Williams averaged 34.0 points and 8.3 rebounds in three games last week, helping the Keydets to a 2-1 record, including two consecutive Big South wins. He opened the week with 34 points and nine rebounds at UNC Asheville, where he was 14-of-20 from the field, including 4-of-6 three-pointers. Against Radford, Williams tallied 28 points in addition to six rebounds, six assists and five steals. Saturday at Liberty, he dropped in 40 points and grabbed 10 rebounds. On the week, Williams was 40-of-66 from the field (=.606) and averaged 5.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

Craig Bradshaw • Senior

Bradshaw helped lead Winthrop to two important Big South wins over High Point and Coastal Carolina. In the two games, he performed well above his season averages entering the week in averaging 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds, while connecting on 12-of-23 field goals (=.522), including 3-of-6 from long range. At High Point, he scored 14 points and connected on three crucial three-pointers. Against CCU, he scored 18 points and grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds, in addition to the go-ahead free throw.

WINTHROP CONCLUDES FIRST HALF OF BIG SOUTH SEASON 7-0

The Winthrop Eagles concluded the first half of the Conference season with a perfect 7-0 record, highlighted by two key wins last week against its closest competition in High Point and Coastal Carolina. Winthrop won 64-63 at High Point last Thursday night, and defeated Coastal Carolina, 65-63 Saturday at home in front of the first sellout crowd (6,100) in the Winthrop Coliseum's 25-year history. Winthrop is the first team to open 7-0 in Conference play since the 1998-99 Eagles opened 8-0 in Big South action.

ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS MATCH-UPS TO BE ANNOUNCED THIS WEEK

The Big South is again participating in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 16-17. Coastal Carolina (home), Liberty (road) and Winthrop (road) will be the League's participants in the rebranded "ESPN BracketBusters" event. The match-ups will be announced over a two-day span this week. On Monday, Jan. 29, ESPNU will host a special Selection Show at 6:00pm ET to announce the 13 televised match-ups, which will be the official "ESPN BracketBusters" contests. On Tuesday, Jan. 30, the remaining 38 match-ups will be announced. The Big South went 2-1 last season in its first-ever appearance in the event, including Winthrop's 98-97 double overtime win over Northern Illinois. It will be Coastal's and Liberty's first appearance in the ESPN BracketBusters, which is in its fifth season.

BLAIR CLOSING IN ON 2,000 CAREER POINTS, LEAGUE'S SCORING RECORD

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR**, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, reached the fourth spot in nine games and moved into the third spot Jan. 6. Blair is two points away from becoming the third player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points, as well as the fourth in NCAA Division I this season to hit the milestone. He is 154 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. He needs to average 15.40 points in his final 10 scheduled games to break the record. MARSHALL PLAN

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is three Big South wins away from becoming the second head coach in League history with 100 regular-season Conference wins, and is on pace to reach it in the fastest amount of time. He is currently 97-24 (.802) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (.889) in the Big South Tournament. Marshall is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 182 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109.

MORE LEAGUE SCORING RECORDS FALL COURTESY OF VMI-LIBERTY

Two weeks after VMI set the single-game Conference record for most points scored in a League contest (116), the Keydets and Liberty Flames both surpassed the total this past Saturday in the Vines Center, as Liberty held on for a 122-117 win over the Runnin' Roos. The two combined for a League-game record 239 points, and the Flames broke the record for team assists in a Big South game with 33 helpers. In fact, 12 Vines Center records were set during the match-up. VMI outscored Liberty in the second half, 75-57, after the Flames jumped to a 65-42 halftime lead.

SONKO, MURRER LATEST TO JOIN BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina senior **MOSES SONKO** and VMI senior **MATT MURRER** joined the Big South's 1,000-point club in their respective road games Saturday, Jan. 27. Sonko scored 12 points at Winthrop Saturday afternoon to hit the exacto at 1,000, while Murrer's 16 points at Liberty later that night pushed his career total to 1,009. The club could add an additional member in Winthrop's **CRAIG BRADSHAW**, as he stands at 935. GOING CLUBBIN'

Of the 31 players in Big South history in the 1,000 career point/500 career rebound club, five are active players: **CHRIS OLIVER** (1,511-783), **ARIZONA REID** (1,106-577), **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1,592-510), **MOSES SONKO** (1,000-506) and **MATT MURRER** (1,009-503). Oliver and Williams are one of seven players with 1,500 points and 500 rebounds, while Oliver is 17 rebounds away from becoming just the second player in League history with 1,500 points and 800 rebounds.

REID ALL ABOUT IT

High Point junior **ARIZONA REID** is quickly climbing the Big South's career rebounding chart, as he is now 30th all-time with 577 rebounds, after reaching the 500-rebound milestone Jan. 10 at VMI. He needs 11 to move into the 29th spot. Meanwhile, in his last nine games, Reid is averaging 25.0 points, 10.7 rebounds and .545 percent from the field (91-of-167). He has scored in double figures in 19 of 22 games this season, and is averaging 22.9 points when doing so.

WILLIAMS ON PACE FOR LEAGUE'S SEASON SCORING RECORDS

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** leads the Big South with a 28.7 scoring average, which is pacing well ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6, set by Campbell's **CLARENCE GRIER** in 1986-87. Williams has scored 659 points this year -- sixth-highest in a single-season -- is hitting .530 percent from the floor (239-of-451), has four 40-point games among his 11 30-point efforts and is averaging 10.39 field goals per contest. He scored 20 points in 10 consecutive games from Dec. 1 to Jan. 13, averaging 30.0 in that span. He also averages 37.0 points when he reaches the 30-point threshold. Williams is on pace to score 889 points this season, which would shatter the League's single-season point total of 759, set by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** in 1992-93.

HOME SWEET HOME

Winthrop has won 16-straight home games, currently tied for 12th-longest in the NCAA. Winthrop has won 39 of its last 40 at the Winthrop Coliseum and is 49-5 (=.907) at home since the start of the 2003-04 season. Winthrop snapped High Point's 15-game home win streak last Thursday, but the Panthers are still 20-3 in its last 23 home appearances at Millis Center, and is 41-10 (=.820) at home since the beginning of the '03-04 campaign. Meanwhile, since **BUZZ PETERSON** took over the Coastal Carolina program last year, the Chanticleers are 23-2 at Kimbel Arena. High Point ended Coastal's 15-game win streak at the on-campus facility with its 59-56 win last Monday in Conway.

SONKO SINKS IT

Coastal Carolina senior forward **MOSES SONKO** continues to lead the Big South in field goal shooting at .598 percent (125-of-209). He is looking to become just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as **DuWAYNE CHEATAM** was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent).

STOP, THIEVES!!

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded 36 steals in his last six games, an average of 6.00. In that span, he set a Big South single-game record with 11 steals vs. Bridgewater College, Jan. 18, and now leads the nation in steals per game at 3.83. His season average is currently second highest in Big South history, trailing only **TONY FAIRLEY**'s record clip of 4.07 in 1986-87. Meanwhile, VMI has broken the Conference's single-season steals record, as the Keydets sit at 377 on the year, breaking the old mark of 376, set by Liberty in 1999-00. The Keydets are averaging 16.39 steals per game and are on pace to finish with 508 steals, which would break the NCAA record of 486, set by Oklahoma in 1987-88. VMI's per game clip is pacing ahead of the NCAA mark of 14.9, held by Long Island in 1997-98.

OLIVER TWIST

Radford senior **CHRIS OLIVER** is approaching 800 career rebounds, a feat accomplished by just four other players in Big South history. He is currently sixth all-time with 783 boards, and needs three to pass Charleston Southern's **HEDER AMBROISE** (785) for fifth place. Oliver is on pace to finish at 851 career rebounds, which would rank third in League history.

DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (21 games) and Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** (22 games) are the lone Big South basketball players to score in double figures in every game this season. Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 42 consecutive games and 54 of his last 55 games, while Oliver has reached double figures in scoring in his last 26 outings.

VMI SITTING ATOP NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.4 POINTS PER GAME

VMI is averaging 103.1 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in 13 games -- including the last four contests -- and have posted four additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in eight of 10 contests -- just missing all 10 games by a combined four points -- and is averaging 118.2 points per game at Cameron Hall. VMI's season average is currently ninth-highest in NCAA Division I history. The last team to average 100 points per game was Southern University in 1994 (101.0). No Big South team was ever led the nation in scoring, and the Keydets are well on their way to setting the Conference's season scoring offense record, which is (was) 83.6 points by Winthrop in 1992-93.

Winthrop was ranked No. 3 in the recent (Jan. 22) *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25, its ninth consecutive week in the top 10. High Point received votes for the third-straight week in the Mid-Major poll, and placed out in the No. 30 spot in last week's poll. Meanwhile, in this week's (Jan. 29) ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll, Winthrop received 10 votes, its most ever and good for the No. 35 spot.

RUNNIN' ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

VMI has already broken the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point field goals and three-point attempts, standing at 336 threes and 1049 attempts through 23 games. The old records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior **LARRY BLAIR** ranks second all-time in League history with 722 field goals made, surpassing Radford's **DOUG DAY**, who had 715 in his career. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,755 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

BUZZING ON THROUGH

Coastal Carolina head coach **BUZZ PETERSON** is three wins away from 200 in his career. The second-year CCU coach owns a 197-128 (=.606) career coaching record, including 31-19 at Coastal. He has had at least a .500 record in eight of his previous 10 seasons as a head coach, and needs four more wins this season for his ninth such occurrence.

THREE-POINT ARTISTS

Coastal Carolina junior **JACK LEASURE** has made 271 career three-pointers, seventh all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 75 of 79 career games, needs four to tie **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina, 1992-95) for sixth all-time at 275. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** became the 14th player in League history with 200 career three-point field goals, reaching the mark on Dec. 21. He stands at 203. Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** reached the milestone Jan. 6 at UNC Asheville and has 210 in his career.

LEADERS OF THE PACK

High Point continues to lead the Big South in three individual statistical categories. **ARIZONA REID** enters the week tops in rebounds at 9.5 per game, while **MIKE JEFFERSON** is first in assists with 5.27 per contest. Redshirt-freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** is first in blocks and blocks per game, with 46 for a 2.09 per game clip. The Big South has never had three players from the same squad lead the Conference in the aforementioned categories in the same season.

LEFT-RIGHT COMBINATION

VMI junior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** and sophomore **CHAVIS HOLMES** are looking to become the first set of teammates to rank first and second in the Big South in scoring. Williams is first at 28.7 points per game, while Holmes is third at 20.3, just behind High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (20.5). The last time one Big South member produced the top two scorers in a season was Radford in 1999-00, as **JASON WILLIAMS** was the League's leading scorer at 18.1, just ahead of teammate **RYAN CHARLES** (18.0).

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL's** tenure as head coach. Through 22 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 58.0 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip. In addition, Winthrop is holding opponents to a .403 field goal percentage, while Conference foes are managing just .373 percent.

POINT, COUNTERPOINT

While VMI is 10-13 on the year, the Keydets have lost nine games by seven points-or-less -- including four by a mere two points, the most in the Big South thus far. Liberty has dropped six games by the same seven-point margin, followed by Radford with five. The Highlanders have lost four of those games by three points-or-less.
