Scrymgeour hit .400 with 22 RBI in 15 games for the Eagles as Winthrop went 13-2 during the two week span. She recorded a hit in all but onegame and notched multiple-hit efforts in five games. She went 3for-4 with four RBI against Big South foe Radford in a non-Conference tilt on March 4, and later followed that with a five RBI game against South Carolina State on March 9. During the two week span, she notched 20 hits, four doubles and four home runs, while posting a .720 slugging percentage and an onbase percentage of .464.

Taylor went 6-2, recorded a 0.74 ERA and earned Winthrop/adidas Invitational Pitching MVP honors with two other teammates during the past two weeks. She posted three one-hit shutout games while recording 68 stikeouts in 57.0 innings pitched. Against Troy on March 2, Taylor tied a school record for stike outs as she mowed down 14 hitters en route to being named to the Georgia Tech Buzz Classic All-Tournament team.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC struggled over its last two regular season tournaments, winning one game in the Magic City Classic against UAB, and winning one game in the Panther Spring Classic against South Alabama. Despite winning only one game in the Panther Spring Classic, though, BSC finished as the runner-up after defeating top-seeded South Alabama in bracket play, courtesy of two home runs from senior **HEATHER FOX** and a single-game-record-tying 11 strikeouts from junior **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** ... The Panthers then advanced to the championship, where they lost to Kennesaw State for the second straight year, by the same 4-3 score ... Senior **MELISSA TAUNTON** and junior **LINDSAY CREIGHTON** earned All-Tournament honors at the Magic City Classic, and junior **GRACE STOKES** and sophomore **KAYLA BACKLUND** were named to the Panther Spring Classic All-Tournament Team.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs dropped four games in the Asics/Winthrop Invitational this week, after having played a pair of double headers earlier in the week ... The Lady Bucs have now dropped four games this season to Gardner-Webb, having played them in two tournaments, as well as a trip up to Boiling Springs ... The week started with a little bit of revenge on Campbell ... After suffering a loss to the Camels in their tournament last weekend, the Lady Bucs beat Campbell at home on Tuesday. It would be the one victory of the week, though, for CSU.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina dropped a pair of one-run games to in-state foe the South Carolina Gamecocks (1-2, 0-1) on Wednesday, Mar. 7 ... The Lady Chants then returned home to host James Madison. CCU fell to the Dukes on Saturday in both games, losing the first1-6 and the second 4-5. On Sunday, the Chants had an offensive struggle with James Madison and came out on top 11-10 in eight innings.

LIBERTY

Liberty opened the year by winning nine out of its first 13 games, posting a 9-4 record over their first 13 contests. This marks the third-best start in school history as the Lady Flames opened last year with a 10-4 record, followed by the 1996 squad that won 17 out of its first 21 games ... Liberty has finished third at the first two tournaments of its annual Spring Break as the Lady Flames posted a 4-1 record to finish third out of five teams at the Tar Heel Invitational and a 3-4 record to finish third out of five teams at the Hawaiian Airlines Spring Fling Tournament ... After hitting a combined 109 home runs over the last two seasons, the Lady Flames have kept the pop in their bats this year as Liberty has belted 24 home runs over the first 19 games of the year. The Lady Flames hit 11 of their 19 home runs at the Tar Heel Invitational, including a school record six against Rhode Island in a game that saw the Lady Flames connected on back-to-back-to-back home runs (by J'NAE JEFFERSON, JESSICA MOORE and ASHLEY WILLIAMS). Nine different players have recorded at least one home run this year ... Senior DAWN JEFFS had her personal career-long 14-game hitting streak snapped in the Lady Flames' second meeting against No. 14 Oregon State. The second baseman has hit safely in 16 out of 18 games this year ... The Lady Flames are scheduled to face their second and third ranked opponent in this week's upcoming Bank of Hawaii Invitational. Liberty opens the tournament against No. 16 Baylor and No. 23 California, plus the Lady Flames will close out their stay at the tournament against host Hawaii who just dropped out of last week's national Top 25 poll. Last week, the Lady Flames squared off against No. 14 Oregon State, dropping 4-2 and 3-1 decisions to the nationally-ranked programs.

RADFORD

Radford is on a seven-game winning streak and has won 13-of-its-last 15 games ... The Highlanders have gone 11-1 in the last two tournaments, going undefeated in pool play both weekends ... They fell in the Championship game of the Buzz Classic to Conference foe Winthrop. However, they rebounded this weekend to win the Eagle's Winthrop/Adidas Invitational, dowing Albany 5-2 in the Championship game ... CASSIE RHODES was named Winthrop/Adidas MVP while RU's pitching staff was named pitching MVP. In six games, Rhodes batted .471 (8-17) with two doubles, a triple, six RBI and four runs scored. She recorded a .706 slugging and .474 on base percentage. She also had a stellar defensive tournament, not committing an error in 25 attempts. RU's pitching staff posted a 1.02 ERA with two shutouts in 41 innings. They struck out 38 and walked just three, while holding their opponents to a .190 batting average ... ASHLEY TAYLOR was named to the Buzz Classic All-Tournament team, her fourth All-Tournament honor this season ... ASHLEY CARLSON has been on fire, getting a hit in 13 of her last 15 games with eight multiple hit games. With five stolen bases this weekend, she moved into third on the school's record book with 51.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is off to one of its best starts in school history at 21-9. Since starting the season 4-7, the Lady Eagles won 11 straight and have won 17 of their last 19 games. Winthrop scored a total of 237 runs in 2006. Through 30 games, Winthrop has scored 173 and is on pace to score well over 300 runs. The school record is 291 set by the 1995 team ... JENNY SCRYMGEOUR has a career-best five home runs this season and has moved into 7th on the all-time list at Winthrop. TESSA THOMAS has also moved up the list into a tie for 8th.
