NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-2 this week, all home games, with a non-conference sweep of Jackson State, Thursday, and a 1-2 showing against Radford ... The Highlanders won Saturday's single game, 2-1, and the teams split in Sunday's doubleheader ... Junior **LINDSAY CREIGHTON** still leads the Panthers at the plate, hitting .348, while sophomore **ANNE LAWRENCE** leads with 22 RBI ... Junior **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** leads in the circle with a 14-13 record and a 1.96 ERA ... Against Jackson State on Thursday, Reynoldson made BSC history as she shattered the single-game strikeout record, ringing up 16 batters in the first game to break the previous record of 11.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

It was a tough week at the plate as CSU had just eight people who recorded a hit, batting just .213 on the weekend ... **ASHLEY CONWAY**, **JILL SHONDEL** and **AMY TRENKAMP** each had three hits on the weekend ... In the circle, **WHITNEY JAMES** saw her first action in over two weeks, pitching four scoreless innings, walking one and giving up just four hits ... **JILLIAN LAFRANCE** went six innings in her start, giving up three earned runs on six hits, striking out four ... **AMANDA NOBLE** ended the week with 7.1 innings logged, giving up 11 hits and six earned runs. She also struck out four.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Lady Chanticleers dropped four games this week, extending their losing streak to five ... On Thursday, Apr. 12 the Chants lost both games in a doubleheader to No. 21 North Carolina ... **KIMBERLY CILLIS** hit a homer to the left in the first game and Carla Hood hit an RBI single in the seventh inning that forced the game to an eighth inning ... CCU took on Winthrop on Saturday, dropping both games with scores of 5-0 and 10-0, respectively ... The two teams did not play a third game on Sunday due to weather in the Conway area, the game has been re-scheduled for Thursday, Apr. 19 at 6 p.m.

LIBERTY

Last week, the first set of national ranks were releases with the Lady Flames ranking in seven out of the 11 team categories, including 19th in home runs per game (1.15). Liberty also had five players receive individual ranks, including **SARAH ELLIS** ranking 13th in saves (3.0) and **JESSICA MOORE** ranking 22nd in home runs (0.30 per game) ... The Lady Flames swept Charleston Southern over the weekend, pushing the team's winning streak to five-straight game to mark the team's longest winning streak of the year. Liberty has now won 12 out of its last 14 games ... Liberty enters the week having posted a perfect 9-0 record in home games this year, tying the school record for consecutive games won at the Liberty Softball Field. The Lady Flames also won nine straight at home from April 3, 1997 to March 10, 1998 and March 7 to April 3, 2006 ... Senior **SARAH SWOR** hit a home run during each game of Liberty's three-game set with Charleston Southern over the weekend, giving her five round trippers on the year which ties last year's career-high total set during her junior campaign ... The Lady Flames had their non-conference doubleheader against Virginia postponed due rain. The two teams will make up the game on April 30 with the first pitch of the twin-bill set for 6 p.m. up in Charlottesville ... Pitcher **SARAH ELLIS** recorded two of Liberty's three victories over the weekend, giving the hurler a new career high in victories. The sophomore leads the Lady Flames with 11 victories, surpassing her freshman total of nine wins last year ... **JESSICA MOORE** scored a team-high four runs over the weekend in Liberty's trio of victories over Charleston Southern, giving the senior 167 career runs scored which ties the outfielder with **STACY RADULOVICH** (1996-99) for first place on Liberty's all-time runs scored list.

RADFORD

Radford continued to move up in the record books last week ... Against the Panthers, the Highs broke the single-season doubles mark of 70 on Sunday, finishing the weekend with 73 ... **ASHLEY CARLSON** moved into second on the career steals (63) and fifth on career runs (98). She also is now third on the single-season runs list with 39 ... Along with those, Carlson is eying the single-season hits and steals records. She needs three base knocks and five thefts to break those records ... Radford, who had set the single-season steals mark earlier this season, stole its 100th base of the season against Longwood ... Carlson had another hitting streak ended this weekend. Her streak ended at 13 games, one shy of her career high 14 she set earlier in the season ... **ASHLEY TAYLOR** has been on fire in her last four Conference starts. She is 4-0 with a 0.25 ERA, allowing just one earned run in 28 innings. She has struck out 47 batters and walked three.

WINTHROP

This season the Lady Eagles have had one of the finest offensive seasons in school history and on Saturday they set a new school record for runs in a single season with 294. The old record was set by the 1995 team that scored 291 runs. Winthrop has now scored 294 on the season with at least 10 games remaining on the schedule.
