NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC took a break from Conference action last week, facing Jacksonville State at home, Wednesday, Belmont on the road, Friday, and Troy at home, Saturday ... The Panthers split with JSU and Belmont but were swept by Troy ... In game one against Belmont, which BSC won 11-1, freshman **DANIELLE HONORE** hit a grand slam and a two-RBI double to tie the single-season RBI record, which she broke earlier this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs did not play a game this week, taking a break for final exams. They will return to action this Wednesday to face the College of Charleston for the second time, after dropping both games of a double header on April 18 ... Freshman **MEGAN HALL** continues to lead the team with a .279 batting average, edging out **AMY TRENKAMP**, who is hitting .275 this season, and leads the way with 39 hits ... Senior **TIFFANY REID** has a team-high 22 RBI, while **ASHLEY CONWAY** has 18 RBI.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal picked up two big wins at the College of Charleston on Wednesday, April 25 ... The Chanticleers scored five runs in the second inning of game one, winning 9-5. CCU won the second with a score of 5-2 ... **ALLISON CANTRELL** finished game one going 3-for-3 with a double, two RBIs and two walks ... **CARLA HOOD** was 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs ... In game two, **ALICIA IRWIN** went 2-for-2 and picked up her third double of the season ... CCU split a doubleheader with Liberty on Friday, April 27 ... Coastal was able to score a run in the eighth inning of game two for the 3-2 ... **KRISTINA SHEPPARD** gave the Chanticleers the 2-0 lead by hitting her ninth home run of the year, a two-run blast to right-center field. Coastal was unable to hold on in the third game with Liberty ... Four hits from the Flames in the bottom of the seventh was the difference that gave Liberty a 4-3 win over Coastal ... **ALLISON CANTRELL** was the offensive star for the Chants as she was 2-for-4 with two solo home runs, followed by **DANYELLE GERDTS** going 2-for-4 from the plate as well.

LIBERTY

Liberty took its fourth-straight Big South series of the year last weekend against Coastal Carolina, moving the Lady Flames into a tie for first place along with Winthrop ... Liberty enters the final weekend of league play with a 9-3 record, marking the team's third-highest conference victory total in program history. The 1999 squad set the school record with an 11-3 mark ... The Lady Flames have a chance to finish in first place for just the third time in program history as the 1999 squad tied for first with an 11-3 record and the 2000 team claimed the regular season title with a 9-1 mark ... **DAWN JEFFS'** two-run home run in the third inning of the final game against Coastal Carolina gave Liberty its 66th home run of the year, tying last year's team record for home runs ... Before traveling to Birmingham-Southern this weekend, the Lady Flames will host No. 18/23 Virginia Tech for a doubleheader on Tuesday. The pair of games will mark the team's 11th and 12th games against nationally-ranked opponents this year, setting a program record ... **TERRA LOWE** tossed her second no-hitter of the year and 11th in program history against Coastal Carolina on Friday during Liberty's series-opening 4-0 victory. During the contest, the senior tied a career high as she fanned 13 batters, including strikeouts for the first six outs of the game ... Jeffs hit safely in all five games last week, extending her hitting streak to 11-straight games. Her hitting streak is her second-longest of the year as the senior had a 14-game hitting streak earlier this year.

RADFORD

At Appalachian State, Radford broke the single-season hit record, breaking the 2005 mark of 441. They currently have 463 base knocks ... **ASHLEY CARLSON** broke the single-season steals record with her 33 swipe against Elon, breaking **SUZIE RATH'S** mark of 32 set back in 1996 ... Radford has hit 39 home runs, second most in school history and are just four shy of breaking the school record, it set last season ... The Highlanders' 38 wins are also three shy of breaking the school record of 40 set last season ... **JENN EVERHART** is currently on a five game hitting streak, hitting .500 (8-16) with two doubles and two RBIs.

WINTHROP

JENNY SCRYMGEOUR has enjoyed a fantastic senior season and currently leads the team with 49 RBI. Her RBI total is the second most in a single season in Winthrop history ... **CHRISTINE YON** holds the record with 57 ... Freshman pitcher **MEGAN EVANS** has had an outstanding first season with the Lady Eagles and has a record of 20-5 ... Her 20 victories is one shy of the freshman record for wins in a single season. She has 150 strikeouts this season, which moves her to 10th on the all-time list at Winthrop.
