Sappelt batted .500 (11-22) in four games, helping the Chanticleers to a 3-1 record last week. He had seven runs scored, two doubles, a triple, two home runs and seven RBI, in addition to a .955 slugging percentage and .522 on-base average. His most memorable hit of the week was his last, a two-out, eighth-inning grand slam that gave the Chants a 14-13 win on Sunday over Liberty. Sappelt also had a home run in Saturday's win over the Flames. In the middle game of the series, Sappelt was 5-for-6 with two RBI. The grand slam was his second of the season.

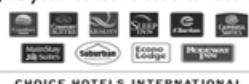
NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

McCully had a hand in all three Coastal victories last week. The freshman earned the victory in Coastal's 5-1 mid-week win over The Citadel, going five innings and allowing just four hits, one earned run and one strikeout. McCully got another win Saturday, pitching 2.1 innings of hitless relief against Liberty. He struck out three as Coastal won 12-9 in the bottom of the ninth. Coastal won 3-of-4 games for the second straight week, but with much different results ... Coastal had stellar pitching in a 5-1 win over The Citadel, as **NICK McCULLY**, **KENT ALTMAN**, **JOEY HAUG** and **DAVID ANDERSON** combined to give up just one earned run and six hits while striking out four ... The bats became the story on the weekend, as Coastal scored 33 runs in taking 2-of-3 from Liberty in the last three games at Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field in 2007 ... Coastal hit .341 in the series and had nine home runs, including a walk-off home run by **MATT RADEMACHER** on Saturday and a grand slam by **DAVID SAPPELT** that gave the Chants the lead in the eighth inning on Sunday ... Rademacher was 8-for-19 (=.421) with 2 HR and 10 RBI in four games. He had two hits in each of the four games and had four RBI in Saturday's game ... **PETE ANDRELCZYK** helped stamp out Liberty rallies this week. He struck out seven and gave up one hit and one unearned run in six innings of relief ... McCully also had a win and a save in the series and he went 8.1 innings this week, giving up just one earned run and striking out four ... Coastal honored seven seniors before Sunday's game, playing their last and maybe most memorable game in Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field ... DH **TIM NANRY** went 5-for-5 with a two-run home run, a double, three runs scored and three RBI Sunday at Coastal Carolina.
