CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Reggie Williams • Junior F • VMI Prince George, Va.

Williams averaged 28.0 points and 6.5 rebounds in two games, helping the Keydets to a 1-1 record. He scored 28 points in VMI's 93-84 win at Richmond, hitting 10-of-15 field goals in addition to five rebounds and two steals. Williams tossed in a team-high 28 points at Penn State on Dec. 30, with eight rebounds, four assists, two steals and 7-of-10 free throws against the Nittany Lions. In the two contests, Williams averaged 54.3 percent from the floor (19-of-35), 40.0 percent from three-point range (6-of-15) and 70.6 percent from the foul line (12-of-17), as well as 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Joshua Mack Guard • Coastal Carolina Hopkinsville, Ky.

Mack averaged 12.0 points in three games for the Chanticleers, scoring in double figures each contest. He had 10 points, four rebounds and three steals vs. College of Charleston, Dec. 18, tallied 14 points, three assists and four three-pointers at Florida State, Dec. 21, and notched 12 points, four assists and hit 57.1 percent from long range (4-of-7) vs. St. Andrews, Dec. 29. Mack was 13-of-35 (=37.1) from the field and 10-of-24 (=41.7) from three-point range, in addition to 2.7 assists and 1.7 steals per game.

OPENING UP

Big South regular-season Conference action begins this Saturday, Jan. 6, with four games on the slate. Coastal Carolina has won its last 10 regular-season League match-ups, the longest streak among the eight members. Winthrop has the next longest streak at two-straight regular-season wins. Each team's wonloss records in Big South openers is as follows: Charleston Southern (8-13), Coastal Carolina (16-5), High Point (5-2), Liberty (4-11), Radford (10-11), UNC Asheville (14-7), VMI (0-3) and Winthrop (8-13).

WINTHROP MOVES INTO NO. 2 SPOT IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Winthrop Eagles' top 10 standing in the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll has reached new heights, as the Eagles are currently tied for the No. 2 spot with Southern Illinois in this week's poll. Winthrop, which was ranked No. 6 last week, and the Saluki's each received 689 points, with SIU garnering a first-place vote. Butler is ranked No. 1. Also, for the fourth time this season, Winthrop has received votes in the ESPN/*USA Today* Coaches Top 25 poll, coming in the 40th spot. The Eagles received votes in the first three polls of the year. Meanwhile, Liberty continues to receive votes in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll, having done so for the fifth consecutive week. The Flames are currently in the 35th position this week.

VMI LEADS NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.1 AVERAGE

Through 15 games, the VMI Keydets have scored 100 points in a contest seven times, and lead the Big South and the nation with a smoldering 102.1 points per game average. VMI scored 104, 156 and 144 points in three consecutive games early in the season, and could become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0). The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 6-9 on the year, the Keydets have lost seven games by seven points-or-less, including three by a mere two points. VMI's last seven losses have been by a combined 41 points -- a 5.9 average. VMI has won its six ballgames this season by an average of 29.0 points.

WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 26.7 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6. Williams is hitting .520 percent from the floor (143-275), has two 40-point games among his six 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.53 field goals per contest. He is averaging 28.4 points in his last seven outings, as well as 36.5 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 827 points this season, which would break the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

BLAIR NOW FOURTH ON LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME SCORING CHART

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, reached the fourth spot in nine games. He is the fourth player in Big South history to score 1,800 career points, and sits at 1,831 -- 25 points away from third-place. Blair is 321 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer, and would need to average 17.83 points in his final 18 games to break the record. THE 700 CLUB

Radford senior CHRIS OLIVER became the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone at East Tennessee State on Dec. 21. He is currently tied with TONY DUNKIN for eighth all-time with 725 boards, and needs 21 to pass Radford's KEVIN ROBINSON (745) for seventh place. The Big South career rebounding record is 954, held by Campbell's JOE SPINKS, and Oliver is on pace to finish at 854 rebounds, which would rank third in League history. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently 28th all-time in the League with 1,376 career points -- eight points shy of 27th.

RUNNIN ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

In addition to its high scoring average, VMI is pacing well ahead of several Big South and NCAA single-season records through the first eight weeks of the 2006-07 season. The Keydets have already made 222 three-point field goals, just 29 away from tying the season record of 251 (Winthrop, 1999-00). The record for three-point attempts is 702 (Winthrop, 1999-00) -- VMI is already at 686 and needs 17 attempts to break the mark. VMI is averaging 14.80 three-point fields per game, pacing well ahead of both the Big South record (9.00 - Birmingham-Southern, 2003-04) and the NCAA season record of 11.86 (Troy, 2005-06). The NCAA record for most three-point field goals in a season is 407, set by Duke in 39 games in 2000-01.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Winthrop's TORRELL MARTIN, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS and Coastal Carolina's JACK LEASURE each surpassed 1,000 career points during the early part of the season. Williams has vaulted into 30th place on the Big South's career scoring chart at 1,333 points, while Martin is 44th at 1,204. Leasure is tied for the 58th spot with 1,110 career points. Here is a look at who is ahead of each player on the chart entering this week's action:

LOOKING AHEAD

Four additional players are approaching 1,000 career points as well and will likely reach the milestone by season's end, if not sooner. VMI senior MATT MURRER is at 930 points, while High Point junior ARIZONA REID is 119 points shy with 881 in his career. Coastal Carolina senior MOSES SONKO has scored 877 points in his career. Winthrop senior CRAIG BRADSHAW stands at 837.

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 242 career three-pointers, tied for eighth all-time in Big South history with Winthrop's TYSON WATERMAN. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 67 of 70 career games, needs 12 more to move into the seventh spot with Winthrop's LaSHAWN COULTER at 254. Meanwhile, Winthrop's TORRELL MARTIN is the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals, reaching the mark on Dec. 21. He stands at 201. Liberty's LARRY BLAIR is one trey away from the milestone.

GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR now ranks third all-time in League history with 660 field goals made, and needs 56 to pass Radford's DOUG DAY (715) for second-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer TONY DUNKIN (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,609 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 175 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 90-24 (=.789) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 13 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 57.8 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

LIFE BEGINS AT 40

Winthrop's MICHAEL JENKINS tied a Big South Conference single-game record with 12 three-pointers en route to a career-high 40 points in the Eagles' season-opening win over North Greenville. Five days later, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS scored 45 points against Virginia Intermont, falling one point shy of the League's single-game scoring record. Williams recorded his second 40-point game of the year with 41 points vs. Cornell on Dec. 1.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** is the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. He has appeared in six games this season, including five consecutive outings since Dec. 16. He is averaging 10.0 minutes, 4.3 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.2 blocks and his shooting 70.6 percent from the floor (12-of-17). George enjoyed his best outing of the year at East Tennessee State, Dec. 19, scoring six points, grabbing nine rebounds and blocking five shots in 15 minutes of action.

STEALING THE SHOW

VMI sophomore **TRAVIS HOLMES** leads the Big South with 2.80 steals per game, currently the fourth-highest steal average in League history. He has hovered around the 3.0 mark, and the last Big South player to average more than 3.00 steals per game was Liberty's **CARL WILLIAMS** in 1999-00 (3.82). Holmes' twin brother, **CHAVIS**, is second in the League with 2.79 steals per game. Chavis is also second in the Conference with 3.50 three-point field goals made per game.
