CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Dwayne Jackson • Senior Guard • Charleston Southern Fort Myers, Fla.

Jackson averaged 23.3 points in helping Charleston Southern post a perfect 3-0 week and ending its 13game overall losing streak and 7game skid in Conference action. In the Bucs' win over Coastal Carolina, Jackson played all 40 minutes, scored 18 points and went 7-of-11 from the floor, in addition to three assists and three steals. Against Covenant, he scored a game-high 29 points, was 12-of-17 from the field and tallied nine rebounds, three assists and three steals. Saturday vs. Radford, Jackson hit 7of-14 shots and was 9-of-12 from the free throw line to finish with 23 points, and added eight rebounds in CSU's win over the Highlanders. On the week, he was 26-of-42 from the floor (=.619), 15-of-20 from the line (=.750) and averaged 7.0rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Shelton Carter
Guard • Charleston Southern
Greensboro, N.C.

Carter averaged 17.3 points and 4.7 assists in Charleston's three wins last week. He opened the week with 20 points against Coastal Carolina, nailing 5-of-7 three-pointers, and had six assists and three steals against the Chanticleers. He had 10 points and four steals vs. Covenant, then tallied a careerhigh 22 points on 8-of-13 shooting vs. Radford, while adding five assists. Carter, who entered the week averaging 5.2 points in his previous 21 appearances, was 18of-33 from the floor (=.545), 10-of-18 from long range (=.556) and averaged 3.3 rebounds and 2.7 steals for the Bucs.

WINTHROP ONE WIN AWAY FROM BIG SOUTH'S FOURTH 10-0 LEAGUE START

Through nine League games, Winthrop remains unscathed with a 9-0 Big South record, and needs one win to become the first team since Coastal Carolina in 1990-91 to start 10-0 in Conference action. That season, the Chanticleers opened 11-0 in Big South games, which is the record for best Conference start. Winthrop would become just the fourth squad to open 10-0, joining Coastal Carolina (1989-90 and 1990-91) and Charleston Southern (1986-87).

BLAIR NOW IN SECOND-PLACE ON LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME SCORING CHART

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR enjoyed two personal milestones last week, as he became the third player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points on Jan. 30 vs. UNC Asheville, and moved into second-place all-time on Feb. 3 vs. High Point with 2,033 points. Blair, who entered the season 12th all-time on the League's career scoring chart, is the the fourth player in NCAA Division I this season to surpass 2,000 points. He is 119 points shy of becoming the Big South's all-time leading scorer. He needs to average 14.88 points in his final eight scheduled games to break the record. MARSHALL PLAN

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is one (1) Big South win away from becoming the second head coach in League history with 100 regular-season Conference wins, and is on pace to reach it in the fastest amount of time. He is currently 99-24 (=.805) all-time in regular-season League match-ups and 16-2 (=.889) in the Big South Tournament. Marshall is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 184 victories, which ranks first in Winthrop history. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109.

BIG SOUTH, WINTHROP NETS TV MATCH-UP IN 2007 O'REILLY ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS

Winthrop has been selected to play in one of 14 televised broadcasts of the 2007 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters games, and will face Missouri State of the Missouri Valley Conference on Friday, Feb. 16 in Springfield, Mo. on ESPN2 at 7:00pm. Winthrop gives the Big South Conference its first participant in a televised BracketBusters contest. It will be the first-ever meeting between Winthrop and Missouri State, as well as Winthrop's first match-up against an MVC member. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina and Liberty will each play members of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) as part of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters series. The Chanticleers will host Canisius, while Liberty will travel to Niagara. Last season, the Big South went 2-1 in the BracketBusters, its first involvement in the event.

20-10

At 19-4 and 9-0 in League play, Winthrop will establish some League firsts with its next win. The Eagles are looking to become the first team in Big South history with three consecutive 20-win seasons. Winthrop (1998-00, 2004-present), Charleston Southern (1985-87) and Radford (1990-92) each won 20 games two-straight years. Meanwhile, Winthrop is one Big South victory from its eighth consecutive 10-win Conference season, which would extend its League record.

BIG SOUTH SEASON RECORDS FALL AT HANDS OF VMI KEYDETS

With less than one month remaining in the 2006-07 season, VMI has already set the following Big South single-season records: points scored (2,566); field goal attempts (2,093); three-point field goals (360), three-point attempts (1,110) and steals (401). The Keydets are on pace to set several per game records, as well as NCAA Division I records for three-point field goals and steals.

BIG SOUTH 1.000-POINT CLUB UPDATE

Coastal Carolina senior MOSES SONKO and VMI senior MATT MURRER were the latest members of the the Big South's 1,000-point club, both reaching the milestone on Saturday, Jan. 27. The club could add an additional member in Winthrop's CRAIG BRADSHAW, as he stands at 971. Below is a look at the active 1,000-point scorers and where they rank in League history:

WILLIAMS CLOSING IN ON SINGLE-SEASON SCORING RECORDS

VMI junior REGGIE WILLIAMS is just the third player in Big South history to score 700 points in a singleseason. His 714 points currently rank third in the season record books, 25 points away from second-place (739 - CLARENCE GRIER, 1986-87). The Big South single-season record is 759 points, set by Coastal Carolina's TONY DUNKIN in 1992-93. Williams' season average of 28.6 points is pacing well ahead of the League's single-season record of 24.6, set by Grier in 1986-87. Williams is on pace to score 886 points this season, and is on pace to finish the year fifth all-time on the Big South's career scoring list with 1,818 career points.

GLASS-PLUS

Coastal Carolina's MOSES SONKO tied a Big South Conference game record with 22 rebounds vs. VMI on. Feb. 3. Winthrop's STEVE NAPPER set the record on Jan. 29, 1994 vs. UMBC. Sonko had 10 offensive boards and 12 defensive grabs against the Keydets in becoming just the ninth player in League history (and second in Conference action) with 20 rebounds in a contest. Winthrop's ALLEN WASHINGTON owns the single-game record of 23 rebounds, established vs. Piedmont on Nov. 30, 1985 -- the Big South's first year of basketball.

GOING CLUBBIN'

Radford's CHRIS OLIVER is 11 rebounds away from becoming just the fifth player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds. He will also become the second player in League history with 1,500 points and 800 boards. High Point's ARIZONA REID is eight rebounds shy of becoming the 26th player in League annals with 600 rebounds. Winthrop's CRAIG BRADSHAW's next two rebounds will give him 500 in his career. Meanwhile, of the 32 players in Big South history in the 1,000 career point/500 career rebound club, five are active players: Oliver (1,538-789), Reid (1,167-592), REGGIE WILLIAMS (1,647-518), MOSES SONKO (1,047-537) and MATT MURRER (1,042-519).

NO FRESHMAN 15

At 19-4, Winthrop is off to its best start under head coach GREGG MARSHALL, and has won at least 15 games in a season for the ninth-straight year, extending its Big South record for most consecutive seasons with at least 15 victories. Meanwhile, High Point has recorded its third 15-win season in four years under head coach BART LUNDY, and have equalled its win total for all of last season (16).

REID ALL ABOUT IT

High Point junior ARIZONA REID is quickly climbing the Big South's career rebounding chart, as he is now tied for 27th all-time with 592 rebounds, after reaching the 500-rebound milestone eight games ago (Jan. 10 at VMI). In his last 11 games, Reid is averaging 26.0 points, 10.1 rebounds and .560 percent from the field (116-of-207). He has scored in double figures in 21 of 24 games this season, and is averaging 23.62 points when doing so.

HOME SWEET HOME

Winthrop has won 16-straight home games, currently tied for 13th-longest in the NCAA. Winthrop has won 39 of its last 40 at the Winthrop Coliseum and is 49-5 (=.907) at home since the start of the 2003-04 season. High Point is 20-3 in its last 23 home appearances at Millis Center, and is 41-10 (=.820) at home since the beginning of the '03-04 campaign. Meanwhile, since BUZZ PETERSON took over the Coastal Carolina program last year, the Chanticleers are 24-2 at Kimbel Arena.

SONKO SINKS IT

Coastal Carolina senior forward MOSES SONKO continues to lead the Big South in field goal shooting at .569 percent (144-of-253). He is looking to become just the second Chanticleer ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage, as DuWAYNE CHEATAM was the first and only in 1989-90 (55.8 percent).

STOP, THIEVES!!

VMI's TRAVIS HOLMES has recorded 42 steals in his last eight games, an average of 5.25. In that span, he set a Big South single-game record with 11 steals vs. Bridgewater College, Jan. 18, and now leads the nation in steals per game at 3.76. His season average is currently tied for third-highest in Big South history. Meanwhile, VMI has broken the Conference's single-season steals record, as the Keydets sit at 401 on the year, becoming the first Big South squad with 400 steals in a season. The Keydets are averaging 16.04 steals per game and are on pace to finish with 497 steals, which would break the NCAA record of 486, set by Oklahoma in 1987-88. VMI's per game clip is pacing ahead of the NCAA mark of 14.9, held by Long Island in 1997-98.

DOUBLE TAKE

Liberty's LARRY BLAIR is the lone player in the Big South to score in double figures in every game this season (23 games). Dating back to last season, Blair has scored in double digits in 44 consecutive games and 56 of his last 57 games. Radford's CHRIS OLIVER saw his double-figure scoring streak end at 26 games (22 this season) after scoring just four points on Jan. 31 vs. High Point.

VMI SITTING ATOP NATION IN SCORING WITH 102.6 POINTS PER GAME

VMI is averaging 102.6 points per game to lead the Big South and nation in scoring. The Keydets have hit the century mark in 13 games and have posted six additional games in the 90s. VMI has scored 100 points at home in eight of 11 contests -- just missing all 11 games by a combined eight points -- and is averaging 116.2 points per game at Cameron Hall. The last team to average 100 points per game was Southern University in 1994 (101.0). No Big South team was ever led the nation in scoring, and the Keydets are well on their way to setting the Conference's season scoring offense record, which is (was) 83.6 points by Winthrop in 1992-93.

POLLSTERS

Winthrop was ranked No. 3 in the recent (Jan. 29) *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25, its 10th consecutive week in the top 10 and third-straight week at No. 3. High Point received votes for the fourth-straight week in the Mid-Major poll, and placed out in the No. 30 spot for the second week in-a-row. Meanwhile, in this week's (Feb. 5) ESPN/*USA Today* Coaches poll, Winthrop received 12 votes, its most ever and up from 10 last week. The Eagles also received votes in the AP Top 25 for the first time this season, and are ranked No. 43 in this week's Collegehoops.net Top 50 poll, one spot ahead of BracketBusters opponent Missouri State.

RUNNIN' ROOS RUNNIN TOWARD LEAGUE, NCAA RECORDS

As mentioned, VMI has already broken the Big South Conference single-season record for three-point field goals and three-point attempts, standing at 360 threes and 1,110 attempts through 25 games. The Keydets' 1,110 attempts also broke the NCAA Division I record of 1,057, set by Duke in 2000-01. The old Big South records of 251 three-pointers and 702 attempts were held by Winthrop in 1999-00. Meanwhile, the chart below details the League and NCAA three-point records VMI will likely surpass this season:

GOAL ORIENTED

Liberty senior LARRY BLAIR ranks second all-time in League history with 734 field goals made, surpassing Radford's DOUG DAY, who had 715 in his career. The Big South career record is 775, held by Big South Hall of Famer TONY DUNKIN (1989-93). Blair is second all-time with 1,780 field goal attempts, trailing Day for the top spot. Day owns the Big South record with 1,782 career field goal attempts.

BUZZING ON THROUGH

Coastal Carolina head coach **BUZZ PETERSON** is two wins away from 200 in his career. The second-year CCU coach owns a 198-130 (=.604) career coaching record, including 32-21 at Coastal. He has had at least a .500 record in eight of his previous 10 seasons as a head coach, and needs three more wins this season for his ninth such occurrence.

LEISURE WORLD

Coastal Carolina junior JACK LEASURE has made 281 career three-pointers, sixth all-time in Big South history. Leasure, who has made a three-pointer in 78 of 82 career games, needs eight to tie RAYMOND ARRINGTON (Radford, 1990-03) for fifth all-time at 289.

LEADERS OF THE PACK

High Point continues to lead the Big South in three individual statistical categories. **ARIZONA REID** enters the week tops in rebounds at 9.4 per game, while **MIKE JEFFERSON** is first in assists with 5.04 per contest. Redshirt-freshman **CRUZ DANIELS** is first in blocks and blocks per game, with 47 for a 1.96 per game clip. The Big South has never had three players from the same squad lead the Conference in the aforementioned categories in the same season.

TWENTY-SOMETHING

The Big South is on its way to having a 20-point scorer for the second consecutive season, marking the first time since the 1993-94 and 1994-95 campaigns. In fact, the Big South had a 20-point scorer five-straight years, from 1990-91 to 1994-95. This season will mark just the 10th time in the 22 years of Big South men's basketball that the League had a 20-point scorer.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

The Winthrop Eagles have led the Big South in scoring defense eight consecutive seasons, all during during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. Through 23 games in 2006-07, the Eagles are holding opponents to a League-low 60.1 points. The 2004-05 Eagles set the Conference scoring defense record with a 59.4 per game clip. In addition, Winthrop is holding opponents to a .405 field goal percentage, while Conference foes are managing just .386 percent.
