Ashley Williams • Junior C • Liberty Lilburn, Ga.

Williams posted a .462 average at the plate at the Women4Women Invitational over the weekend. Liberty faced three teams in the top 25 in the four-game span. Against No. 25 California on March 23, Williams was 4-for-4 with two doubles and three RBI. In the Lady Flames' upset of No. 6 Michigan, she drove in Liberty's two runs to lift LU to the 2-0 win. Michigan was the highest-ranked softball opponent that Liberty has ever defeated in the program's history. For the week, she posted six hits, five RBI, four doubles and notched a slugging percentage of .769.

> Cassie Rhodes • Junior SS • Radford Goode, Va.

Rhodes hit .533 with eight RBI as Radford won the Georgetown Hoya Classic. She posted eight hits, two homers and one double over the fivegame span. She also stole four bases for the Highlanders to help RU set the single-season stolen base record with 84. She recorded two multi-hit games and two multi-RBI games, including five RBI against Georgetown on March 24. Rhodes finished the week with an impressive 1.000 slugging percentage.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Megan Evans • Freshman Winthrop Brooklin, Ontario

Evans posted a 3-0 record and a 1.20 ERA on the week with a shutout and a combined shutout. She pitched 11.2 innings with five strikeouts and only allowed two runs. She posted no walks in the three games to extend her streak to 12.0 innings without a walk. Evans leads her team with 87 stikeouts on the season and has not lost a game since Feb. 25 at Alabama.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 4-2 this week, splitting with Nicholls State on the road, Monday, then sweeping Alabama State at home, Thursday, and splitting with North Florida at home, Friday ... Two of BSC's four wins were shutouts ... Junior LINDSAY CREIGHTON leads the team batting .361, while sophomore ANNE LAWRENCE leads with 17 RBI ... In the circle, junior BETHNEY REYNOLDSON leads with a 10-10 record and a 2.03 ERA.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Runs were at a premium this week for the Lady Bucs as they scored just five runs in four games, posting a 1-3 record for the week. The Lady Bucs hit just .167 from the plate, but more importantly, left 23 runners on base ... AMY TRENKAMP and JILL SHONDEL each stole a base this week, the only two to do so. CAITLIN ALLEN got a hit in her only plate appearance, hitting one of three doubles that CSU recorded ... With a pair of hits in game one against Coastal Carolina, Trenkamp got her eighth multi-hit game ... In the circle, JILLIAN LAFRANCE led the way with a 2.55 ERA, despite taking two losses on the week. She pitched 11 innings and struck out eight, walking just two ... AMANDA NOBLE earned the victory in CSU's win over Jacksonville, posting a 1-1 record and 3.00 ERA. She pitched 14 innings and struck out seven

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Lady Chanticleers headed to Charleston Southern on Saturday, Mar. 24 to play a pair of games with the Lady Bucs. Coastal opened the conference season with two wins against CSU. The Chants took the first 5-1 and the second 3-0 ... In game one, **KRISTINA SHEPPARD** increased her season RBI total to 22 going 2-for-2 at the plate with two RBI singles in the contest ... In game two, **GLYNN TOLLESON** went 3-for-4 at the plate including a two-RBI single to to center field ... **DANYELLE GERDTS** also got on board with triple in the seventh inning.

LIBERTY

Liberty posted its third win over a nationally-ranked opponent this weekend when they shutout No. 6/9 Michigan, 2-0, at the Women4Women Softball Invitational. Liberty has also knocked off No. 10/14 Baylor (4-0) and No. 23 Hawaii (4-3), both at last week's Bank of Hawaii Invitational in Honolulu, Hawaii. Liberty has now defeated six nationally-ranked opponents over the last three years, downing No. 25 Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2005 (2-1) and sweeping No. 24 Virginia Tech last year in Blacksburg (6-5 and 3-0). Liberty's win over No. 6/9 Michigan marked the highest-ranked opponent Liberty has ever defeated in program history and the third-highest in athletic department history. The baseball program knocked of No. 3 Wake Forest in 2002 and the men's soccer team downed No. 5 Wake Forest in 2000. Eight out of Liberty's last 12 opponents have been ranked in the Top 25 with Liberty posting a 6-6 record during those last 12 contests. Liberty continues its run against the country's top-ranked teams as the Lady Flames square off against the nation's best in No. 1 Tennessee for a non-conference doubleheader in Knoxville, Tenn. This marks the second time in program history the softball team has faced the nation's top-ranked team as Liberty squared off against No. 1 UCLA in the opening game of the 2002 NCAA Regionals, falling 3-0 to the Bruins in Liberty's first-ever NCAA Tournament game ... JESSICA MOORE moved into second place on the Lady Flames' all-time hit list this past weekend as the senior now has 189 career hits (in iust three years). Moore needs 37 hits this year to become the school's all-time career hits leader, moving past STACY RADULOVICH who finished her career with 224 hits (1996-99) ... Senior pitcher SARAH SWOR enters the week needing just five more strikeouts to become Liberty's all-time saves leader as the hurler has 441 strikeouts to her credit. Ali Thompson (2000-02) finished her Liberty career with 446 strikeouts.

RADFORD

Radford concluded its regular season tournament play with a 3-0 win over Canisius to claim the Hoya Classic. It was the Highs' fourth straight (2-2) Championship game. During that stretch, RU is 18-2 (13-0 in pool play) ... Just 40 games into the season, Radford broke the single-season stolen base record vs. Canisius on Sunday. The Highlanders have stolen 83 bases (83-103), breaking the record of 81, set in 2003 ... BRE FELIX set another pitching record at RU, making her 100th career start, breaking the record of 99 held by SHEREE' FLETCHER ... After a 4-10 start, the Highs have gone 20-6. During the start, RU batted just .238 and posted a 3.07 ERA. Since then, they have batted .317witha 2.14 ERA.

WINTHROP

LISA KINGSMORE has been a hitting machine as she is currently riding a 16-game hitting streak and is hitting .472 during that same stretch. This past week she had 11 hits in seven games ... After the Lady Eagles started the season 4-7, they have since gone 25-3. During those first 11 games the team's ERA was 5.80 and the team averaged 4.2 runs per game. In the last 28 games, the team ERA has dropped to 1.17 and the team is averaging 6.4 runs. In addition, Winthrop was getting outscored by its opponents 31-12 in the first two innings in the first 11 games. In the last 28 games, Winthrop has outscored its opponents in the first two innings 44-13. During the last 28 games Winthrop has recorded 10 shutouts ... Over the past week, Winthrop's pitchers combined to toss 34 consecutive innings without allowing a single run. Senior LAURA HILL moved into fourth this past weekend on the all-time career RBI list at Winthrop as she now has 89.
