Lentz had a superb two-game span as he batted .778 (7-9) with three home runs, 10 RBI, five runs scored, a 1.889 slugging percentage and an .818 on-base average in leading Winthrop to wins over No. 24 College of Charleston and Conference foe High Point. Lentz opened the week with a 3-5 performance plus a home run and three RBI in a 16-14 win over the Cougars. On Sunday at High Point, the senior went 4-4, belted two home runs - including a grand slam - and finished with seven RBI and three runs scored. Lentz received National Player of the Weeks Monday from *Collegiate Baseball* for his performance last week.

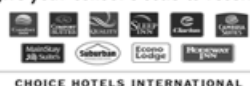
NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK
