Arizona Reid • Junior

Reid averaged 30.5 points and 14.0 rebounds in two Big South wins last week in helping the Panthers to a 3-0 start in Conference play. At VMI, Reid tied his career-high with 32 points in addition to 14 rebounds and 15-of-25 shooting (=60.0) as the Panthers knocked off the Keydets, 115-104. Saturday vs. UNC Asheville, Reid stopped the Bulldogs' 29-8 opening rally with a three-pointer, which sparked a 42-5 High Point run that led to HPU's eventual 26-point win. He finished the game with 29 points and 15 rebounds, and was 3-of-4 from three-point range -- matching his season-to-date total. Reid recorded his 500th career rebound at VMI, narrowly reached 1,000 career points vs. Asheville (993), was 27-of-44 from the field (=61.4), 4-of-4 from the line and averaged 2.0 assists per game.

Mack averaged 15.0 points and 53.6 percent from the field (15-of-28) in three games last week, helping the Chanticleers to two wins. He scored in double figures in each game, including 16 points in Coastal's first road win of the season at UNC Asheville, Jan. 8. Mack tied his career-high with 19 points vs. Savannah State, Jan. 10, and added 10 points, five assists and three steals in a four-point loss at Radford. On the week, Mack was 10-of-19 from three-point range (=52.6), 5-of-6 from the line (=83.3) and averaged 4.3 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.7 steals.

WINTHROP, HIGH POINT REMAINING UNBEATENS IN CONFERENCE PLAY

Winthrop and High Point remain undefeated in Big South play, as both squads are off to 3-0 starts. Winthrop is 3-0 in the League for the second consecutive year and fourth time overall under head coach **GREGG MARSHALL**. Last season, the Eagles jumped out to a 6-0 Conference start. High Point is 3-0 for the third time since 2003-04 -- all under head coach **BART LUNDY**. The Panthers have never started 4-0 in League play.

VMI SETS MORE RECORDS IN WIN OVER CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

VMI's record-setting season continued this past Saturday, as the Keydets set four Conference Game marks in their 116-83 win over Charleston Southern. The 116 points are the most scored in a League game, breaking the old record of 115 (done twice, including by High Point just last week at VMI). VMI's 21 three-pointers made and 56 three-point attempts also set new standards in a Big South contest, while its 23 steals were also the most in a regular-season Conference match-up.

ACTION JACKSON

Charleston Southern guard **DWAYNE JACKSON** entered the Big South Conference record books over the weekend with his effort at VMI. The senior guard scored 43 of the Buccaneers' 83 points against the Keydets, the third-highest individual total in a regular-season Big South Conference game. Jackson did set Conference game records for field goals and field goal attempts, as he was 19-of-31 from the floor. The previous record was 17 field goals (Winthrop's **MELVIN BRANHAM** in 1994) and 29 attempts (UNC Asheville's **WILLIE SIMPSON** in 1986 and VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** last week vs. High Point).

ANOTHER HIGH POINT AFFAIR

VMI was also involved in another record outing in its game vs. High Point last Wednesday. The Panthers defeated the Keydets, 115-104, in the first Big South game in which both teams scored 100 points, which established the new standard for combined points (219), breaking the old record of 213, set by Coastal Carolina (115) and UMBC (98) on Jan. 14, 1993. High Point also tied the Conference game record for most field goals (46), while VMI broke the record for most three-point attempts (45), which the Keydets broke one game later vs. Charleston Southern.

LIFE BEGINS AT 40

The Big South has had five individual 40-point games in 2006-07, the most currently on record for a single-season and the most since it was accomplished four times during the 1992-93 campaign. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** has scored 40 points in a game three times this season, the most by an individual in a single-season. He just missed tying the Big South's single-game record of 46 by one point on Nov. 15. Below are this year's 40-point outputs, in chronological order:

WILLIAMS PACING THE LEAGUE'S SCORING CHART

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 27.8 scoring average, which is pacing ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6, set by Campbell's **CLARENCE GRIER** in 1986-87. Williams is hitting .514 percent from the floor (178-346), has three 40-point games among his eight 30-point efforts and is averaging 9.89 field goals per contest. He is averaging 30.0 points in his last 10 outings, as well as 37.0 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 862 points this season, which would shatter the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

BLAIR CHIPPING AWAY AT LEAGUE'S CAREER SCORING RECORD

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR**, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, reached the fourth spot in nine games and moved into the third spot Jan. 6. The third player in Big South history to score 1,900 career points (now at 1,903), Blair is 97 points away from 2,000 and is 249 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. He needs to average 17.79 points in his final 14 scheduled games to break the record. Below are the top three scorers in Big South history:

THE 700 CLUB

Radford senior **CHRIS OLIVER** became the 15th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone at East Tennessee State on Dec. 21. He is currently seventh all-time with 747 boards, and needs nine to pass Radford's **ASWAN WAINWRIGHT** (755) for sixth place. Oliver is on pace to finish at 848 rebounds, which would rank third in League history. Meanwhile, Oliver is currently tied for 25th all-time in the League with 1,434 career points -- five points shy of 24th.

VMI INCREASES ITS SCORING AVERAGE TO 101.5 POINTS

VMI is averaging 101.5 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in nine games and posted three additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in six of seven contests -- just missing a seventh by one point -- and is averaging 122.4 points per game at Cameron Hall. VMI is looking to become the first squad in the nation to average 100 points a contest since Southern University in 1994 (101.0), as well as the first Big South member to lead the nation in scoring. The Keydets averaged 71.3 points last season. The Big South record for scoring offense is (was) 83.6 points (Winthrop, 1992-93).

DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (17 games) and Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** (18 games) are the lone Big South basketball players to score in double figures in every game this season. Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 38 consecutive games and 50 of his last 51 games, while Oliver has reached double figures in scoring in his last 22 outings.

RUNNIN ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

VMI has already broken the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point field goals and three-point attempts, standing at 266 threes and 824 attempts through 18 games. The old records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. Meanwhile, the chart below details the League and NCAA records VMI will likely surpass this season:

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** has made 264 career three-pointers, seventh all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 72 of 75 career games, needs 11 to tie **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina, 1992-95) for sixth all-time. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** became the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals, reaching the mark on Dec. 21. He stands at 203. Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** reached the milestone Jan. 6 at UNC Asheville and has 205 in his career.

GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** ranks third all-time in League history with 688 field goals made, and needs 28 to pass Radford's **DOUG DAY** (715) for second-place. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,684 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 178 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 93-24 (.795) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (.889) in the Big South Tournament.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN**, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** and Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** each surpassed 1,000 career points during the early part of the season. Williams has vaulted into a tie for 25th place on the Big South's career scoring chart at 1,434 points, while Martin is 42nd at 1,220. Leasure is in the 47th spot with 1,190 career points. REID ALL ABOUT IT

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** is seven (7) points away from becoming the 77th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club. Last week, he became the 38th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone at VMI. He now has 525 career boards, currently 36th all-time. He is the second player during High Point's tenure in the Big South to reach 500 rebounds. Meanwhile, Reid has reached double figures in scoring in 14 of 17 games this season, and is averaging 23.0 points when doing so.

POST MOVES

In addition to High Point forward **ARIZONA REID**, three additional players are approaching 1,000 career points as well and will likely reach the milestone by season's end, if not sooner. Coastal Carolina senior forward **MOSES SONKO** has scored 952 points in his career, while VMI senior forward **MATT MURRER** is at 936 points. Winthrop senior center/forward **CRAIG BRADSHAW** stands at 884.

LEFT-RIGHT COMBINATION

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (27.8) and sophomore **CHAVIS HOLMES** (20.6) rank first and second, respectively, in the Big South in scoring. The last time one Big South member produced the top two scorers in a season was Radford in 1999-00, as **JASON WILLIAMS** was the League's leading scorer at 18.1, just ahead of teammate **RYAN CHARLES** (18.0). Meanwhile, as of Jan. 14, Williams and Holmes are the only teammates in the nation averaging 20.0 points per game.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 17 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 58.3 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip.

STEALING THE SHOW

VMI sophomore **TRAVIS HOLMES** leads the Big South with 3.33 steals per game, currently the fourth-highest steal average in League history. He recorded a League season-high eight steals Saturday vs. Charleston Southern, and has notched four steals in a game seven times this year. The last Big South player to average more than 3.00 steals per game was Liberty's **CARL WILLIAMS** in 1999-00 (3.82). Holmes' twin brother, **CHAVIS**, is second in the League with 2.59 steals per game. Chavis is also first in the Conference with 3.59 three-point field goals made per game and second in three-point percentage at 41.8 (61-of-146).

LEADERS OF THE PACK

High Point has three players leading the Big South in statistical categories. **ARIZONA REID** enters the week tops in rebounds at 9.3 per game, while **MIKE JEFFERSON** is first in assists with 5.35 per contest. Redshirt-freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** is first in blocks and blocks per game, with 41 for a 2.41 per game clip. The Big South has never had three players from the same squad lead the Conference in the aforementioned categories in the same season.

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 7-11 on the year, the Keydets have lost seven games by seven points-or-less -- including three by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty and Radford have dropped four games by the same margin, with the Highs losing three by three points-or-less.

Winthrop (13) and High Point (12) have already reached 10 wins this season. Winthrop has reached the mark all nine years under head coach **GREGG MARSHALL**, while the Panthers have notched 10 wins for the fourth-straight season -- all under head coach **BART LUNDY**. Radford head coach **BYRON SAMUELS** is four wins away from his fifth consecutive year with double-digit wins.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville's 7-6 center **KENNY GEORGE** is the tallest player in Big South and UNC Asheville history. He has appeared in nine games this season, including eight consecutive outings since Dec. 16. He is averaging 9.8 minutes, 4.2 points, 3.1 rebounds, 2.3 blocks and is shooting 75.0 percent from the floor (18-of-24). George has blocked at least five shots in a game three times, including a career-high seven vs. Liberty on Jan. 6. He also tallied a career-high eight points against the Flames.

The game will air on its original date and time -- Saturday, March 3 at 2:00pm. The Semifinals will again be carried by ESPNU on Thursday, March 1, at 6:00 and 8:30pm, and will be held at the site of the regular-season champion.

BIG SOUTH BACK IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 16-17. Coastal Carolina (home), Liberty (road) and Winthrop (road) will be the League's participants in the rebranded "ESPNU BracketBusters." The Big South went 2-1 last season in its first-ever appearance in the event, including Winthrop's 98-97 double overtime win over Northern Illinois.
