Giedrius Knysas • Sophomore
F/C • Charleston Southern

Knysas averaged 22.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in helping the Bucs to a 1-1 record last week. In just 20 minutes against Asbury, Knysas tallied a career-high 22 points on 9-of-16 from the floor (=.562) and contributed two steals in CSU's 93-68 win. At undefeated Clemson Saturday, Knysas again posted 22 points, this time on 8-of-10 shooting (=.800) and 5-of-6 from the line in the losing effort. He also recorded his first career double-double with 10 rebounds against the Tigers. For the week, the 6-9 forward/center was 17-of-26 from the floor (=.654), 2-of-4 from three-point range (=.500) and 8-of-12 from the line (=.667). Knysas also moved into the top spot in the Big South Conference in field goal percentage at .615 percent (32-of-52).

VMI TURNING HEADS NATIONALLY WITH ITS SCORING OUTPUT

Through seven games, the VMI Keydets have scored 100 points in a contest four times, and lead the Big South with a smoldering 105.6 points per game average. VMI scored 104, 156 and 144 points in three consecutive games recently, and is looking to become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0). The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 27.4 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6. Williams is hitting .532 percent from the floor (74-139), has four 30-point games and is averaging 10.6 field goals per contest. He is also fifth in the Conference with 8.7 rebounds.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR**, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, has already jumped into eighth place through three games. He owns the eighth spot with 1,654 points, and needs 11 to move into seventh. Blair is 498 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB INCREASES MEMBERSHIP

The Big South's 1,000-point club has already added three members in the young season in Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** (75th), VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (76th) and Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (77th). Williams has vaulted to 56th all-time at 1,125, while Martin is 68th at 1,072. Leasure is in the 73rd spot with 1,022 career points. The trio's career totals and respective standing will be tracked all season long.

BIG SOUTH 600

Radford junior **CHRIS OLIVER** became the 26th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone in the season opener vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He is now at 659, 22nd all-time. He needs two rebounds to pass former Charleston Southern player **JEFF DANIELS** (660) for 21st. Oliver also is 41 boards shy of becoming just the 15th player in Big South history with 700 rebounds. The Big South career record is 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently 42nd all-time in the League with 1,220 career points.

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** has made 225 career three-pointers, 10th all-time in Big South history. He needs 10 to move into the ninth spot. Meanwhile, Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** is 15 treys shy of becoming the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals. Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** is 17 away from the milestone.

REACHING HIS GOAL

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** now ranks eighth all-time in League history with 590 field goals made, and needs 15 to move into seventh-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93).

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 168 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 90-24 (=.789) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through five games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 58.2 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** tied a Big South Conference single-game record with 12 three-pointers en route to a career-high 40 points in the Eagles' season-opening win over North Greenville. Five days later, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** set a Big South single-game record with 18 field goals made vs. Virginia Intermont and finished with 45 points, falling one point shy of the League's single-game scoring record.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** made his Bulldog debut Nov. 22 at Virginia, officially becoming the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. In 15 minutes vs. the Cavaliers, he scored four points on 2-of-3 FG and blocked five shots. George is the tallest college player in the nation.

WINTHROP FALLS OUT OF ESPN/USA TODAY COACHES POLL

After three consecutive weeks of receiving votes, Winthrop has fallen out of the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll. Last week, the Eagles were in the 41st spot with four votes received, its most of the season. So far in 2006-07, Winthrop has defeated SEC member Mississippi State on the road, and fell in the waning minutes to two Top 25 teams (North Carolina, Maryland) in a three-game span. Meanwhile, Winthrop is ranked No. 9 in the *CollegeInsider.com* preseason Mid-Major poll, with the next poll due out next week (Dec. 4).

BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP GAME MOVED TO ESPN

The 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Men's Basketball Championship game, originally to be broadcast on ESPN2, has been moved to ESPN. The game will air on its original date and time -- Saturday, March 3 at 2:00pm. The Semifinals will again be carried by ESPNU on Thursday, March 1, at 6:00 and 8:30pm, and will be held at the site of the regular-season champion.

BIG SOUTH BACK IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 16-17. Coastal Carolina (home), Liberty (road) and Winthrop (road) will be the League's participants. The Big South went 2-1 last season in its first-ever appearance in the event, including Winthrop's 98-97 double overtime win over Northern Illinois. It will be Coastal's and Liberty's first appearance in the BracketBusters, which is in its fifth season. The wins in last year's series helped push the Big South Conference four spots in the national RPI to a League-best 19th.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers struggled in the first half against Asbury, trailing 40-39, but a tightened defense, and faster paced game allowed the Bucs to run away in the second half, out-scoring the Eagles 53-48 in the final 20 minutes ... Down as much as 11 early in the second half at Clemson, Charleston Southern mounted a 10-0 run to cut the deficit to one, but the undefeated Tigers scored 17 answered points to pull away late ... CSU has four players scoring in double figures: **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** (13.8), **CHRIS MOORE** (13.7), **DWAYNE JACKSON** (11.8) and **DONNELL COVINGTON** (10.8)

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal is 41-15 (=.732) at Kimbel Arena since 2002-03, including 16-1 under head coach **BUZZ PETERSON**. The lone loss was a tough overtime battle with Radford last season ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** recorded his third consecutive double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds vs. Asbury, and now leads the Big South in rebounding at 11.0 per game ... **JACK LEASURE** has scored 22 points in each of his past two outings ... Coastal hosts Southern Virginia Wednesday night in its lone action of the week.

HIGH POINT

High Point finished an interesting week of basketball with a 1-1 mark ... HPU defeated Chowan in a game that last 18 hours and covered two days, thanks to a power outage on campus that saw play halted with :17 seconds left in the first half and forced a restart the following day ... The Panthers then visited No. 24 Maryland and kept things close until a late surge pushed the Terps in front for good ... High Point will play four games in a span of a week, including a stretch of three home contests in five days beginning on Saturday against Ohio Valley University ... HPU is 2-0 at home this year and has won their last six home games.

LIBERTY

Head coach **RANDY DUNTON** currently has 99 career college coaching wins and can reach the 100-victory plateau Monday night with a win over Southern Virginia. Dunton is 54-69 in his tenure at Liberty ... Liberty has recorded two straight wins by 30-plus points, the first time since the 1992-93 season. LU has scored 90 points in consecutive games for the first time since 1992-93 as well ...
