# CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Craig Bradshaw • Senior Forward • Winthrop Wellington, New Zealand

Bradshaw averaged 17.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in helping Winthrop to two League wins last week, as well as securing a first round home game in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship. In the Eagles' 80-76, come-from-behind over Liberty, Bradshaw scored 20 points and hauled in 10 rebounds, while hitting 7-of-12 from the field (=.583) and adding three assists and three blocked shots. At 11:12 remaining in the game, he sparked a 19-4 run with a three-pointer and posted seven points in the span to help Winthrop overtake the Flames. Against Radford, Bradshaw tallied 14 points and five rebounds, as well as two blocks. On the week, Bradshaw was 12-of-21 from the field ( =.571), 4-of-8 from threepoint range ( =.500) and averaged 2.0 assists and 2.5 blocks.

#### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Eugene Harris Guard • High Point Pittsburgh, Pa.

Harris averaged 10.0 points in helping High Point to two wins as well as holding onto second-place in the Big South standings. Against Coastal Carolina, Harris came off the bench and scored 11 points, including a trio of three-pointers in the first half that pushed the Panthers ahead for good. In the second half, he hauled in four key offensive rebounds, one of which led to a three-pointer and another that kept a Panthers' possession alive with 1:50 remaining. Earlier in the week, he scored nine points in 17 minutes in High Point's road win at Savannah State. For the week, Harris was 7-of-13 from the floor ( =.538), 4-of-8 from long range (=.500), 2-of-2 from the line with three assists and two steals.

#### WINTHROP TIES LEAGUE RECORD FOR BEST CONFERENCE START AT 11-0

The Winthrop Eagles have tied the Big South record for best Conference start at 11-0, matching the feat set by Coastal Carolina in both 1989-90 and 1990-91. Winthrop, which has already secured a first round home game in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Basketball Championship, needs one more Big South win to clinch at least a share of the regular-season title. The Eagles have won 13 consecutive regular-season League games, dating back to last season.

#### WILLIAMS NATION'S LEADING SCORER, NETS LEAGUE'S SINGLE-SEASON SCORING RECORD

With his 21 points vs. UNC Asheville Saturday, VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** broke the Big South's single-season scoring record of 759 points, set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93. Williams is currently at 764 points, and his season average of 28.3 points per game leads the nation and is well ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6, set by **CLARENCE GRIER** in 1986-87. Williams is on pace to score 877 points this season, as well as finishing the year fifth all-time on the Big South's career scoring list with 1,810 career points.

#### LARRY BLAIR WATCH: 78 POINTS FROM ALL-TIME SCORING RECORD

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR is 78 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. He needs to average 13.00 points in his final six scheduled games to break the record, but is on pace to break the mark on Feb. 21 at VMI. The third player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points, reaching the total Jan. 30 vs. UNC Asheville, Blair started the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart. #### MARSHALL PLAN

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** became the second head coach in League history with 100 regular-season Conference wins when the Eagles defeated Liberty on Feb. 6, reaching the mark in the fastest amount of time (124 games). He is currently 101-24 (=.808) all-time in regular-season League matchups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament. Marshall is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 186 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109.

#### IN THE JUMP CIRCLE THIS WEEK; BIG SOUTH AND O'REILLY ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS

The Big South's anticipated participation in the 2007 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters takes center stage this weekend, beginning with Winthrop's appearance at Missouri State Friday night on ESPN2. It will be the first-ever meeting between Winthrop and Missouri State, as well as Winthrop's first match-up against an MVC member. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina and Liberty will each play members of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) on Saturday. The Chanticleers will host Canisius, while Liberty will travel to Niagara. Last season, the Big South went 2-1 in the BracketBusters, its first involvement in the event.

#### 20-10

Winthrop established some League firsts with its 80-76 victory over Liberty last week. The Eagles became the first team in Big South history with three consecutive 20-win seasons, and reached 10 Conference wins for the eighth consecutive year, extending their League record. Since the 2004-05 campaign, Winthrop is 71-18 overall (=.798) and 39-4 (=.907) in Conference play.

#### VMI'S RECORD-SETTING SEASON BOOSTING WIN TOTAL

VMI's five Conference wins are its most since joining the Big South in 2003. The previous high was four in that initial 2003-04 season. In addition, the Keydets' 12 overall wins are the most since winning 12 ballgames in 1998-99. Meanwhile, with less than three weeks remaining this season, VMI has already set the following Big South single-season records: points scored (2,773); field goal attempts (2,254); three-point field goals (381), three-point attempts (1,183) and steals (430). The Keydets are on pace to set several per game records, as well as NCAA Division I records for three-point field goals and steals.

#### HOME SWEET HOME

Winthrop has won 18-straight home games, currently tied for ninth-longest in the NCAA. Winthrop has won 41 of its last 42 at the Winthrop Coliseum and is 51-5 (=.911) at home since the start of the 2003-04 season. High Point is 21-3 in its last 24 home appearances at Millis Center, and is 42-10 (=.808) at home since **BART LUNDY** took the reigns in '03-04. Meanwhile, since **BUZZ PETERSON** took over the Coastal Carolina program last year, the Chanticleers are 25-3 at Kimbel Arena (=.893).

#### **BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT CLUB UPDATE**

#### GOING CLUBBIN'

Radford's CHRIS OLIVER became the fifth player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds when he surpassed the total Feb. 10 at Winthrop. He is also just the second player in League history with 1,500 points and 800 boards (1,578 and 806). High Point's ARIZONA REID became just the 15th player in Big South annals with 1,200 career points (1,202) and 600 rebounds (604) this past weekend vs. Coastal Carolina. Meanwhile, of the 33 players in Big South history in the 1,000 career point/500 career rebound club, six are active players: Oliver, Reid, MOSES SONKO (1,086-556), MATT MURRER (1,094-536), REGGIE WILLIAMS (1,697-528) and recent addition CRAIG BRADSHAW (1,005-513).

#### **HIGH TIDE**

At 18-8, High Point is two wins away from its first 20-win season since moving up to Division I and first 20-win campaign since 1995-96 (24 wins). Should the Panthers reach 20 wins prior to the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, it would mark just the second time in League history that two Big South teams won 20 games during the regular-season. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament.

#### FLAMES ON FIRE IN PAST SIX GAMES

Liberty has gone 5-1 in its past six games, and almost made it a perfect 6-0 with its four-point loss at Winthrop last week, a game in which the Flames led by seven points with 11:31 remaining. In the six-game span, Liberty is averaging 87.2 points, .559 percent from the field (193-of-345), .382 percent from long range (29-of-76) and a +4.1 rebounding margin. Individually, **DWIGHT BREWINGTON** has arguably been the main spark, as he is averaging 19.0 points, .723 percent from the floor (47-of-65), 5.2 rebounds and 2.7 assists in the stretch, while averaging 25.8 minutes.

#### **REID ALL ABOUT IT**

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** is quickly climbing the Big South's career rebounding chart, as he is now 26th all-time with 604 rebounds. He reached the 600-rebound milestone Feb. 10 vs. Coastal Carolina - exactly one month and 11 games after reaching 500 rebounds at VMI on Jan. 10. He needs 10 rebounds to catch his assistant coach and former Radford standout **DON BURGESS** (614) for 25th place in Big South history.

#### SONKO SINKS IT

Coastal Carolina senior forward MOSES SONKO continues to lead the Big South in field goal shooting at .558 percent (159-of-285). He is looking to become just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as **DuWAYNE CHEATAM** was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent).

#### STOP, THIEVES!!

VMI owns the Conference's single-season steals record, as the Keydets sit at 430 on the year, becoming the first Big South squad with 400 steals in a season. The Keydets are averaging 15.93 steals per game and are on pace to finish with 494 steals, which would break the NCAA record of 486, set by Oklahoma in 1987-88. VMI's per game clip is pacing ahead of the NCAA mark of 14.9, held by Long Island in 1997-98.

#### DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** is the lone player in the Big South to score in double figures in every game this season (25 games). Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 46 consecutive games and 58 of his last 59 games.

#### **BUZZING ON THROUGH**

Coastal Carolina head coach **BUZZ PETERSON** is one win away from 200 in his career. The second-year CCU coach owns a 199-131 (=.603) career coaching record, including 33-22 at Coastal. He has had at least a .500 record in eight of his previous 10 seasons as a head coach, and needs three more wins this season for his ninth such occurrence.

#### VMI SITTING ATOP NATION IN SCORING WITH 102,7 POINTS PER GAME

VMI is averaging 102.7 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in 15 games and have posted six additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in nine of 12 contests -- just missing all 12 games by a combined eight points -- and is averaging 115.0 points per game at Cameron Hall. The last Division I team to average 100 points per game was Southern University in 1994 (101.0). No Big South team was ever led the nation in scoring, and the Keydets are well on their way to setting the Conference's season scoring offense record, which is (was) 83.6 points by Winthrop in 1992-93.

#### **POLLSTERS**

Winthrop was ranked No. 2 in the recent (Feb. 5) *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25, its 11th consecutive week in the top 10 and fourth-straight week among the top three. It is Winthrop's highest ranking since sharing the No. 2 spot with Southern Illinois on Jan. 1. In this week's AP Top 25, Winthrop was 36th with 15 points, its highest total ever. Last week, Winthrop tallied 12 points in the ESPN/*USA Today* Coaches poll.

#### RUNNIN' ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

As mentioned, VMI has already broken the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point field goals and three-point attempts, standing at 381 threes and 1,183 attempts through 27 games. The Keydets' 1,183 attempts also surpass the NCAA Division I record of 1,057, set by Duke in 2000-01. The old Big South records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. Meanwhile, the chart below details the League and NCAA three-point records VMI will likely surpass this season:

#### **GOAL ORIENTED**

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR ranks second all-time in League history with 747 field goals made, 29 away from supplanting Big South Hall of Famer TONY DUNKIN (1989-93), who owns the career record of 775. Meanwhile, Blair is the League's all-time leader in field goal attempts with 1,819, breaking DOUG DAY's career mark of 1,780.

#### JUST GO TO YOUR HOME

Winthrop is the first and only squad to clinch a first round home game in the Advance Auto Parts Big South Championship in the five years of the League's home site tournament format, which began in 2003. With that, below is a look a this year's Conference Games won-loss record at home and on the road, listed in order of the current standings. #### LEISURE WORLD

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 288 career three-pointers, sixth all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 80 of 84 career games, needs one to tie RAYMOND ARRINGTON (Radford, 1990-03) for fifth all-time at 289.

#### TWENTY-SOMETHING

The Big South will have a 20-point scorer for the second consecutive season, marking the first time since the 1993-94 and 1994-95 campaigns that this feat has been accomplished. In fact, the Big South had a 20-point scorer five-straight years, from 1990-91 to 1994-95. This season will mark just the 10th time in the 22 years of Big South men's basketball that the League has had a 20-point scorer.

#### POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 12-15 on the year, the Keydets have lost nine games by seven points-or-less -- including four by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty has dropped seven games by the same seven-point margin, followed by Radford and Coastal Carolina with five. The Highlanders have lost four of those games by three points-or-less.

#### IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed two student-athletes on the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-team squad late last week. Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** was named to the team for the second consecutive year, while Charleston Southern sophomore **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** received his first such honor. Leasure and Knysas advance to the national ballot with the opportunity to earn Academic All-America status.

#### PUTTING HIS BEST FOOT FORWARD

Winthrop senior **TORRELL MARTIN** appears to have returned to form after missing seven-plus games with a foot injury. Martin scored a team-high 20 points Saturday vs. Radford and was 8-of-12 from the field, including 4-of-6 from three-point range in his most extensive action (28 minutes) since returning to the lineup Feb. 3. Prior to his injury, Martin was averaging 15.5 points, .485 percent from the field and 5.9 rebounds in 14 games. He departed the Jan. 6 VMI after playing just seven minutes and was out through Jan. 31.

#### **GLASS-PLUS**

Coastal Carolina's MOSES SONKO tied a Big South Conference game record with 22 rebounds vs. VMI on Feb. 3. Winthrop's STEVE NAPPER set the record on Jan. 29, 1994 vs. UMBC. Sonko had 10 offensive boards and 12 defensive grabs against the Keydets in becoming just the ninth player in League history (and second in Conference action) with 20 rebounds in a contest. Winthrop's ALLEN WASHINGTON owns the single-game record of 23 rebounds, established vs. Piedmont on Nov. 30, 1985 -- the Big South's first year of basketball.

#### **DEFENSIVE MINDED**

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 25 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 60.7 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip. In addition, Winthrop is holding opponents to a .408 field goal percentage, while Conference foes are managing just .396 percent.

#### LIFE BEGINS AT 40

The Big South has had six individual 40-point games in 2006-07, the most currently on record for a single-season and the most since it was accomplished four times during the 1992-93 campaign. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** has scored 40 points in a game four times this season, the most by an individual in a single-season. #### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs' three-game win streak was halted last week at home against VMI. Five of CSU's eight players reached double figures, led by **DWAYNE JACKSON**'s 26 points, his third-highest output of the season. Charleston Southern led in the second half but was not able to hold on, despite shooting 58.8 percent from the floor ...
