Duggan hit .353 (6-17) on the week and had three home runs in the Big South regular-season title clinching series against Winthrop. He belted the game-winning home run in the seventh inning of Saturday's game against the Eagles. He then had two home runs in the series finale, a 7-2 win. Duggan started out the week by going 2-for-4 with a run scored in the 11-7 win at No. 5 Virginia. On the week, Duggan had an .882 slugging percentage, eight RBI - including back-to-back four RBI games, plus five runs scored and three sacrifice hits. All three sacrifices led to Coastal runs and increased his NCAA-leading total to 26 -- tied for second-most in a season in NCAA history.

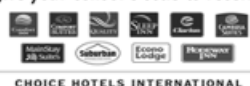

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers followed up their first Big South series victory of the season (vs. High Point) with their first Conference series sweep (vs. Radford) to end the regular season ... The pitching finally came together for CSU as the Bucs allowed just seven runs in the three games vs. RU (2.3 per game) ... It was CSU's first Conference sweep since the 2005 season ... **WES BRUNDRIDGE** ended the regular season with a nine-game hitting streak, and led the way last week with seven hits ... **SEAN DOHERTY** had a team-leading four RBI on the week, and tied a school record with four stolen bases in one game, with three coming in the same inning ... On the mound, Buccaneer reliever **PAYTON TWEDDALE** set a school record with his eighth save of the season, giving him the record for saves in a season (previously six) and career (14, previous record was 12) ... Starters **CODY HIGGINS** and **D.J. THRONEBURG** made the most of their starts, going 6.2 and 7.2 innings deep, respectively. Current team leaders:

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its 10th regular-season Big South Conference title this past weekend by taking 2-of-3 games at Winthrop ... It was Coastal's second regular-season title in three years and its fourth in the last nine years ... After dropping the series opener, Coastal came back and scored eight runs in the seventh and eighth innings in a 10-5 win on Saturday ... **DOM DUGGAN** hit the game-winning home run in the seventh and the Chants scored five runs in the eighth inning to seal the win ... Coastal won Sunday, 7-2, for the outright title ... Duggan had two home runs in the game, while **DAVID SAPPELT** broke out of a mini-slump with three hits and a home run ... **TOMMY BALDRIDGE** had eight hits on the week and now leads the team in batting average (.384) and RBI (55) ... Coastal opened the week by defeating No. 5 Virginia, 11-7. A five-run first inning, fueled by a Baldridge triple, propelled the Chants to its third win this season over a top-15 team and its second win over the Cavaliers. HIGH POINT

High Point played a pair of in-state non-conference road games to close out the 2007 regular-season slate ... HPU dropped a tough loss at Western Carolina before topping longtime rival Elon, 9-7 in 10 innings ... The win gave HPU a three-game sweep over the Phoenix this year ... With 26 wins this year, the Panthers are just one win shy of matching last year's Division I program record total of 27 ... HPU has or is on pace to set several Division I program pitching records, including strikeouts (396 - already a record), ERA (4.90) and opponent's batting average (.272) ... 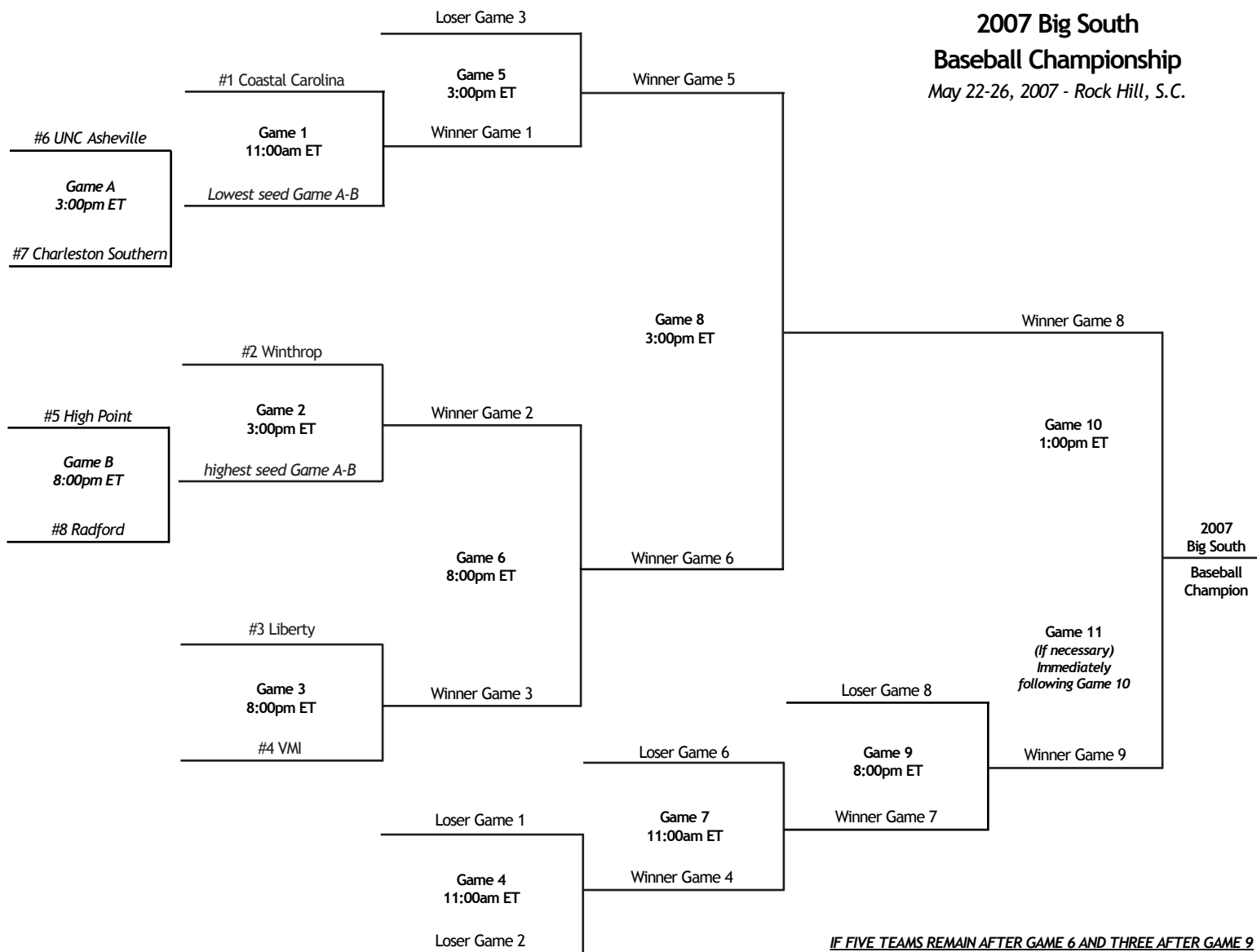

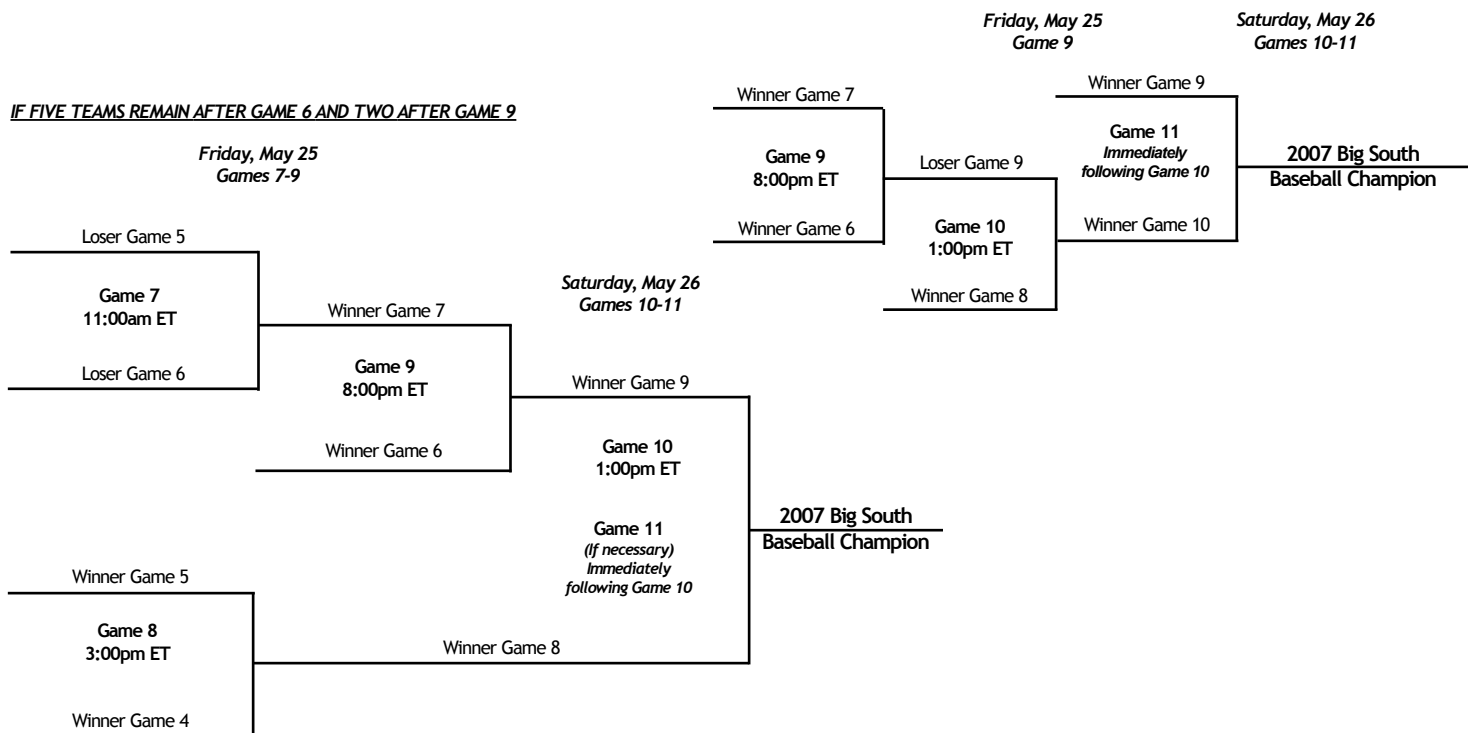
