Terrell led the Flames' offensive attack Saturday, rushing for 153 yards on 21 carries and a touchdown against Tusculum, which was last season's No. 2 rushing defense in NCAA Division II. His 1-yard touchdown run midway through the second quarter was Liberty's first TD of the year and allowed the Flames to re-take the lead at 10-7. He also caught two passes for 12 yards out of the backfield. The 153-yard total marked the third-best rushing performance of his Liberty career, and it was his seventh consecutive game with a rushing touchdown. Terrell also moved into the Big South's all-time Top 10 in career rushing yards, as he now ranks ninth in League history with 1,494.

NEW BALANCE
DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JOE TAYLOR • LB • R-Sophomore
 VMI • Richmond, Va.

Taylor made his first career start and played his first game at linebacker for the Keydets, and responded with a team-high 12 tackles (four solo, eight assists) in VMI's 20-0 season-opening win over Lock Haven. He was the only defender in double-digit stops and helped VMI to its first shutout in two years. Taylor also recorded a half-sack for minus-3 yards in helping the Keydet defense limit the Bald Eagles to 162 yards total offense, which was the best effort since Jim Reid took over as head coach in 2006. The Keydet defenders limited LHU to 66 rushing yards and 96 pass yards, also best marks during Reid's tenure.

LIBERTY, VMI KICKOFF 2007 SEASON WITH HOME WINS

Big South preseason favorite Liberty University won its fourth consecutive season opener this past Saturday, a 38-14 win over Tusculum. VMI also was victorious Saturday with its 20-0 shutout of Lock Haven and now has opened a season with a win three-straight years. The Flames will look to open 2-0 for the second time in as many years this coming Saturday when they host Shippensburg. VMI is looking for its first 2-0 start since 2002 when the Keydets were members of the SoCon. VMI is home Saturday vs. William & Mary.

FLAMES ON A WIN STREAK

Liberty's win over Tusculum was its fourth consecutive victory, dating back to last season. The last time the Flames won four consecutive games was in 2004 when Liberty closed out the campaign with four-straight wins to finish 6-5. Liberty's last five-game win streak was from 1992-93, when the Flames reeled off six consecutive wins during the crossover seasons. LU ended the 1992 season with three consecutive wins and then opened the 1993 season at 3-0.

NOT A REGULAR OCCURRENCE

Following its 23-18 loss at Delaware State Saturday, Coastal Carolina has lost two consecutive games for just the third time in team history. CCU first lost back-to-back games in its first season of 2003, and endured a two-game skid with a loss in the season finale in 2005 and the season opener of 2006. Coastal's loss prior to Delaware State was to eventual national champion Appalachian State in last year's FCS playoffs. The Chanticleers host Winston-Salem State Saturday and have never lost three consecutive ballgames, nor have started a season 0-2.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

VMI running back **NAT JACKSON** became the 16th player in Big South history to surpass the 1,000 career rushing yard milestone Saturday vs. Lock Haven. Jackson gained 80 yards vs. the Bald Eagles, pushing his career mark to 1,058 and grabbing the 15th spot from Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** (1,020 career yards). **TRAVIS MAYS** (Charleston Southern) is 14th all-time with 1,144 rushing yards.

I'VE GOT NEXT

Coastal Carolina fullback **MIKE TOLBERT** is 26 yards away from the Big South's 1,000-yard rushing club. He finished with 52 yards Saturday night at Delaware State to increase his career total to 974. Tolbert is looking to become the fourth Coastal Carolina player with 1,000 career rushing yards, joining **AUNDRES PERKINS** (2,343), **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) and **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638).

ROSS FOR LESS

Charleston Southern senior linebacker **JADA ROSS** is closing in on the Big South record for career tackles, as he is just 26 away from the all-time mark of 364, set by **JAMAR LEATH** (Coastal Carolina), which was established last season. Ross recorded 16 stops Saturday at The Citadel to push his career total to 339, and needs another nine to move into second-place. Below is a look at the top tacklers in Big South history:

RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

VMI true freshman **MICHAEL RAINEY-WILES** recorded the longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history when he scored an 83-yard touchdown run late in the fourth quarter Saturday vs. Lock Haven. Rainey-Wiles' effort surpassed the previous long of 80 yards, first set by Elon's **RASHAUD PALMER** vs. Liberty in 2002 and equalled last season by Coastal Carolina's **MIKE TOLBERT** vs. VMI. Rainey-Wiles finished with 91 rushing yards on seven carries vs. the Bald Eagles.

A GOOD DAY FOR A RUN

VMI's 397 team rushing yards Saturday vs. Lock Haven tied for the fifth-most in a single-game in Big South history, and was the most by a League member since Charleston Southern totaled 397 yards against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. The Keydets fell three yards shy of its first 400-yard rushing game since joining the Big South in 2003. The single-game team rushing record is 459 yards, set by Liberty against Norfolk State on Nov. 8, 2003.

PAT ON THE BACK

Charleston Southern kicker **NICK ELLIS** became the third kicker in Big South history with 100 career PAT kicks with his two PATs vs. The Citadel. Ellis is now 100-107 in his career (=93.5) and needs 18 PATs to move into second-place. Former Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE** is the League's career PAT leader with 177.

PLAYING CATCH UP

Liberty wide receivers **BRANDON TURNER** and **WYNTON JACKSON** became the 10th and 11th players, respectively, with 100 career receptions when they reached the milestone Saturday vs. Tusculum. Turner finished with four receptions to move to 101, while Jackson had three catches for exactly 100. Turner increased his career yardage total to 1,407 and moved into ninth in League history. Jackson is at 1,295 career yards and remains 11th all-time.

WHO'S NOW?

Charleston Southern junior WR **MARKUS MURRY** is on pace to become the 12th player with 1,000 career receiving yards, as he is at 933 following Week 1.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 46 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb has scored in each of its last 41 contests, followed by VMI (28), Charleston Southern (21) and Liberty (19).

CENTURY MARK

Two Big South coaches are likely to record their 100th career collegiate win this season. Coastal Carolina's **DAVID BENNETT** and Gardner-Webb's **STEVE PATTON** each entered the season with 97 career wins at the collegiate level. Bennett is 97-29, including a 34-12 mark at Coastal. Patton is 97-66-1 in his collegiate head coaching career, including a 67-43 record at the helm of the Bulldogs.

MORE WINNING STREAKS

In addition to Liberty's current four-game winning streak, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina are looking to extend win streaks as well. CSU has won its last nine home games and is three away from tying the Big South record of 12, set by Coastal Carolina. CSU's streak began Oct. 15, 2005 with a 63-42 win over West Virginia Wesleyan. The Bucs' home opener is set for Sept. 15 vs. Johnson C. Smith. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina has won its last five home games and faces Winston-Salem State in its first home game this Saturday, Sept. 8.

HEAD RUSH

Liberty junior RB **ZACH TERRELL** is the Big South's leading active rusher with 1,494 career rushing yards, and moved into the League's all-time Top 10 this past weekend. He is currently ninth and needs 61 yards for the eighth spot. Terrell also stands 506 rushing yards shy of becoming the fifth player in Big South history with 2,000 rushing yards. Meanwhile, Terrell has scored a rushing touchdown in his last seven games (dating back to 2006) and has 11 in that span.

FLAG(LER) ON THE PLAY

Gardner-Webb wide receiver **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** is approaching the No. 2 spot on the Big South's career reception chart. He hauled in seven passes Saturday at Ohio to push his career total to 135, and needs 16 catches to tie **ZOHN BURDEN** (VMI) for second at 151. Flagler is fourth all-time in receiving yards at 1,820, and needs 116 yards to catch Burden (1,936).

HE MAKES IT LOOK SO SIMP-LE

Coastal Carolina senior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** -- the active career touchdown reception leader in FCS with 34 -- has caught a touchdown pass in his last nine games (13 total) following his 33-yard TD catch Saturday at Delaware State. He his seventh all-time in the Big South in receptions (123) and second in yardage (2,091). Simpson is the Big South's career leader with 34 touchdown receptions -- 27.6 percent of his 123 receptions.

200 POINTS

Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** became the fourth player in Big South history to score 200 points in a career when he scored on a 33-yard touchdown reception Saturday at Delaware State. Simpson now has 204 career points. Of the four players in League history with 200 points, three are from Coastal Carolina: Simpson, **JOSH HOKE** (297) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286).

ROLL CALL

Liberty, which set Big South attendance records last year for per game average and overall, drew 14,925 fans to Saturday's season opener vs. Tusculum, the second-largest crowd in Big South history. The figure now gives Liberty each spot in the top 10 for highest single-game attendance in Conference annals.

BIG SOUTH SPRINKLED ON NFL ROSTERS

With Saturday, Sept. 1 as the final cut-down day in the NFL, the Big South had several former players make NFL rosters. Newest additions include former Coastal Carolina standouts **TYLER THIGPEN** (Kansas City Chiefs) and **QUINTON TEAL** (Carolina Panthers). Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** is currently on the Chiefs' injured reserve list. Former Liberty RB **SAMKON GADO** will begin his second season with the Houston Texans.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOHNSTON CANDIDATE FOR NATIONAL AWARD

Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is one of 27 college football players named to the 2007 Ted Hendricks Defensive End of the Year Award Preseason Watch List. The award is presented annually to the top defensive end in college football, and Johnston is the lone student-athlete from an FCS program. The Watch List also includes preseason FBS All-Americans **CALAIS CAMPBELL** (Miami) and **DERRICK HARVEY** (Florida).

BIG SOUTH ADDS STONY BROOK AS ASSOCIATE MEMBER

On March 20, 2007, the Big South Conference added Stony Brook University as an associate member in football. Stony Brook will begin competing in the Big South in the 2008 season and will immediately be eligible for the League's championship. The addition of Stony Brook will give the Big South six Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) members in 2008. Presbyterian College will officially join the Big South in 2008-09 and will be considered an Independent this season. Next year, PC will be included in Conference scheduling, but as part of its transition to Division I, the Blue Hose will not count in the League standings nor be eligible for the football championship until 2011-12. The Big South will have six core playing members beginning in 2008 and will be eligible to qualify for an automatic bid to the FCS playoffs in 2010.
