Harris had the best week of his young career in leading the Chanticleers to a pair of wins at VMI and at home over Liberty. At VMI, he posted a career-high 31 points and made it a double-double with 11 rebounds along with two blocks and one steal. He tallied 21 in the first half to give CCU an 11-point halftime lead, but his crunch-time occurred with 7.6 seconds left when he grabbed a key offensive rebound with Coastal up one and was fouled and hit the first free throw to seal the victory. Harris followed that up with his second double-double of the week with a team-high 18 points and 10 rebounds, along with career-bests of three blocks and five steals in the win over Liberty. He scored 12 of his points in the second half, including four in the closing seconds to squelch a late LU rally. On the week, Harris averaged 24.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and was 20-of-24 from the field (=.833).

WINTHROP, HIGH POINT REMAINING UNBEATENS IN CONFERENCE PLAY

For the first time in Big South history, the League has two teams that have opened Conference play with 5-0 records in the same year. Winthrop is 5-0 for the second consecutive year, while High Point's 5-0 start is its best ever. Last season, the Eagles jumped out to a 6-0 Conference start.

BIG WEEK IN THE BIG SOUTH

This week (Jan. 22-28) will feature the Big South's top teams facing each other on the hardwood. On Monday, 5-0 High Point visits 4-1 Coastal Carolina in Conway, S.C. On Thursday, the Panthers host 5-0 Winthrop at Millis Center. The week concludes Saturday with Winthrop hosting Coastal Carolina in a rematch of last year's Big South Championship game, and will be televised regionally on SportSouth.

BLAIR CLOSING IN ON 2,000 CAREER POINTS, LEAGUE'S SCORING RECORD

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR**, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, reached the fourth spot in nine games and moved into the third spot Jan. 6. The third player in Big South history to score 1,900 career points (now at 1,953), Blair is 47 points away from 2,000 and is 199 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. He needs to average 16.58 points in his final 12 scheduled games to break the record. Below are the top three scorers in Big South history:

NO FRESHMAN 15

Winthrop has won 15 games in a season for the ninth-straight year, all under head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** and extending its Big South record for most consecutive seasons with at least 15 victories. The Eagles are off to their best start under Coach Marshall as well. Meanwhile, High Point is one win away from its third 15-win season in four years under head coach **BART LUNDY**.

HOME SWEET HOME

Winthrop and High Point each have won 15-straight home games, currently tied for 14th-longest in the NCAA. Winthrop has won 38 of its last 39 at the Winthrop Coliseum and is 48-5 (=.906) at home since the start of the 2003-04 season. High Point is 20-2 in its last 22 home appearances at Millis Center, and is 41-9 (=.820) at home since the beginning of the '03-04 campaign. Meanwhile, since **BUZZ PETERSON** took over the Coastal Carolina program last year, the Chanticleers are 23-1 at Kimbel Arena, including a current 15-game win streak at the on-campus facility. Coastal's loss to the College of Charleston earlier this season at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center counts as a home loss, therefore the Chants are not listed in the current home win streaks nationally.

ARIZONA REID LATEST TO JOIN BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** joined the Big South's 1,000-point club during last Wednesday's game against Liberty. Reid is now the sixth active player with 1,000 career points. The club could add an additional three members before year's end as well. Below is a look at the active 1,000-point scorers, where they rank in League history, and those approaching the milestone:

REID ALL ABOUT IT

Upon reaching 1,000 career points last week, High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** became the 27th player in Big South history to have both 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. He surpassed the rebounding milestone Jan. 10 at VMI, and now has 543 career boards, currently 32nd all-time. Meanwhile, in his last six games, Reid is averaging 27.3 points, 10.3 rebounds and .579 percent from the field (69-of-119). He has reached double figures in scoring in 16 of 19 games this season, and is averaging 23.4 points when doing so.

WILLIAMS ON PACE FOR LEAGUE'S SEASON SCORING RECORDS

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 27.9 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6, set by Campbell's **CLARENCE GRIER** in 1986-87. Williams is hitting .517 percent from the floor (199-385), has three 40-point games among his nine 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.95 field goals per contest. He scored 20 points in 10 consecutive games from Dec. 1 to Jan. 13, averaging 30.0 in that span. He also averages 37.0 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 864 points this season, which would shatter the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

SONKO SINKS IT

Coastal Carolina senior forward **MOSES SONKO** recorded his 500th career rebound Saturday vs. Liberty, and enters the week 28 points shy of 1,000 in his career. Sonko continues to lead the Big South in field goal shooting at .596 percent (112-of-188). He is looking to become just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as **DuWAYNE CHEATAM** was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent).

STOP, THIEF!!

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** set a Big South single-game record with 11 steals last Thursday vs. Bridgewater College. The output was his ninth game this season with at least four steals, and pushed his season average to 3.60 steals per game -- currently first in the nation. Twin brother **CHAVIS** recorded nine steals in the game as well, helping the Keydets to 26 steals on the night. On the season, VMI has 324 steals and needs 52 more to tie the Big South single-season record of 376, set by Liberty in 1999-00. The Keydets are averaging 16.20 steals per game and are on pace to finish with 502 steals, which would break the NCAA record of 486, set by Oklahoma in 1987-88. VMI's per game clip is pacing ahead of the NCAA mark of 14.9, held by Long Island in 1997-98.

OLIVER TWIST

Radford senior **CHRIS OLIVER**, who became the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone at East Tennessee State on Dec. 21, is currently sixth all-time with 772 boards, and needs 14 to pass Charleston Southern's **HEADER AMBROISE** (785) for fifth place. Oliver is on pace to finish at 848 career rebounds, which would rank third in League history.

DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (19 games) and Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** (21 games) are the lone Big South basketball players to score in double figures in every game this season. Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 40 consecutive games and 52 of his last 53 games, while Oliver has reached double figures in scoring in his last 25 outings.

VMI SITTING ATOP NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.4 POINTS PER GAME

VMI is averaging 102.4 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in 10 games and posted four additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in seven of nine contests -- just missing all nine games by a combined four points -- and is averaging 119.9 points per game at Cameron Hall. VMI is looking to become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0), as well as the first Big South member to lead the nation in scoring. The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is (was) 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

RUNNIN' ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

VMI has already broken the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point field goals and three-point attempts, standing at 299 threes and 929 attempts through 20 games. The old records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. Meanwhile, the chart below details the League and NCAA three-point records VMI will likely surpass this season:

GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** ranks third all-time in League history with 706 field goals made, and needs 10 to pass Radford's **DOUG DAY** (715) for second-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,720 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

BUZZING ON THROUGH

Coastal Carolina head coach **BUZZ PETERSON** is three wins away from 200 in his career. The second-year CCU coach owns a 197-126 (= .610) career coaching record, including 31-17 at Coastal. He has had at least a .500 record in eight of his previous 10 seasons as a head coach, and needs four more wins this season for his ninth such occurrence.

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** has made 268 career three-pointers, seventh all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 74 of 77 career games, needs seven to tie **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina, 1992-95) for sixth all-time at 275. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** became the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals, reaching the mark on Dec. 21. He stands at 203. Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** reached the milestone Jan. 6 at UNC Asheville and has 209 in his career.

THE TAJ McCULL

In his last six games, Winthrop forward **TAJ McCULLOUGH** is averaging 12.2 points -- 4.1 more than his season average of 8.1 points. In the span, McCullough is 30-of-48 (=.625) from the floor while averaging 5.7 rebounds. He has also tallied 11 assists and 13 steals during his current run.

LEADERS OF THE PACK

High Point has three players leading the Big South in statistical categories. **ARIZONA REID** enters the week tops in rebounds at 9.3 per game, while **MIKE JEFFERSON** is first in assists with 5.79 per contest. Redshirt-freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** is first in blocks and blocks per game, with 46 for a 2.42 per game clip. The Big South has never had three players from the same squad lead the Conference in the aforementioned categories in the same season.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 180 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 95-24 (=.798) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

LEFT-RIGHT COMBINATION

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (27.9) and sophomore **CHAVIS HOLMES** (20.5) rank first and tied for second, respectively, in the Big South in scoring. The last time one Big South member produced the top two scorers in a season was Radford in 1999-00, as **JASON WILLIAMS** was the League's leading scorer at 18.1, just ahead of teammate **RYAN CHARLES** (18.0). Meanwhile, through games of Jan. 21, Williams and Holmes are one of two sets of teammates nationally averaging 20.0 points per game, joining Hofstra's Loren Stokes and Antoine Agudio.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL's** tenure as head coach. Through 20 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 57.5 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 8-12 on the year, the Keydets have lost eight games by seven points-or-less -- including four by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty has dropped six games by the same seven-point margin, followed by Radford with five. The Highlanders have lost four of those games by three points-or-less.

LIFE BEGINS AT 40

The Big South has had five individual 40-point games in 2006-07, the most currently on record for a single-season and the most since it was accomplished four times during the 1992-93 campaign. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** has scored 40 points in a game three times this season, the most by an individual in a single-season. He just missed tying the Big South's single-game record of 46 by one point on Nov. 15. Below are this year's 40-point outputs, in chronological order:

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** is the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. He has appeared in 11 games this season, including 10 consecutive outings since Dec. 16. He is averaging 9.9 minutes, 4.2 points, 3.2 rebounds, 2.2 blocks and is shooting .724 percent from the floor (21-of-29). George has blocked at least five shots in a game three times, including a career-high seven vs. Liberty on Jan. 6.

VMI SETS MORE RECORDS IN WIN OVER CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

VMI's record-setting season reached new heights on Jan. 13, as the Keydets set four Conference Game marks in their 116-83 win over Charleston Southern. The 116 points are the most scored in a League game, breaking the old record of 115 (done twice, including by High Point at VMI, Jan. 10). VMI's 21 three-pointers made and 56 three-point attempts also set new standards in a Big South contest, while its 23 steals were also the most in a regular-season Conference match-up.

BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP GAME MOVED TO ESPN

The 2007 Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Men's Basketball Championship game, originally to be broadcast on ESPN2, will now air live on ESPN. The game will air on its original date and time -- Saturday, March 3 at 2:00pm. The Semifinals will again be carried by ESPNU on Thursday, March 1, at 6:00 and 8:30pm, and will be held at the site of the regular-season champion.

BIG SOUTH BACK IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 16-17. Coastal Carolina (home), Liberty (road) and Winthrop (road) will be the League's participants in the rebranded "ESPNU BracketBusters." The Big South went 2-1 last season in its first-ever appearance in the event, including Winthrop's 98-97 double overtime win over Northern Illinois. It will be Coastal's and Liberty's first appearance in the ESPNU BracketBusters, which is in its fifth season. The wins in last year's series helped push the Big South Conference four spots in the national RPI to a League-best 19th.

The Bucs showed signs of life amidst their current slump. Against Radford, the Bucs held the lead with under 5:00 left in the game. Against High Point, the Bucs held a lead with as little as :09 seconds remaining, but could not hang on ... **DONNELL COVINGTON** averaged 19.5 points per game last week, moving him into the team lead for the season with 14.6 points per contest ... In League play, he already has 21 assists, totaling 95 for the season ... **DWAYNE JACKSON** was a perfect 11-of-11 from the free throw line against High Point, and CSU hit a season-high 28 free throws ... The Bucs host Liberty Monday and visit Asheville Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina's 4-1 Conference start is its best since opening 5-0 in 1990-91 ... Of the prior three 5-0 starts, all three resulted in winning Conference records, including the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 1990-91 after winning both the Big South regular season (13-1 record) and tournament titles ... Junior guard **JACK LEASURE** has hit 118-of-140 free throw attempts in his career, a clip of 84.3 percent that is currently the best career free throw percentage in Coastal history ... The Chanticleers host High Point Monday and visit Winthrop Saturday.

HIGH POINT

High Point extended its program record Division I win streak with a pair of Big South Conference wins over Liberty and Charleston Southern ... HPU has won seven straight games on its way to the program's best season start overall (14-5) and in Conference play (5-0) ... With 11 home wins, the Panthers have also established a record for home wins during their D-I era ...
