Jennings tied a Big South season record with his seventh 100-yard rushing game of the year as he rushed for 114 yards in Liberty's 31-0, Conference-championship victory at Gardner-Webb. Jennings also hauled in two receptions for 60 yards, including a 52-yard scoring play to give Liberty an early 14-0 lead. He finished the afternoon with 174 all-purpose yards against the Bulldogs.

NEW BALANCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

STEVEN ACKLEY • DE • Senior
 Liberty • Columbia, Tenn.

Ackley capped off his career with four solo tackles, two of which were for losses totaling 10 yards, and a sack, in Liberty's 31-0 win at Gardner-Webb. He also forced a fumble and helped the Flames' defense hold Gardner-Webb to 187 total offensive yards, 10 first downs (zero rushing), 16 net rushing yards, seven drives of three plays-or-less, and just 22:13 in time of possession.

Maypray set a Big South single-game record with 204 kickoff return yards against The Citadel, including a Conference-record 99-yarder for a score to open the second half. He became the second player in Big South history with two kickoff return touchdowns in one season, and he finished the day averaging 29.1 yards on seven kickoff returns. Maypray, who also set the school record for season kickoff return yardage with 889, recorded his fifth 200 all-purpose yard game of the season and increased his Big South all-purpose record total to 1,975 yards.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

JEFFREY WILLIAMS • LB
 Gardner-Webb • Frisco City, Ala.

Williams set a new career-high with 17 tackles against Liberty, including nine solo stops, a half tackle for loss and a pass break-up in the season finale against the Flames. It was his seventh double-digit tackle game of the year and a career-high for solo hits. Williams finished second in the Big South in total tackles (120) and tackles per game (10.9) this season, and ranked No. 2 among all Division I freshman in hits per game in 2007.

LIBERTY CAPS RECORD BREAKING SEASON WITH FIRST BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP

Preseason Big South favorite Liberty shutout Gardner-Webb this past Saturday, 31-0, to win the outright Big South football championship with a perfect 4-0 record in League action. The Flames, which were 1-10 overall and 0-4 in Conference in 2005, is the third Big South team to go undefeated in League play, joining Gardner-Webb (2002, 2003) and Coastal Carolina (2004, 2006). Liberty set several Big South records during its championship run, which are detailed below.

LIBERTY SETS NUMEROUS BIG SOUTH SCORING RECORDS (PART ONE)

Liberty scored a Big South single-season record 469 points in 2007, breaking the old mark of 413 points set by Coastal Carolina in 2004. The Flames broke the season record with its Big South single-game record 73 points against VMI in Week 11. Liberty became the first Big South team to average more than 40 points a season (42.6), scored at least 30 points in a game a Big South-record 10 times (breaking the old mark of eight), and had five games with at least 40 points -- tying the Conference record set by Coastal Carolina in 2004. In addition, the Flames established the Big South record for most touchdowns scored with 61, eclipsing the previous best of 55 touchdowns by Coastal in 2004, while their 53 offensive TDs tied the Conference mark.

LIBERTY SETS NUMEROUS BIG SOUTH SCORING RECORDS (PART TWO)

Continuing on with Liberty's record-setting championship season, the Flames also set the Big South mark for most points scored in a League slate (191 points). The old record was 148 points by Gardner-Webb in four Conference games in 2003. Liberty's scoring margin during the Big South season was 30.8 points per game, well above the previous best of 22.3 (Gardner-Webb in 2003). The Flames became the first team in Conference history with two 50-point games against Big South opponents in the same season, and is the first team in League annals to score 30 points in all four Conference games (NOTE: Gardner-Webb scored at least 30 points in its three League games in 2002 when each team played a three-game Conference schedule).

JENNINGS SETS TWO TOUCHDOWN RECORDS IN 2007

Liberty RB RASHAD JENNINGS scored on a 52-yard pass play at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday for his Big South-record 17th touchdown of the season. He broke the old mark of 16, set by Coastal Carolina WR JEROME SIMPSON in 2006. Jennings also finished the 2007 campaign with a Conference-record 15 rushing touchdowns. The old mark was 14, held by Coastal Carolina's AUNDRES PERKINS and Liberty's EUGENE GOODMAN in 2003. Jennings set the Big South single-season scoring record this year with 104 points, and tied the League mark for most consecutive multi-touchdown games (five).

ZACH ATTACK CLOSES OUT SEASON WITH STREAK INTACT

Liberty junior RB ZACH TERRELL extended his rushing touchdown scoring streak to 16 games with a 3-yard run at Gardner-Webb Saturday. He has scored 21 touchdowns in that span, increasing his career total to 26, good for sole possession of second all-time in Big South history. The Conference's career rushing touchdown record is 46, held by Coastal Carolina's AUNDRES PERKINS.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty kicker NOAH GREENBAUM became the first kicker in Big South history to score 100 points in a season, as he ended the 2007 campaign with a kick scoring record 101 points. Greenbaum also set League records for season PATs (56-of-59), single-game PATs (10-of-10) and most 10-point kicking games (five). His 15 field goals led the Big South and are the second-most in a season.

CONFERENCE GAME WIN STREAKS

The Liberty Flames will carry a six-game Conference game win streak into 2008, currently the longest streak in the League. The Big South record for consecutive League wins is eight, held by Coastal Carolina from 2003-05. Coastal Carolina ended the 2007 season with two consecutive Big South wins as well.

BIG SOUTH GROWTH CHART

The Big South played its final season with five football members in 2007, as the League will jump to six football members in 2008 with Stony Brook University joining as an associate member. The Seawolves will be immediately eligible for the League's championship. The addition of Stony Brook will give the Big South six core Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) members beginning in 2008 and the League will be eligible to qualify for an automatic bid to the FCS playoffs in 2010. The Big South will officially have seven football-playing members in 2011 once Presbyterian completes its transition to Division I and receives full status by the NCAA.

TOUGHEST SCHEDULE EVER

The Big South played arguably its toughest non-Conference schedule in the League's six-year history this season, as 18 of the League's 20 non-Conference losses came against the nation's top programs (four of the losses were to Football Bowl Subdivision [FBS] opponents). Excluding Presbyterian, the combined final regular-season record of the FCS opponents the Big South faced was 71-39 (=.645 percent). Six losses came against teams that received an FCS playoff berth (Appalachian State, Delaware State, James Madison, Wofford), four were at the hands of programs that later entered the Top 25 (Elon, The Citadel, Georgia Southern), and the remaining four defeats came against opponents that received votes in either *The Sports Network* or FCS Coaches Polls (William & Mary, Lehigh, Furman) during the season.

HONEST ABEGESAH

VMI sophomore FB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** failed to lead the Keydets in rushing this past Saturday against The Citadel, marking the first time all season that Abegesah was not VMI's top rusher in a game. However, Abegesah still gained enough yards (44) to finish as the Big South's leading rusher with 1,121 -- the fourth-most in a season and just eight ahead of Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** (1,113). It is the second-straight year that a VMI runner led the Big South in rushing, and Jennings has fallen just short of the title for the second consecutive season. In 2006, Keydet RB **SEAN MIZZER** led the Big South with 1,022 rushing yards, outgaining Jennings by two yards. Meanwhile, the Big South produced two 1,000-yard rushers for the third time in the Conference's six years of football.

WHAT A RUSH!

VMI established the Big South season record for rushing yards, gaining 3,115 yards on the ground and breaking the previous record of 3,058 (Coastal Carolina in 2004). The Keydets averaged a Conference record 283.2 rushing yards per game, breaking the old mark of 278.0 (Coastal Carolina in 2004). The Keydets, which were just the second team to gain more than 3,000 yards, also set a Big South record for rush attempts in a season with 647. VMI finished as the League's leader in rushing offense in consecutive seasons, as the Keydets led the Conference last year with 206.6 rushing yards per game.

TWO BILLS

In addition to VMI, Liberty (215.9) and Coastal Carolina (207.0) also averaged 200 yards rushing per game, marking the first time three teams averaged 200 rushing yards in the same season in Big South history.

JENNINGS' JAUNTS

Liberty junior RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** tied the Big South season record with his seventh 100-yard rushing performance of the season with his 114 rushing yards at Gardner-Webb. He also became just the second player in Conference history with back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons, joining former Liberty rusher **DRE BARNES** (2002, 2003). Jennings' 2007 season total of 1,113 rushing yards is fifth-most in Big South history. In 20 career games with the Flames, Jennings has rushed for 100 yards 12 times, including seven games over 160.

2,000-YARD ODYSSEY

Liberty running back duo **ZACH TERRELL** and **RASHAD JENNINGS** each surpassed 2,000 career rushing yards against VMI in Week 11, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau. They flipped each other to close out the season, as Jennings stands fifth all-time in Big South history with 2,133 career rushing yards, just ahead of sixth-place Terrell (2,104). Jennings will enter his senior season next year needing 1,276 yards to tie the all-time rushing record of 3,409, held by Liberty's **DRE BARNES**.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS

The Big South recorded 19 return touchdowns this season. The breakdown is as follows: interceptions (5), punt returns (5), fumble returns (4), kickoff returns (4) and a blocked field goal return (1). Liberty returned a Big South-record four punt returns for touchdowns, and tied the Conference record with three INT scores. Charleston Southern's three fumble return touchdowns are a Big South record as well.

ALL FOR ONE

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** finished the 2007 season with the Big South single-season record for all-purpose yards with 1,975 following his fifth game with 200, as he collected 224 vs. The Citadel this past Saturday. Maypray set a Big South single-game record with 204 kickoff return yards, including a Conference-best 99-yarder for a score. He is the second player in Big South history with two kickoff return touchdowns in one season. Maypray averaged a record 179.5 all-purpose yards per game, and established a VMI and Big South single-game record with 346 all-purpose yards vs. Charleston Southern in Week 10.

BIG SOUTH ENJOYS HIGHEST-SCORING CONFERENCE SEASON TO DATE

The 10 Big South Conference games this season combined for 587 points, breaking the previous high of 568 points, set last year. This season's 58.7 combined points per game is the second-highest average in League history, falling shy of the season record of 60.3, set in 2002 during a six-game League slate. Liberty and VMI combined to score 107 points in Week 11, the most combined points in a regulation game and matching the League record, set by Gardner-Webb (55) and VMI (52) in triple-over-time in 2005.

FIRST AND TEN

Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** hauled in a 41-yard touchdown catch at Charleston Southern Saturday, ending the season with seven TD receptions in his last four games and finishing his senior year with 11. Simpson became the first player in Big South history with two 10-touchdown catch seasons when he reached the mark in Week 11, and he departs Coastal with 44 career touchdown receptions -- tied for fourth all-time in NCAA FCS history.

50-50 RAFFLE

Gardner-Webb receiving duo **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (59) and **DOBSON COLLINS** (51) are the second set of teammates in Big South history with at least 50 receptions in the same season. The first group was Charleston Southern's **EDDIE GADSON** (69) and **HARRY SEABROOK** (54) in 2004. Flagler is the first and only player in Conference history with three 50-catch seasons. The senior wideout hauled in 64 passes as a junior in 2006 and caught 55 balls in 2005.

BIG SOUTH 1,000-YARD RUSHING CLUB

The Big South's 1,000-yard career rushing list stands at 19 members with the conclusion of the 2007 season. The club added two members in Week 11, as VMI's **HOWARD ABEGESAH** and Gardner-Webb's **DAVID MONTGOMERY** reached the milestone. The Big South had six active 1,000-yard career rushers on the field in the final week of the season. The 1,000-yard career rushing list appears below.

JADA, COMIN' ATTYA

Charleston Southern senior linebacker **JADA ROSS** concluded his career Saturday against Coastal Carolina with 17 tackles, pushing his season total to a League-best 131 and becoming the first player in Conference history to lead the League in tackles in consecutive seasons. He was tops in 2006 with 127 stops, and his 131 this year are third-most in a single-season in Big South history. Ross departs CSU as the Big South's all-time leading tackler with 454. He became the Big South's all-time leading tackler during Week 4 at Hawai'i and became the first player in the Conference with 400 career tackles in Week 8 vs. Liberty.

AT A LOSS FOR WORDS

Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON**, a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, set the single-season Big South record for TFL with 24.0 stops behind the line for minus-115 yards. The previous mark was held by former teammate **HAROLD WELLS**, who posted 22.5 TFL in 2004. Johnston had a TFL in nine of 11 outings, including five games with at least 3.0 tackle-for-loss, and departs as the Big South's career leader with 53.5 TFL.

SACK IT TO ME

Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** also departs the Big South as the Conference's all-time leader in quarterback sacks with 20.5, just ahead of graduating Coastal Carolina DL **ADRIN GRADY** (19.0). Grady entered the season as the all-time leader, but Johnston surpassed Grady in Week 6 at Appalachian State. Grady reclaimed the title in Week 7 vs. Chowan, only to see Johnston regain the lead for good in Week 8 at VMI.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 56 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Gardner-Webb saw its 50-game streak with a point scored end this past Saturday vs. Liberty. Charleston Southern narrowly extended its point scoring streak to 31 games over the weekend, as the Bucs needed a defensive extra point against Coastal Carolina to crack the scoreboard. Meanwhile, VMI (38) and Liberty (27) extended their respective scoring streaks to close out the 2007 campaign.

SIMPSON CONCLUDES CAREER AMONG BIG SOUTH GREATS

Coastal Carolina senior WR **JEROME SIMPSON** departs the Big South as just the second player in Conference history with 40 career touchdowns, cradling in a career record 44 TD pass receptions in his four years. Simpson also graduates as the Big South's career leader in receiving yards (2,720), and finished third all-time in receptions (161). He caught 27.3 percent of his career receptions for touchdowns.

FLAG(LER) ON THE PLAY

Gardner-Webb wide receiver **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** graduates as the second-leading receiver in Big South history in the three major categories (receptions, yardage and touchdowns). Flagler, who moved into second in career receptions in Week 5 vs. Austin Peay, finishes with 188 career catches, falling 14 shy of the all-time record of 202 receptions, held by Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE**. Flagler surpassed Price (2,429) in Week 10 for second all-time in career yardage, and ends at 2,552 in his career. Flagler became the second player in Big South history with 30 career TD catches (31) in Week 10 as well.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Charleston Southern WR **DEE BROWN** finished as the League's leader in receptions with 69. Brown continues a Charleston Southern tradition, as a Bucs receiver has led or shared the Big South lead in receptions every year of Big South football. The lone "shared" year was in 2002, when CSU's **AARON DUNKLIN** and Gardner-Webb's **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** co-led the Big South with 45 receptions.

Charleston Southern kicker **NICK ELLIS** became the third kicker and fifth player overall with 200 career points during Week 9 at Gardner-Webb, and departs fifth all-time in scoring with 214 points, behind K **JOSH HOKE** (297), RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286), WR **JEROME SIMPSON** (264) and K **HUNTER SMITH** (228).

BROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** became the fifth QB in Big South history with 4,000 career passing yards, reaching the milestone vs. VMI in Week 11. He is currently at 4,416 and sits 680 yards from the fourth spot. Smith has climbed up the Big South passing record book, as he is fourth in touchdown passes (31), fifth in completions (305) and sixth in attempts (528).

PAT ON THE BACK

Charleston Southern kicker **NICK ELLIS** graduates second all-time in Big South history in career PATs, as he was 127-135 (=94.1 percent) in his career. He surpassed Gardner-Webb's **HUNTER SMITH** in Week 8, who had 118 point-after-touchdown kicks from 2003-06.

EIGHT IS NOT ENOUGH

Liberty extended its Big South-leading home winning streak to a school-record eight games with its 73-34 win over VMI in Week 11. The Flames posted its first 6-0 home season, its most wins at Williams Stadium in school history. In its current streak, Liberty is averaging 44.3 points and holding opponents to 16.3 points per game. Liberty's next home game is in 2008.

THE BEST DEFENSE IS A GOOD OFFENSE

Coastal Carolina's **SANTINI WASHINGTON** played both wide receiver and defensive back against Gardner-Webb in Week 11, becoming the first player in school history to play on both sides of the ball. Washington caught a pass, and recorded four tackles, a TFL and an interception. In Week 10, Gardner-Webb DE **BRIAN JOHNSTON** caught a 3-yard touchdown pass vs. Savannah State, becoming the first defensive player in the Big South to score an offensive touchdown since Gardner-Webb DL **HAROLD WELLS** recorded eight rushing TDs for the Bulldogs in 2004.

TWO COACHES REACH 100-WIN MILESTONES WITHIN A WEEK OF EACH OTHER

Gardner-Webb head coach **STEVE PATTON** and Coastal Carolina leader **DAVID BENNETT** each recorded their 100th career coaching win this season. In Week 8, Patton captured his 100th collegiate win in GWU's 36-22 victory at VMI. It was Patton's third attempt at the century mark, and he is now 102-71-1 in his collegiate head coaching career, including a 72-48 record at the helm of the Bulldogs. His record in Big South games stands at 15-8 (=.652 percent).

Bennett notched his 100th win in Week 9 following Coastal's dramatic, come-from-behind win over VMI, 42-35, to open Big South play. It was Bennett's second attempt at the milestone victory. He is now 102-34 in his career, including a 39-17 mark at Coastal (15-5 Big South record).

BIG SOUTH SETS SINGLE-SEASON ATTENDANCE RECORD

As a League, the five Big South football members drew a record 209,668 fans through 28 home dates, a record average of 7,488. Last season, the Big South enjoyed a record average of 6,838 and total attendance of 191,476 in 28 home dates. Liberty averaged 14,190 fans this season, breaking the school and Big South single-season record for average attendance and overall (85,140).

PRESBYTERIAN FINISHES FIRST DIVISION I SEASON 6-5, 2-2 VS. FUTURE BIG SOUTH FOES

Future Big South member Presbyterian College finished its first season at the FCS level with a 28-24 loss at Charleston Southern, ending the 2007 campaign with a 6-5 record. PC went 2-2 against future Conference members and played the four games on the road. The lone League foe PC did not face in 2007 was Gardner-Webb. Presbyterian College will officially join the Big South in 2008-09 and is considered an Independent this season. Next year, PC will be included in Conference scheduling, but as part of its transition to Division I, the Blue Hose will not count in the League standings and statistics, nor be eligible for the football championship until 2011-12.

STONY BROOK CONCLUDES SEASON AT 6-5

Stony Brook threw a scare into No. 24 Elon this past Saturday, pulling to within eight points late before a late score enabled the Phoenix to gain a 38-23 win over the Seawolves in their final football game of the season, ending the year at 6-5. Of the Seawolves' five losses, four were to ranked teams (Youngstown State, Hofstra, Richmond, Elon), and two were by five points-or-less (Hofstra, Albany). Earlier this season, the Seawolves received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 poll for three-straight weeks, and were ranked in the outlet's "Mid-Major" Top 10 poll as well.
