Chris Oliver • Senior F • Radford Winston-Salem, N.C.

Oliver averaged 27.0 points and 9.5 rebounds in two wins last week. including the Highlanders' first-ever win at Richmond. He tallied a double-double vs. the Spiders, scoring 24 points and 10 rebounds, while shooting 56.3 percent from the floor (9-of-16) and a perfect 6-of-6 from the line. He also tallied six steals and a block in the win. Oliver then posted 30 points and nine rebounds against West Virginia Wesleyan, hitting 72.2 percent from the field on 13-of-18 shooting. He also had four blocks, two steals and two assists against the Bobcats. On the week, Oliver shot 64.7 from the floor (22-of-34), 90.9 from the charity stripe (10-of-11) and posted five blocks and eight steals.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

B.J. Jenkins Guard • Liberty Virginia Beach, Va.

Jenkins averaged 14.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals in Liberty's two wins last week, including a 64-56 victory over East Carolina. He shot 64.3 percent from the field (9-of-14), 42.9 percent from long range (3-of-7) and 77.8 from the line (7-of-9). Jenkins scored a career-high 16 points vs. Southern Virginia, and added 12 points vs. East Carolina. Against the Pirates, Jenkins also grabbed three rebounds, dished out three assists and notched three steals in 21 minutes off the bench.

BIG SOUTH ENJOYS BREAKOUT WEEK

The Big South enjoyed a solid week of non-Conference wins the past seven days, beginning with Radford's 67-50 win at Atlantic 10 member Richmond. It was the League's first win over an A-10 member since the 2004-05 season. On Thursday, Charleston Southern defeated SoCon preseason favorite College of Charleston in overtime, 84-80, to sweep the "City of Charleston" championship for the second consecutive season. Saturday, Winthrop won at MAC member Northern Illinois, 72-62, in a rematch of last year's BracketBuster match-up. UNC Asheville came back to win at Furman, which had defeated Vanderbilt earlier in the week. Liberty knocked off East Carolina, 64-56, marking the third-straight year the Big South defeated a Conference USA member.

THIS WEEK'S ACTION CHALLENGING AS WELL

This week's (Dec. 4-10) men's basketball action will see Winthrop travel to No. 12 Wisconsin and UNC Asheville visits Atlantic 10 member Charlotte Monday night. Tuesday, Radford hosts 2006 Final Four participant George Mason at the Dedmon Center. Saturday, High Point takes on No. 3 North Carolina in Chapel Hill.

VMI TURNING HEADS NATIONALLY WITH ITS SCORING OUTPUT

Through 10 games, the VMI Keydets have scored 100 points in a contest four times, and lead the Big South with a smoldering 99.0 points per game average. VMI scored 104, 156 and 144 points in three consecutive games recently, and could become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0). The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 3-7 on the year, the Keydets have lost six games by seven points-or-less, including two by a mere two points. VMI went winless on its recent five-game road trip, but took every game to the wire, losing by a combined 21 points (4.2 average). VMI has won its three ballgames this season by an average of 31 points.

WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 26.4 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6 Williams is hitting .516 percent from the floor (95-184), has two 40-point games among his five 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.5 field goals per contest. He is on pace to score 818 points this season, which would break the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, has already jumped into seventh place through five games with 1,687 career points. He needs 25 to move into sixth and 13 to become just the seventh player with 1,700 points. Blair is 465 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB INCREASES MEMBERSHIP

The Big South's 1,000-point club has already added three members in the young season in Winthrop's TORRELL MARTIN, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS and Coastal Carolina's JACK LEASURE. Williams has vaulted to 46th all-time at 1,197 points, while Martin is 57th at 1,122. Leasure is in the 70th spot with 1,034 career points. The trio's career totals and respective standing will be tracked all season long.

BIG SOUTH 600

Radford senior CHRIS OLIVER is 22 rebounds away from becoming the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. He is currently 18th all-time with 678 boards, and if he maintains his season average of 9.1 rebounds in two games this week (18 total rebounds), he would move into 15th place, passing Liberty's PETER ALUMA (682), Winthrop's TYRONE WALKER (690) and Winthrop's CHAD STEELE (692). The Big South career record is 954, held by Campbell's JOE SPINKS, and Oliver is on pace to finish at 869 rebounds, which would rank second in League history. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently 31st all-time in the League with 1,274 career points.

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 227 career three-pointers, 10th all-time in Big South history. He needs eight to move into the ninth spot. Meanwhile, Winthrop's TORRELL MARTIN is 11 treys shy of becoming the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals. Liberty's LARRY BLAIR is 12 away from the milestone.

REACHING HIS GOAL

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR now ranks tied for seventh all-time in League history with 604 field goals made, and needs 18 to pass Campbell's **HENRY WILSON** (621) for sixth-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93).

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 171 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 90-24 (=.789) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through eight games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 56.2 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

FIELD PATROL

In addition to its high scoring average, VMI is pacing well ahead of several Big South single-season records during the young 2006-07 season. The Keydets have already made 148 three-point field goals, just 103 away from tying the season record of 251 (Winthrop, 1999-00). The record for three-point attempts is 702 (Winthrop, 1999-00), while the record for three-pointers per game is 9.00, set by Birmingham-Southern in 2003-04. The Keydets are also on pace for 1,116 field goals made, which would shatter the League mark of 937 by Charleston Southern in 1986-87. And, of course, VMI is on pace to break the Big South's scoring record of 2,520 points (Radford, 1992-93), as the Keydets are currently in position for 3,069 points this season.

40-40

Winthrop's MICHAEL JENKINS tied a Big South Conference single-game record with 12 three-pointers en route to a career-high 40 points in the Eagles' season-opening win over North Greenville. Five days later, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS set a Big South single-game record with 18 field goals made vs. Virginia Intermont and finished with 45 points, falling one point shy of the League's single-game scoring record. Williams recorded his second 40-point game of the year with 41 points vs. Cornell on Dec. 1.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** made his Bulldog debut Nov. 22 at Virginia, officially becoming the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. In 15 minutes vs. the Cavaliers, he scored four points on 2-of-3 FG and blocked five shots. George is the tallest college player in the nation.

McLEAN DELUXE

Liberty junior forward **ALEX McLEAN** is one reason for Liberty's 4-1 start this year, as the junior college transfer is leading the Big South in field goal percentage at 61.8 percent. After a 9-20 start from the field in the first two games, McLean is hitting 75.8 percent from the floor in his last three outings (25-of-33), including an 11-of-13 FG (=84.6) and 26 point effort vs. Houghton, Nov. 25. He also is first in the League with 7.0 defensive rebounds, second with 9.8 rebounds and has scored in double figures all five games.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina sophomore **JOSEPH HARRIS** is currently the lone player in the Big South averaging 10 rebounds a game, as he is atop the leaderboard with 10.6. The last Coastal Carolina player to lead the Big South in rebounding was **WILLIAM CALVIN** in 1986-87, the League's second men's basketball season.

High Point redshirt freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** leads the Big South with 23 blocked shots and a 3.29 per game average. The last Big South player to average 3.0 blocks a game was Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** in 1996-97. Daniels has blocked at least one shot in six of his seven appearances and has three games with at least five swats. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **C.J. WALKER** is second to Daniels in blocks this season, and ranks fifth all-time in League history with 172 rejections.

MR. SMITH(SON) GOES TO ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville junior **BRYAN SMITHSON** has quietly enjoyed his debut season with the Bulldogs, as the transfer from Middle Tennessee State has scored in double figures all seven games and is averaging 16.0 points -- good for seventh in the Big South. He is shooting 82.8 percent from the free throw line (24-of-29) and is averaging 1.71 steals per game as well.

WINTHROP NINTH IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Big South continues its presence in the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, with Winthrop making the outlet's preseason rankings at No. 9. Coastal Carolina also received votes in the preseason poll. The next poll will be announced Monday, Dec. 4. Meamwhile, Winthrop received votes in the first three ESPN/*USA Today* Coaches polls of the season as well.

COACHES CORNER

Liberty head coach **RANDY DUNTON** recorded his 100th career college win Nov. 27 when the Flames defeated Southern Virginia, 109-64. Now in his sixth season as Liberty's coach, Dunton is 10th all-time in Big South history with 67 career wins, and needs four more victories to move into ninth-place.
