NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-2 this week with two road wins against Chattanooga and then a 1-2 showing at home against Winthrop in the Big South openers for both teams ... Junior **LINDSAY CREIGHTON** leads the squad hitting .373, while sophomore **ANNE LAWRENCE** leads with 21 RBI ... Junior **BETHNEY REYNOLDS** leads in the circle with a 12-11 record and a 2.16 ERA.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs continued to hit the ball, but struggled to score in four conference losses this week. The Lady Bucs scored just twice, despite tallying 21 hits ... **AMANDA NOBLE** was a perfect 3-for-3 against Radford, and finished the week 4-for-5 from the plate. From the circle, she took three of the losses, going in the distance in all three games that she threw ... Freshman **JILLIAN LAFRANCE** took the other loss, going four innings in the second game against Radford ... The Lady Bucs had six players record at least two hits this week, but left 24 runners on base. In game three against Coastal, the Lady Bucs loaded the bases twice, but were unable to score.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers extended their win streak to five by picking up three wins this week ... First the Chants finished their three-game series with Charleston Southern, winning on the road 5-0 on Wed. Mar. 28. Next, CCU hosted Campbell for a doubleheader on Sat., Mar. 31. The Chants took game one in six innings 9-1. Coastal posted 11 hits with homeruns from **CARLA HOOD**, **ALLISON CANTRELL** and **ASHLEY GERDTS** ... In game two, CCU took an early lead but the Camels tied it at three in the sixth. After the Coastal defense held strong in the top of the seventh, Cantrell hit a game-winning homerun to end the game at 4-3 ... **KRISTINA SHEPPARD** continues to lead the team in batting average at .340 with Cantrell behind her at .306.

LIBERTY

Liberty faced No. 1 Tennessee last Monday, marking the second time in the history of the softball program the Lady Flames have faced the No. 1 team in the nation. Liberty's first time against the nation's top-ranked team was against No. 1 UCLA in the first round of the 2002 NCAA Regionals. The doubleheader with No. 1 Tennessee closed a stretch where Liberty faced 10 nationally-ranked teams over 14 games. Liberty finished the run with a 6-8 record, including wins over No. 6 Michigan, No. 10 Baylor and No. 23 Hawaii. Liberty's success against some of the best teams in the nation garnered national attention last week as the Lady Flames received a vote in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25 poll. Liberty was one of 12 teams to also receive consideration for last week's Top 25, tying for 34th place along with Creighton, Cal State Fullerton and Penn State, as the quartet of teams each received a single vote in the latest poll ... The Lady Flames swept Norfolk State, 2-0 and 4-1, in their home opener last Wednesday, upping Liberty's record to 10-3 in home openers since moving to the Division I level in 1994 ... Liberty posted a perfect 4-0 record over the weekend as they hosted the Blue Ridge Thunder Softball Tournament at the Liberty Softball Field to claim the championship ... **CLAIRE FRIDEY**, who entered the weekend just 1-for-7 on the year, was Liberty's hottest hitter as the junior batted .727 from the plate by going 8-for-11, with four runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI. She got the game-winning hit in the bottom of the seventh against Hampton to give Liberty the championship win and she hit her first career game slam against Georgetown earlier in the day ... **SARAH SWOR** struck out three batters in a five-inning 10-2 win over Georgetown, inching the senior closer to the school's all-time strikeout record. Swor has 444 career strikeouts and needs just three more to pass current record holder **ALI THOMPSON** who finished her career with 446 Ks.

RADFORD

Radford extended its winning streak to eight games on Sunday, tying the school record set back in 1996 ... After dropping its first four games at home, RU has won its last five ... **ASHLEY CARLSON**, currently on an eight-game hitting streak, moved into fifth on RU's career hit list with 170. She needs 12 base knocks to break the single-season record of 74. Carlson is also third on RU's single-season steals list with 24 and needs two for second and 10 to break the record ... **JENN EVERHART** tied two records against Longwood on Thursday with two home runs and nine total bases. She becomes just the third Highlander to hit two home runs in a game and just the second player to accumulate nine total bases ... **ASHLEY TAYLOR** recorded her 500th career strikeout and **BRE FELIX** notched her 20th career shutout vs. Charleston Southern on Saturday. Taylor, who ranks fourth on RU's career homer list with 18, moved into fourth on the career RBI list with 93.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles remained on the road this week as they played at South Carolina and at Birmingham-Southern ... They have now played 14 straight games away from home and will have a double-header at North Carolina A&T on Wednesday before returning home for a three-game series with Liberty starting on Friday, Apr. 6. Winthrop is 11-3 during that stretch so far.
