Cowan led the Panthers to a series victory in their Big South opener with Liberty. He batted .611 for the week (11-18) including a .643 average against the Flames. Cowan had four-straight multi-hit performances, including a 4-5 outing with two runs scored in HPU's 10-2 win over Liberty on Saturday. He went 3-4 with three RBI in game one vs. LU and reached based 11 times and posted a .688 on-base percentage against Liberty (.667 overall). He also went 2-4 with an RBI at No. 22 East Carolina earlier in the week. Cowan led High Point with 13 total bases and slugged .722 on the week, and finished with three runs scored, five RBI, two doubles and two walks in four games.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal, ranked as high as 15th in the *Baseball America* poll and in the top-20 of all five active polls, has now won 11 games in a row. The Chanticleers have not won 11 games in a row since April 17-May 6, 2001 ... Coastal also is off to its best start since the 1983 season, when CCU had a 25-3-1 record ... Coastal has won 20 of its last 23 Big South series dating back to 2004 ... Coastal has now won nine of its last 10 games against Radford ... **DAVID ANDERSON** saved three of Coastal's four victories this week. He gave up only one hit and struck out seven in 4.1 innings ... Another Coastal pitcher having a great season is **BOBBY GAGG**. Gagg gave up six hits and struck out five in Saturday's 10-3 win over Radford, and is now 5-1 on the year with a 2.53 ERA ... **DAVID SAPPELT**'s 16-game hitting streak was snapped Sunday.
