## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-1 last week with a 5-2 home win over Georgia State followed by two wins on the road against Alcorn State (2-0, 4-0) and a tough loss at McNeese State (5-4). Saturday's game against McNeese was the first time that the Panthers had played outside of Birmingham since Feb. 25 in Mobile at the Jaguar Classic, and the first time they had played outside the state of Alabama since Feb. 18 in the OU/Nike Invitational. Junior Lindsay Creighton leads the squad batting .342, while junior **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** (7-9) leads the Panthers in the circle with a 2.22 ERA.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Clutch hitting in both games against Presbyterian allowed the Lady Bucs two come-from-behind victories on Saturday. In both games, the Lady Bucs found themselves trailing by three, and in both games, they came back to win it ... **CANDACE ROWELL** went 3-for-6 with a double and two RBI to lead the way. Game one took eight innings to decide, and after PC scored two in the top of the inning, the Lady Bucs scored three in the bottom, using a triple by **JILL SHONDEL**, who then scored the third and final run on an RBI single down the line by **ASHLEY CONWAY** ... In game two, the Lady Bucs surrendered three runs in the top of the first, but steadily came back, scoring on in the bottom of the sixth to take the lead.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina had a seven-game home stand this week. The Chanticleers opened the week on Monday and Tuesday hosting the Pirates from East Carolina. Coastal went 2-1 in the three-game series ... CCU then hosted a three-way doubleheader with Appalachian State and Kennesaw State. Coastal dropped all four games, with close 10 inning 8-7 loss to ASU day one.

## LIBERTY

Liberty recorded a pair of victories over Top 25 teams this past week at the Bank of Hawaii Invitational, with a 4-3 win over No. 23/25 Hawaii and a 4-0 shutout victory over No. 10/14 Baylor. The pair of victories marks the fourth and fifth time in program history that Liberty has defeated ranked teams. It also marks the highest ranked opponents Liberty has ever defeated as the Lady Flames had previously downed No. 25 Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2005 and swept a doubleheader from No. 24 Virginia Tech in 2006 ... The Lady Flames posted a 3-1 record at the Bank of Hawaii Invitational, allowing the team to finish up its Hawaii Spring Break swing with a 6-5 record. Liberty posted the 3-1 record in pool play at the tournament, but was unable to compete for the championship due to prearranged travel plans. Liberty posted a 3-4 record to start the 12-day tour at the Hawaiian Airlines Spring Fling Tournament where they finished third ... **JESSICA MOORE** and **TERRA LOWE** were both named to the Bank of Hawaii Invitational all-tournament team. Moore finished the four games with a .600 batting percentage (6-of-10) along with a double, home run and three RBI. Lowe posted a perfect 2-0 record, a 0.00 ERA and a save in three appearances, including victories over No. 23/25 Hawaii and No. 10/14 Baylor ... Liberty will continue to face some of the best teams in the nation this weekend when the Lady Flames travel to Louisville, Ky., to participate in the Louisville Classic. The field includes host Louisville, who was ranked No. 20 in the preseason NFCA poll, along with No. 7 Northwestern, No. 9 Michigan and No. 25 California.

## RADFORD

Radford has qualified for four straight Tournament Championship games. They are 1-2 (one rainout) after falling in the Catamount Classic Championship Game ... In the last four tournaments, RU is 17-3, batting .317 with 15 home runs, 52 stolen bases and slugged .475. They are undefeated (11-0) in pool/round-robin play in the last three tourneys ... **SARAH HIMAN** and **ASHLEY CARLSON** were named to the Catamount Classic All-Tournament team. Himan batted .533 with a home run, six runs and six RBI, including two game-winning walk off singles. Carlson batted .474 with six runs score and four stolen bases. She had her 14-game hitting streak snapped in the Championship Game ... Four individual records were tied or broken this weekend at the Catamount Classic. **ALEX RODERICK** set a school record with three doubles vs. Detroit in the semifinal game. Against UNCW, **ASHLEY TAYLOR** tied the school record with two home runs and six RBI. The HR record tied her performance from last year vs. Georgetown and the RBI record tied **SARA BETH CLAYTON** from the 2004 season. **AMANDA DAVIDSON** tied the stolen base record with three vs. Western Carolina in round-robin play. Radford is running wild on the bases, stealing 70 in 35 games this season ... They have surpassed last season's total of 57 and the 70 steals is just one shy of how many RU attempted in 2006.

## WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles currently have four players with hitting streaks of seven games or longer. Laura Hill and **TESSA THOMAS** each have seven-game hitting streaks while **JENNY SCRYMGEOUR** has an eight game streak and **LISA KINGSMORE** is at nine ... Winthrop opened up the season 4-7 with six of the seven losses coming to nationally ranked opponents. In that span the Lady Eagles ERA was 5.80. Since then Winthrop is 19-2 with an ERA of 1.07 ... The freshmen duo of **MEGAN EVANS** and **CARI WOOLDRIDGE** have been solid on the mound since opening up with tough competition. In the last 21 games Wooldridge has an ERA of 1.06 (4-0) and Evans has 1.12 ERA (8-0) with a combined 17 starts ... Scrymgeour has been on a tear the last 21 games. She leads the team in that stretch with a .429 average and has scored 12 runs with six doubles, five home runs and driven in 33. She is slugging .729 and has an on-base % of .474. During that stretch she has just four strikeouts with six walks in 70 at-bats.
