Martin scored 51 points in three games, helping Winthrop to a 2-1 record last week and near-upset of No. 2 North Carolina. He averaged 17.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game, and scored a game-high 25 points vs. the Tar Heels in the Preseason NIT as he connected on a career-high seven three-pointers. He had his first double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. Iona in the Preseason NIT. Martin added 15 points and five rebounds in the Eagles' win at Mississippi State, Winthrop's second win ever over an SEC school.

Williams dropped in a school-record 45 points in VMI's 156-95 win over Virginia Intermont last week. In just 24 minutes of action, he was 18-of-26 from the floor (.692 percent), hit 4-of-9 three-pointers (.444), grabbed eight rebounds and tallied six steals.

WINTHROP PICKED AS TEAM TO BEAT IN 2006-07

For the second-straight year, Winthrop is the unanimous selection to win the Big South Conference title this season, as voted by the League's head coaches, sports information directors and media panel. The Eagles were the Conference's regular-season and tournament champion last year following a League-best 23-8 overall record and 13-3 mark in Big South games. Coastal Carolina, last year's regular-season and tournament runner-up, finished second in the voting with 187 points, just five points ahead of No. 3 High Point (182). Charleston Southern, which has reached the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship semifinals the past two years, was predicted to finish fourth (121), while Liberty placed fifth in the voting (117). UNC Asheville was predicted sixth (100), followed by Radford (seventh) and VMI (eighth).

WINTHROP RECEIVES VOTES IN ESPN/USA TODAY COACHES POLL

For three consecutive weeks, Winthrop has received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll. The Eagles are currently in the 41st spot, up eight spots from last week's position in the poll. The Eagles have played two Top 25 teams (North Carolina, Maryland) in a three-game span. Winthrop is ranked No. 9 in the *CollegeInsider.com* preseason Mid-Major poll.

MARTIN TABBED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

For the second-straight year, Winthrop guard **TORRELL MARTIN** has been voted the League's Preseason Men's Basketball Player of the Year. Martin has earned First-team All-Big South honors the past two seasons and is coming off a campaign where averaged 13.8 points, 5.6 rebounds, 44.3 percent from the floor and 1.78 steals per game. He was named MVP of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship for the second-straight year in helping the Eagles capture their sixth tournament crown in eight years. In League play, he averaged 16.0 points, 5.4 rebounds, 47.4 percent from the floor and 47.7 percent from beyond the arc. Martin received six first-place votes and finished with 94 points in the voting to earn a spot on the preseason All-Conference team. Joining Martin on the preseason team are **LARRY BLAIR** (Liberty), **ARIZONA REID** (High Point), **JACK LEASURE** (Coastal Carolina) and **CRAIG BRADSHAW** (Winthrop).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB INCREASES MEMBERSHIP

Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** became the 15th player in school history and 75th in Big South history to reach 1,000 career points when he topped the mark in the season opener vs. North Greenville. He is now at 1,072 points in his career (68th place). Meanwhile, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** became the 76th player, and his recent scoring output as vaulted him into 66th place with 1,077 points. Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** hit the milestone Sunday vs. Wright State, as he scored 22 points to hit 1,000 on the dot to become the 77th player with 1,000 career points.

BIG SOUTH 600

Radford junior **CHRIS OLIVER** became the 26th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone in the season opener vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He is now at 633, 23rd all-time in Big South history. He needs five rebounds to pass former Winthrop post player **EDDIE GAY** for 22nd place. The Big South career rebound record is 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently tied for 48th all-time in the League with 1,182 career points.

BIG SOUTH'S 2006-07 SEASON SET AT EIGHT TEAMS

The Big South will have eight men's basketball teams competing in 2006-07 and will utilize a 14-game Conference season. The change was made following Birmingham-Southern shuttering of its men's program due to a mass exodus of players following the school's announcement that it will drop down to Division III beginning in June 2007.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** enters the 2006-07 campaign 11th all-time on the League's career scoring chart with 1,603 points. He needs just one point to move into the top 10 and 549 points to become the Big South's all-time leading scorer. Below are the Top 11 scorers in League history:

TWENTY-SOMETHING

For just the second time in Conference history, two 20-win teams met in the Big South Tournament Championship Game last season when Winthrop and Coastal Carolina battled for the League crown. Winthrop entered with 22 wins, while Coastal posted 20 victories. The first time was in 1999, when 20-win Winthrop met 20-win Radford for the championship. Meanwhile, the Big South had two 20-win teams last year for the first time since 1999 (sixth time overall).

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles led the Big South in scoring defense for the eighth-straight season in 2005-06, extending their League record. Winthrop allowed 61.2 points per game, the second-lowest mark in Big South history. The Eagles have led the Conference in scoring defense during **GREGG MARSHALL's** eight-year tenure as head coach. Meanwhile, Winthrop held its opponents to 40.1 percent shooting from the field and 31.6 percent from the arc, both Big South bests last season. In 2004-05, the Eagles limited their opponents to a 39.9 field goal percentage and 33.3 percent success rate from long-range. Through five games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to 58.2 points and .413 field goal shooting.

12-PACK

Three Big South teams (Winthrop, Coastal Carolina and Birmingham-Southern) finished with at least 12 Conference wins last season for just the second time in Big South history. The trio joined the 1993-94 campaign, when four members (Towson State, Radford, Campbell, Liberty) achieved the mark. Of course, the Big South played an 18-game schedule in '93-94, compared to the 16-game format last season.

TONIGHT ON 20/20

Winthrop concluded the 2005-06 season with a 23-8 record, extending its Big South record for 20-win seasons to six. The Eagles have posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for the second time since 1998. No Big South team has won 20 contests three-straight years. Winthrop has posted five 20-win seasons under head coach **GREGG MARSHALL**.

NO FRESHMAN 15

Five Big South squads (Winthrop, Birmingham-Southern, Coastal Carolina, Radford and High Point) won 15 games in 2005-06, the first time five members had at least 15 wins since six accomplished the feat in 1993-94.

BIG SOUTH BACK IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 16-17. Coastal Carolina (home), Liberty (road) and Winthrop (road) will be the League's participants. The Big South went 2-1 last season in its first-ever appearance in the event, including Winthrop's 98-97 double overtime win over Northern Illinois. It will be Coastal's and Liberty's first appearance in the BracketBusters, which is in its fifth season. The wins in last year's series helped push the Big South Conference four spots in the national RPI to a League-best 19th.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 168 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 90-24 (=.789) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

THAT'S A FACT, JACK

2005-06 Big South Player of the Year **JACK LEASURE** was also honored as the Conference's Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the first men's basketball player in League history to earn both awards in the same season since the academic honor began in 1996-97. A Coastal player earned Player of the Year accolades for the second-straight season, while Leasure is the second overall CCU student-athlete to earn Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville mentor **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is in his 11th season as UNC Asheville's coach this year, tying the League record for longest tenured head coach. Former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** coached the Highlanders for 11 seasons from 1991-02. Biedenbach and Bradley are the only coaches to coach at least 10 years in the Conference.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern defeated The Citadel last week for the second consecutive year ... The Bucs are 3-0 at home, and winless in two games on the road ... CSU is second in the Big South in scoring offense, averaging 80.8 points per game ... CHRIS MOORE is tied for ninth in scoring at 15.2 points, and ranks 10th in rebounding at 5.8 boards per contest ... Charleston Southern won Monday night vs. Asbury, and visits Clemson Friday evening.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal is 40-15 (=.727) at Kimbel Arena since 2002-03, including a double-overtime, home opening win over Wright State this past Sunday ... JOSEPH HARRIS recorded his second consecutive double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds ... JACK LEASURE reached 1,000 career points with his 22-point effort ... Coastal hosts Asbury Wednesday night in its lone action of the week.

HIGH POINT

High Point opened its home schedule with a 94-67 win over Covenant College ... The victory kept the Panthers a perfect 8-0 in home openers during their Division I history ... The Covenant win marked the 50th in Coach BART LUNDY's five-year career at HPU ... The game was also the 250th in Lundy's head coaching career and the 200th in HPU's Division I history ... Junior ARIZONA REID posted a career-best double-double with 32 points and 17 rebounds in the win ... MIKE JEFFERSON missed a triple-double with seven points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists ... The Panthers host Chowan on Tuesday before visiting No. 24 Maryland on Friday in a game to be televised on CSN Mid-Atlantic.

LIBERTY

LARRY BLAIR needs 20 points to move into ninth-place on the Big South career scoring list ... Junior college transfer ALEX McLEAN is in just his third year of playing organized basketball, as he did not play in high school and spent the past two years at Suffolk Community College. McLean scored 13 points and grabbed eight rebounds at Oklahoma on Nov. 16 ... DWIGHT BREWINGTON is one of three players at the Division I level that plays with some sort of hearing impairment. He has 60% hearing loss in both ears and plays with hearing aids ... Liberty returns to action Tuesday night vs. Cincinnati Christian and Saturday vs. Houghton.

RADFORD

Radford got its first win of the season after starting 0-4 for just the second time in school history ... RU rebounded from a heartbreaking overtime loss to Western Illinois Friday in a game they were leading by six with under a minute to play ... The Highlanders will play a Thanksgiving special at Air Force Wednesday before returning to the Dedmon Center for their home opener Saturday night against Campbell ... REGGIE McINTYRE, who has stepped up his scoring output all season, tallied a career-high 21 points in the OT loss to Western Illinois.

UNC ASHEVILLE

BRETT WARNER scored a career-high 16 points in a 77-76 loss at Duquesne. The Bulldogs trailed by nine with two minutes left and took a 76-75 lead before being called for a foul with 1.3 seconds left ... UNC Asheville plays twice this week as it will play Virginia for the first time ever ... The Bulldogs finish the week with a home game against Eastern Kentucky Saturday afternoon ... C.J. WALKER has tied the school record for career blocked shots with 164. He is currently tied with PAT JOLLEY ... Junior guard BRYAN SMITHSON is off to a great start as he's averaging a team-leading 17.0 points and shooting 51.4 percent from the field (19-of-37).

VMI

VMI has scored 100 points in three-straight games, averaging 134.7 points in the span ... In the Keydets' 156-95 win over Virginia Intermont, VMI shattered the record book with 24 records ... REGGIE WILLIAMS is averaging 28.8 points this season, including 39.0 in his last three outings ... Freshman ADAM LONON dished out 11 assists in the win over Virginia Intermont ... VMI defeated Southern Virginia Monday night, 144-127, and visits James Madison and Howard this week.

WINTHROP

Winthrop defeated Mississippi State for its second all-time victory over an SEC school ... PHILLIP WILLIAMS led the Eagles over MSU with a career-high 22 points and 11 rebounds. It was his first career double-double ... The Eagles continued their high-profile early season schedule with an 11-point setback at No. 24 Maryland Monday night ... For the first time in the program's history, the Eagles will not be playing a game during Thanksgiving weekend because the dates had to be kept open for a possible NIT Season Tip-off semifinal appearance in New York City.
