NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern ended the season with two straight losses in the 2007 Big South Conference Softball Tournament, losing to host Coastal Carolina in the first game, 7-3, on a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the seventh inning, and losing to Charleston Southern, 2-1, the following day ... Junior LINDSAY CREIGHTON ended the season with a team-high .322 batting average, while junior BETHNEY REYNOLDSON went 17-18 with a 2.24 ERA in the circle.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs posted a 2-1 record in the 2007 Big South Tournament, beating Birmingham-Southern for the third time this season ... JILL SHONDEL posted a .429 batting average en route to earning all-tournament honors ... JILLIAN LAFRANCE also earned all-tournament honors as she appeared in the circle in all three games, giving up six runs in 18.2 innings. LaFrance also had two hits, scoring twice ... The Lady Bucs hit 15 homeruns this season, with three of them coming in the tournament as Shondel, LaFrance and ASHLEY CONWAY all went deep ... Shondel ends the season with a team-high .279 batting average and nine doubles, while AMY TRENKAMP led the team with 42 hits ... LaFrance had five homeruns to lead the team in that category, and also posted the lowest ERA on the team at 3.11 in 26 appearances in her freshman campaign.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal played host to the 2007 Big South Conference Tournament last weekend ... CCU started the weekend with a dramatic victory over Birmingham Southern when ASHLEY GERDTS hit a walk off grand slam to get the 7-3 win ... The Chanticleers then defeated the No. 1 ranked Liberty off the bat of ALLISON CANTRELI. Cantrell homered twice, including a three-run home run in the top of the seventh to propel the Lady Chants past No. 1 Liberty, 7-4 ... Winthrop then gave the Chants their first tournament loss with a game winning hit in the bottom of the eighth ... Coastal's season came to an end in a dramatic loss to Radford despite another homer from ASHLEY GERDTS and a two-run double from GLYNN TOLLESON in the top of the seventh.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames finished the season with 36 victories, tying for the third most wins in a season in program history ... **DAWN JEFFS** led the Big South Conference this year with 91 hits, setting a new program record as she surpassed her total of 86 set last year ... Liberty finished the season with a program-record 73 home runs, giving Liberty back-to-back seasons with 60 or more home runs. The Lady Flames are one of only six teams in the nation to have recorded 60 or more home runs over the last two-consecutive seasons ... **JESSICA MOORE** became the first player in school history to garner Big South Player of the Year honors twice during her career as she was named the League's best player this season. Moore is also the fourth player in league history to garner Player of the Year honors multiple times ... The Lady Flames' senior class of **BETH HENSLEY**, **DAWN JEFFS**, **TERRA LOWE**, **JESSICA MOORE** and **SARAH SWOR** posted 118 victories during their careers, finishing as the sixth most successful senior class in program history.

RADFORD

Radford reached the Big South Championship Game for the second straight season and was one win away from a Championship for the first time in school history ... It marked the sixth straight Championship game this season for the Highlanders. They finished 3-3 in those games, winning the Winthrop/Adidas Tournament and Hoya Classic. In their last five tournaments, RU went 25-4 ... Radford had its most productive offensive season is school history, shattering several school records in the process. As a team, RU set new marks for batting average (.297), hits (554), runs (320), doubles (98), home runs (48), RBI (265) and slugging (.442). They also broke the single-season steals (128), strikeouts (492) and winning streak (9 games) records ... Indvidually, ASHLEY CARLSON set a new hits (91) and steals (36) record and ranks fourth and second on those career charts ... ASHLEY TAYLOR set the single-season (266) and single-game (16) strikeout records. She also tied the single-season home run mark with 12. She ranks second on the career strikeout, shutout and home run charts at RU ... CASSIE RHODES set a new total bases record with 130 and tied the single-season triples mark (7) ... Five different Highs hit 10+ doubles, including a League-leading 19 by ALEX RODERICK, just two shy of the single-season mark. She also set the single-game record with three vs. Detroit ... It also marked the first season, two different players had 40+ RBI (Taylor 48 and Rhodes 46) ... Along with the records, six returnees set three-plus career marks, including breakout offensive seasons by ASHLEY CARLSON, MICHELLE CARLSON, ASHLEY TAYLOR, Rhodes and ALEX RODERICK.

WINTHROP

By capturing two wins in the NCAA Tennessee Regional, the Lady Eagles finished their season with a new school record of 50 wins. The 50 wins put head coach MARK COOKE over 500 victories at Winthrop. He is now 505-493-3 in 18 season at Winthrop. He is approaching the 600 win mark in his career as he is now 589-540-3 ... Senior designated player LAURA HILL and sophomore LISA KINGSMORE had outstanding seasons for Winthrop by setting career-highs in several categories. But both excelled in the classroom as well as the playing field and that combination helped both eam CoSIDA Academic All-America honors. Hill was named to the first team and Kingsmore was named to the second team. They are the first two Winthrop softball players to be named to CoSIDA's Academic All-America Team.
