Gregory batted .526 (10-19) in helping the Highlanders to a 2-2 record last week - snapping a 12-game overall losing streak as well as a 10-game Conference skid. He opened the week with a 2-5 performance in Radford's 9-3 win vs. Richmond. Against VMI, Gregory batted .571 (8-14) in the three-game series, leading the Highs to a 4-3 victory in the opener with three hits and two runs scored - including the game-winning tally. On Saturday, he started the rally that brought Radford back from a 9-0 deficit to tie the game. On the week, Gregory had a .526 on-base percentage, a .684 slugging percentage, seven runs scored, three runs batted in, three doubles and a stolen base.

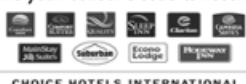

Higgins blanked High Point Friday night, 1-0, in tossing a complete game four-hitter. He walked just two batters while striking out four in hurling the Buccaneers' second complete game of the season and the first of his CSU career. It also was the first complete game shutout by a Buccaneer pitcher this year, and helped Charleston Southern claim its first Big South series win of the season, as the Bucs took two-of-three from the Panthers. Higgins also recorded a strikeout in one inning of work in CSU's 15-4 win at Campbell. His line last week: 1-0, 0.90 ERA, 10 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 3 BB, 5 SO, .162 opponents batting average.

The Buccaneers took their first Big South series this weekend after splitting a pair of non-conference, midweek games ... **JUSTIN FYLE** led the way with eight hits, posting a .381 batting average for the week, hitting two home runs ... **ANTHONY HAYES** also went deep twice, giving them both five home runs for the season ... On the mound, **CODY HIGGINS** pitched the first complete-game of his career, and just the second of the season for CSU. COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 3-1 on the week, getting a dramatic come-from-behind 8-7 victory over the College of Charleston and then winning 2-of-3 games at UNC Asheville ... The two wins, coupled with Liberty's sweep of Winthrop, gives the Chants a one-game lead over the Eagles in the standings ... The two teams will play each other in the last week of the season, as Coastal needs to win one game for a co-championship and 2-of-3 to win the outright Big South title and No. 1 seed in the Big South Tournament ... Coastal head coach **GARY GILMORE** won his 700th career game May 12 in a 10-2 win over UNC Asheville. Gilmore now has a 701-363 record in his 18th season as a head coach and a 448-260 record in his 12th year at Coastal. It was a year to the date that Gilmore won his 400th game at Coastal ... Coastal has won 40 games for the sixth time in the last seven seasons ... Coastal scored seven runs in the bottom of the ninth in its 8-7 win over the College of Charleston ... **DOCK DOYLE** had two hits in the inning, including the game-winning single, while **TOMMY BALDRIDGE** had a two-run home run in the frame. Baldrige had two home runs and five RBI on the week ... **BOBBY GAGG** became the first pitcher in the Big South to record 10 wins this season. Gagg went seven innings and allowed six hits and one earned run in the 10-2 win over UNCA ... **JOHN MARIOTTI** improved to 6-0 with Sunday's win over the Bulldogs. Mariotti struck out four and gave up four hits in six innings ... **ANDY DeLaGARZA** is one of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes the top senior student-athlete in college baseball.
