. It was Leasure's second-straight All-District selection and Kynsas' first such honor.

#### LIFE BEGINS AT 40

The Big South had eight individual 40-point games in 2006-07, the most for a single-season and the most since it was accomplished four times during the 1992-93 campaign. REGGIE WILLIAMS scored 40 points in a game four times this season, the most by an individual in a single-season. He just missed tying the Big South's single-game record of 46 by one point on Nov. 15. #### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers' season came to an end at 8-22 after an injury-plagued year that saw just eight players, six of them on scholarship, suit up for the quarterfinal match up against Winthrop ... With 16 points against Winthrop, DWAYNE JACKSON took over the team scoring lead, averaging 17.0 points per game in Big South games, and 14.4 points per game overall ... Fellow senior DONNELL COVINGTON finished with a 14.2 ppg mark as the only two seniors on the team finished their CSU careers having been two of the top-three scorers all season.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

After last year's run to the Championship Game, Coastal Carolina was defeated in the quarterfinals by No. 5 seed UNC Asheville at home, 77-64 ... Senior forward MOSES SONKO finished the season as the League's leader in field goal percentage (.560), just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as DuWAYNE CHEATAM was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent) ... As a team, Coastal Carolina ranked second in the Big South in steals (277) and steals per game (9.23), and was second in offensive rebounds per game with 13.20.

#### HIGH POINT

High Point completed its best Division I season in 2006-07, posting record win totals overall (22) and in Big South play (11) ... The Panthers return all but one senior (LANDON QUICK) next season ... HPU reached the semifinals of the Big South Tournament for the fourth consecutive year -- all under head coach BART LUNDY -- and also earned the program's 100th Division I victory ... Junior ARIZONA REID became just the second HPU player to garner Big South Player of the Year accolades. Reid finished the season as one of just five players in the country averaging more than 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds ... All-Freshman Team member EUGENE HARRIS marks HPU's third-straight season with an All-Freshman team honoree.

LARRY BLAIR finished his career with 53 games in which he reached the 20-point plateau, or 43.4 percent of his 122 career appearances. He reached the 15-point plateau in 81 games (66.4 percent) and double-figures in 105 outings, including his last 52-straight games ... Blair finished his career at Liberty holding records in field goals in the Division I era (801), three-point field goals (227), minutes played (4,123), games played (122) and steals in the Division I era (221) ... Blair finished his career two rebounds short of becoming the first player in Big South history with 2,000 points, 700 field goals, 200 three-point field goals, 500 rebounds, 300 assists and 200 steals ... ALEX MCLEAN's 19 rebounds at VMI, Feb. 21 broke the Liberty Division I era record of 18 held by MIKE COLEMAN and JULIUS NWOSU.

#### RADFORD

The Highlanders finished the year at 8-22 overall and 3-11 in Conference play, losing 10 of their last 11 games ... The quarterfinal loss marked the last game for Radford seniors REGGIE McINTYRE and CHRIS OLIVER ... Freshman AMIR JOHNSON scored 23 points and grabbed eight rebounds, tying career highs in each category ... The No. 7 seed was the lowest seed RU has had since the 1990 Big South Tournament, when it was No. 7 as well. The Highlanders have not won a Big South Tournament game since 2003.

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville ended the season playing its best basketball of the year as the Bulldogs won four of their last five games ... For the second time in his career, K.J. GARLAND made the Big South All-Tournament team despite UNC Asheville not making the finals. Garland averaged 20.0 points in Asheville's two games ... Four starters and 11 lettermen return to next year's squad ... Junior BRYAN SMITHSON led the Bulldogs in scoring (14.6), and also led the team in steals (60), three-pointers (43) and free throw percentage (.852) ... Garland ranks seventh in school history with 329 assists and 10th all-time with 93 three-pointers ... C.J. WALKER is now fifth all-time in Big South history in blocked shots (190).

REGGIE WILLIAMS finished the Big South Tournament with 64 points and 26 rebounds (21.3 ppg, 8.7 rpg), while TRAVIS HOLMES tallied 63 points and 21 boards (21.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg) ... The 33 games played by VMI in 2006-07 were the most in a season ... After averaging 102.7 points in the regular-season, VMI altered its offense and averaged 83.7 points, while hitting .492 percent from the floor (94-of-191) and .353 percent from long range (30-of-85) in the Big South Tournament.

#### WINTHROP

Winthrop finished the 2006-07 season as the Big South's leader in seven statistical categories: scoring defense (61.4), scoring margin (+13.4), field goal defense (.411), three-point field goal percentage (.360), rebounding defense (31.0), rebounding margin (+6.6) and assist/turnover ratio (1.27) ... The Eagles were second in five categories as well: field goal percentage (.477), blocked shots (3.71), assists (16.68), defensive rebounds (25.21) and three-point fields per game (8.18) ... CHRIS GAYNOR ranked first in the Big South in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.15). Gaynor also owns 427 career assists and is approaching the Big South's career Top 10.
