Taylor posted two complete game wins to help Radford to a 2-1 series win over Big South foe Coastal Carolina over the weekend. She got her weekend started with 16 stikeouts in a shutout win over the Lady Chanticleers on April 6. The next day, Taylor recorded 14 stikeouts as the Highlanders downed Coastal, 8-1. In the two-game span, Taylor pitched 14.0 innings, struck out 30 batters, scattered nine hits and only allowed one run. Taylor is currently ranked No. 1 in the Big South with 185 stikeouts and a 1.92 ERA.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went on the road this week for their second Big South Conference series of the season to face Charleston Southern. BSC won handily in five innings in the first game, 10-1, but struggled in the next two games, losing by the scores of 4-1 and 4-0 for the Lady Buccaneers to win the series.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs took two-of-three from Birmingham-Southern, rebounding from a tough game-one loss. It was the first conference victory and conference series sweep of the season for CSU. The game three shutout was the first for CSU since March 4 ... AMY TRENKAMP was 2-for-3 in the final game, and led the way with four hits on the weekend ... CANDACE ROWELL hit the only double of the week, while Megan hall recorded the only triple for CSU ... JILLIAN LAFRANCE pitched two complete games, earning both victories for CSU, giving up just one run and 11 hits ... AMANDA NOBLE and CAITLIN ALEN split time in game one, with Noble taking the loss after giving up five runs in the start.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina softball team extended their win streak to six on Wednesday, Apr. 4 with a 3-1 victory over UNC Wilmington ... Senior CARLA HOOD hit a two-run walk-off homerun in the bottom of the seventh to seal the win ... CCU then hit the road to take on Radford in a three-game series. Coastal split two games with Radford University on Friday, Apr. 6. In very chilly conditions Coastal dropped the first 7-0, but won the second 7-5 with six homeruns ... GLYNN TOLLESON hit three homers and ALLISON CANTRELL finished with two in the victory ... On Saturday, Apr. 7, they fell to the Highlanders from Radford University 8-1 ... BRITTANY BIRNBAUM hit her second career homerun in the loss ... With the loss, the Chanticleers fell to 15-24 overall and 4-2 in the conference.

LIBERTY

For the second week in a row, the Lady Flames received votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25 poll as Liberty garnered two votes towards Top 25 consideration, earning the program a No. 34 nationally ranking in last week's poll ... The Lady Flames finished the week hitting eight home runs over five games, giving Liberty 45 home runs during the year. The 45 round trippers marks the second-highest figure in program history and the third-straight year Liberty has hit 40 or more home runs as Liberty hit 43 in 2005 and a school-record 66 last year. The Lady Flames have belted 154 home runs over the last three seasons ... **SARAH SWOR** fanned three batters during Liberty's marathon 12-11 loss to Winthrop on Friday, enabling the senior to move into sole possession of Liberty's all-time career strikeout record. Swor now has 449 Ks to her career credit, three ahead of former school record holder **ALI THOMPSON** who finished her career with 446 strikeouts (2000-02) ... The Lady Flames pounded out 30 hits during their three-game set with Winthrop this weekend, including eight or more hits during all three contests. Liberty has finished with eight or more hits during seven out of its last 10 games and 23 games overall this year. The Lady Flames are averaging 7.9 hits per game this year, which is ahead of the 2000 squad who holds the school record for hits in a season with 473 (averaged 7.5 per game) ... TERRA LOWE recorded two wins during the course of the week, giving the senior 36 career victories, which ranks fourth on Liberty's all-time career win list. Standing ahead of her in third place is fellow teammate Swor with 46 career victories ... Sophomore SARAH ELLIS came in to close out Liberty's 7-2 win over Winthrop on Friday, giving the hurler her third save of the year and the team it's sixth. The six saves on the year marks a new school record after Liberty's squad recorded five saves in 2006. The three saves ties Ellis for Liberty's single season record as Swor recorded three saves over the last two seasons as well as KATIE PHILLIPS doing so during the 1996 campaign ... The Lady Flames will begin the first of three-straight home weekend Big South Conference series this weekend when Liberty hosts Charleston Southern. The two teams will square off in a doubleheader on Friday and a single game on Saturday.

RADFORE

Radford won its school record ninth straight game with its game one win over Coastal Carolina. **ASHLEY CARLSON** moved up on the career and single season charts this weekend. She moved into second on the single-season hits list with 67, needing eight more to break the record. She also moved into second on the single-season steals (26) and tied for third in runs (38). Career wise, she is tied for second in steals (61) and ranks fifth in runs (97) ... Radford hit three doubles this weekend and need just three more to break the single-season record of 70 set back in 1997. They also need two more steals to reach the century mark.

WINTHROP

SARAH MAGEE was hit for the ninth time of the season on Friday. She had broken the season record of five and is the all-time leader with a total of 11. Her ninth HBP on the season scored the gamewinning run on Friday against Liberty ... Junior STEPHANIE REID is climbing the Winthrop All-Time leaders list in several categories. Reid is 10th all-time in runs (90), 11th all-time in doubles (23), tied for 4th all-time in home runs (14), 7th in total bases (222) and 10th in stolen bases (33) ... Senior DH/3B LAURA HILL is just four RBI away from becoming the fourth Lady Eagle to reach 100 for her career ... Senior 1B HILARY PEACOCK is at 90 for her career ... Senior catcher JENNY SCRYMGEOUR continues to have a great senior season as she's set career-highs in at-base, runs scores, hits, doubles, triples, home runs, RBI, total bases, walks, and snagged her first career stolen bases this year. She currently leads the Big South with 44 RBI. In the late innings, Winthrop had been very good at keeping its opponents from scoring, but struggled this past weekend against Liberty ... The Lady Eagles allowed 14 runs from the fifth inning and on. They had only allowed 16 runs in the seventh inning all season, but allowed 10 to Liberty, which included a 7-run seventh in the 12-11 victory.
