NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-2 this week in a three-game series on the road against Coastal Carolina, winning the first game, 2-1, but dropping the final two games, 9-6 and 9-0 ... Junior **LINDSAY CREIGHTON** leads Birmingham-Southern at the plate hitting .333, while sophomore **ANNE LAWRENCE** leads with 22 RBI. In the circle, junior **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** (15-13) leads with a 2.02 ERA.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Even with an 0-5 record on the week, possibly the most disappointing part of the week was losing top-pitcher **AMANDA NOBLE** to an ankle injury ... Freshman **JILLIAN LAFRANCE** hit .538 and had the only homerun of the week ... She was responsible for all four runs that CSU scored this week ... **WHITNEY JAMES** posted a team-low 4.67 ERA in three appearances, pitching nine innings ... LaFrance led the team with 11.1 innings, but with little run support, took three losses.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 2-2 this week picking up two wins over Birmingham-Southern ... To start the week CCU fell to the Winthrop Eagles 2-0 on Thursday, Apr. 19 ... Winthrop took an early 2-0 lead when **HILARY PEACOCK** hit a two-out, two RBI double to right center in the top of the first inning which proved to be the game-winning hit ... Coastal then hosted BSC for a three-game conference series ... Coastal fell in the first with a score of 2-1, but won the second 9-6 with back-to-back home runs from **GLYNN TOLLESON** and **ALLISON CANTRELL** ... Also in game two, **KRISTINA SHEPPARD** hit two home runs and finished the game going 2-for-3 with home runs in back-to-back innings ... In game three, Coastal scored six runs on six hits in the bottom of the third inning to beat the Birmingham-Southern Panthers 9-0 on Sunday afternoon to win the series 2-1 ... **DANYELLE GERDTS** led Coastal with three of its 11 hits and finished the day 3-for-4 ... Her sister, **ASHLEY GERDTS** picked up two hits and finished 2-for-2 at the plate. CCU improves to 17-30 overall and 5-5 in Big South Conference play.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames' victory over UNC Greensboro on Wednesday gave the team its 30th win of the year, marking the second-consecutive season and the seventh time in program history the Lady Flames have eclipsed the 30-win plateau ... Liberty's 1-0 victory over Radford in the first game of its weekend series gave Liberty its 11-straight win at home, marking the best start at home in program history. The Lady Flames are now 12-1 at home this year ... The Lady Flames belted 13 home runs last week, pushing the team's total to 63 on the season. Liberty now stands just three home runs short of last year's school record 66 round trippers ... **ASHLEY WILLIAMS** hit four home runs last week, giving the catcher 10 on the year. Liberty now has three players on its roster with 10 or more home runs (**DAWN JEFFS** with 13 and **JESSICA MOORE** with 16), marking the first time in program history the Lady Flames have had three 10-plus homer players on the same squad ... **SARAH ELLIS** came in to close out Liberty's 4-2 eight inning victory over UNC Greensboro, giving the sophomore her fourth save of the year which sets a new school record. **SARAH SWOR** (2005 and 2006) and Katie Phillips (1996) had previously held the record with three saves ... Moore scored a team-best 12 run last week, enabling the senior to become the school's all-time career runs scored leader. Moore, who accomplished the goal in just three seasons, entered the week tied with previous record holder Stacy Radulovich (167) and now has 179 career runs to her credit ... Senior **TERRA LOWE** struck out 32 batters on the week, giving the hurler 427 career strikeouts which is tied for fourth in school history along with Leslie Inge. Fellow teammate Sarah Swor is the school's all-time strikeouts leader with 461 career Ks.

RADFORD

ASHLEY CARLSON and **ASHLEY TAYLOR** broke single-season records last week ... Carlson recorded six hits on the week and broke the hits record against Liberty on Friday with her 75th base knock. The record of 74 was previously held by **MELISSA PICKEL** (1996). Carlson ended the week with 78 hits. Carlson also tied the stolen base record with her 32nd vs. Liberty on Saturday ... With her second strikeout against ETSU, Taylor broke the school's all-time career strikeout record of 213 set by her and teammate **BRE FELIX** in 2006. She finished the week with 16 strikeouts and currently has 228 ... As a team, Radford set the single season record for total bases with 639, breaking the mark of 631 set in 2005 ... They have also recorded the second most hits (429), home runs (37) and runs scored in school history ... They need 13 hits and six homers shy of those respective records.

WINTHROP

This season has been a record breaking season for the Lady Eagles ... Winthrop has already set single season records for runs (316), hits (494), RBI (274) and shutouts (18). Winthrop is just one victory away from tying the school mark for a single season. It is also just two doubles away from tying the school record ... Sophomore **LISA KINGSMORE** has had an outstanding season and on Saturday she set a single season record for hits with 74. The previous record was held by Winthrop Hall of Famer **CHRISTINE YON** (73, 1995) ... Freshman **MEGAN EVANS** has 20 wins in her first season and is just one win away from the freshman record of 21 wins ... That mark is held by 4-time All-Big South selection **KELLI JOHNSON** ... Senior **LAURA HILL** became just the fourth player in Winthrop history to record 100 or more RBI in a career. Hill had five RBI this past week and now has 101 ... Senior **JENNY SCRYMGEOUR** had three RBI over the weekend and now has 49 on the year. That is the second most RBI in a single season in Winthrop history. Yon holds the record at 57.
