Moses Sonko • Senior F • Coastal Carolina Greenwich, R.I.

Sonko averaged 22.0 points on 67.9 percent (19-of-28) shooting from the floor in just 20.0 minutes per game in two contests last week. In an overtime loss at South Carolina State, Sonko was 9-of-16 (56.2 percent) from the floor and 4of-5 from the line for a team-high 22 points. He also added three offensive rebounds. This past Saturday vs. Brevard, Sonko again dropped in 22 points on 10-of-12 from the floor (83.3 percent), and was 2-of-2 from long range. Sonko, who entered the week averaging 13.8 points, also had 4.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game, and now leads Coastal in scoring for the first time in his career.

# **NEW BALANCE** Freshman of the Week

Joshua Mack Guard • Coastal Carolina Hopkinsville, Ky.

Mack averaged 13.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.0 steals in two games last week. At South Carolina State, he posted a careerhigh 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting (63.6 percent) and hit 5-of-8 from three-point range, including the one that sent the game into overtime. Mack also added three rebounds and five assists at SCSU. He then had seven points, five rebounds, two assists and two steals in limited action against Brevard.

#### VMI LEADS NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.3 AVERAGE

Through 13 games, the VMI Keydets have scored 100 points in a contest six times, and lead the Big South and the nation with a smoldering 102.1 points per game average. VMI scored 104, 156 and 144 points in three consecutive games early in the season, and could become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0). The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

#### POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 5-8 on the year, the Keydets have lost seven games by seven points-or-less, including three by a mere two points. VMI's last six losses have been by a combined 23 points -- a 3.8 average. VMI has won its five ballgames this season by an average of 33.0 points.

#### WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 26.5 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6 Williams is hitting .517 percent from the floor (124-240), has two 40-point games among his six 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.5 field goals per contest. He is averaging 28.6 points in his last five outings, as well as 36.5 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 821 points this season, which would break the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

#### BLAIR NOW FIFTH ON LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME SCORING CHART

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, has already jumped into fifth place through eight games. He stands at 1,737 career points, and needs two points to move into the fourth spot. Blair is 415 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer, and would need to average 18.04 points in his final 23 games to break the record. #### THE 700 CLUB

Radford senior **CHRIS OLIVER** is seven rebounds away from becoming the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. He is currently 15th all-time with 693 boards, and needs 11 to join Charleston Southern's **T.L. LATSON** in 14th place with 704. The Big South career rebounding record is 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**, and Oliver is on pace to finish at 860 rebounds, which would rank second in League history. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently 31st all-time in the League with 1,312 career points -- two points shy of 30th.

### BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB INCREASES MEMBERSHIP

The Big South's 1,000-point club has already added three members in the young season in Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN**, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** and Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE**. Williams has vaulted into 32nd place at 1,277 points, while Martin is 55th at 1,158. Leasure is in the 68th spot with 1,073 career points. ## LOOKING AHEAD

Four additional players are approaching 1,000 career points as well and will likely reach the milestone by season's end, if not sooner. VMI senior MATT MURRER is at 900 points, while High Point junior ARIZONA REID is 142 points shy with 858 in his career. Coastal Carolina senior MOSES SONKO has scored 67 points in his last three games to move up to 833 points in his career. Winthrop senior CRAIG BRADSHAW recently surpassed 800 points and stands at 806.

#### THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 235 career three-pointers, ninth all-time in Big South history with Charleston Southern's BRETT LARRICK. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 64 of 67 career games, needs seven more to move into the eighth spot. Meanwhile, Winthrop's TORRELL MARTIN is three treys shy of becoming the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals. Liberty's LARRY BLAIR is nine away from the milestone.

#### RUNNIN ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

In addition to its high scoring average, VMI is pacing well ahead of several Big South single-season records during the first month of the 2006-07 season. The Keydets have already made 191 three-point field goals, just 60 away from tying the season record of 251 (Winthrop, 1999-00). The record for three-point attempts is 702 (Winthrop, 1999-00) -- VMI is already at 598. VMI is averaging 14.69 three-point fields per game, pacing well ahead of both the Big South record (9.00 - Birmingham-Southern, 2003-04) and the NCAA season record of 11.86 (Troy, 2005-06). The NCAA record for most three-point field goals in a season is 407, set by Duke in 39 games in 2000-01.

#### **GOAL ORIENTED**

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR now ranks sixth all-time in League history with 623 field goals made, and needs six to pass Winthrop's LaSHAWN COULTER (628) for fifth-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer TONY DUNKIN (1989-93).

#### SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 172 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 90-24 (=.789) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament.

#### **DEFENSIVE MINDED**

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 10 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 57.8 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

#### LIFE BEGINS AT 40

Winthrop's MICHAEL JENKINS tied a Big South Conference single-game record with 12 three-pointers en route to a career-high 40 points in the Eagles' season-opening win over North Greenville. Five days later, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS set a Big South single-game record with 18 field goals made vs. Virginia Intermont and finished with 45 points, falling one point shy of the League's single-game scoring record. Williams recorded his second 40-point game of the year with 41 points vs. Cornell on Dec. 1.

## **BIG MAN ON CAMPUS**

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** made his Bulldog debut Nov. 22 at Virginia, officially becoming the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. In 15 minutes vs. the Cavaliers, he scored four points on 2-of-3 FG and blocked five shots. He also saw action this past Saturday at No. 3 North Carolina, scoring four points with a block in seven minutes on the floor. George is the tallest player in college basketball.

### MOVIN' ON UP

High Point junior guard **MIKE JEFFERSON** leads the Big South with a 5.82 assist average, the highest average in the League since VMI's **RICHARD LITTLE** averaged 5.89 in 2003-04. Jefferson, who has handed out at least six helpers in a game five times this season, could become the first Big South player to average 6.0 assists since Campbell's **DAN POGUE** averaged 7.4 in 1993-94. No High Point player has led the Conference in assists in a campaign.

## MR. SMITH(SON) GOES TO ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville junior BRYAN SMITHSON has quietly enjoyed his debut season with the Bulldogs, as the transfer from Middle Tennessee State has scored in double figures all 10 games and is averaging 16.6 points -- good for sixth in the Big South. He has been Asheville's leading scorer in seven of 10 games (averaging 18.4 points when doing so), is shooting 83.3 percent from the free throw line (35-of-42) and is averaging 2.00 steals per game as well. Smithson is one of just three players in the Big South to score in double figures every game this season (LARRY BLAIR, CHRIS OLIVER).

#### STEALING THE SHOW

VMI sophomore **TRAVIS HOLMES** leads the Big South with 3.23 steals per game, currently the fourth-highest steal average in League history. The last Big South player to average more than 3.00 steals per game was Liberty's **CARL WILLIAMS** in 1999-00 (3.82). Holmes' twin brother, **CHAVIS**, is second in the League with 2.75 steals per game. Chavis is also second in the Conference with 3.42 three-point field goals made per game.

#### WINTHROP REMAINS IN TOP 10 IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Big South continues its presence in the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, with Winthrop currently ranked No. 8 in the recent Dec. 11 poll. Liberty received votes for the second-straight week and is in the 43rd position, up from the previous week's No. 51 position. Coastal Carolina received votes in the preseason poll. Meanwhile, Winthrop received votes in the first three ESPN/*USA Today* Coaches polls of the season as well.

#### **COACHES CORNER**

Liberty head coach **RANDY DUNTON** recorded his 100th career college win Nov. 27 when the Flames defeated Southern Virginia, 109-64.
