Eddie Van Es • Sophomore OF • VMI Hampton, Va.

Van Es batted .450 (9-20) with five runs scored and seven batted in to lead VMI to a 4-1 record last week, including a win over No. 10 Auburn and three-game sweep of Big South foe Charleston Southern. He went 3-4 with a game-tying tworun home run in the sixth inning and an RBI triple in the eighth inning to lead the Keydets past Auburn on March 13. Van Es then went 2-5 with a double and two RBI in the second and final game of the series with the Tigers. He added two walks and collected an RBI in game one vs. Charleston Southern, then had a pair of hits in each of the final two games against the Bucs. On the week, Van Es slugged .850 while sporting an on-base average of .522, plus three doubles, a triple, a home run, three walks and two sacrifices. Van Es also recorded 15 putouts from his rightfield position.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Adam Hoyt • Freshman Radford • LHP Chesapeake, Va.

Hoyt had a fantastic outing on Sunday, picking up his first career win with a five-hit, seven inning complete game 1-0 shutout of North Carolina A&T. He allowed just five singles against 24 batters faced (=.208 average), while fanning six hitters and issuing no walks. It was his first complete game in four starts, his first shutout and his second-lowest hits allowed in an outing this year. Hoyt's effort helped Radford equal its win total for all of last season (seven).

The Bucs combined for eight errors in the three games against VMI, five of which came in a heart-breaking loss on Sunday ... **RYAN SMART** led the way offensively for CSU, going 5-for-9 from the plate, scoring three times and knocking in one RBI ... **LIONEL GREENE** and **SEAN DOHERTY** also hit better than .400 for the week, each recording a triple, as the Bucs pounded 38 hits in four games. Freshman NICK McCULLY struck out nine in five innings in the win over UNC Wilmington. He allowed three hits and no earned runs to pick up his second win of the season ... Senior ANDY DeLaGARZA won his fifth game on the mound in the 5-2 win over Eastern Michigan March 15. He allowed eight hits and two runs in picking up his 16th career win ... Coastal used the long ball in the 12-3 win over Eastern Michigan, March 17. The Chanticleers hit back-to-back-to-back home runs in the eighth inning. TOMMY BALDRIDGE, DOCK DOYLE, DAVID ANDERSON and RICKY GRICE left the yard. Anderson and Grice were pinch hitters and it was the first career home run for both Doyle and Grice. Baldridge hit two home runs in the game, upping his total to four on the season ... Senior DOM DUGGAN has 12 sacrifice hits this season. That mark leads the nation as of March 18, according to Boyd's World. Duggan also has 10 doubles on the year ... Sophomore DAVID SAPPELT has 43 hits after 22 games this season. The leadoff hitter has a .472 on-base percentage despite walking just eight times ... Coastal used home runs by MATT RADEMACHER and Anderson to defeat EMU 10-7. Playing with that ranking, the Keydets won four of five on the week, including a 7-3 defeat at No. 10 Auburn, the highest-ranked opponent the Keydets have defeated in program history. Only a 10-8 walk-off loss to No. 10 Auburn in game two of the midweek series broke the Keydets' winning streak, as the team has now won 11 of their last 12 outings ... Senior shortstop **CHAD RICE** has collected hits in each of those 12 games, as he currently has the team's best streak of the season, hitting .415 along the way ...
