Leasure broke through last week with his best back-to-back games of the season, averaging 22.0 points in leading the Chanticleers to two wins. He scored a season-high 24 points, going 7-of-11 from the field, 6-of-8 from three-point range and 4-of-4 from the charity stripe, along with three assists and two steals in Coastal's win over McNeese State. He followed that with 20 points, hitting 6-of-11 treys, as well as three assists and two steals in Saturday's win over Charleston Southern. Leasure tallied 11 of his 20 points -- including three triples -- in the closing seven-and-a-half minutes to seal the win. On the week, Leasure was 14-of-26 from the field (=53.8) and 12-of-19 from long range (=63.2).

BIG SOUTH "HOMECOMING KINGS"

The Big South regular-season Conference slate began this past Saturday, and all four home teams claimed victory -- Coastal Carolina, UNC Asheville, High Point and Winthrop. Coastal Carolina has now won its last 11 regular-season League match-ups, while Winthrop's streak is at three games. The home team wins is significant due to the Big South's Conference Tournament format: home sites of the top four seeds.

WINTHROP RANKED NO. 2 SPOT IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Winthrop Eagles' top 10 standing in the *CollegiateInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll reached new heights last week, as the Eagles were tied for the No. 2 spot with Southern Illinois in the recent Jan. 1 poll. Winthrop and the Salukis each received 689 points, with SIU garnering a first-place vote. Butler is ranked No. 1. Also, for the fourth time this season, Winthrop received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll, coming in the 40th spot. The Eagles received votes in the first three polls of the year.

ROLE REVERSAL

In the early anticipated Big South Conference game between the nation's leading offense (VMI) and the Conference's stingiest defense (Winthrop), the Winthrop Eagles prevailed over the Keydets Saturday night, 108-76. Winthrop's 108 eight points were the second-most in a Big South game in League history, while its 40 field goals was tied for second-highest. VMI's 37 three-point attempts also tied for second-most in a Big South contest. Winthrop held VMI to 26 points below its season average (102.1), while the Keydets scored 18 points more than what the Eagles were accustomed to allowing (58.8).

VMI CONTINUES TO AVERAGE 100 POINTS A GAME

Despite its 108-76 setback at Winthrop this past Saturday, VMI is still averaging 100.4 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in seven games and posted three additional games in the 90s. VMI is looking to become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0), as well as the first Big South member to lead the nation in scoring. The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 6-10 on the year, the Keydets have lost seven games by seven points-or-less -- including three by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty and Radford have dropped four games by the same margin, with the Highs losing three by three points-or-less.

WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 26.5 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6. Williams is hitting .512 percent from the floor (151-295), has two 40-point games among his six 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.44 field goals per contest. He is averaging 27.9 points in his last eight outings, as well as 36.5 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 822 points this season, which would break the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

BLAIR NOW THIRD ON LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME SCORING CHART

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR**, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, reached the fourth spot in nine games and surpassed former Radford standout **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** for third-place this past Saturday at UNC Asheville. The fourth player in Big South history to score 1,800 career points, Blair at 1,869 -- 131 points away from 2,000. Blair is 283 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer, and would need to average 17.69 points in his final 16 games to break the record. THE 700 CLUB

Radford senior **CHRIS OLIVER** became the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone at East Tennessee State on Dec. 21. He is currently eighth all-time with 729 boards, and needs 17 to pass Radford's **KEVIN ROBINSON** (745) for seventh place. The Big South career rebounding record is 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**, and Oliver is on pace to finish at 845 rebounds, which would rank third in League history. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently 26th all-time in the League with 1,394 career points -- 45 points shy of 25th.

DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (15 games) and Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** (16 games) are the lone Big South basketball players to score in double figures in every game this season. Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 36 consecutive games and 48 of his last 49 games, while Oliver has reached double figures in scoring in his last 20 outings.

RUNNIN ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

VMI has already established the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point attempts, as its 723 attempts from downtown have broken the previous League mark of 702, set by Winthrop in 1999-00. The Keydets are also just **19** three-pointers away from breaking the Eagles' League record of 251, also in 1999-00. Below is a closer look at the League and NCAA records VMI will likely surpass:

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** has made 254 career three-pointers, tied for seventh all-time in Big South history with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER**. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 69 of 72 career games, needs 21 to tie **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina, 1992-95) for sixth all-time. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** became the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals, reaching the mark on Dec. 21. He stands at 203. Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** reached the milestone Saturday at UNC Asheville and has 201 in his career.

GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** now ranks third all-time in League history with 675 field goals made, and needs 41 to pass Radford's **DOUG DAY** (715) for second-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,647 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 176 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 91-24 (=.791) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN**, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** and Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** each surpassed 1,000 career points during the early part of the season. Williams has vaulted into 29th place on the Big South's career scoring chart at 1,357 points, while Martin is 43rd at 1,220. Leasure is in the 56th spot with 1,154 career points. LOOKING AHEAD

Four additional players are approaching 1,000 career points as well and will likely reach the milestone by season's end, if not sooner. High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** is 68 points shy with 932 in his career, while VMI senior **MATT MURRER** is at 930 points. Coastal Carolina senior **MOSES SONKO** has scored 903 points in his career. Winthrop senior **CRAIG BRADSHAW** stands at 860.

REID ALL ABOUT IT

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** enters this week needing three rebounds to become the 38th player in Big South history with 500 career boards. He would be the second player during High Point's tenure in the Big South to reach the milestone. Former Panthers forward **DANNY GATHINGS** notched 597 caroms from 2002-05, 26th all-time in League annals. Meanwhile, Reid has reached double figures in scoring in 12 of 15 games this season, and is averaging 21.8 points when doing so.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 14 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 59.9 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** is the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. He has appeared in seven games this season, including six consecutive outings since Dec. 16. He is averaging 10.6 minutes, 4.9 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.9 blocks and is shooting 76.2 percent from the floor (16-of-21). George has blocked at least five shots in a game three times, including a career-high seven vs. Liberty this past Saturday. He also tallied a career-high eight points against the Flames.

STEALING THE SHOW

VMI sophomore **TRAVIS HOLMES** leads the Big South with 3.00 steals per game, currently the fourth-highest steal average in League history. The last Big South player to average more than 3.00 steals per game was Liberty's **CARL WILLIAMS** in 1999-00 (3.82). Holmes' twin brother, **CHAVIS**, is second in the League with 2.67 steals per game. Chavis is also first in the Conference with 3.53 three-point field goals made per game and second in three-point percentage at 43.4 (53-of-122).

LIFE BEGINS AT 40

Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** tied a Big South Conference single-game record with 12 three-pointers en route to a career-high 40 points in the Eagles' season-opening win over North Greenville. Five days later, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** scored 45 points against Virginia Intermont, falling one point shy of the League's single-game scoring record. Williams recorded his second 40-point game of the year with 41 points vs. Cornell on Dec. 1.

LEADERS OF THE PACK

High Point has three players leading the Big South in statistical categories. **ARIZONA REID** enters the week tops in rebounds at 8.7 per game, while **MIKE JEFFERSON** is first in assists with 5.33 per contest. Redshirt-freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** is first in blocks and blocks per game, with 40 for a 2.67 per game clip. The Big South has never had three players from the same squad lead the Conference in the aforementioned categories in the same season.
